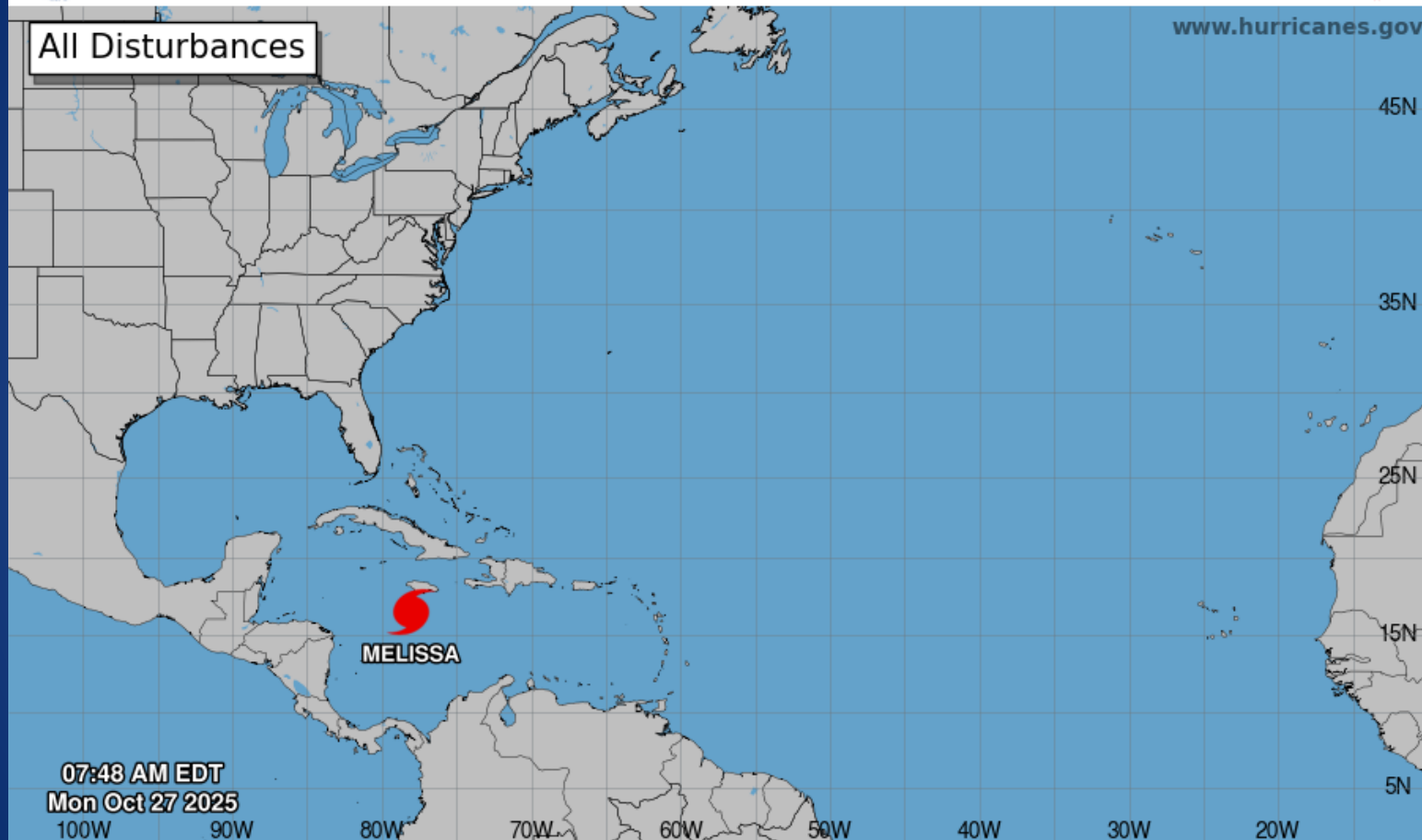
Seven-Day Graphical Tropical Weather Outlook

