Elevated fire weather conditions will occur again today south of a Merton to Menard to Mason line. Any fires that develop will spread quickly and have the potential to become uncontrollable as a result. **Avoid any activities that could result in accidental fire starts.**



The main time frame of concern is from 11 AM through 7 PM CST Today.



- Humidity: 15% to 20%
- Winds: From the north 15 to 20 MPH with gusts to 30 MPH
- Temperatures: 65 to 70

Dry conditions and breezy winds will combine with plentiful dry fuels to increase the fire weather risk today, mainly across the southern part of the region.


