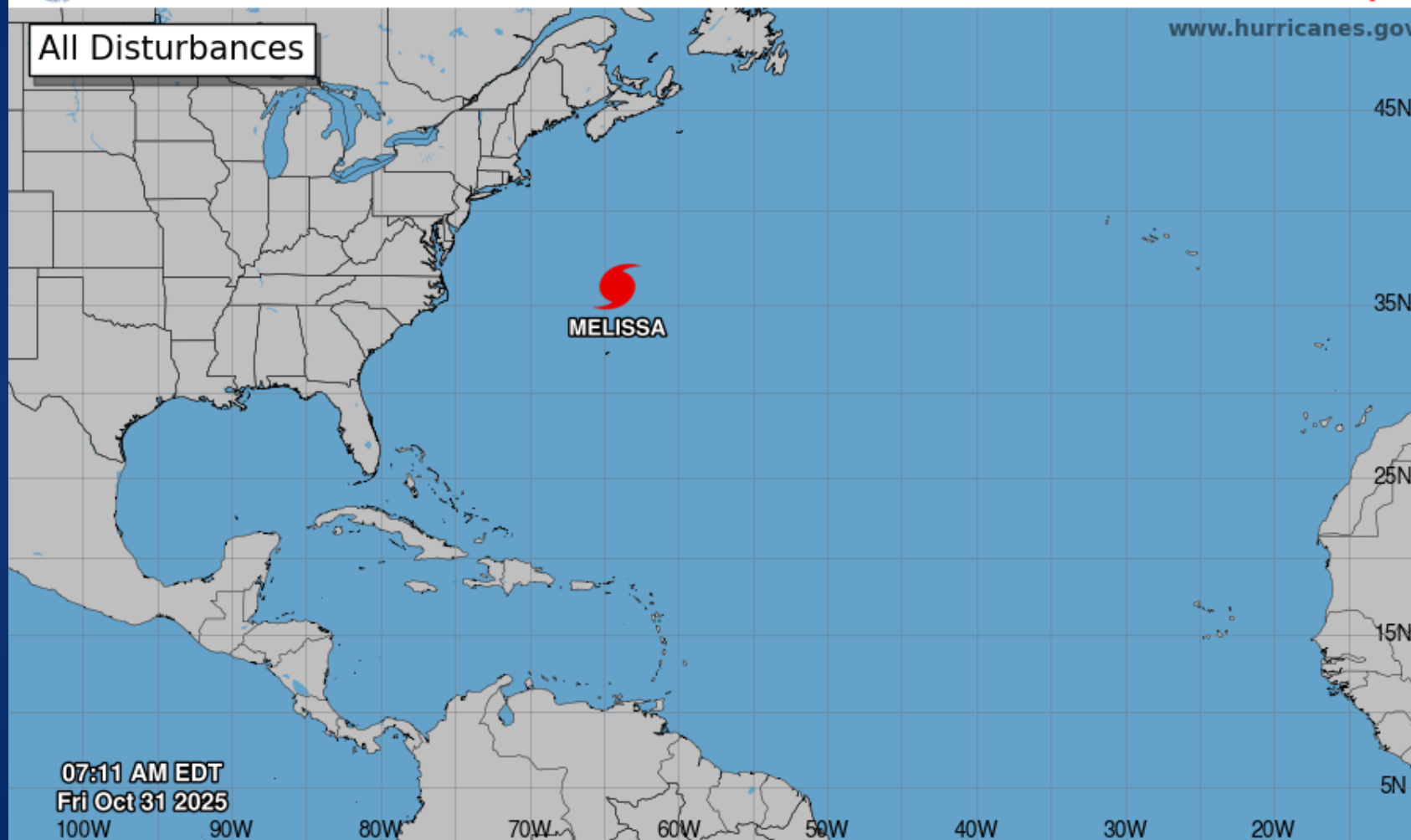
Seven-Day Graphical Tropical Weather Outlook

