
Seven-Day Graphical Tropical Weather Outlook











Keetch-Byram Drought Index



Fire Activity (*Last 24 Hours)

Report of 224 (+3) fires and 1,251,789 (+1,018) acres have been burned this year. There are 87 (-1) counties with burn bans. The Keetch-Byram Drought Index list contains 133 (+4) counties with an average over 400.