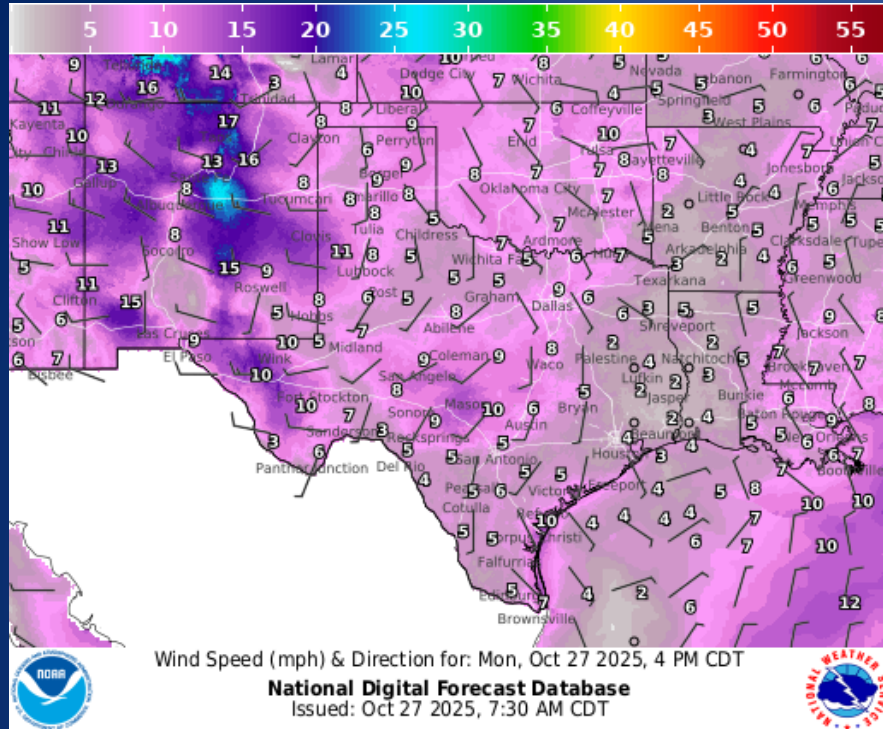

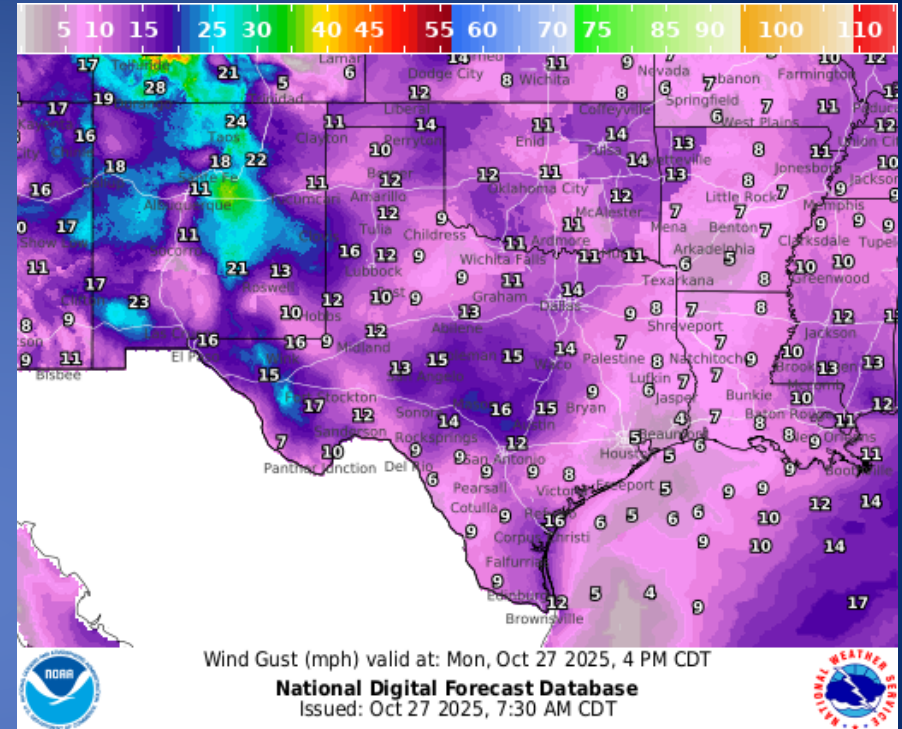

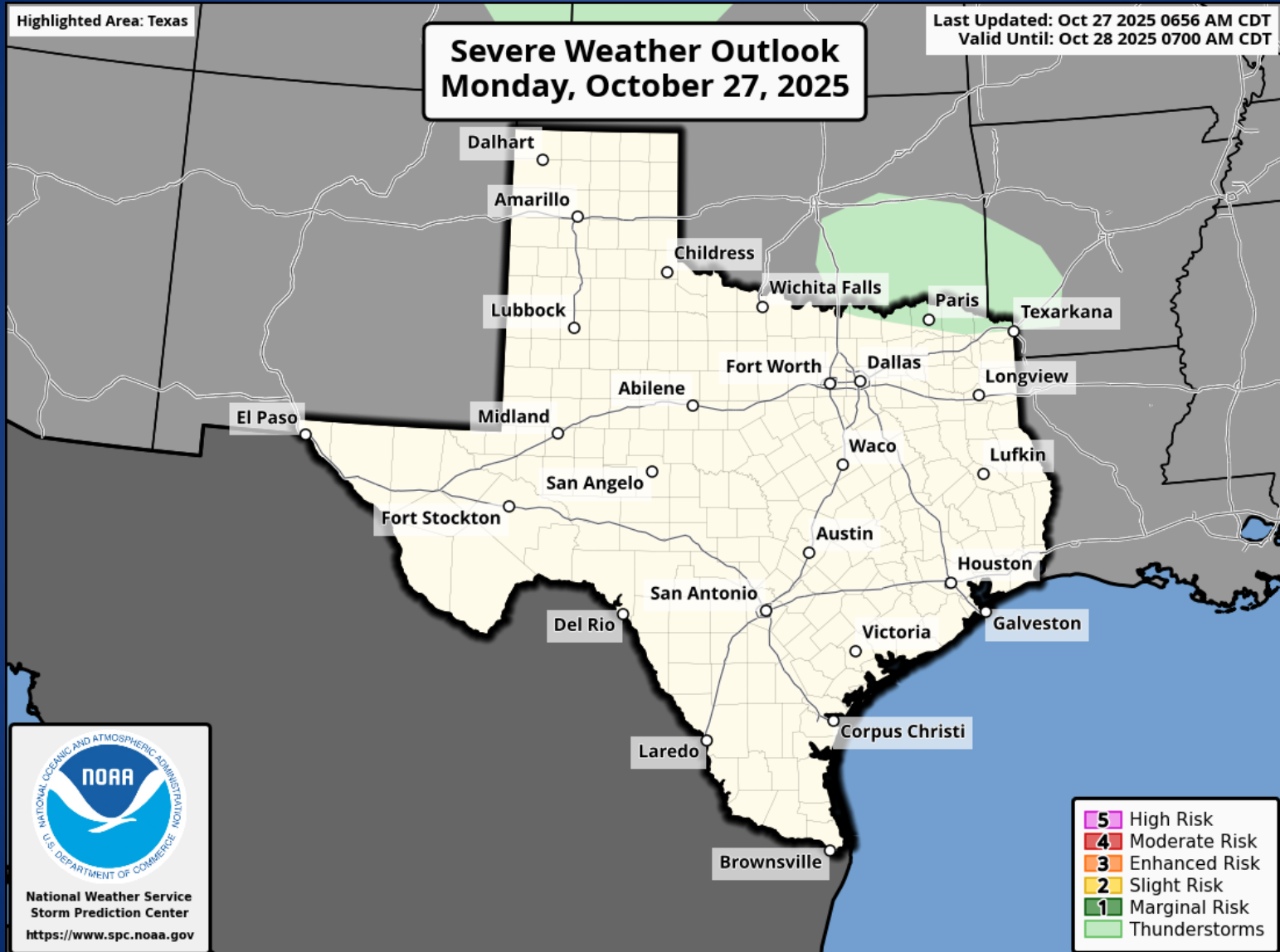


