**STATEWIDE CURRENT SITUATION:** On July 19, Governor Greg Abbott announced that the federal government has updated President Donald J. Trump's Major Disaster Declaration to include Hamilton and Travis counties in response to the recent flooding across Texas.

### **OPERATIONAL PRIORITIES:**

- Protect life and property.
- Support rapid & effective response.
- Collect and disseminate accurate incident information to improve decision-making.
- Accurately track incident costs associated with assigned resources for cost recovery.

## Region 6 (Includes DDs 17, 18, and 24)

DD 18 – New Braunfels (Includes Atascosa, Bandera, Bexar, Comal, Frio, Gillespie, Guadalupe, Karnes, Kendall, Kerr, McMullen, Medina, and Wilson Counties):

On July 6, DDEOC activated to Level III.

# **Kerr County:**

A family reunification center is located at Trinity Baptist Church on 800 Jackson Road in Kerr Co. The American Red Cross has a shelter located at Calvary Baptist Church on 113 Methodist Encampment Road in Kerr Co. and a medical is located at Kerr Co. First United Methodist Church on 321 Thompson Drive in Kerr Co.

Region 7 (Includes DDs 8, 9, and 10)

DD 10 – (Includes Coke, Concho, Irion, Edwards, Crockett, Kimble, Mason, McCulloch, Menard, Reagan, Schleicher, Sterling, Sutton, and Tom Green Counties):

On July 4, DDEOC 10 activated to Level III.

#### RESPONDING STATE AGENCIES/ORGANIZATIONS REPORTS

# Texas Division of Emergency Management (TDEM): Communications Coordination Group (CCG):

As of July 19, CCG partners across the public, private and volunteer sectors continue to assess the situation and adjust their response, as necessary. Cellular providers have provided cellphone charging accessories that include wall and car charging adapters, portable batteries, and headlamps. T-Mobile has provided a Command Trailer to support operations at the Unified Command Center. The Mobile Connectivity Center (MCC) provided by AT&T will remain at the Hunt Store located at 1634 TX-39, from 10:00AM to 3:00PM.

The Radio Amateur Civil Emergency Service (RACES) SOC Support team continues to provide Auxiliary Communications (AUXCOM) support for the CCG. The team provides coordination of Amateur Radio field operations as well as resource tracking of CCG assets. Due to the stability in overall communications, the plan is to reduce the size of the Communications Team supporting the Incident Management Team (IMT).

As of July 16, there are twelve (12) mobile cellular platforms supporting operations in Burnet, Kerr, and Williamson counties. Cellular providers are also providing Low Earth Orbit (LEO) satellite devices to support ongoing operations.

# **Incident Support Task Force (ISTF):**

As of July 19, shelter operations are currently under review to identify unmet needs, support transition assistance plans, and to support long-term housing strategies. This includes addressing immediate barriers to recovery for impacted survivors still in the

shelters. VOAD partners are reaching out to support feeding, and on standby for supplies and clean up.

Feeding partners are in coordination with local jurisdictions, have mobilized to meet current needs and are continuing to assess community demand. As feeding operations have stabilized, the overall need for meals is trending downward due to the strong support from numerous partners. Efforts to right-size the footprint for feeding are underway, with operations expected to scale down in the coming days. Meal distribution strategies are also being re-evaluated to support additional community-based activities beyond initial disaster response needs.

### Mass Care:

## Sheltering:

As of July 20, fifteen shelters are operational across the affected areas in Texas, with a population of 304 people and 101 pets.

## Feeding:

As of July 20, there are seven fixed sites that have served 4,360 meals.

