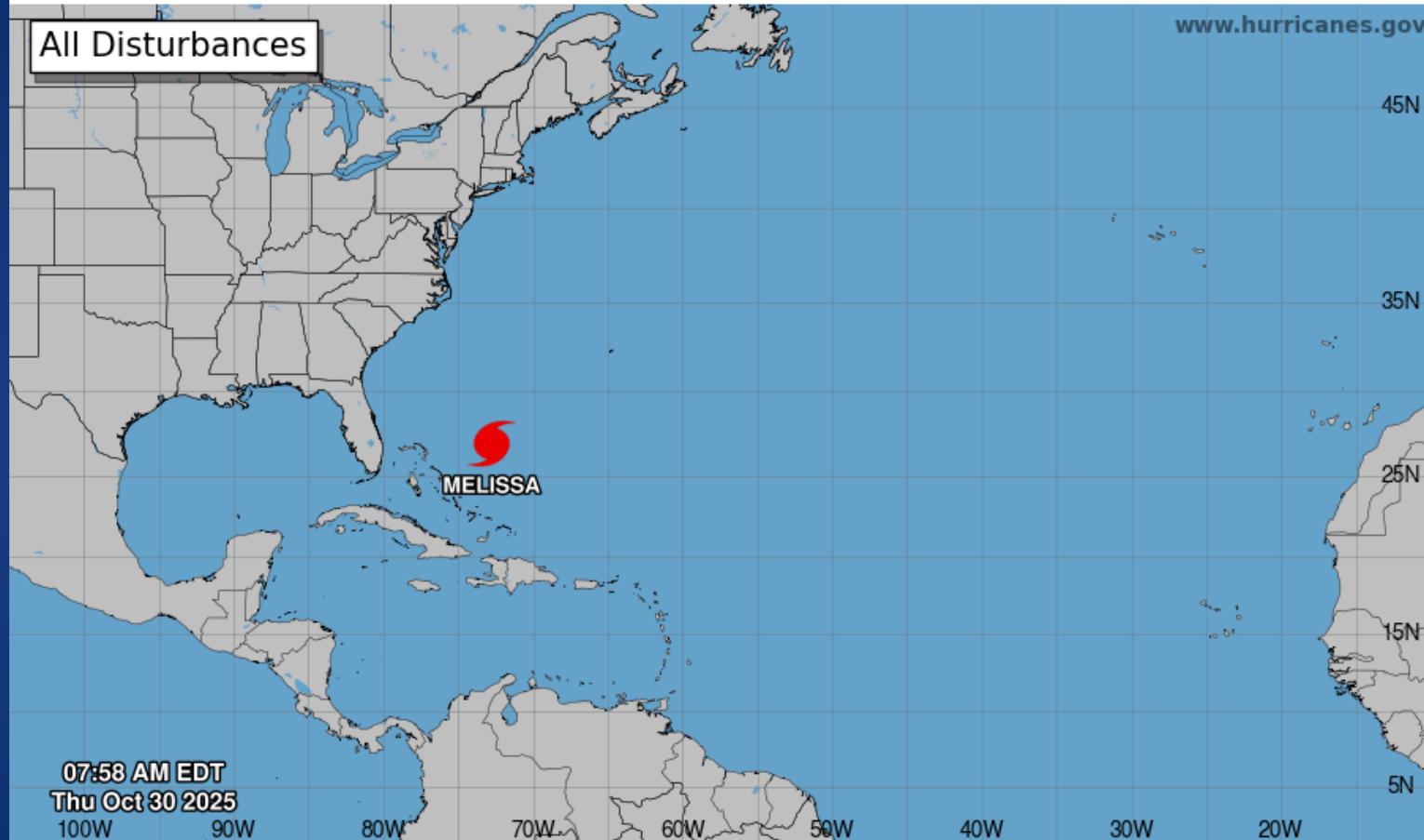
Seven-Day Graphical Tropical Weather Outlook

