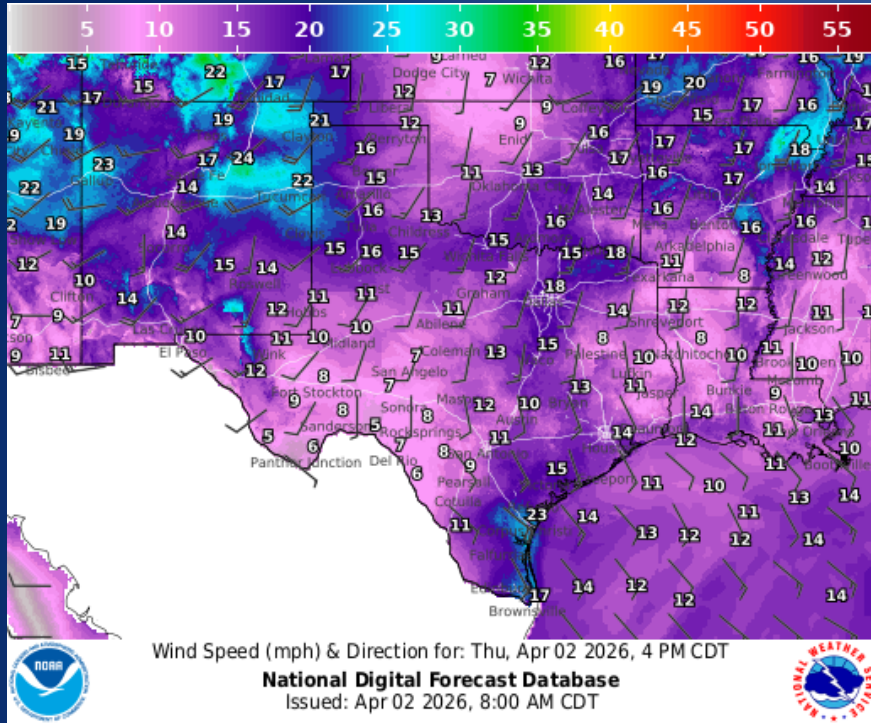

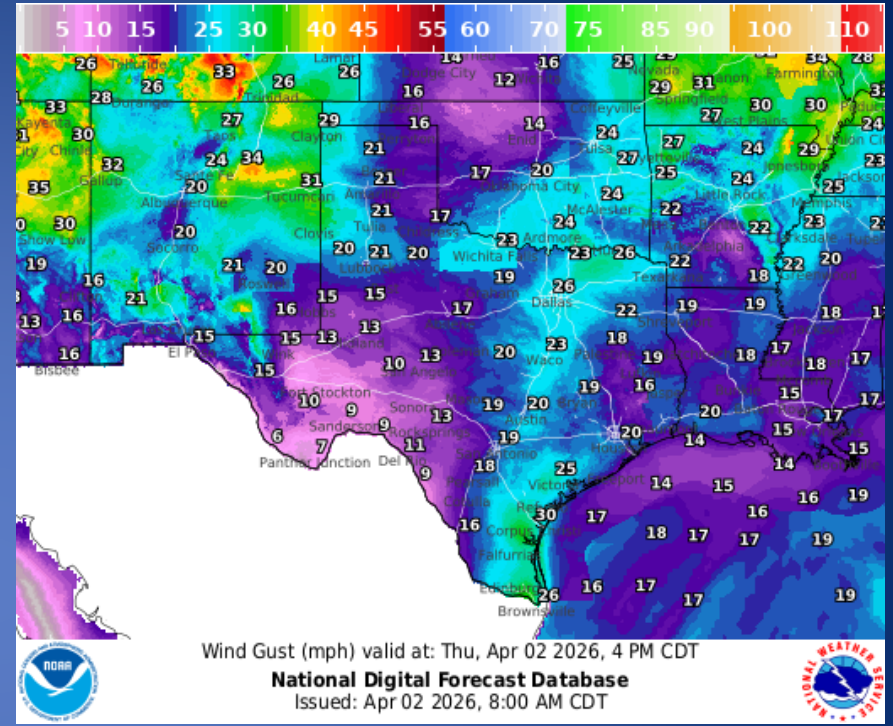

