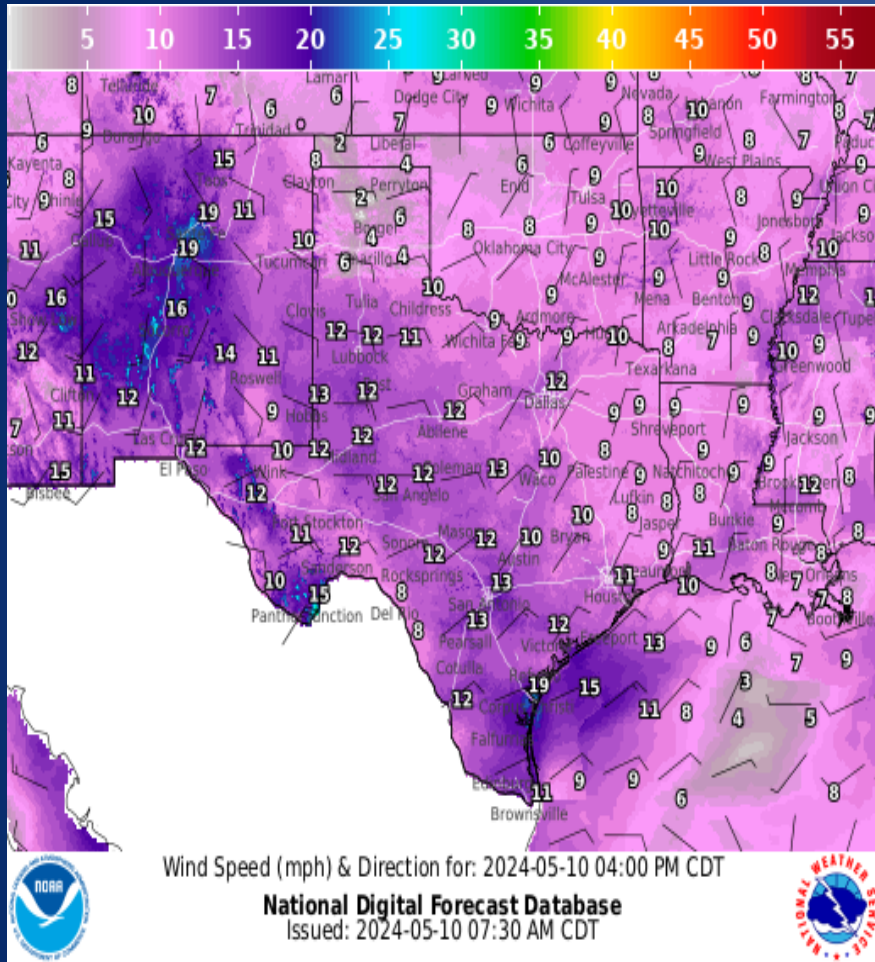

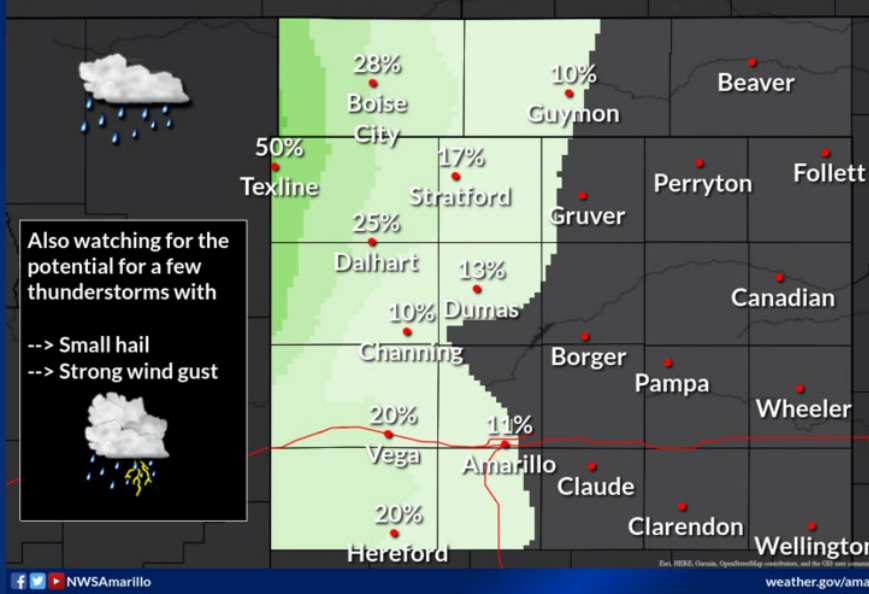

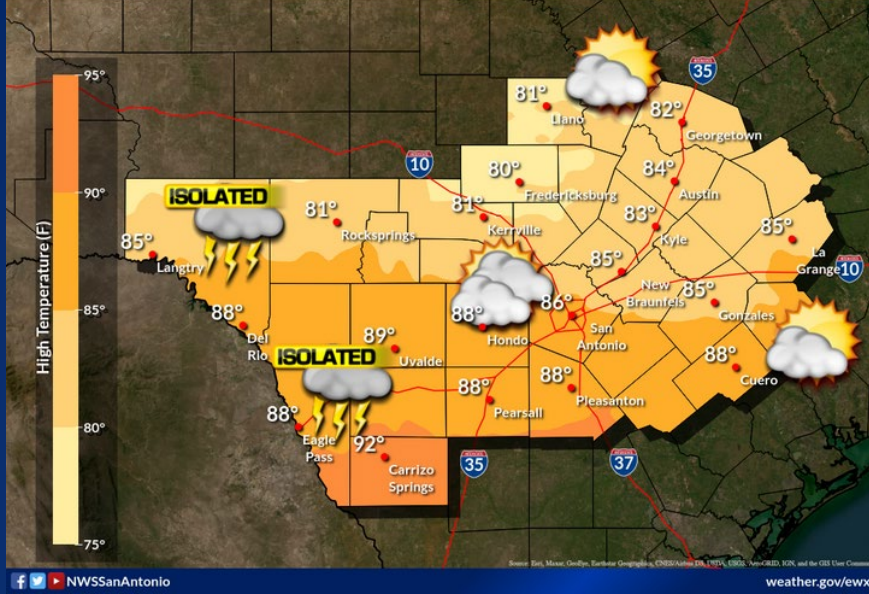