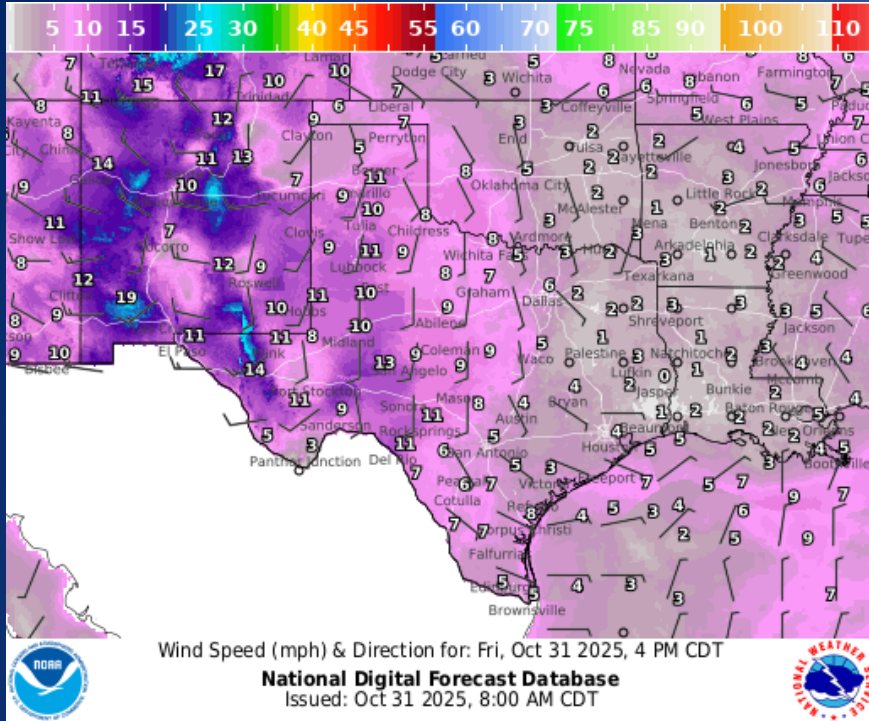

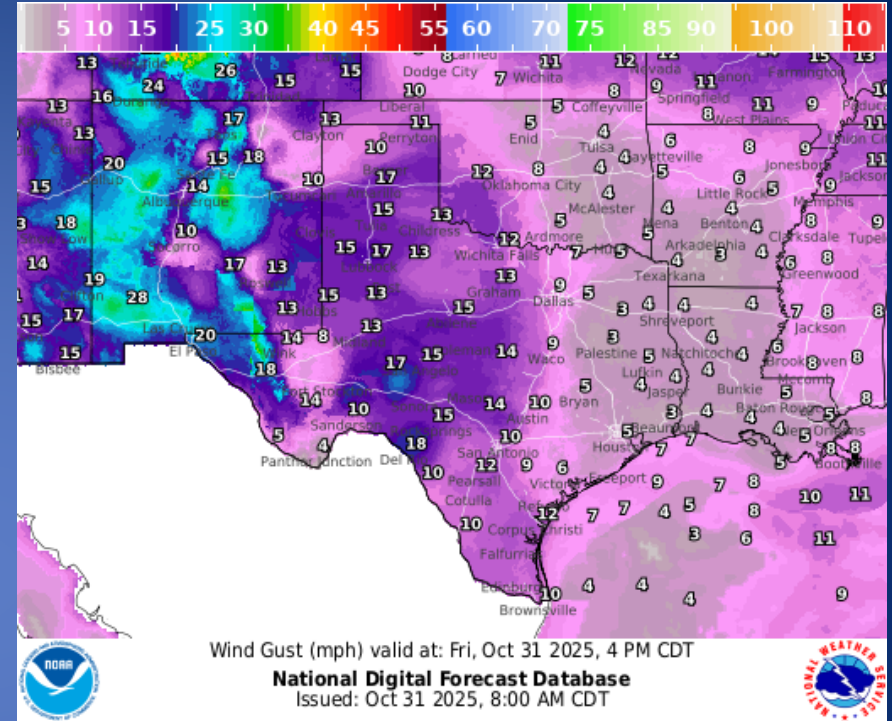

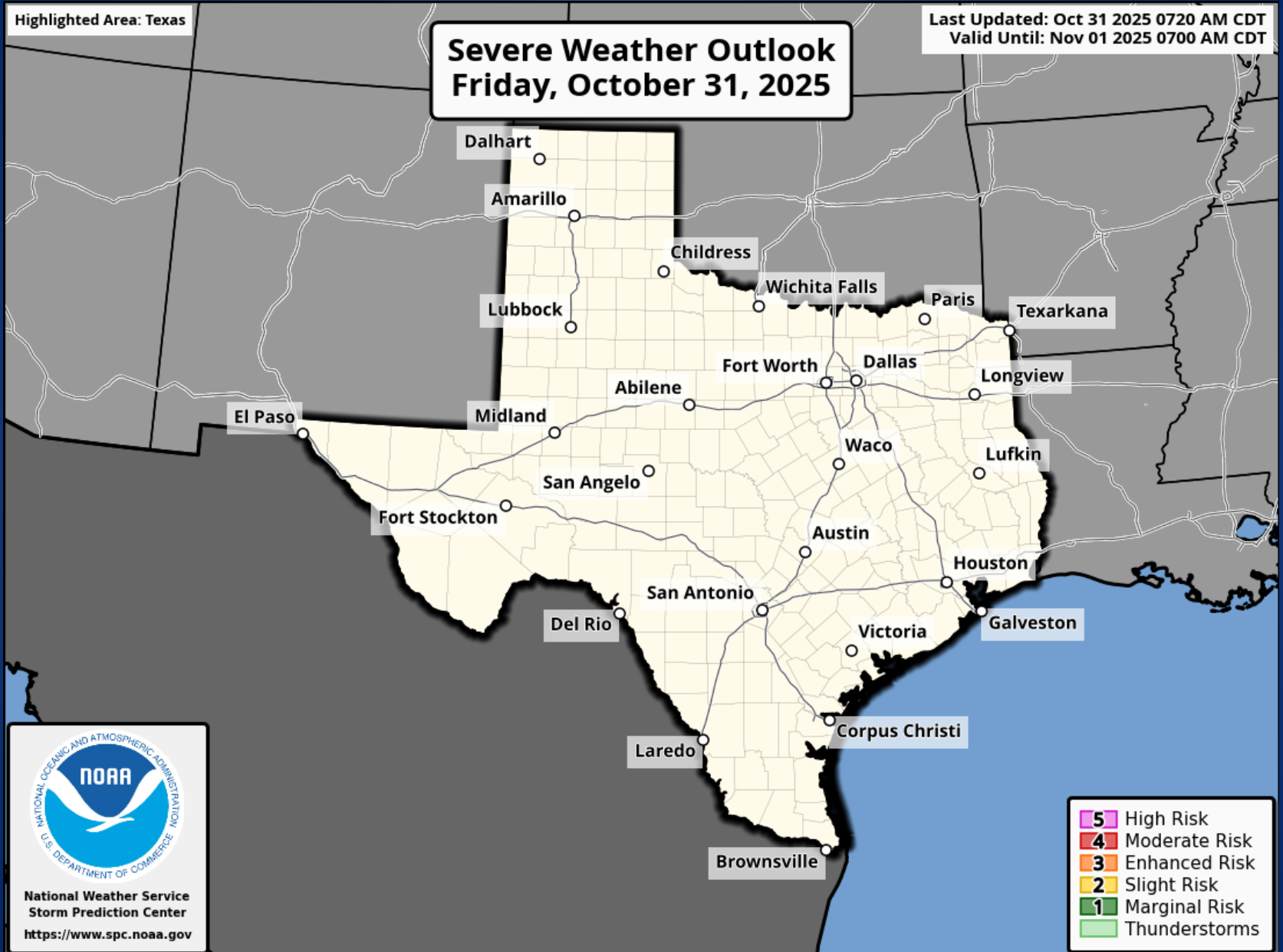

Low Humidity and Critically Dry Fuels



Key Messages

- Conditions today are favorable for erratic wildfire growth.
- Avoid activities that may cause a spark!
 - **Relative Humidity:** 15-25%
 - **Fuels:** Critically Dry
 - **Winds:** 5-10 mph

