






Large Hail

A couple of storms late tonight across western/northwest North Texas could be strong with small hail and gusty winds.**







(4 km x 4 km resolution)



# Fire Activity (\*Last 24 Hours)

Report of 44 (no change) fires and 551 (no change) acres have been burned this year. There are 117 (+1) counties with burn bans. The Keetch–Byram Drought Index list contains 180 (+1) counties with an average over 400.
