

Winter Storm Warning

January 19, 2025 5:50 PM

Midnight Monday Until Midnight Tuesday

- A Winter Storm Warning means that snow and/or sleet accumulations leading to significant impacts are <u>expected</u>.
- Total snow accumulations of 3-6 inches are expected across the region. Wind gusts up to 35 mph
- Roads, especially bridges and overpasses, will likely become slick and hazardous.
- Persons should consider delaying travel. Motorists should use extreme caution if travel is absolutely necessary.

A Winter Storm Warning will be in effect for all of Southeast Texas from 6pm Monday - 6pm Tuesday.





A winter storm warning has been issued for all of South Texas except the barrier islands for Monday night into Tuesday. A mix of wintry precipitation will be possible in these areas. Roads will likely become slick in spots.



A Winter Storm Warning is in effect for Zapata, Jim Hogg, and Brooks counties from 12 AM Tuesday to noon Tuesday. Heavy mixed precipitation (freezing rain/drizzle, snow, and sleet) are possible. Total snow and sleep accumulations up to 1 inch are possible, and a light glaze of ice is possible. A Winter Storm Watch is in effect for Starr, Hidalgo, Inland Kenedy, and Inland Willacy counties from 3 AM Tuesday to 3 PM Tuesday. Mixed precipitation, including freezing rain and sleet are possible. Total ice accumulations around a light glaze are possible.



A Winter Storm Warning is in effect from Monday night into Tuesday for the I-35 corridor and Coastal Plains. where a snow/sleet mix of 1/2 to 1 1/2 inches and/or freezing rain accumulation up to 1/10 an inch is expected. A Winter Weather Advisory is in effect for the Hill Country and Rio Grande, where a snow/sleet mix from a dusting up to 1/2 inch and/or freezing rain accumulations up to 1/10 of an inch are possible. Consider delaying travel Monday night through Tuesday.





Fire Danger Forecast




Burn Ban




