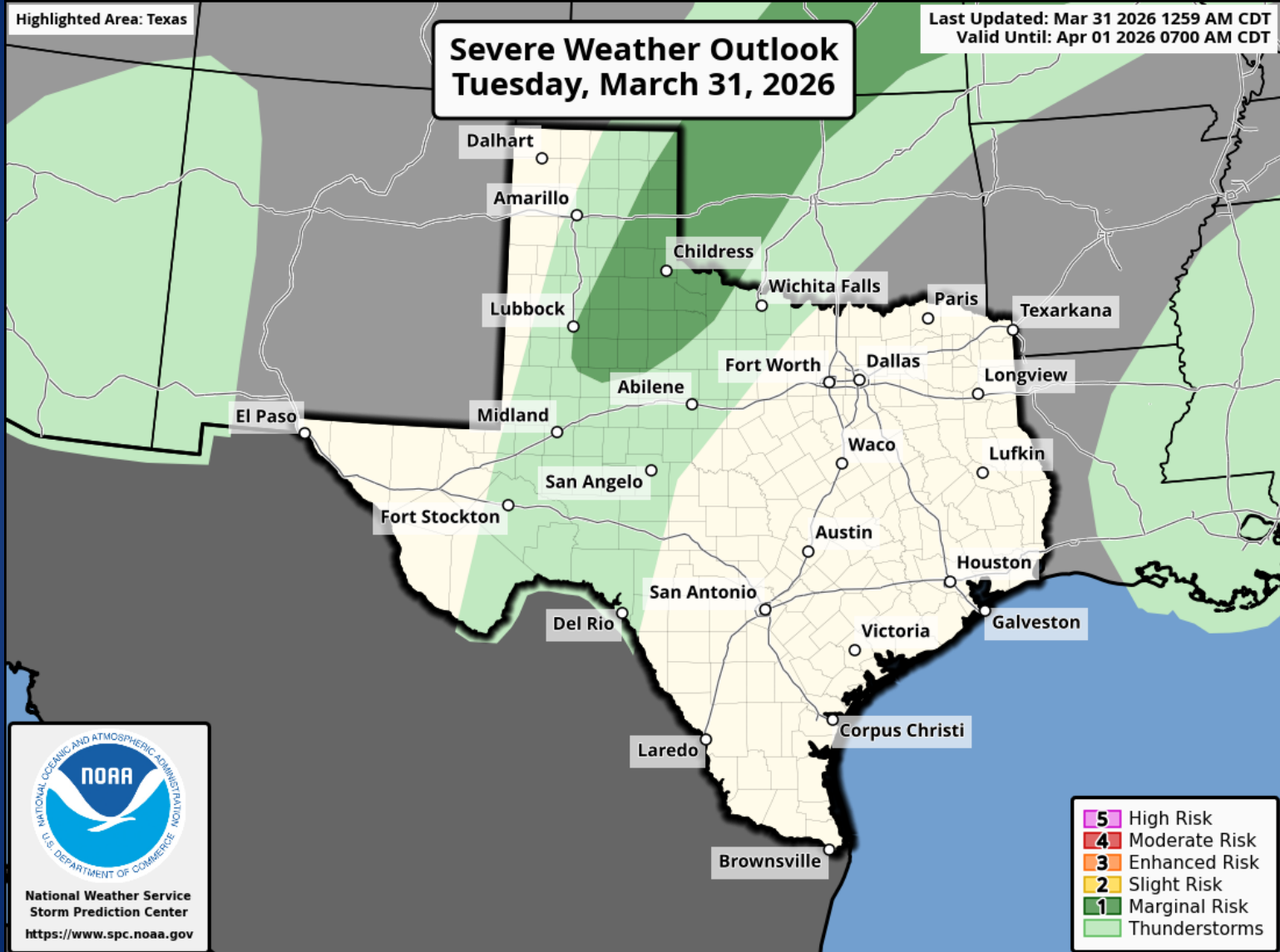

There is a 10-30% chance for showers and thunderstorms to develop in the eastern Texas and Oklahoma Panhandles Tuesday afternoon and evening. Although the chance is low, a few storms may become severe. At this time, the primary concern would be on large hail up to 1.5 inches and wind gusts upwards of 65 mph.