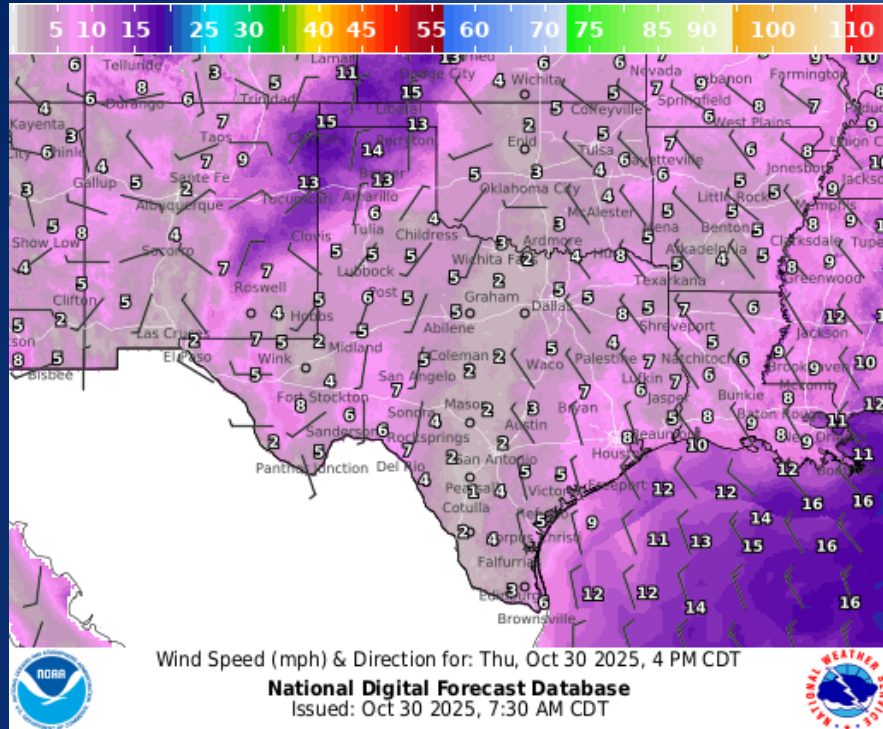

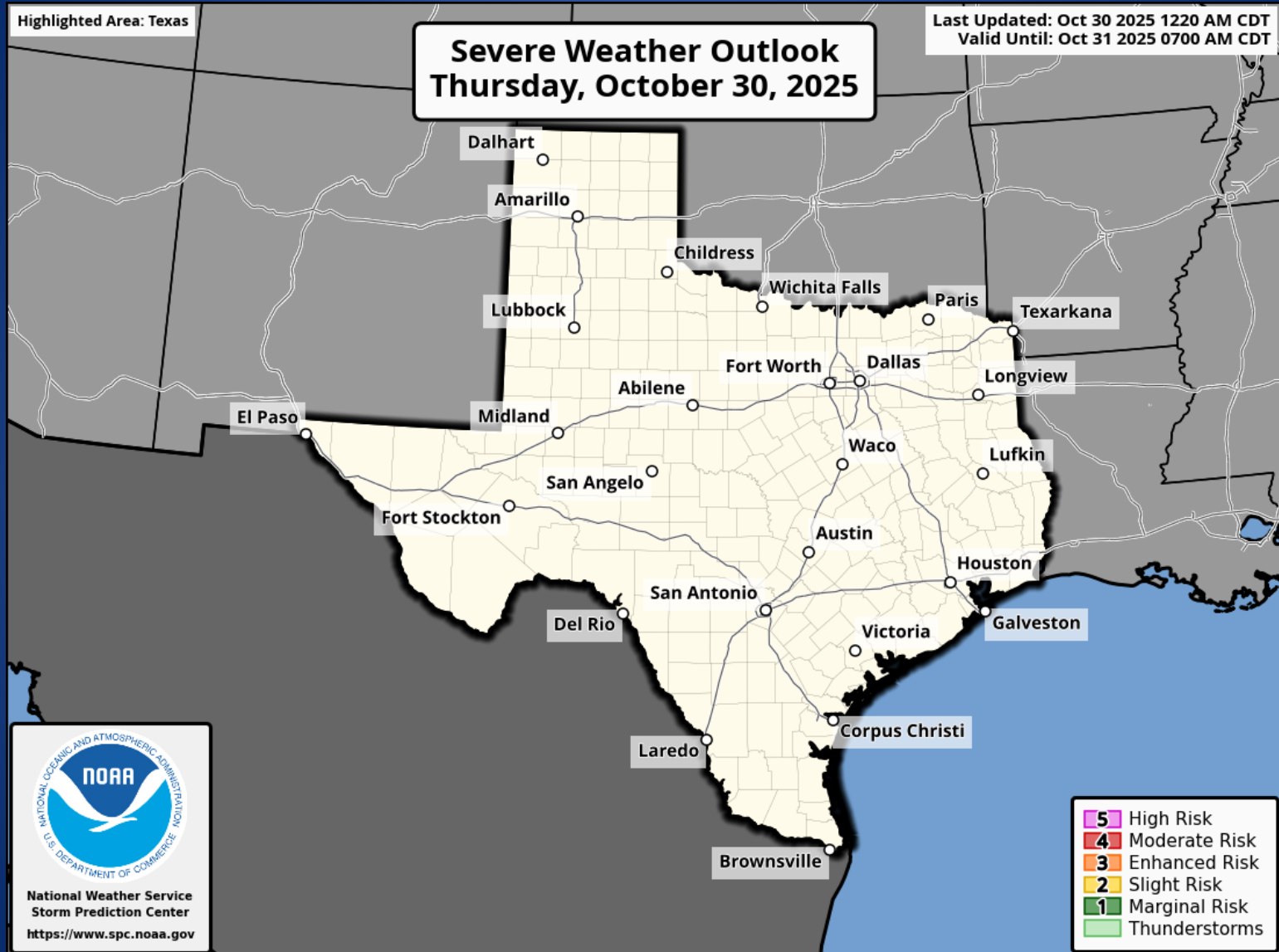

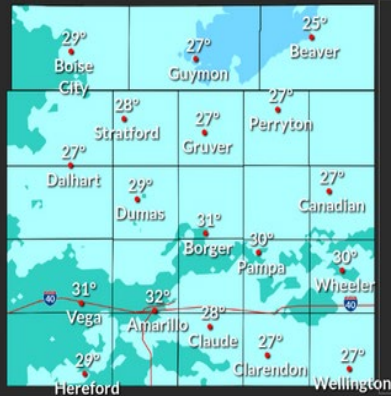

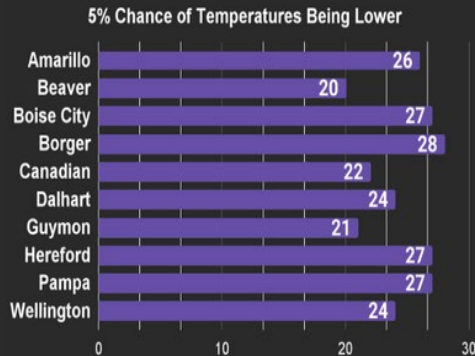

A solid freeze looks to be in play Thursday morning for any areas that fail to freeze on Wednesday. At this point all areas have a good chance to have their season ending freeze, with most locations looking to at least be in the 20s to low 30s by the time the sun rises. However, colder temperatures could still be possible with locations nearing the low 20s instead.

Key Messages