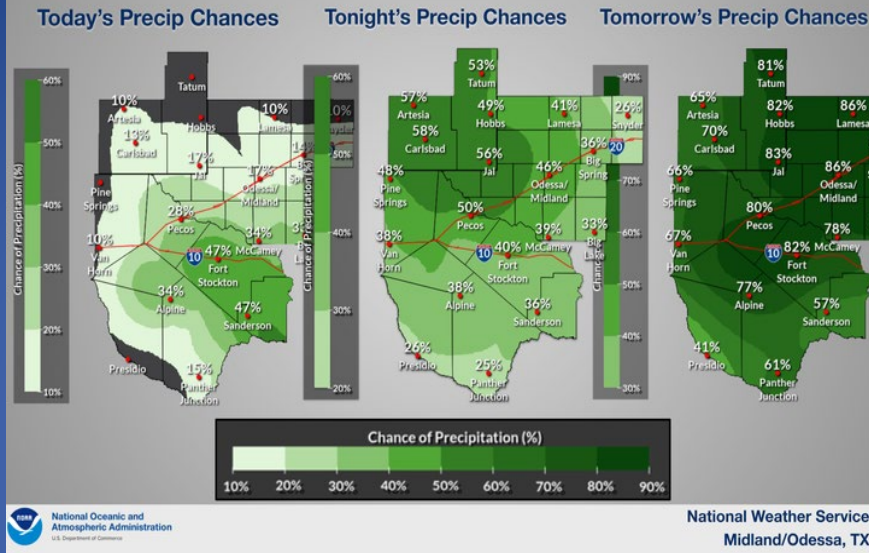


Rainfall Chances Increase

There are good chances the area will see beneficial rainfall through the weekend.



