



Wind Speeds







Warm, dry and breezy conditions will lead to fire weather concern on Friday afternoon across western Oklahoma and portions of western-north Texas.









Report of 364 (+6) fires and 29,855 (+25) acres have been burned this year. There are 182 (+7) counties with burn bans. The Keetch–Byram Drought Index list contains 139 (+2) counties with an average over 400.