Team Rubicon, Global Empowerment Mission, Convoy of Hope, and ITDRC are providing support at the reunification centers. The ISTF Voluntary Agency Liaison (VAL) team remains actively engaged in community response efforts, including volunteer and donations management, residential debris cleanup, and survivor services. Support is being provided across multiple sites such as Family Assistance Centers (FACs), Multi-Agency Resource Centers (MARC), Volunteer Reception Centers (VRCs), and Disaster Recovery Centers (DRC). Coordination continues to be a priority to align efforts, close

service gaps, and advance long-term recovery goals. A Volunteer Reception Center is located at 855 Hays St., Kerrville, TX

# Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service (AgriLife):

As of July 20, there are 17 DAR personnel activated. There were 418 entries from the State of Texas Assessment Tool portal from landowners with agricultural damage to fencing, crops, livestock, and equipment and 130 of those are requesting assistance from the AgriLife Extension Service. County Extension Agents in the affected counties have been notified to contact the landowners to provide relief assistance.

DAR Specialists and County Extension Agents are staffing DRC in Kerrville, Tom Green County, Williamson, and Hunt Counties with plans to expand to Burnet and San Saba Counties.

There are three DAR specialists providing logistical support for the TAMU VET Team in Kerr County. The Texas A&M Vet Team continues to support canines providing SAR and Human Remains Detection (HRD) missions in Kerr County. There are three DAR logistics personnel positioned at the Lancer TDEM warehouse in San Antonio.

Texas A&M Engineering Extension Service Public Works Response Team (PWRT): On July 20, PWRT is finishing the pumping in San Angelo.

**Texas A&M Engineering Extension Service Texas Task Force 1 (TEEX/TX-TF1)**: On July 19, all search missions in Region 8 were completed, and teams have begun the process of moving to Region 6 to bolster continuing searches in Kerr and Kendall Counties. An additional eight Human Remains Detection (HRD) canines along with ground penetrating radar have arrived to aid search teams.

On July 17, Texas A&M Task Force 1 resources continue to work Search and Rescue (SAR) missions in Kerr, Travis, Kendall, and Williamson Counties. There are three Swiftwater Rescue (SWR) boat squads that are moving to Jefferson, Angelina, and Jasper Counties. One SWR boat squad is moving to Liberty County in preparation for tropical weather.

# Texas A&M Forest Service (TAMFS):

July 20, TAMFS, United States Forest Service (USFS) and Texas Intrastate Fire Mutual Aid System (TIFMAS) Saw Modules are assisting with search, rescue and recovery operations. TAMFS has deployed three Skid Steers, eight TIFMAS Strike Teams, two mobile command posts, thirteen Heavy Equipment Bosses, TAMFS Aviation Liaison Officer (LNO) and one Urban Forest Strike Team. A total of 303 personnel are

#### committed to this event.

# **Department of Information Resources (DIR):**

DIR is monitoring the situation using cybersecurity tooling and threat intelligence feeds. No cyber threats related to this weather event have been identified. The Texas.gov homepage banner has been updated to include flood recovery resources and a link to the Kerr County Flood Relief Fund.

# **Public Utility Commission of Texas (PUC):**

As of July 12, the PUC reported no significant power outages. One LNO remains assigned to the SOC and will support 24-hour operations if needed.

# **Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission (TABC):**

Fourteen of TABC's Special Response Team (SRT) members are working alongside Texas DPS and TPWD in checkpoint, and search and recovery operations. Twenty SRT members remain on standby and are ready to respond if needed. Additional law enforcement personnel are available if more are needed if all SRT resources are used.

# Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ):

As of July 18, all impacted drinking water systems previously being tracked by TCEQ for this event have rescinded their Boil Water Notices. TCEQ has staff available to respond to any air, water, and waste-related issues. TCEQ is providing local governments with technical assistance and guidance on debris management.

# **Texas Department of Agriculture (TDA):**

TDA is staffing shifts at the SOC to monitor unmet needs in the agricultural community. The free, confidential Agri-Stress Helpline offers 24/7 support via call or text for those experiencing stress or loss. Staffed by trained professionals, it serves the agriculture, forestry, and fishing sectors, providing support and referrals to local mental health resources. So far, it has helped over 285 Texans in 114 counties. Call or text 1-833-897-2474 for assistance.