A cold front has brought increased moisture into the area. An approaching upper disturbance will cause rain chances to increase today in the lower Trans Pecos and Big Bend, then spread north and east into the remainder of the area. Rain amounts will range from a couple of tenths of an inch in the west to an inch or more in the eastern Permian Basin.

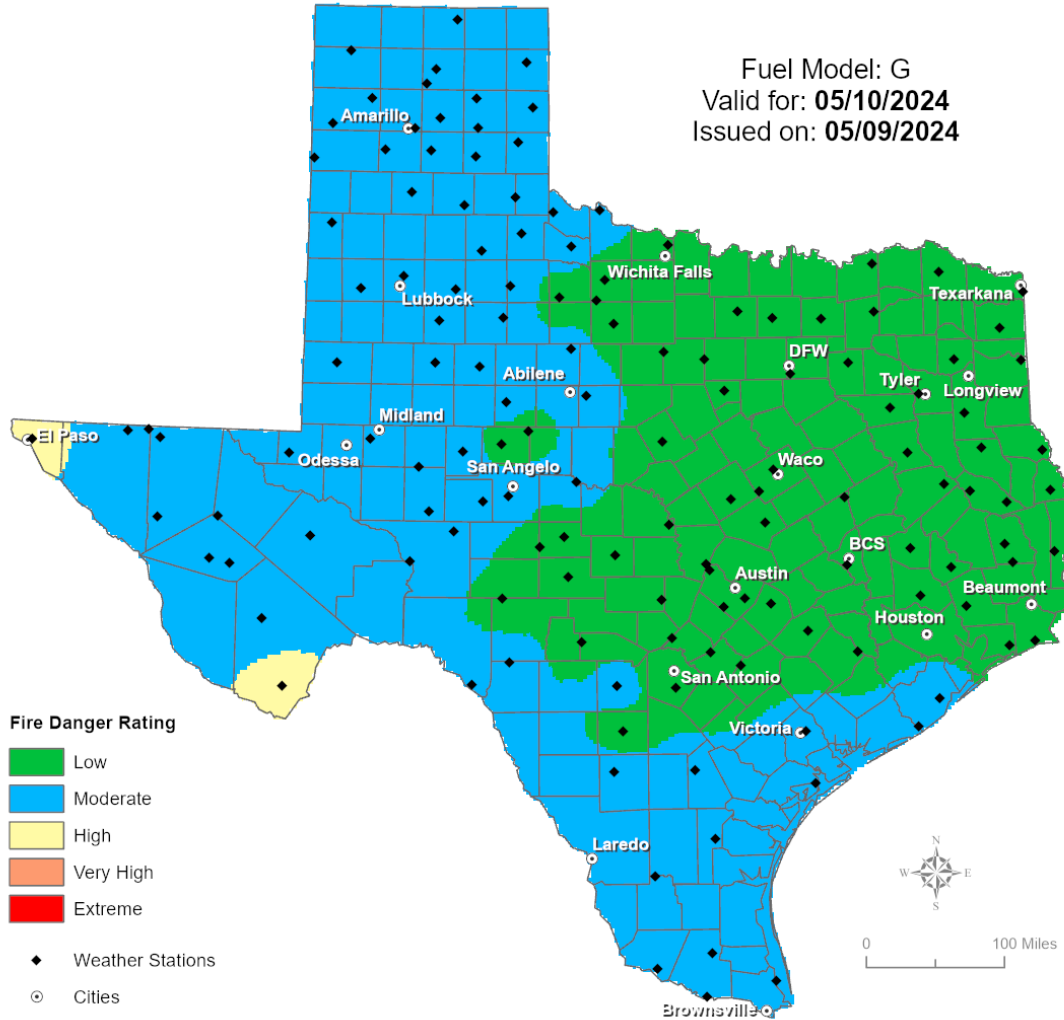

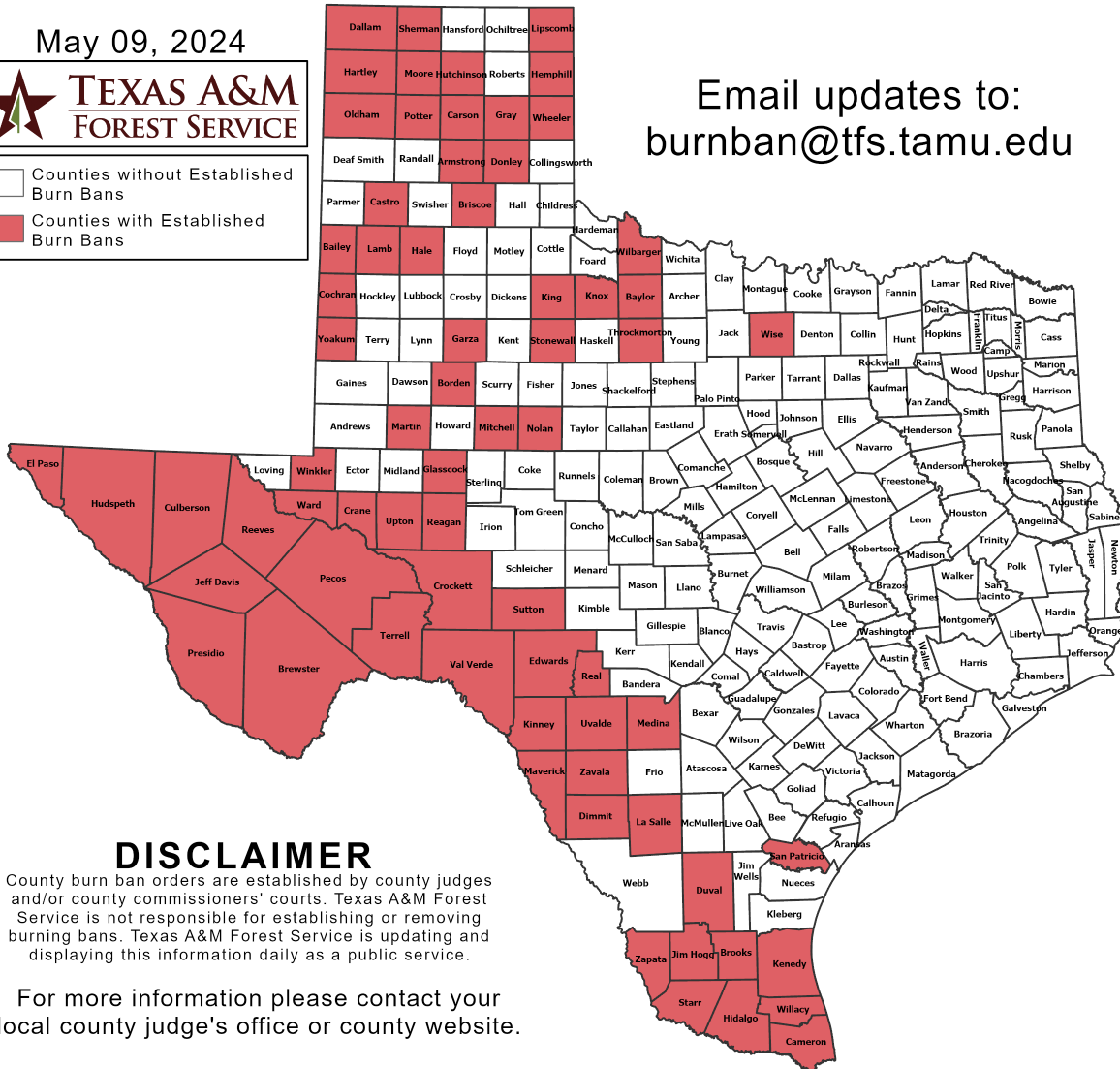

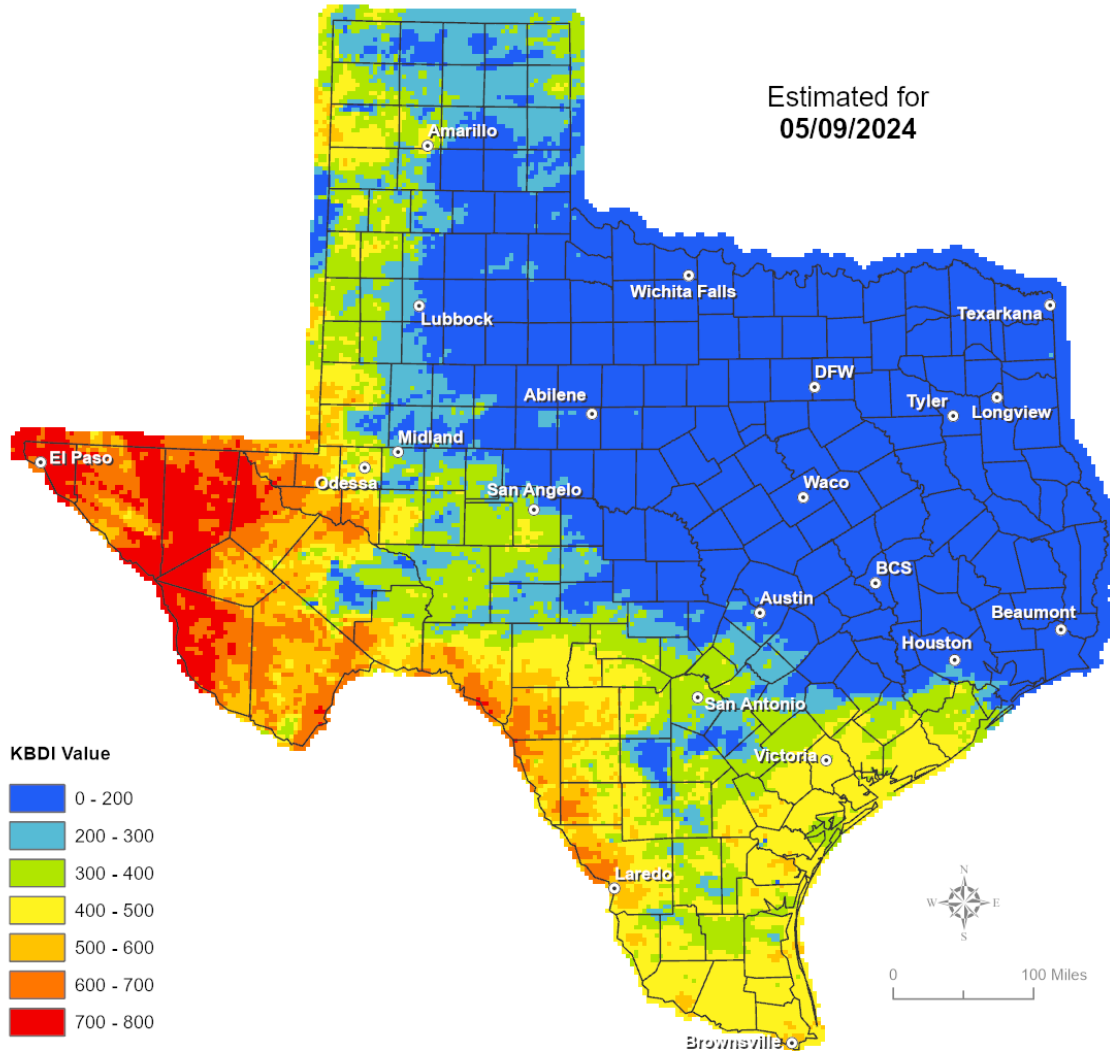