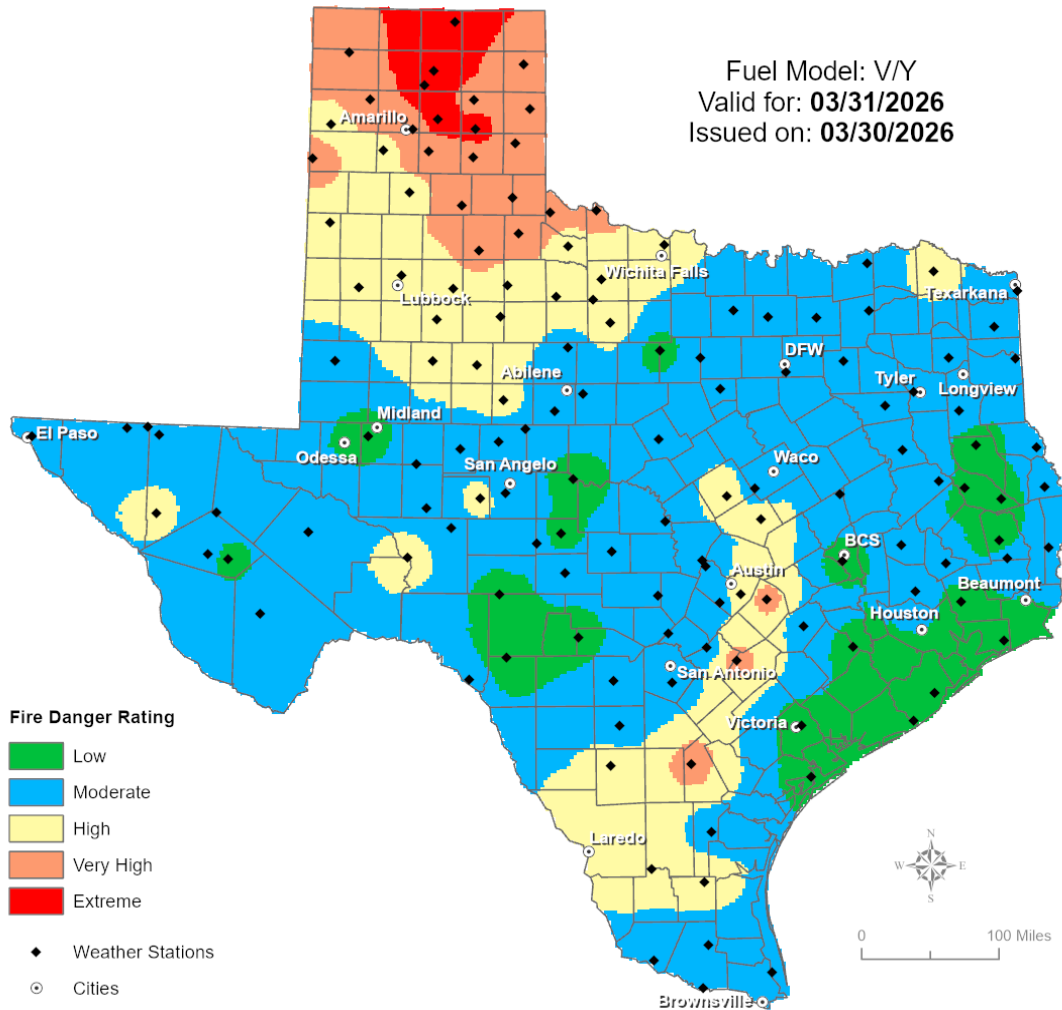

## Forecast Fire Danger



