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


Here is a look at total snowfall totals ending Tuesday night. The highest amounts are expected in the western Oklahoma Panhandle and the northwest Texas Panhandle.



#### **Hazardous Weather**



Travel impacts are Thursday and Friday, especially on untreated roads across North TX where 2-5 inches of snow is likely. A transition zone and wintry mix will occur across Central Texas. Mainly a rain-snow mix is expected across the southeast, with little to no snow accumulations along with an isolated light glaze of ice. Untreated surface roads and elevated bridges/overpasses will be impacted. The heaviest precip will occur during the daytime Thursday. Consider altering any late week travel plans, and keep up with the forecast!








## **Keetch-Byram Drought Index**