Wind Speeds

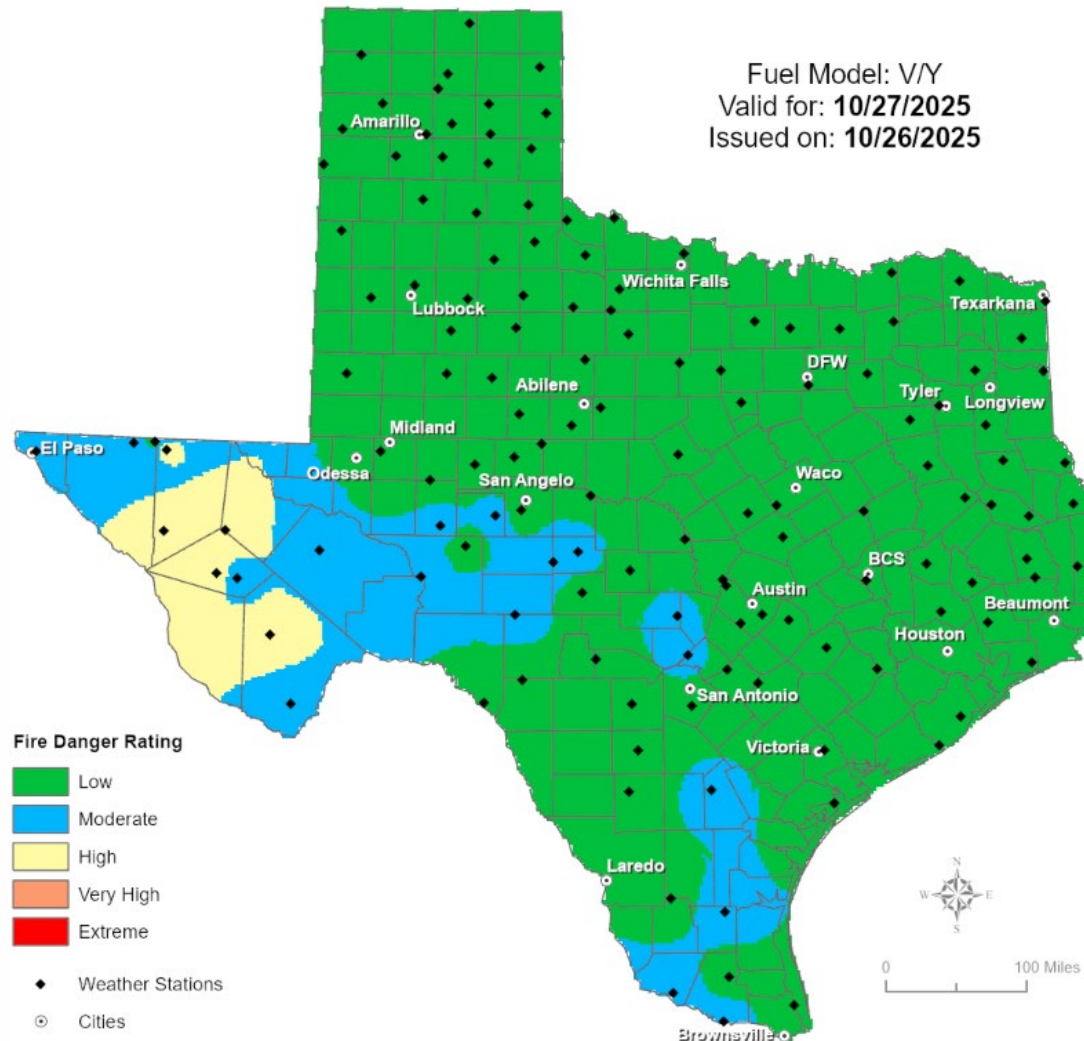

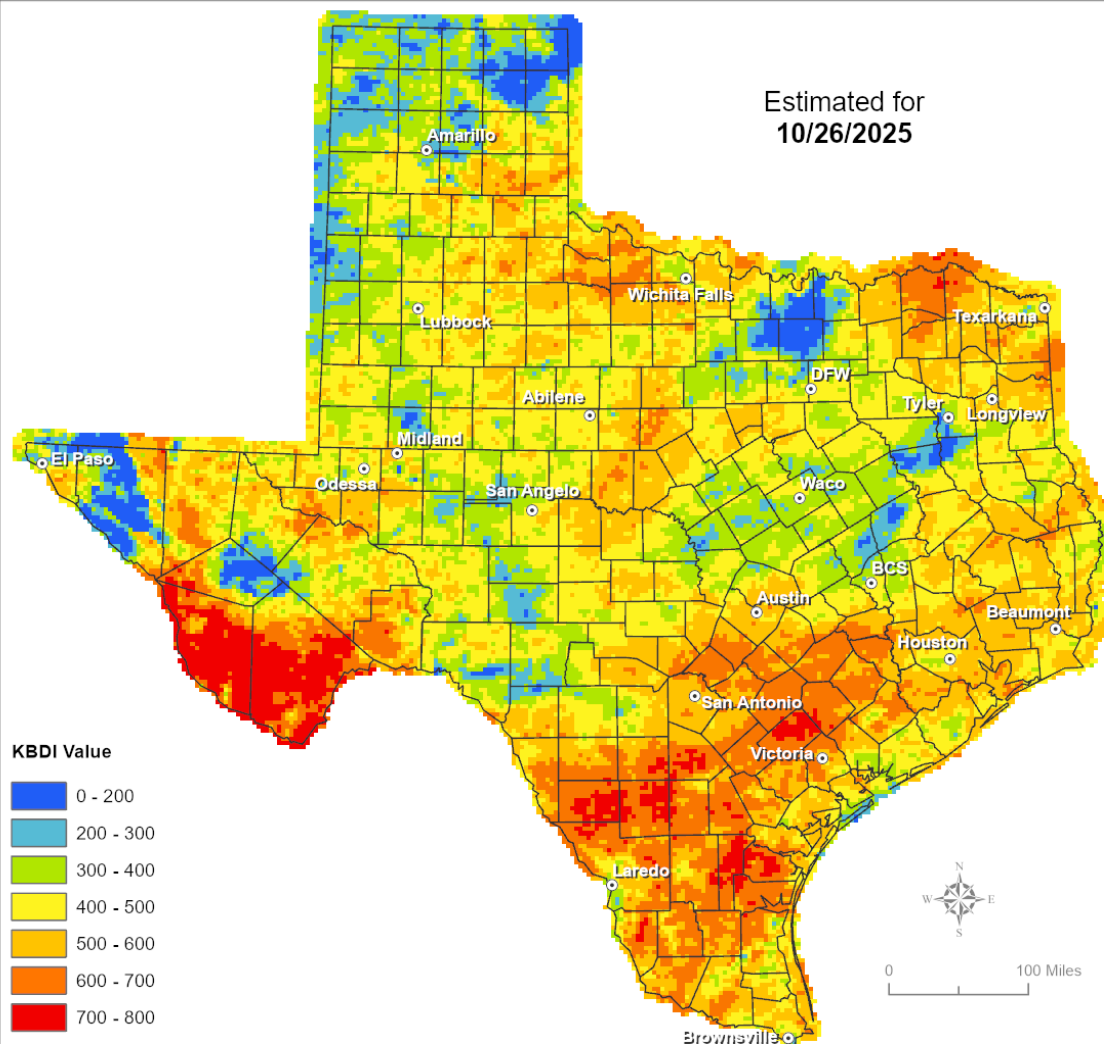

