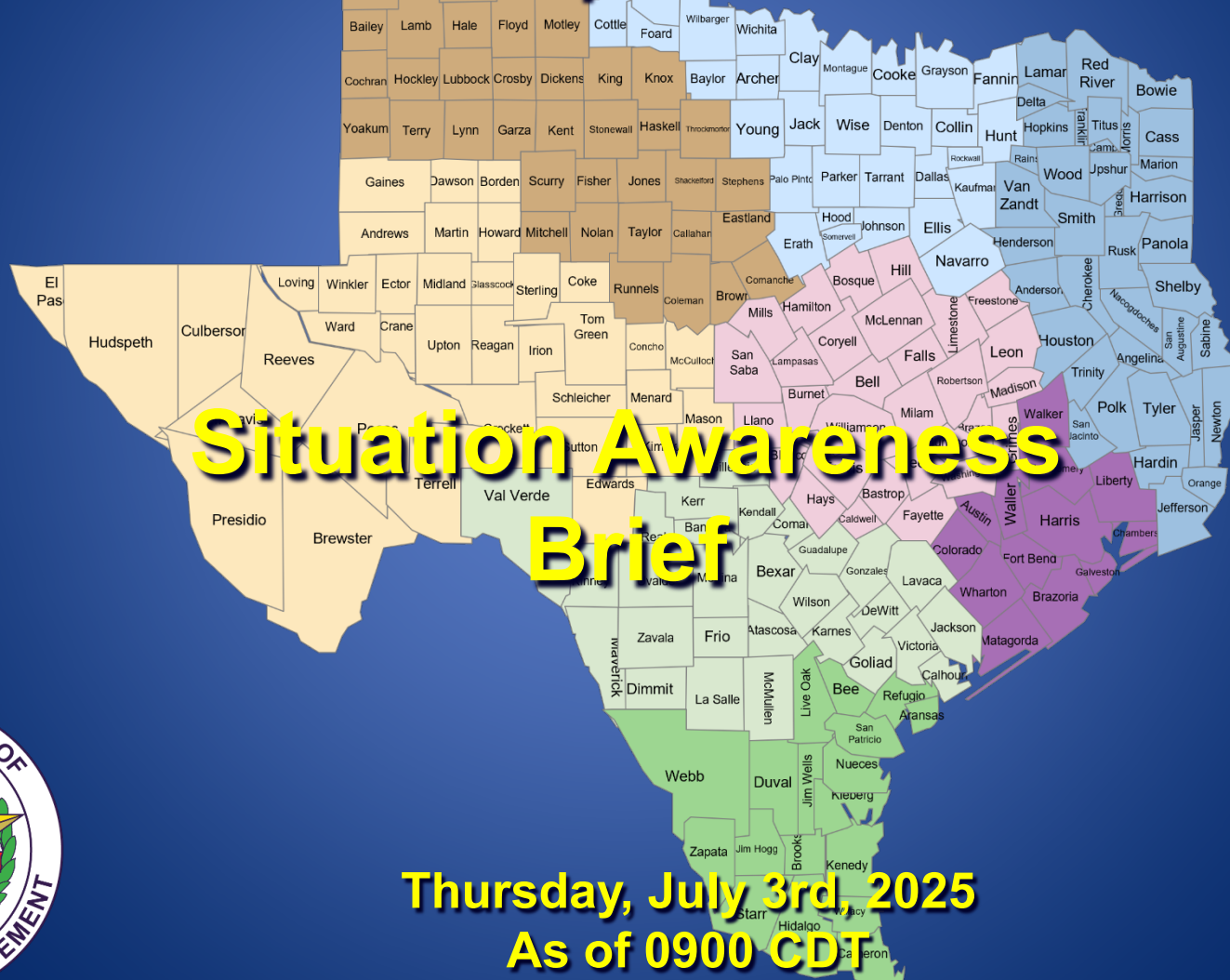

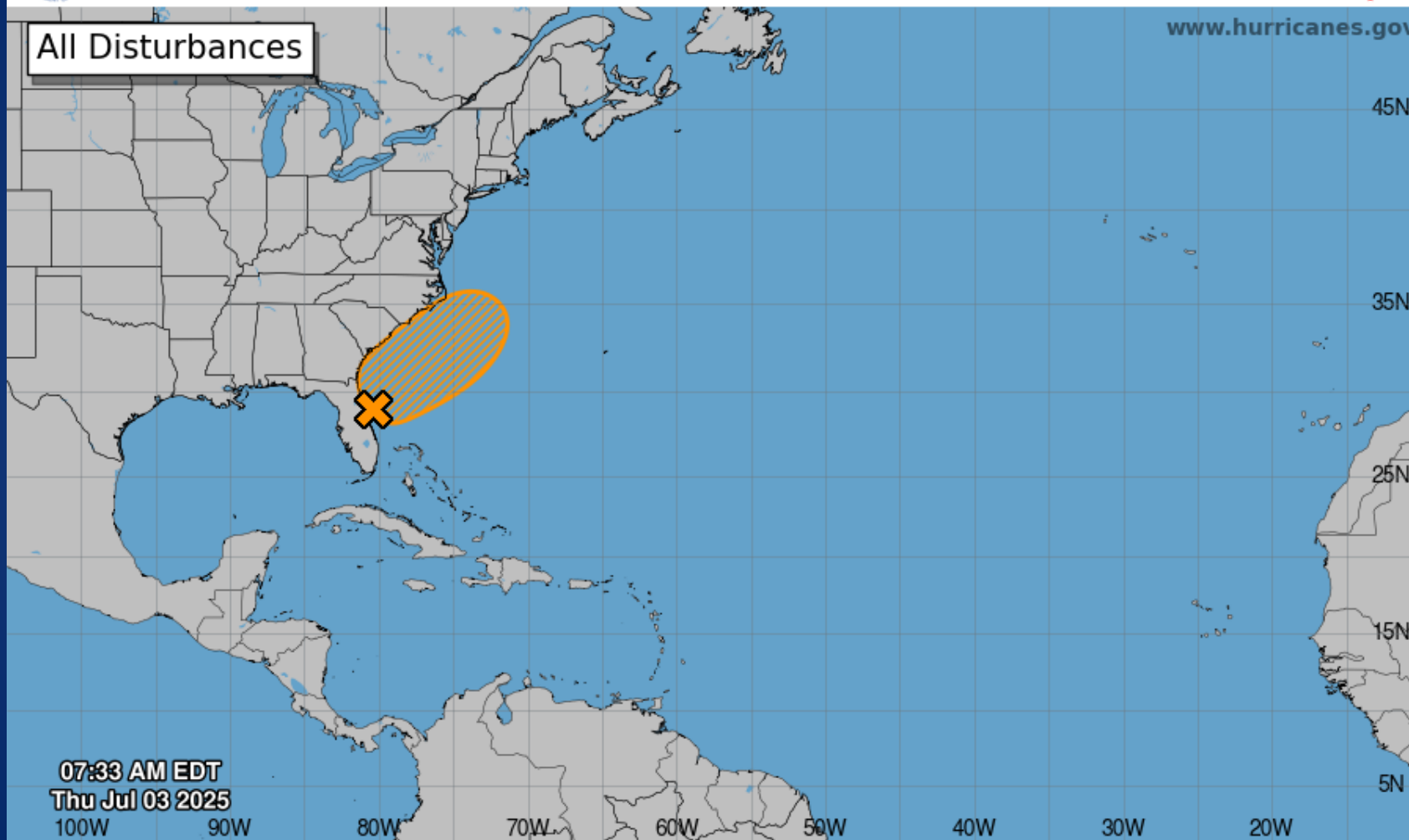
