





## Keetch-Byram Drought Index


(4 km x 4 km resolution)

Report of 332 (+1) fires and 1,271,106 (+1) acres have been burned this year. There are 119 (-6) counties with burn bans. The Keetch-Byram Drought Index list contains 158 (-1) counties with an average over 400.
