


## Seven-Day Graphical Tropical Weather Outlook



# Fire Activity (\*Last 24 Hours)

Report of 562 (No Change) fires and 1,282,325 (No Change) acres have been burned this year. There are 131 (-3) counties with burn bans. The Keetch-Byram Drought Index list contains 140 (+4) counties with an average over 400.
