





A Red Flag Warning has been issued for the Hill Country, Southern Edwards Plateau and Rio Grande Plains from 11 AM to 7 PM Thursday. Breezy northerly winds of 10-20 mph with gusts up to 30 mph and humidity values as low as 12% will produce critical fire conditions across the area. Avoid open flames, keep vehicles off dry grass, use grills on pavement, properly discard cigarettes and remember to obey burn bans!








Keetch-Byram Drought Index



Fire Activity (*Last 24 Hours)

Report of 327 (+31) fires and 29,830 (+358) acres have been burned this year. There are 175 (+6) counties with burn bans. The Keetch–Byram Drought Index list contains 137 (+2) counties with an average over 400.
