FEMA Region 6 Weather Threat Briefing

Wednesday, January 29, 2025

Summary

- **Marginal risk (level 1 of 5) of severe storms today over W/Ctrl/NTX, S OK and slight risk (level 2 of 5) Thu over E TX, LA. Marginal risk (level 1 of 5) Fri over far SE LA.**
- **Slight risk (level 2 of 4) of heavy rainfall/flash flooding today over SE OK, NTX then shifting Thu over SE OK, AR, NW LA, NETX.**
- **Minor impacts (level 2 of 5) from snow today and Thursday over N NM.**
- **Minor river flooding will continue into next week in E TX. Additional minor (possibly moderate) flooding may occur in E TX and LA starting late week with the expected heavy rainfall.**



Note: Even though the image displays 5 days of forecasted rainfall, river forecasts only include 1-2 days of rainfall





Minor river flooding continues next week in E TX with flooding of low-lying pastures, swampland, and secondary roads.

Additional minor to isolated moderate flooding may occur in E TX and LA late week with rainfall mid to late week.







Tomorrow's Tornado & Severe Wind / Hail Probabilities






Excessive Rainfall Outlook




