




Wind Speeds


Severe weather is likely on Sunday east of an advancing dryline, particularly across northern Oklahoma. While the overall coverage of storms is uncertain/may remain limited, any thunderstorm will be capable of producing large hail, damaging wind gusts and tornadoes.

Scattered severe storms are expected to develop along a dryline in western North Texas this evening which will spread eastward heading towards sunset. The greatest chance for storms will be near and north of I-20 after 5 PM, with storms winding down by midnight. Hail and damaging winds will be the main hazards, but a tornado or two cannot be ruled out.

There will be a threat for strong to severe thunderstorms late this afternoon but especially during the evening hours across at least the northwest half of the Four State Region.



An early-season heatwave continues into early next week. Heat index values will likely extend into the triple digits daily across most of South Texas through Wednesday followed by a break from the triple digit feels-like temperatures later in the week due to a front. Moderate to extreme heat-related impacts are expected. Please use heat safety and take caution!



Another round of strong to severe storms are possible this afternoon and this evening.



A Red Flag Warning is in effect from noon CDT /11 AM MDT/ to 10 PM CDT /9 PM MDT/ for Southeast New Mexico, the Guadalupe, Delaware, Davis, and Chinati Mountains, Davis Mountain Foothills, Marfa Plateau, Culberson and Reeves County Plains, and Loving County.





## **Fire Danger Forecast**




#### **Burn Ban**

# **Keetch-Byram Drought Index**