## Seven-Day Graphical Tropical Weather Outlook

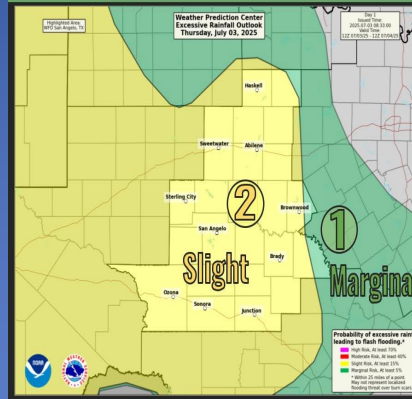

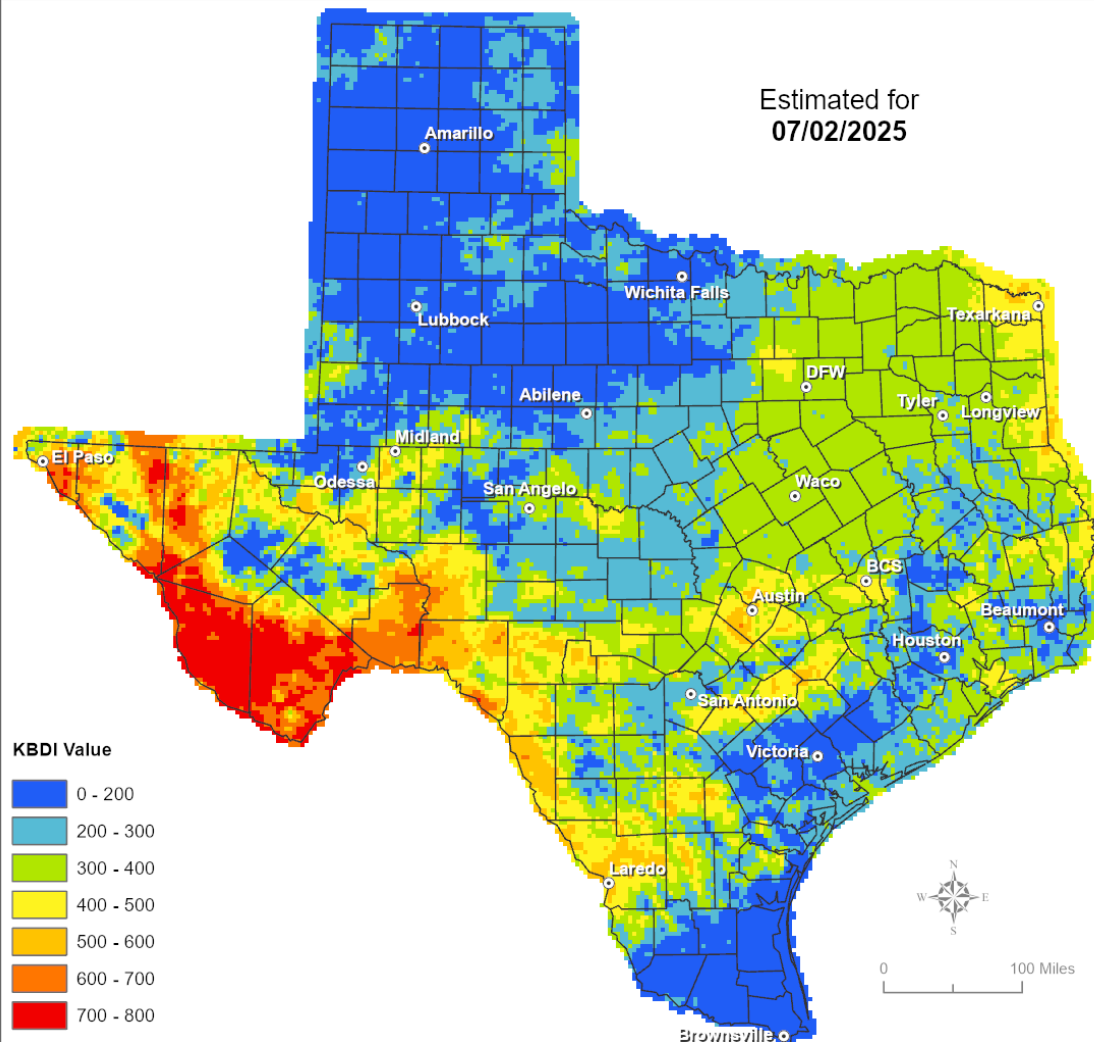


# Keetch-Byram Drought Index

## Keetch-Byram