Keetch-Byram Drought Index

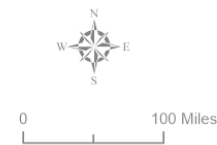
Keetch-Byram Drought Index

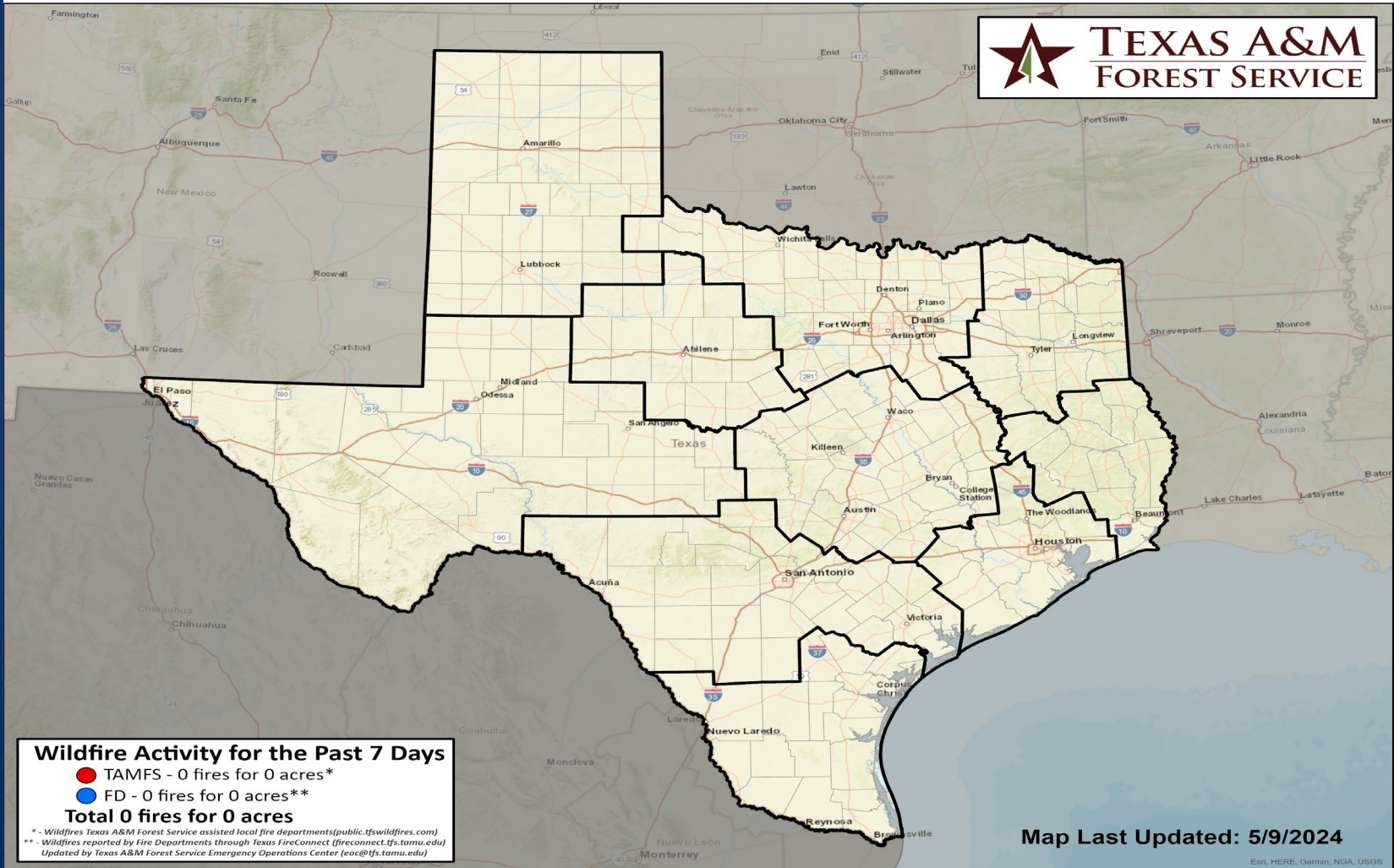