- Conditions today are favorable for erratic wildfire growth.
- Avoid activities that may cause a spark!

- **Relative Humidity:** 10-25%
- **Fuels:** Critically Dry
- **Winds:** 10 mph, gusts to 15 mph

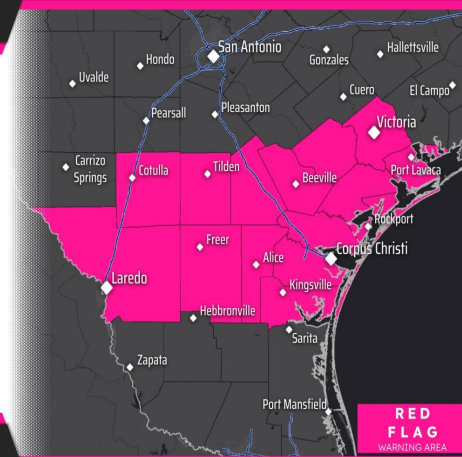

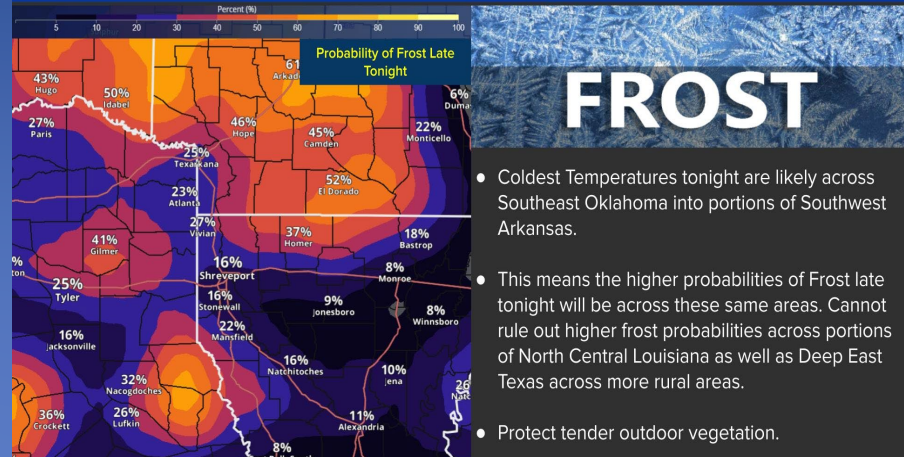
A Red Flag Warning is in effect through this evening across all of South Texas. While northerly winds will only be around 10 mph, relative humidity dropping as low as 10% and the presence of critically dry fuels will exacerbate fire weather conditions.

