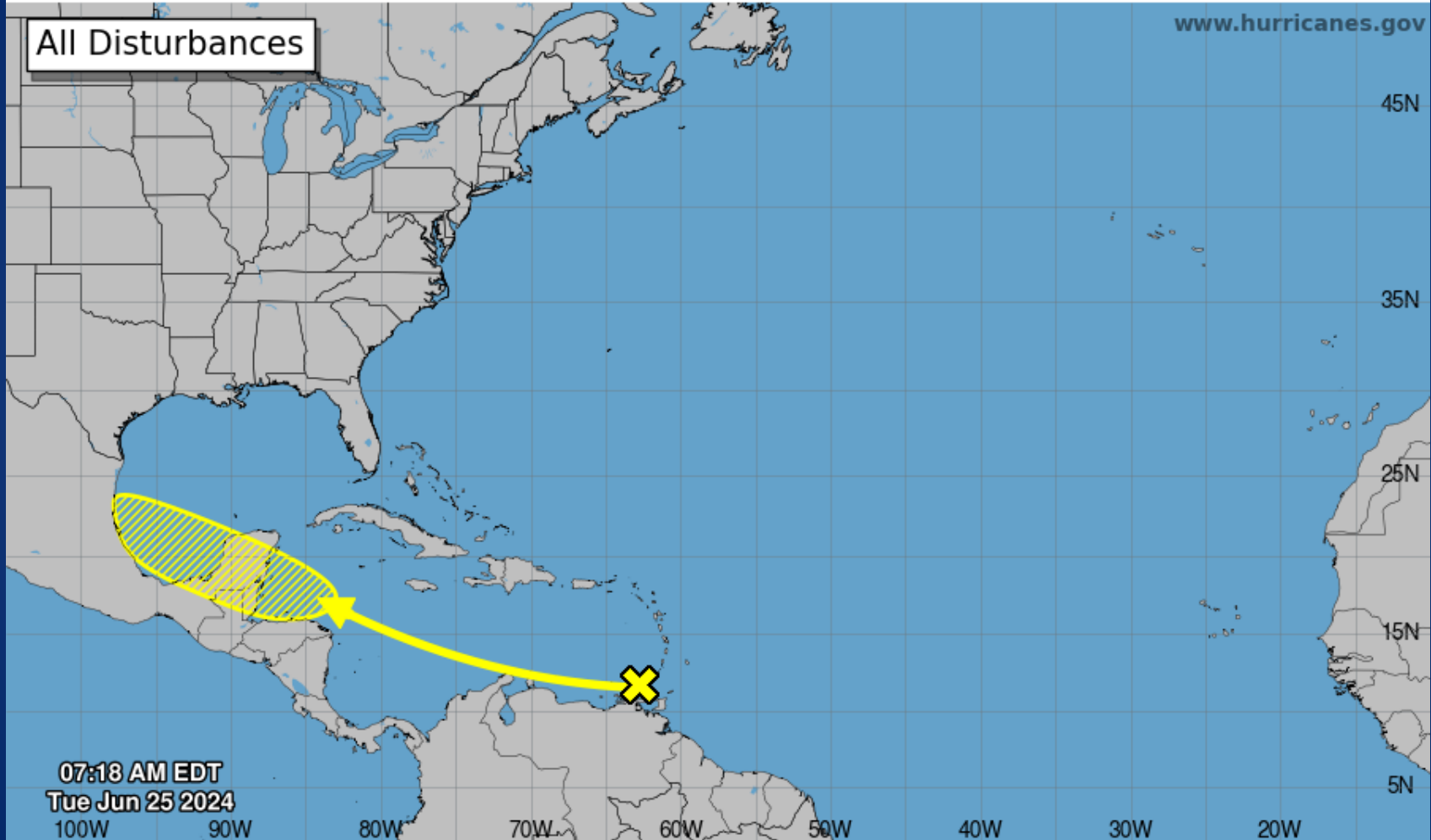
Seven-Day Graphical Tropical Weather Outlook