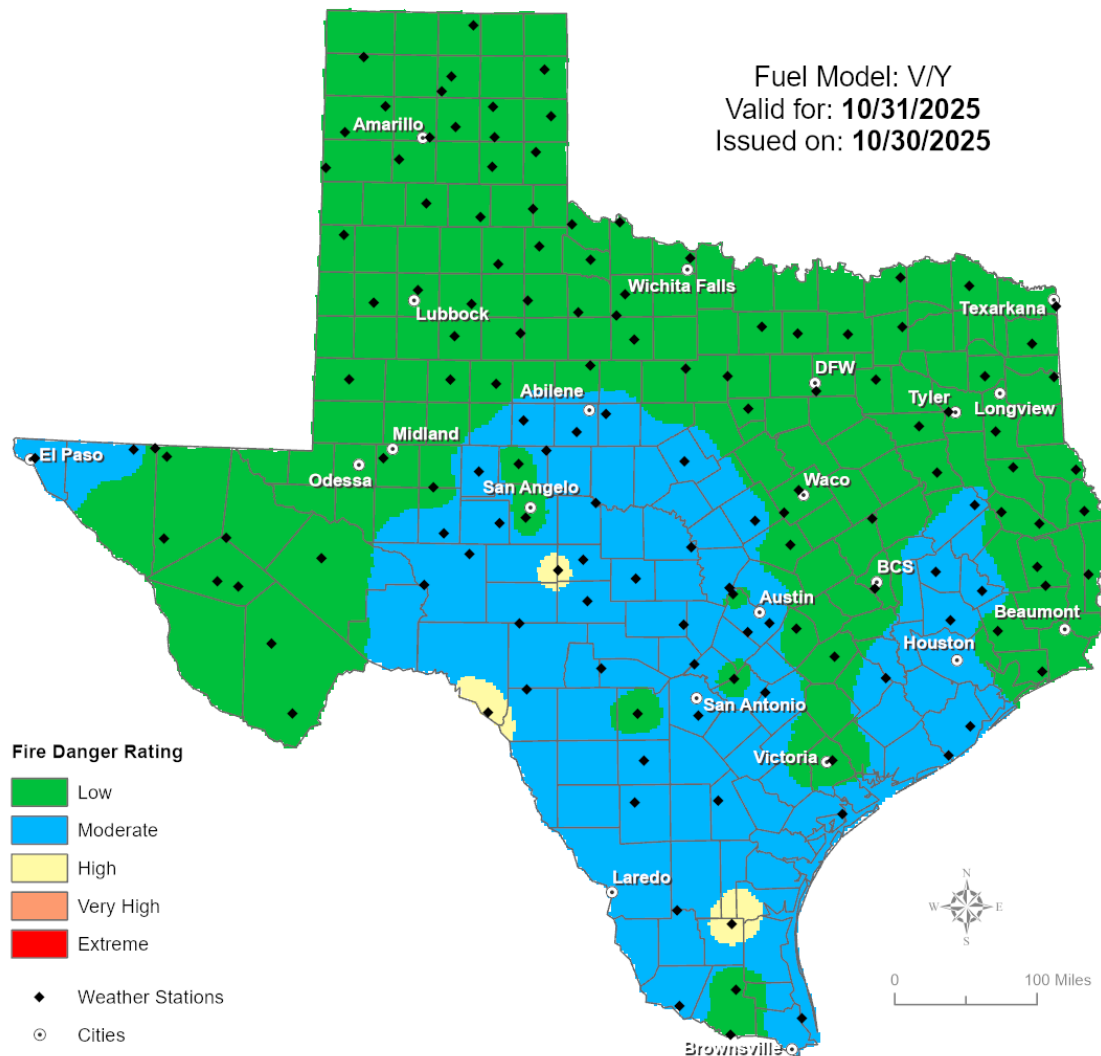

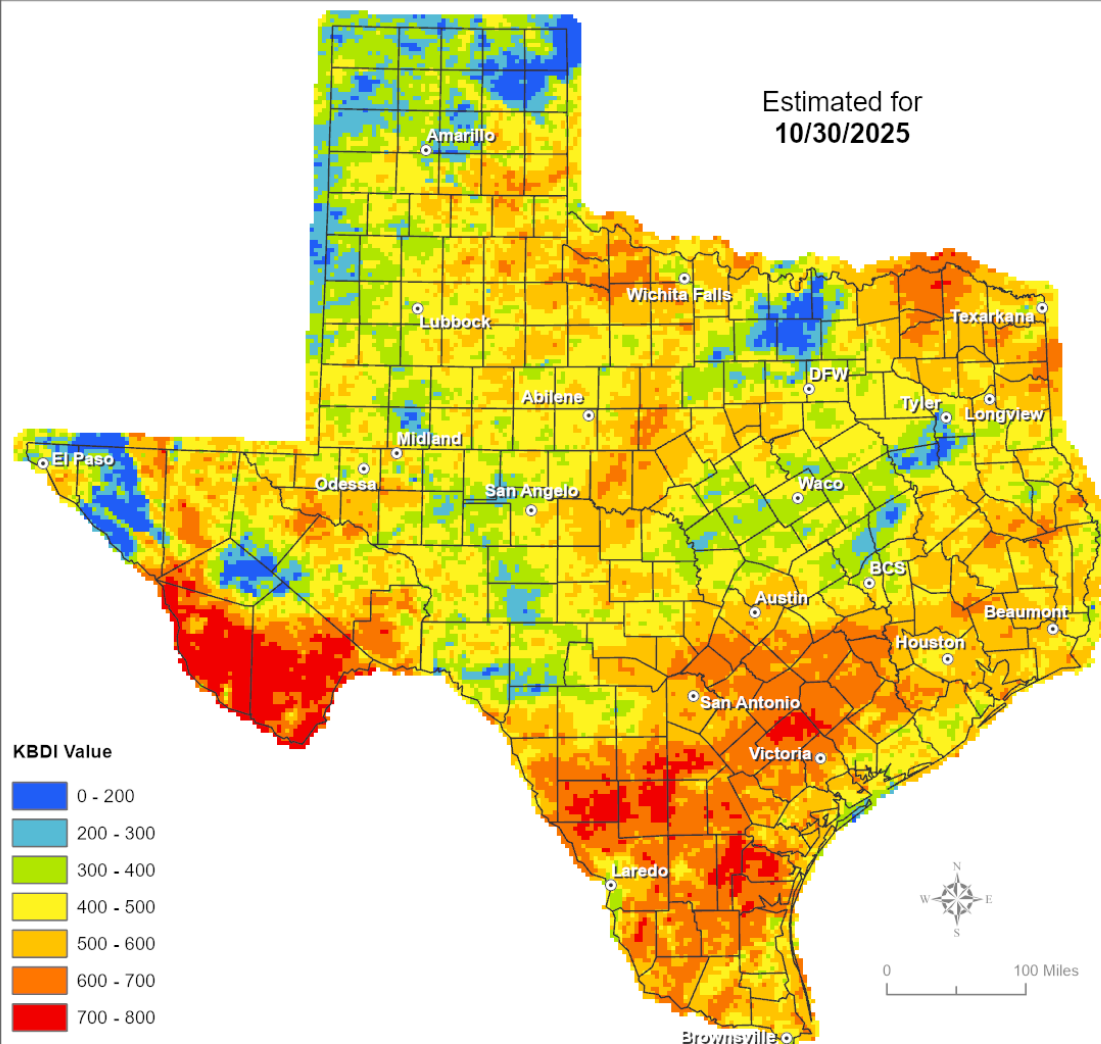

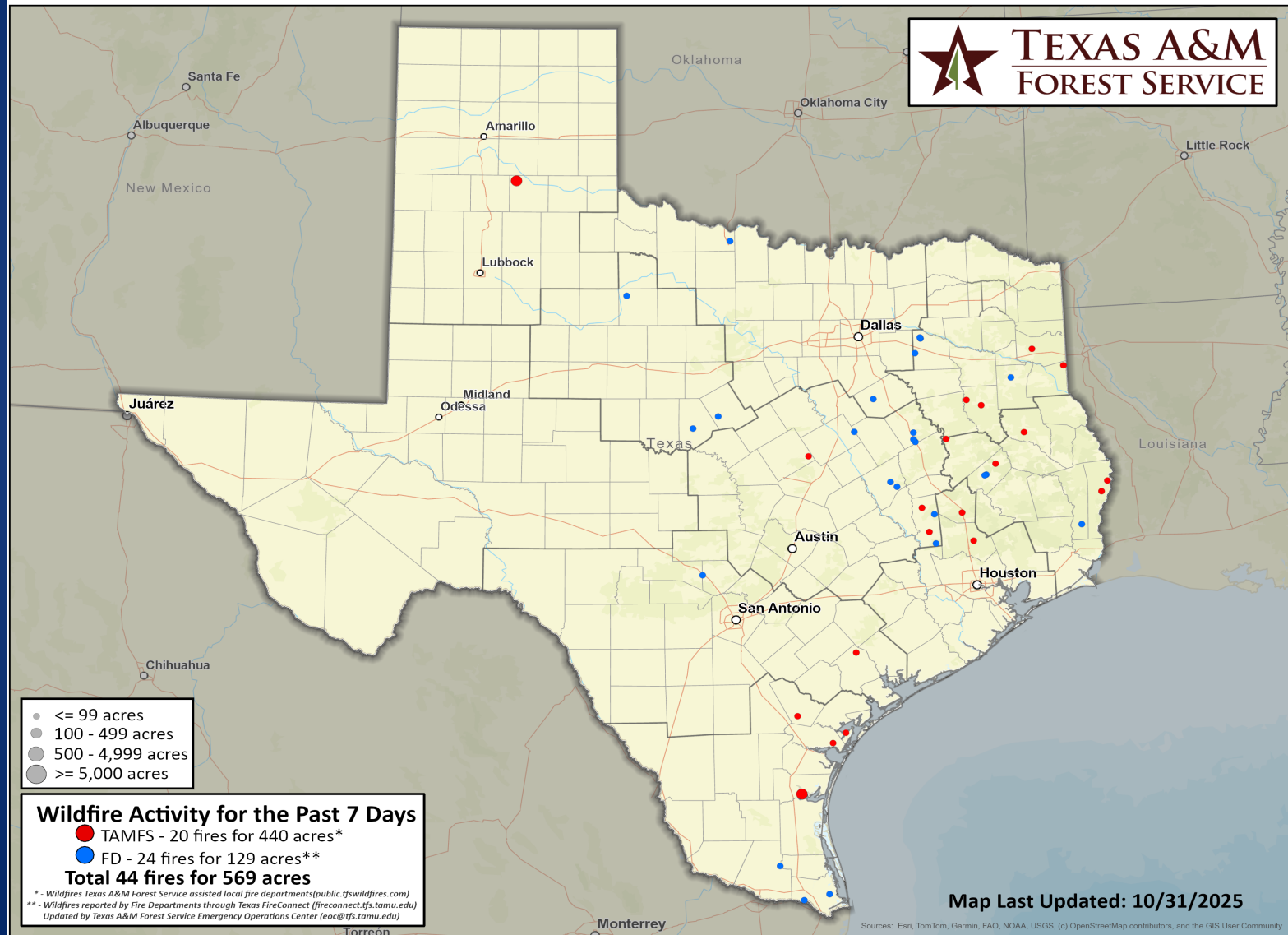

Fire Activity (*Last 24 Hours)

Report of 668 (+14) fires and 98,339 (+256) acres have been burned this year. There are 138 (-3) counties with burn bans. The Keetch–Byram Drought Index list contains 205 (+2) counties with an average over 400.