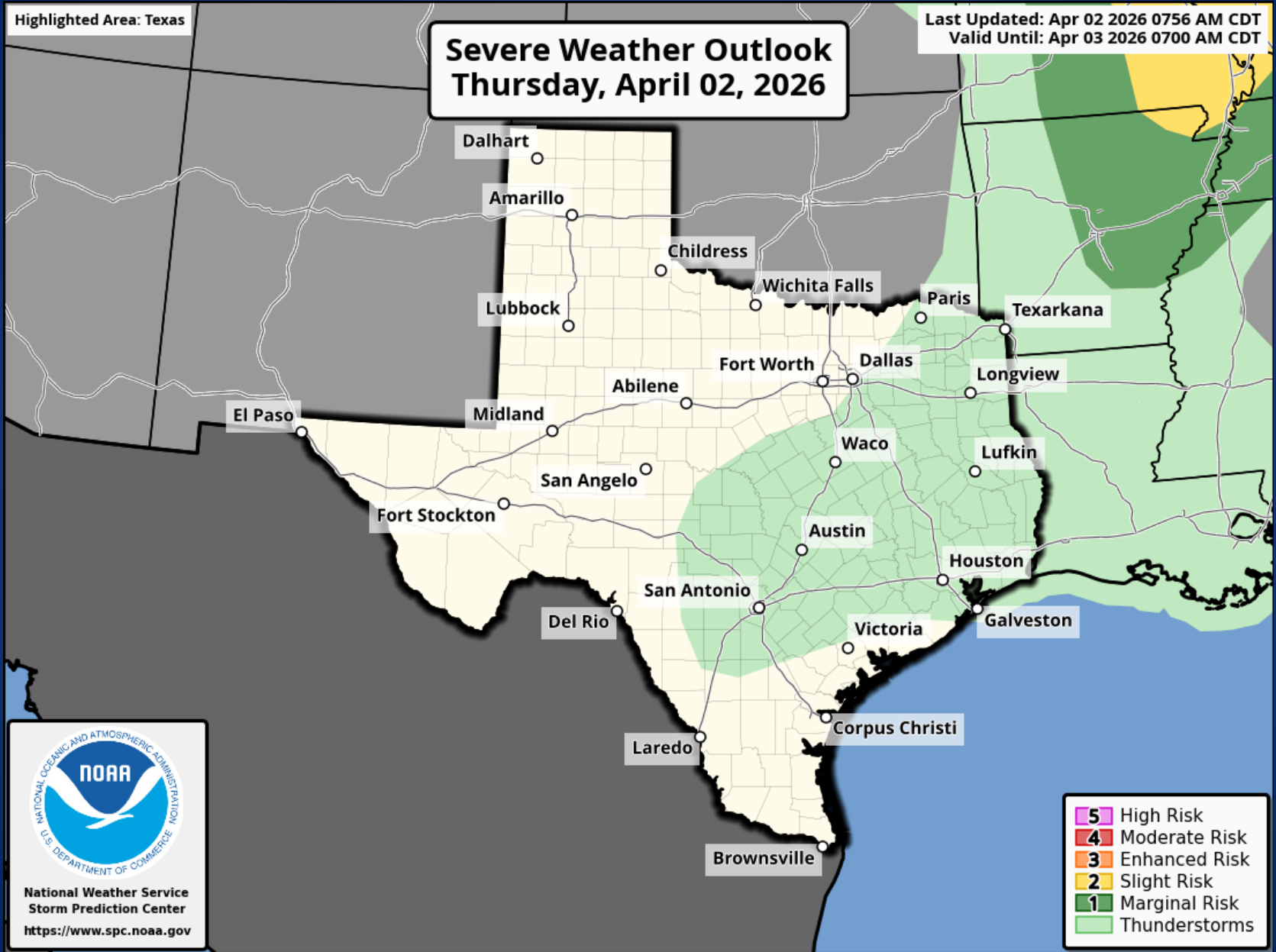


## Wind Speed



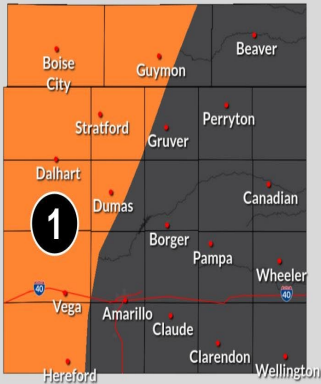