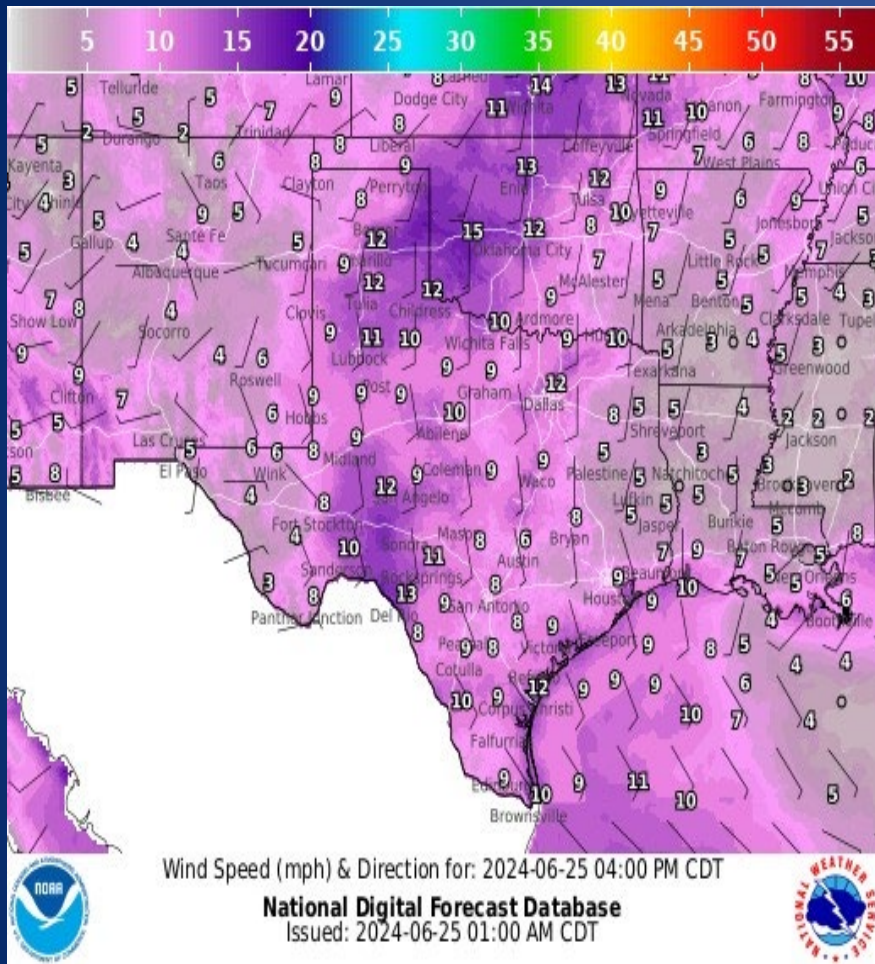

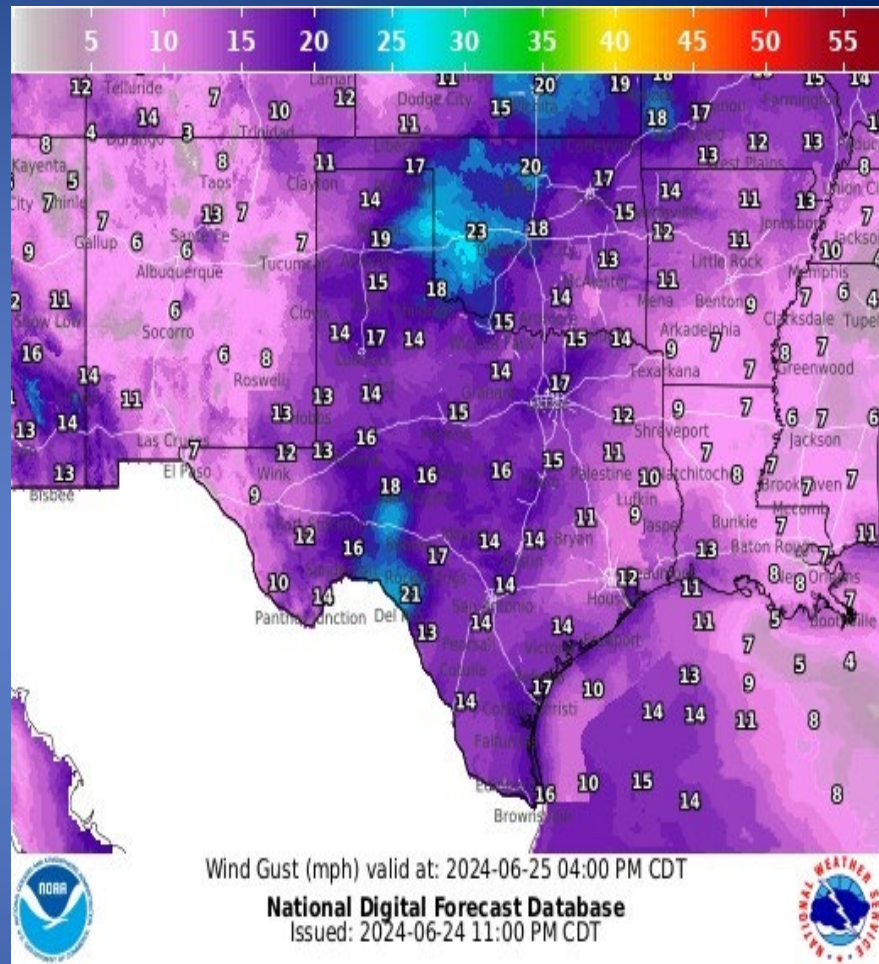

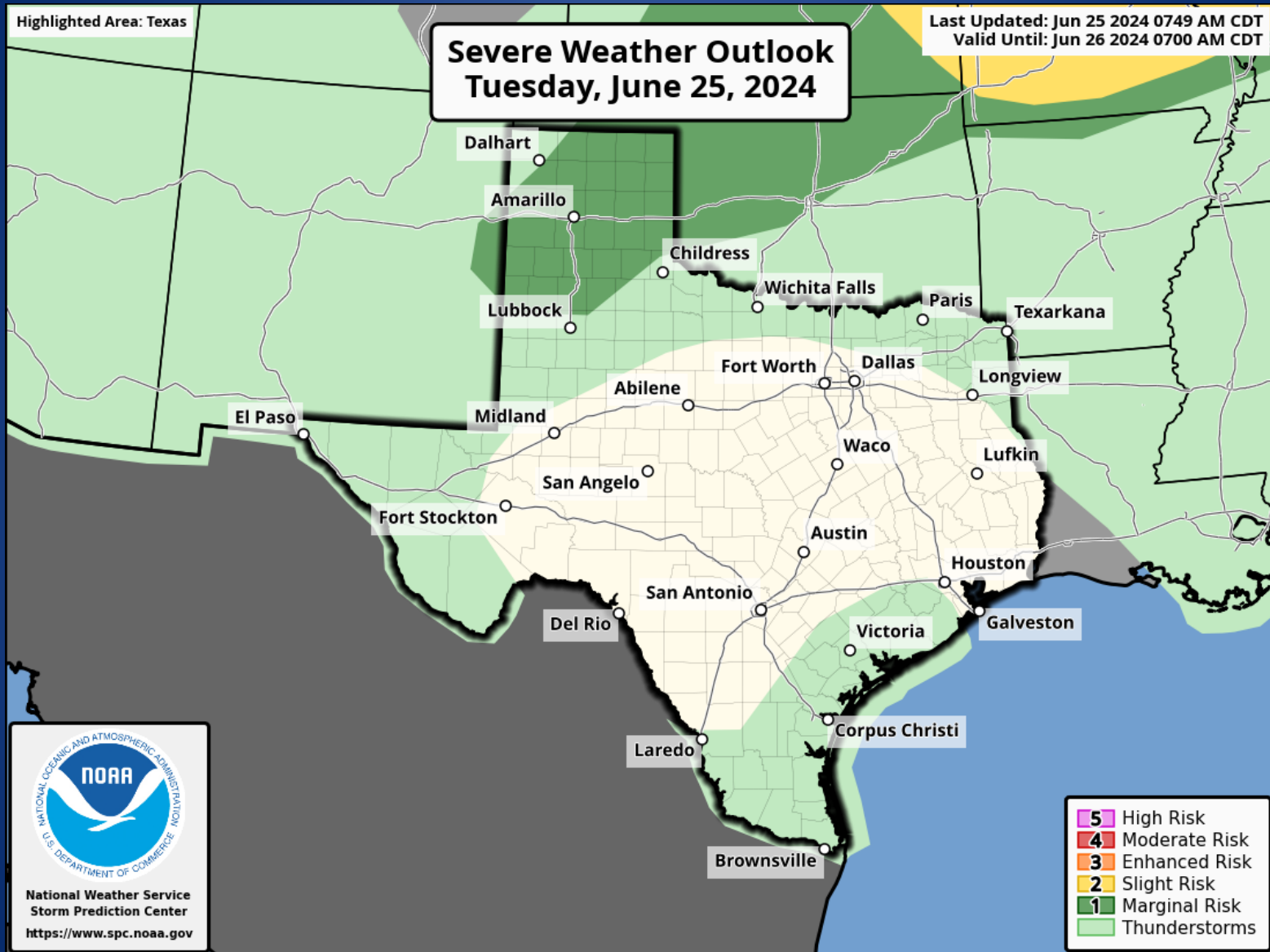

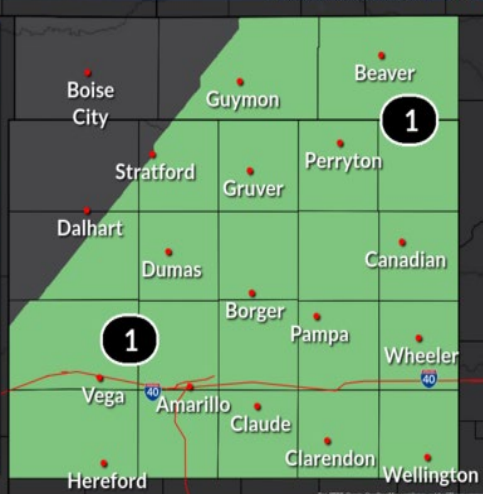

HOT! It will remain hot and humid outside of any thunderstorms.

