FEMA Region 6 Weather Threat Briefing

Summary

- **Flash Flooding:**

- Marginal risk (level 1 of 4) over southeast LA today
- Cold front brings isolated heavy rain/flash flooding risk to E AR tomorrow.

- **Tropical Weather:**

- A tropical wave moving through the Tropical Atlantic has a 70% of development in the next 7 days. No impacts to FEMA 6 in the next 7 days.
- A disturbance in the Gulf of America has a near 0% chance of development, with heavy rain and isolated coastal flooding as the main impacts through Monday along the Gulf Coast.

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



Note: Even though the image displays 5 days of forecasted rainfall, river forecasts only include 1-2 days of rainfall


















“Day 3-7” Hazards Outlook