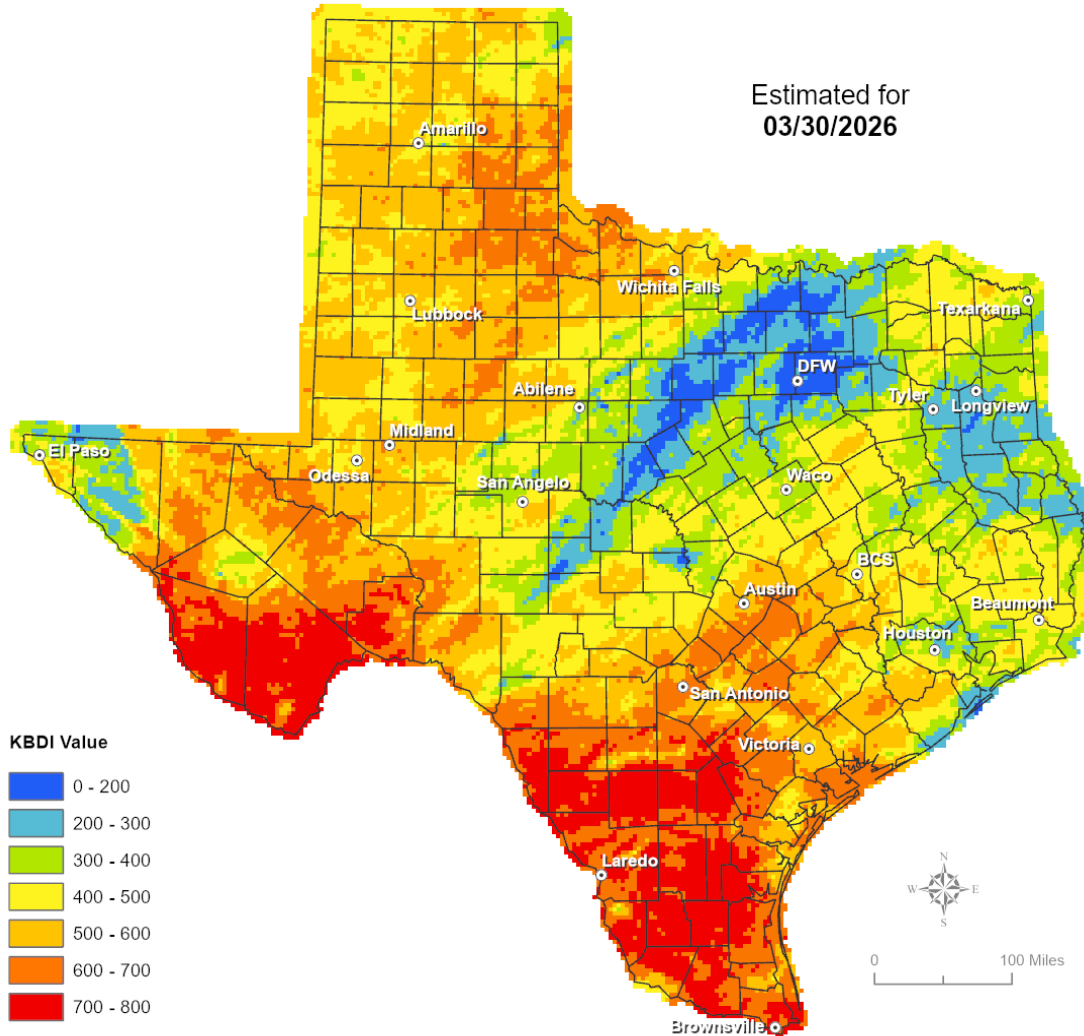


# Keetch-Byram Drought

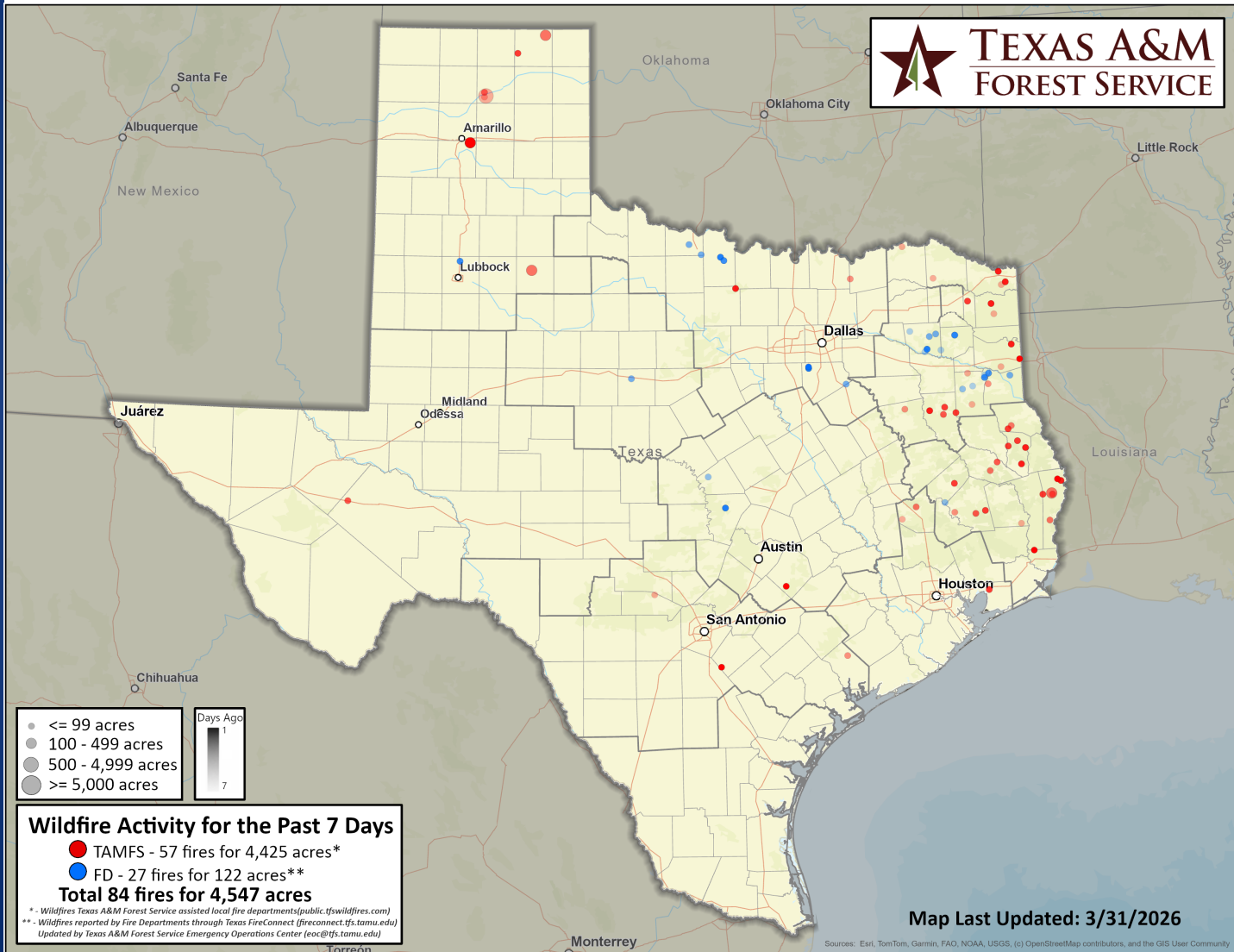
