Summary

- **Severe Weather:**

- Marginal risk (level 1 of 5) over N/W OK and the E TX/OK Panhandles today.
- Slight risk (level 2 of 5) over SE OK, W AR and N/C TX on Wednesday and over W OK, N TX and the TX/OK Panhandles on Thursday.
- Slight to enhanced risk (levels 2-3 of 5) over OK, N/C TX and W AR on Friday.
- Slight risk over SE OK, AR, N TX and N LA Saturday and over S/C-E TX on Sunday.

- **Flash Flooding:**

- Marginal risk (level 1 of 4) tomorrow in SE OK, AR, N TX.
- Monitoring portions of OK, AR, N TX, and LA for heavy rainfall on Friday and again Saturday.
 - Heavy rain may persist into Sunday for TX, LA.

- **Fire Weather:**

- Elevated to critical (levels 1-2 of 3) over E NM, W/NW TX and the TX/OK Panhandles today, Thursday and Friday.
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- **River Flooding:**

- Monitoring for minor to isolated moderate river flooding to develop over N/C TX, E OK and W AR starting on Thursday.



Note: Even though the image displays 5 days of forecasted rainfall, river forecasts only include 1-2 days of rainfall




Monitoring for the development of minor to isolated moderate river flooding over N/CTX, E OK and W AR.

Note: Numerical levels (e.g. level 1 of 4) will not be assigned to riverine flooding due to the varying levels of impacts across flood categories.







Today's Tornado & Severe Wind / Hail Probabilities









Tomorrow's Tornado & Severe Wind / Hail Probabilities






Enhanced risk (level 3 of 5) for severe storms over OK. Large hail, damaging winds and tornadoes possible.

Slight risk (level 2 of 5) for severe storms in W AR, N/CTX. Hail and wind are the main threats. Isolated tornadoes cannot be ruled out.

Elevated to critical (levels 1-2 of 3) fire weather concerns in E NM, W/NW TX, TX/OK Panhandles.

Marginal risk (level 1 of 4) for flash flooding in E OK, W AR, N TX, NW LA.





Monitoring for locally heavy rainfall in TX, AR and LA










“Day 3-7” Hazards Outlook