TDA's Hay Hotline is open for those wishing to donate hay. Donors can register at <a href="https://texasagriculture.gov/Home/Production-Agriculture/Hay-Hotline">https://texasagriculture.gov/Home/Production-Agriculture/Hay-Hotline</a> and will be contacted if requests are received.

TDA's STAR (State of Texas Agriculture Relief) Fund is accepting applications from those who suffered agricultural losses due to the recent weather event. Funds may be used for rebuilding fences, restoring operations, and other disaster-related costs. Applicants in counties included in the Texas Governor's disaster declaration have 90 days from the proclamation date to apply. The deadline is November 4, 2025, at 11:59 p.m. Apply at https://texasagriculture.gov/Home/Production-Agriculture/Disaster-Assistance/STAR-Fund/Severe-Weather.

Through the Emergency Food Assistance Program (TEFAP), TDA food bank

contractors distribute USDA-donated food to emergency feeding organizations. Texans can access this food via on-site meals or take-home packages.

# Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS):

As of July 19, DPS continues assisting Texas Task Force 1 (TX-TF1) search teams with searches along the river and tributaries in Region 6. In Region 8, search teams assisted with the completion of searches of Big Sandy Creek and Cow Creek and have been demobilized. The Driver License Division's disaster recovery mobile unit was requested to assist with issuing replacement identification.

On July 17, the DPS Dive Recovery Team is assisting TX-TF1 in Kerr County with nine personnel and a dive boat. The DPS Tactical Marine Unit is also assisting TX-TF1 and DPS Special Operations Group with river searches.

On July 16, members from the Israeli Defense Forces (IDF) arrived to assist Texas to locate missing people with their knowledge, manpower, and technology.

Over 300 DPS personnel are actively working in coordination with local, state, and federal partners in search and recovery efforts, assisting at evacuation shelters, reunification centers, and providing security.

# **Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS):**

There have been 1,252 vaccines have been provided to first responders, 630 Tdap and 622 Hepatitis A. The AMBUS (MPV 801) was replaced by MPV 6-04 for three active AMBUS in Kerrville. Public Health Region (PHR) 8 has assigned personnel and assets Grimes Funeral Home along with the Texas Funeral Directors Association who continues to support operations with three personnel.

# **Texas Emergency Medical Task Force (EMTF):**

The total patient contacts for this activation are 9,669 encounters, 220 treated, 125 transported.

# **Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT):**

As of July 18, TxDOT has 17 locations on state-maintained roads impacted by flooding, eight locations are closed from flooding and seven are closed due to damage. TxDOT has received over 80 requests to inspect bridges.

## Texas Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC):

On July 19, one Other Needs Assistance (ONA) member was deployed to each of the DRC located in San Saba and Burnet.

# **Texas Military Department (TMD):**

As of July 20, TMD has deployed 227 personnel, 50 vehicles, and nine aircraft in support of our state partners. TMD has seven UH-60s staged in San Antonio, Marble Falls, and Kerrville and two CH-47 in Fredericksburg. There are four Ground Transportation Platoons (GTPs), one Tactical Air Control Party (TAC-P), an Air Operations Center and SOC Support Team in Austin. There is a General Support Unit (GSU), two Electronic Tracking Network (ETN) teams performing damage assessment, two teams and a SOC support team. TMD has activated Chaplains and Behavioral Specialists to support service members working on the rescue and recovery operations. A Public Affairs Team, a Search and Extraction (SAE) MRP, and a Fatality Search and Recovery (FSRT) MRP have been deployed to provide support for search and recovery operations.

The State of Arkansas has provided four UH-60 Helicopter and 24 personnel staged in Austin. The State of North Dakota has provided eight pilots for the MQ-9 Drone. The two State of Arizona Air National Guard Ground Control Station Maintenance (MQ-9) personnel have been released.