Clear skies, near calm winds and much colder temperatures could result in patchy frost across portions of the Four State Region Overnight. The higher probabilities of seeing frost will reside across Southeast Oklahoma and Southwest Arkansas but cannot be ruled out across more rural areas of Northern Louisiana and Northeast Texas.

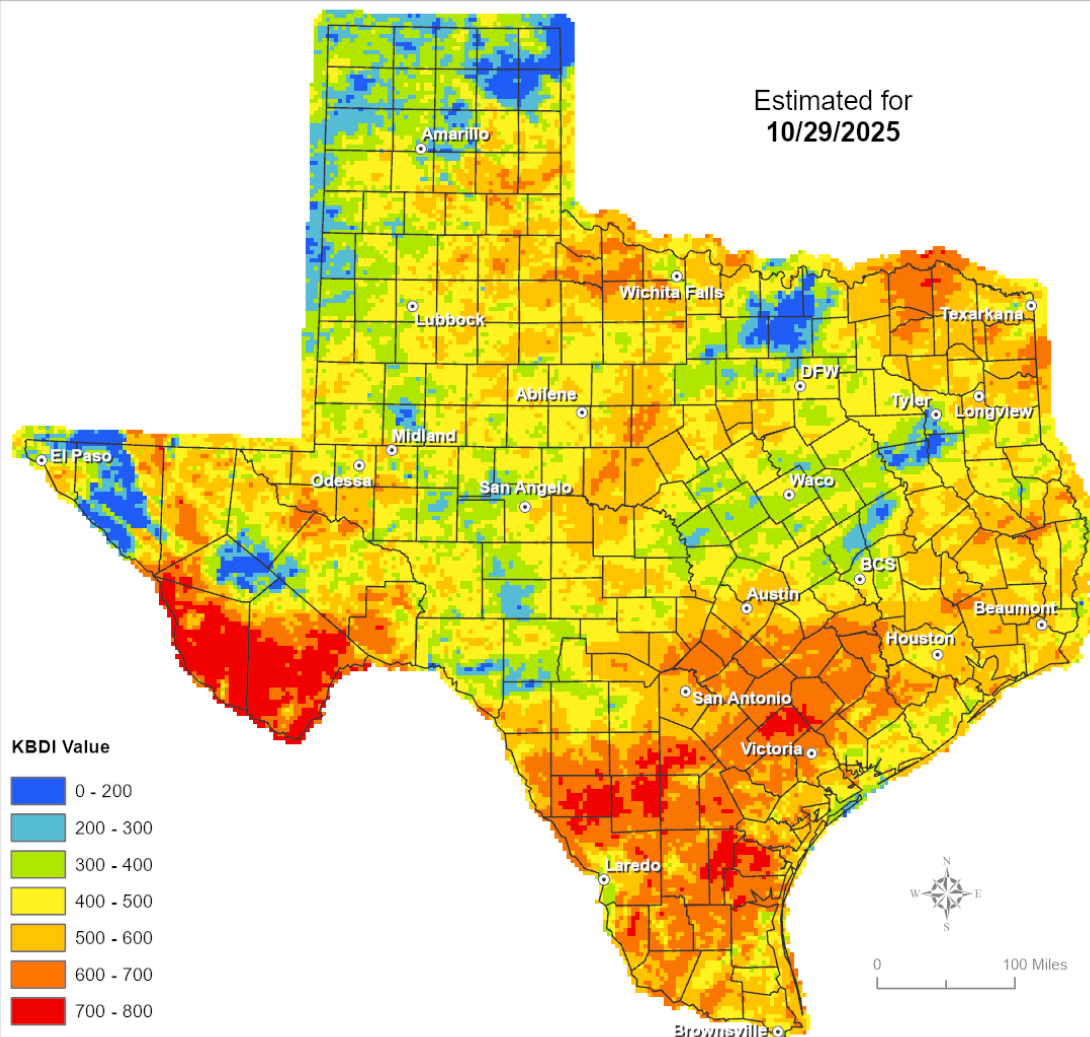
