

Hazardous Weather

Rain & Storm Chances Thursday & Friday



Scattered showers and a few isolated thunderstorms will accompany a Pacific cold front moving through the region today, with the best chances north of I-20 this morning. Behind the front, gusty winds and much drier air will support an elevated fire weather threat near and west of I-35 this afternoon. Additional showers and isolated storms possible Friday across parts of East and Central Texas before a stronger cold front arrives late Friday.





(4 km x 4 km resolution)



Report of 48 (+4) fires and 560 (+9) acres have been burned this year. There are 121 (+4) counties with burn bans. The Keetch–Byram Drought Index list contains 188 (+8) counties with an average over 400.
