


Another active weather day is expected on Friday with strong to severe storms developing in the afternoon. Large hail, damaging winds and a few tornadoes will all be possible. Most likely intensity for each hazard (if the hazard occurs) will be winds below 75 mph, hail 2 inches or less and tornadoes in the EF0-EF1 category. Additionally, there will be a low potential for flash flooding with any heavy rain-producing thunderstorm.

Near Critical Fire Danger is forecast for Thursday in the Sacramento and Capitan Mtns due to strong southwest winds and dry conditions.








Isolated Tornado


Severe Weather Risk Thursday Evening & Night






Keetch-Byram Drought Index