Keetch-Byram Drought Index

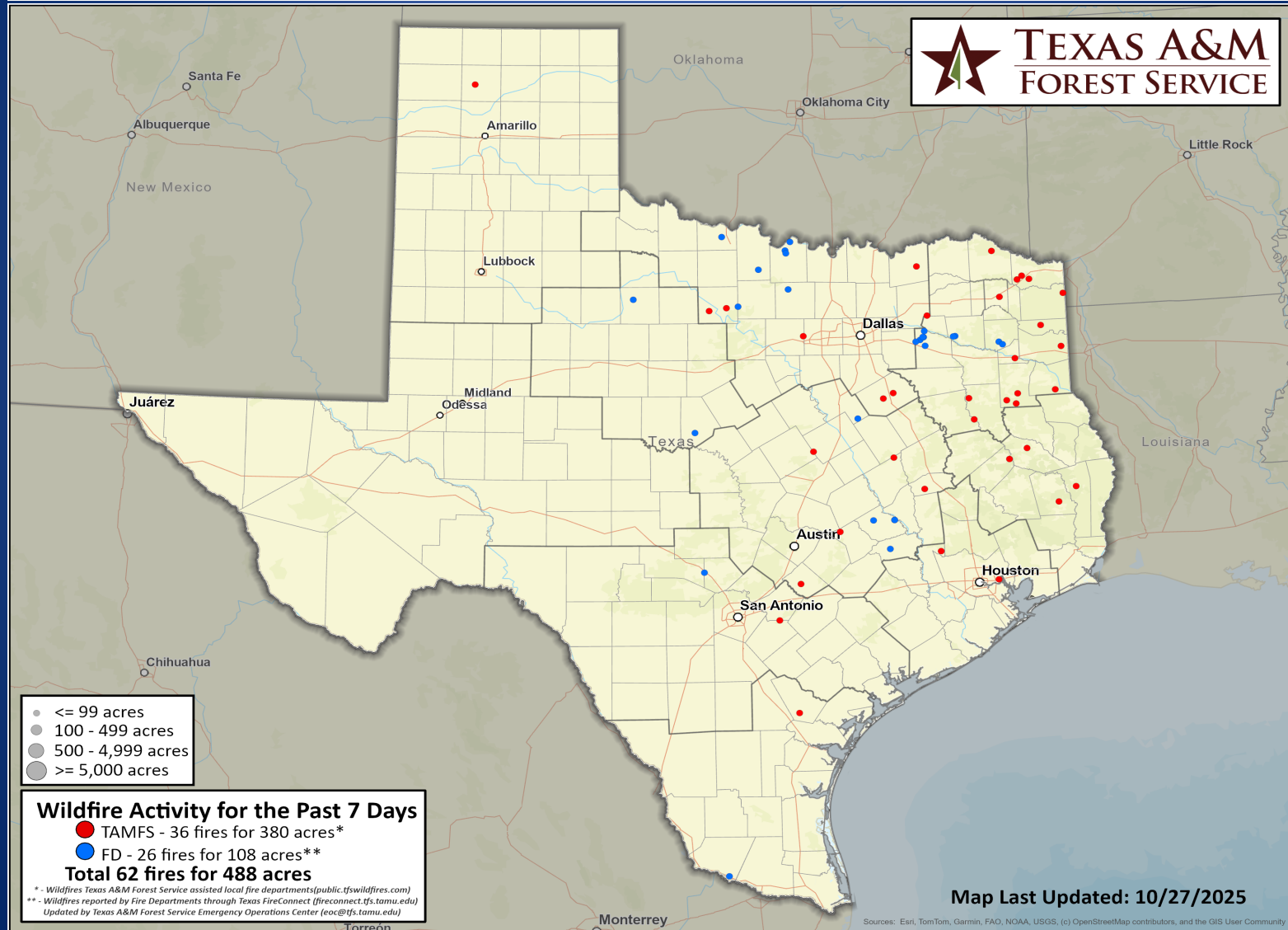

Report of 652 (No Change) fires and 97,991 (No Change) acres have been burned this year. There are 157 (-6) counties with burn bans. The Keetch–Byram Drought Index list contains 193 (-19) counties with an average over 400.
