



North/northwest winds behind the front at 10-20 mph, gusts to near 30 mph




Wind chills will be mainly in the teens Thursday morning!

- Rainfall amounts of 2 to 3 inches with locally higher amounts




Locally Heavy Rain & Flooding Possible