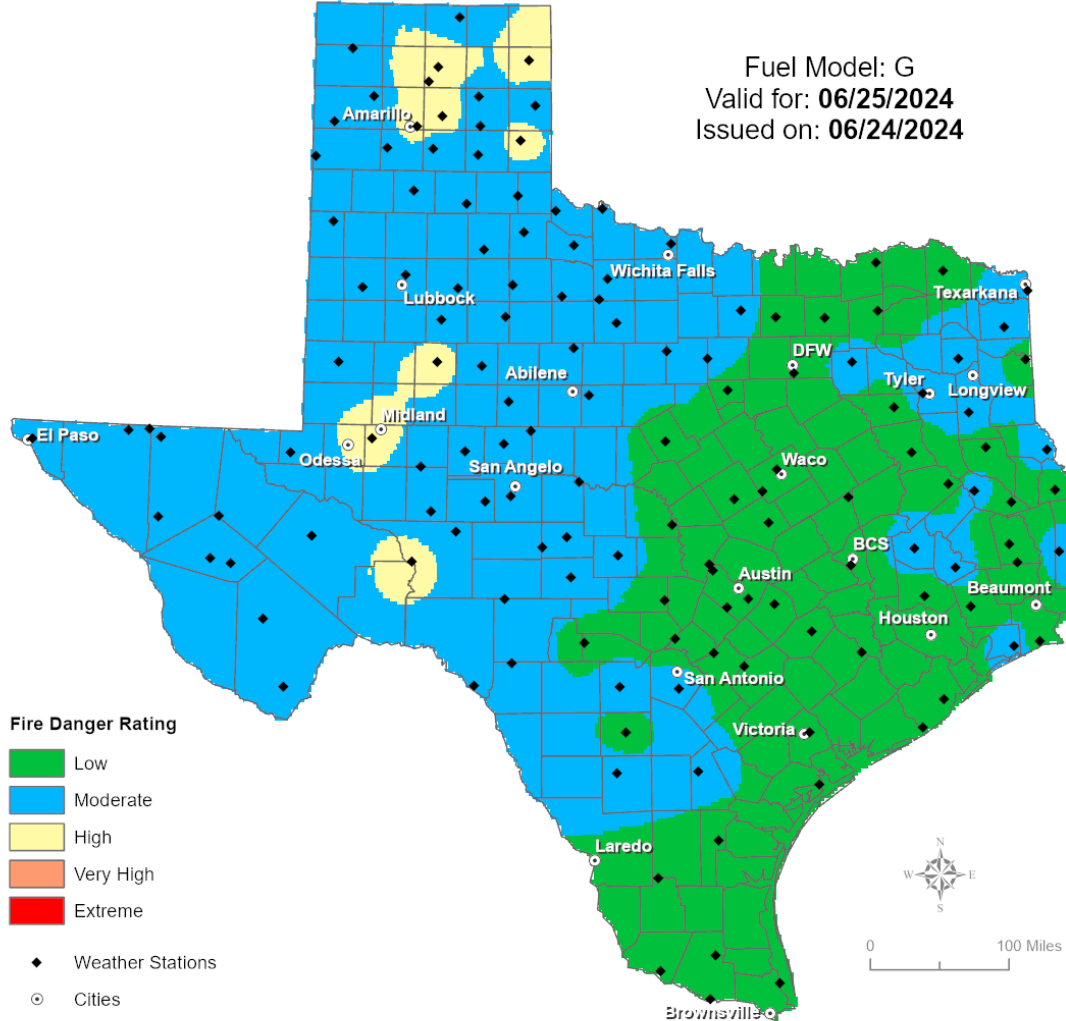

Forecast Fire Danger

