


Scattered severe thunderstorms are possible across portions of southern Oklahoma and north Texas during the afternoon and evening on Thursday. Damaging wind gusts and large hail will both be possible.



Temperatures will continue to climb today into the mid and upper 90s ahead of an approaching cold front. This front will move through late this evening and tonight with scattered showers and storms increasing across our northeast counties. A few of these storms could be strong with gusty winds and some hail.

#### **Hazardous Weather**



The threat for showers and thunderstorms, some of which may contain heavy rainfall, will be possible this afternoon and evening near a weak cool front as it enters Northeast Texas, Southeast Oklahoma, and Southwest Arkansas. Any flooding is expected to be localized and affecting low lying, poor drainage areas.

#### Hot! A Few Storms Developing Late.



Highs around 100 across the Big Country, with mid and upper 90s across the rest of the area.



Southwest winds 10-15 mph gusting to near 25 mph at times.



An approaching cold front will produce a few storms late this afternoon and evening across the Big Country. Gusty winds and brief heavy rainfall will be possible.