TMD has flown recon missions and provided flights for 280 first responders. EMAC Aircraft provided flights for 31 first responders, five canines, delivered 100 meals to Leander, and conducted eight damage assessments.

## **Texas Parks and Wildlife Department (TPWD):**

On July 19, Texas Game Wardens supporting the multi-agency search and recovery operations in Cow Creek and Big Sandy in Travis County were demobilized. The Texas Game Warden Dive team has been requested to assist in search and recovery efforts in Kerrville and are scheduled to deploy on the morning of July 22.

On July 17, Texas Game Wardens resumed search for occupants of a vehicle swept off the road in Uvalde County at river crossing at FM 187. Texas Game Wardens are providing support at the Incident Command IC trailer, liaising with local landowners, assisting with Unmanned Aircraft System (UAS), and assisting with ground search efforts.

## Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs (TDHCA):

TDHCA is actively supporting the state's response to the severe weather event by supporting its community action agency partners at the local level and coordinating

resources with HUD at the federal level.

# American Red Cross (ARC):

On July 20, there are 15 ARC-managed shelters; six in Tom Green County, one in Kimble County, four in Williamson County, and four in Burnet County, which had 304 guests and 101 pets. ARC has provided 546 meals in Tom Green, Williamson, and Bexar counties with 43 clean up kits.

ARC continues delivering support to families of the hospitalized, missing, or deceased at the Kerrville Family Assistance Center (FAC). Personnel staffed the DRC with support for canteen operations, Individual Disaster Care (IDC), and webform enrollment. In Tom Green, Kimble, and Williamson Counties, ARC continued Shelter Resident Transition (SRT) casework, and feeding operations.

### The Salvation Army (TSA):

The TSA is supporting feeding operations and Emotional and Spiritual Care in Ingram (City West Church). In Kerrville, the San Antonio Canteen is stationed at the Wal-Mart

providing drinks, snacks, and distributing relief supplies. A volunteer reception center is set up in the Kerrville Social Services Building. The San Angelo canteen is stationed at Hargraves Auto and is serving first responders and survivors. The Big Lake RRU are patrolling neighborhoods to provide food, hydration, and snacks. TSA has provided 6,877 meals, 32,366 drinks, 27,691 snacks, 1,438 hygiene kits, 998 clean up kits, 324 cleaning supplies, and 1,229 articles of clothing.

# **Southern Baptists of Texas Convention Disaster Relief (SBTC):**

SBTC has responding to four locations in the recent Central Texas Floods: Kerrville, San Saba, San Angelo, and Leander. In Kerrville, a Quick Response Feeding Unit (QRU), IMT, chaplains, shower/laundry units, and assessors are operational at First Baptist Church Kerrville. In San Saba, a QRU, IMT, assessors, chaplains, shower/laundry units, and mud out units are operational at First Baptist Church, San Saba. In San Angelo, a QRU is deployed in support of Red Cross shelters. In Leander, a laundry unit deployed in support of TDEM Point of Distribution (POD) at Round Mountain Baptist Church. SBTC has provided 13,490 volunteer hours, 1,007 ministry contacts, and 9,917 meals.

# **Texans on Mission (TXM):**

On July 14, TXM responded to the floods in San Angelo with assessors, IMT, electrical, electronic, shower and laundry services, feeding, with the flood recovery team. Assessors continue to work and are also pursuing work orders and signatures for the sorting of debris at houses that have had muck-out completed. This is to help the City of San Angelo meet the FEMA requirements. There have been 62 work orders processed with 52 remaining.

On July 14, the San Angelo Emergency Manager has asked TXM to figure out how to help to sort the debris per FEMA guideline, and we are working on a plan. The logistics required to do this work, such as obtaining work orders and owner liability signatures to access their property are ongoing. Our assessors will be assisting with this effort. This project will be coordinated with the City of San Angelo Public Works Department. TXM have worked 6,797 hours, distributed 2,065 meals, and completed 44 assessments.
