**STATEWIDE CURRENT SITUATION:** On March 4, Governor Greg Abbott announced that he directed the Texas Division of Emergency Management (TDEM) to activate state emergency response resources ahead of a severe weather threat expected to impact portions of Texas beginning March 4 and continuing through the weekend.

**OPERATIONAL PRIORITIES:**

1. Protect life and property.
2. Support rapid & effective response.
3. Collect and disseminate accurate incident information to improve decision-making.
4. Accurately track incident costs associated with assigned resources for cost recovery.

**RESPONDING STATE AGENCIES/ORGANIZATIONS REPORTS**

**Texas A&M Engineering Extension Service Texas Task Force 1 (TEEX/TX-TF1):**  
As of March 18, all Texas A&M Task Force 1,2 and 3 resources have been demobilized.

**Texas A&M Engineering Extension Service Texas Task Force 2 (TEEX/TX-TF2):**  
As of March 18, all Texas A&M Task Force 1,2 and 3 resources have been demobilized.

**Texas A&M Engineering Extension Service Texas Task Force 3 (TEEX/TX-TF3):**  
As of March 18, all Texas A&M Task Force 1,2 and 3 resources have been demobilized.

**Texas A&M Forest Service (TAMFS):**  
The Texas A&M Forest Service has activated three Texas Intrastate Fire Mutual Aid System (TIFMAS) All-hazard Strike Teams (ST) in response to forecasted severe weather. The STs are currently located in Midland, Amarillo, and Vernon. In total, TAMFS has 61 personnel committed to the event.

**Texas Military Department (TMD):**  
TMD has released all assets.

**Texas Parks and Wildlife Department (TPWD):**  
TPWD has Texas Game Wardens and State Park Police Officers prepared to respond and support operations.

**Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT):**  
As of March 11, there were no roadways closed or impacted due to weather or wildfires. TxDOT has an Emergency Management Coordinator (EMC) and a State Operations Center (SOC) Liaison Officer (LNO) supporting in Austin. TxDOT continues to coordinate with Texas A&M Forest Service (TAMFS) for Dynamic Message Sign (DMS) wildfire messaging, if needed.

**Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS):**  
As of March 12, the DSHS All-Hazard Severe Weather Packages (SWX) have been released and re-assigned for fire weather support.

**Texas Emergency Medical Task Force (EMTF):**  
As of March 5, DSHS EMTF activated a State Coordination Officer (SCO) and Liaison Officer (LNO). Two severe weather packages have been activated and staged.