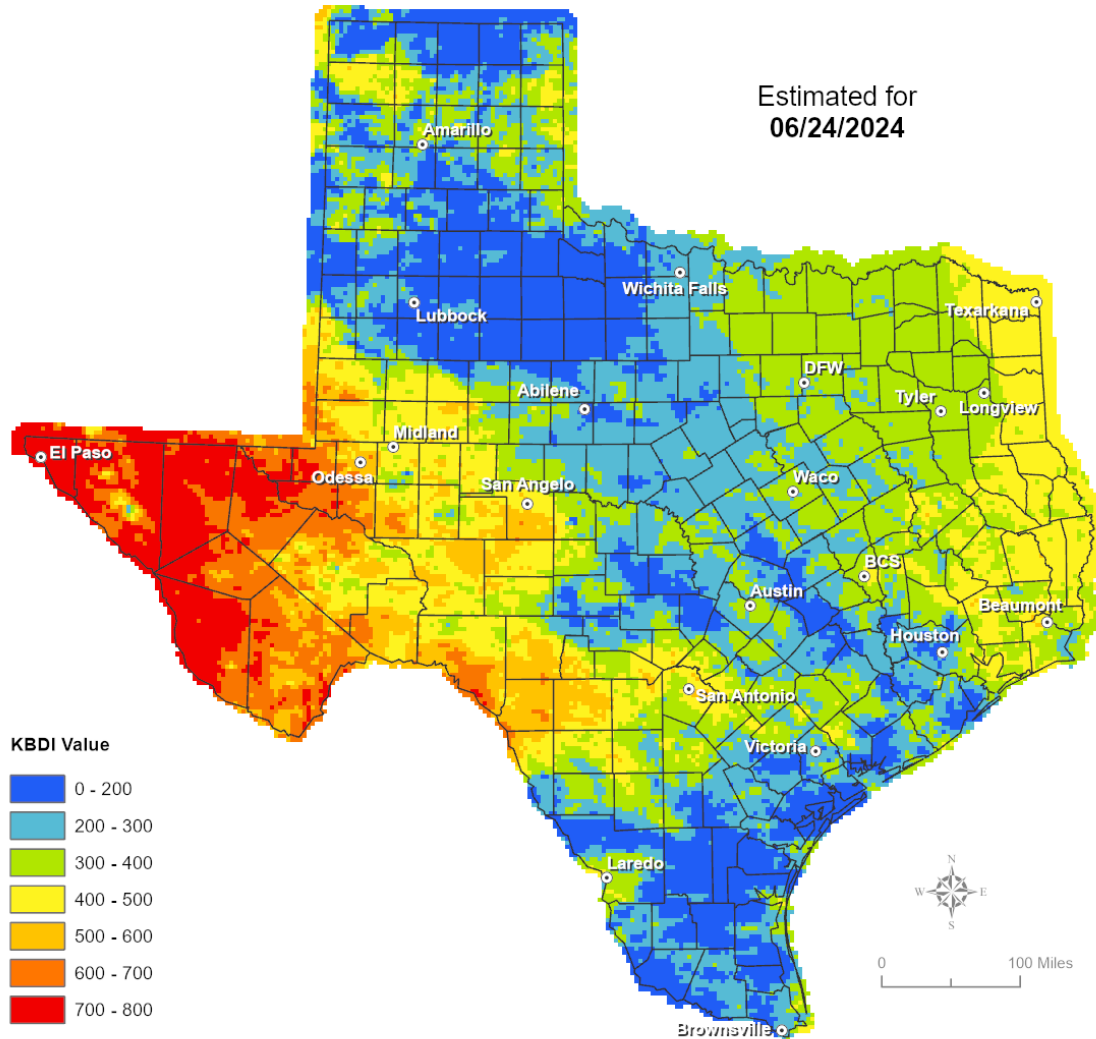


Keetch-Byram Drought Index

