Hazardous Weather



Elevated fire danger expected early this week, primarily due to very low min RHs. Fuels will continue to dry out (ERCs approaching or exceeding the 90th percentile) as a result of warm conditions.



Elevated fire weather is likely today for the far western and southwest South Plains. A Rangeland Fire Danger statement is in effect for these areas from 11 AM until 6 PM. Avoid outdoor burning until conditions improve.






Keetch-Byram Drought Index

Keetch-Byram Drought Index