Drought Index

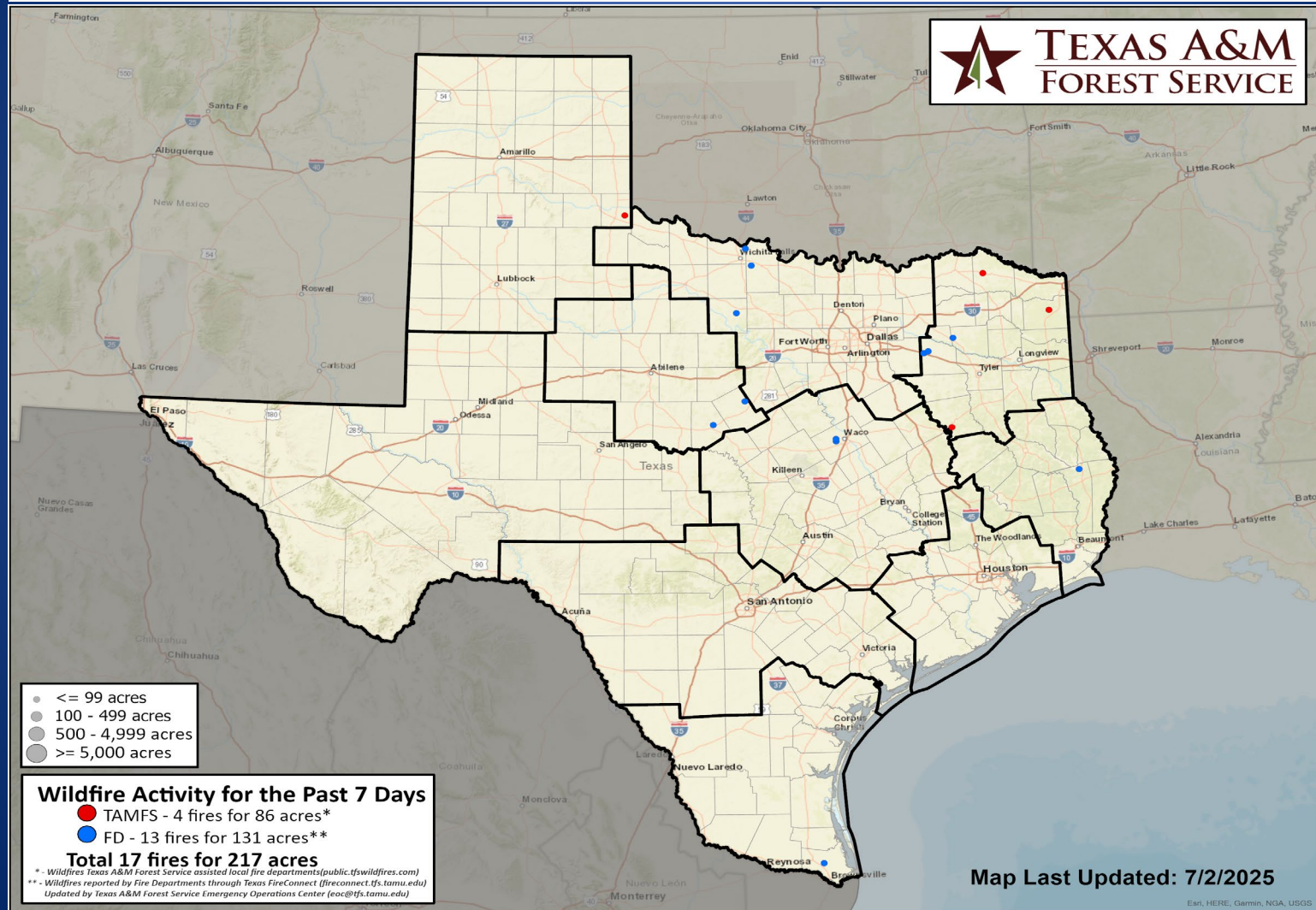
(4 km x 4 km resolution)