Keetch-Byram Drought Index

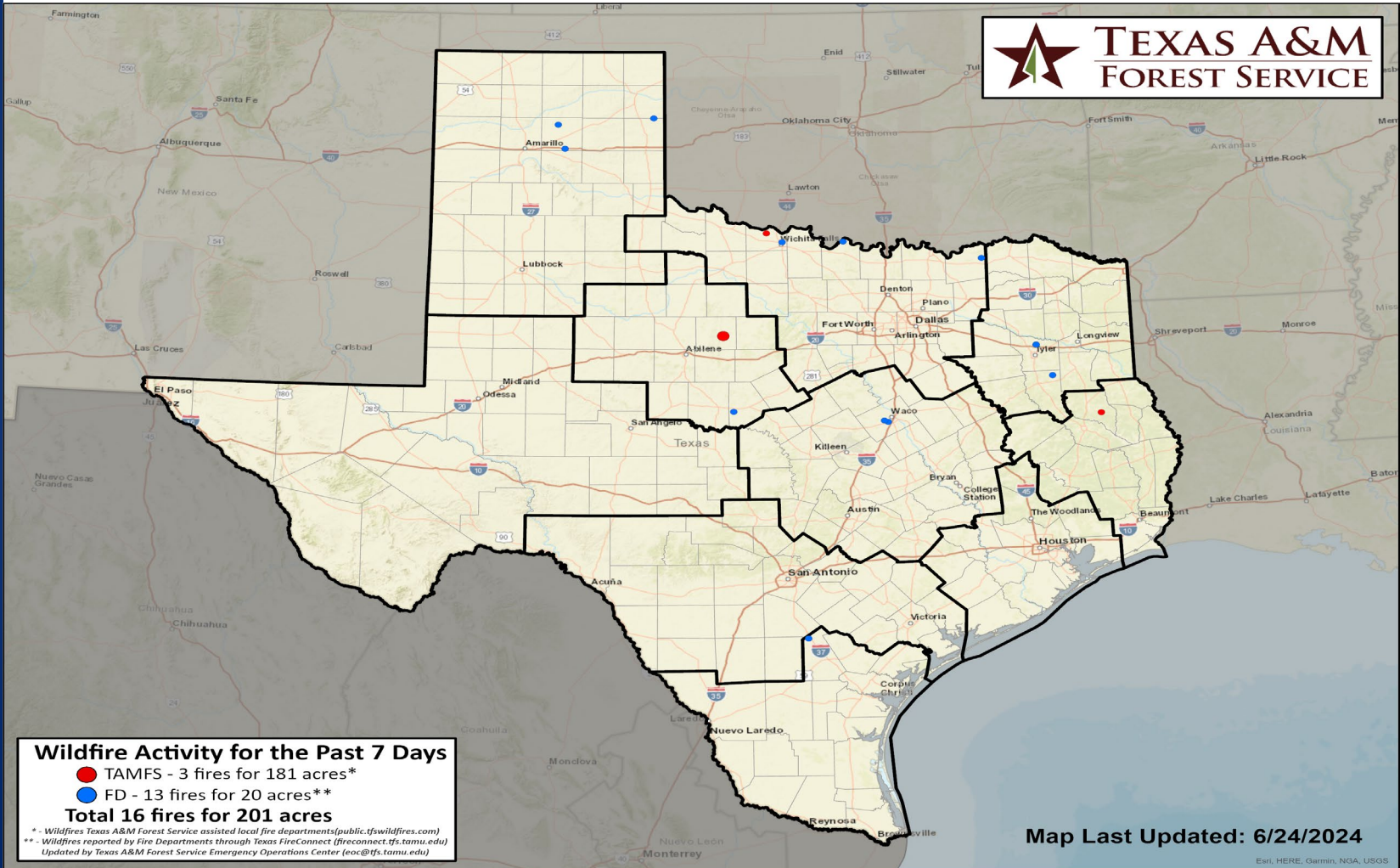