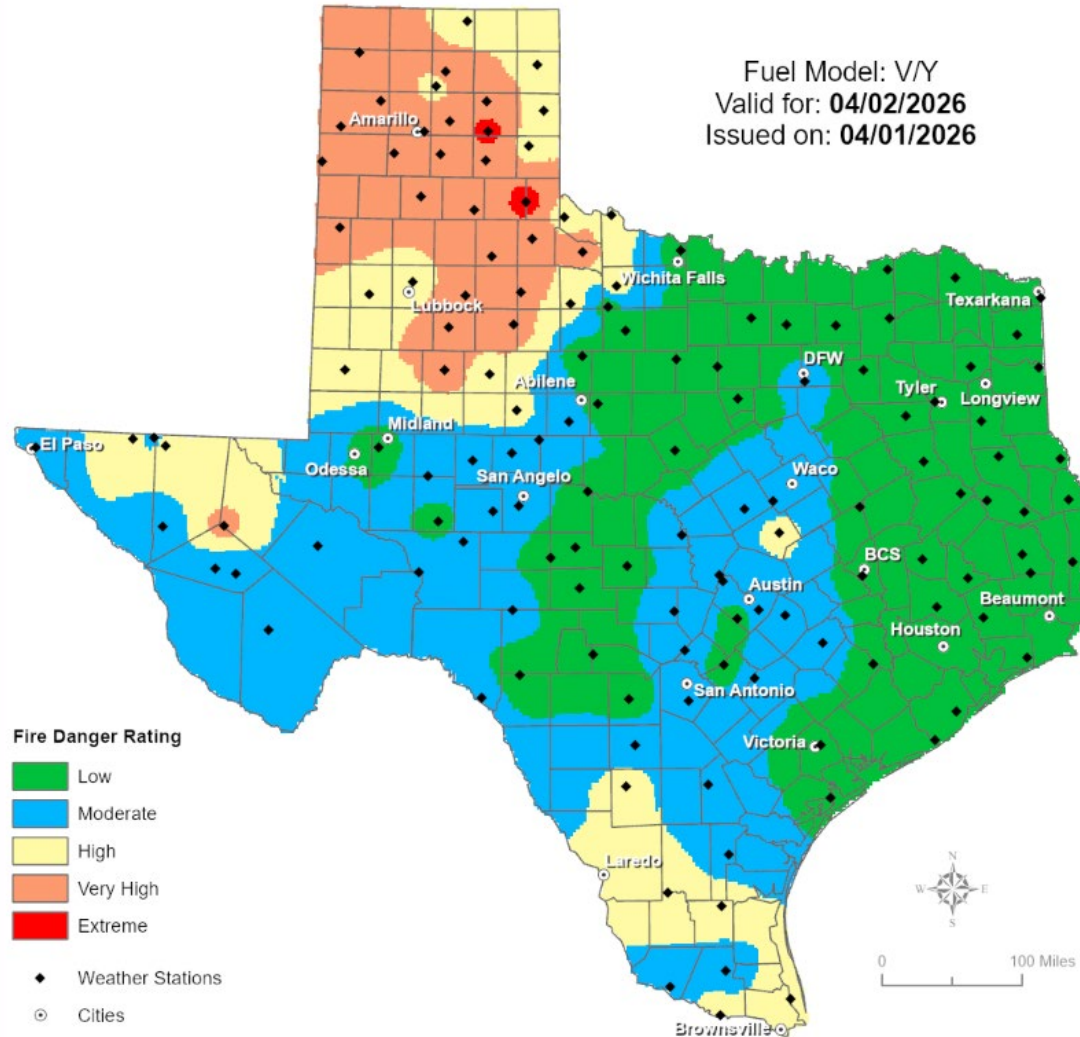

## Forecast Fire Danger



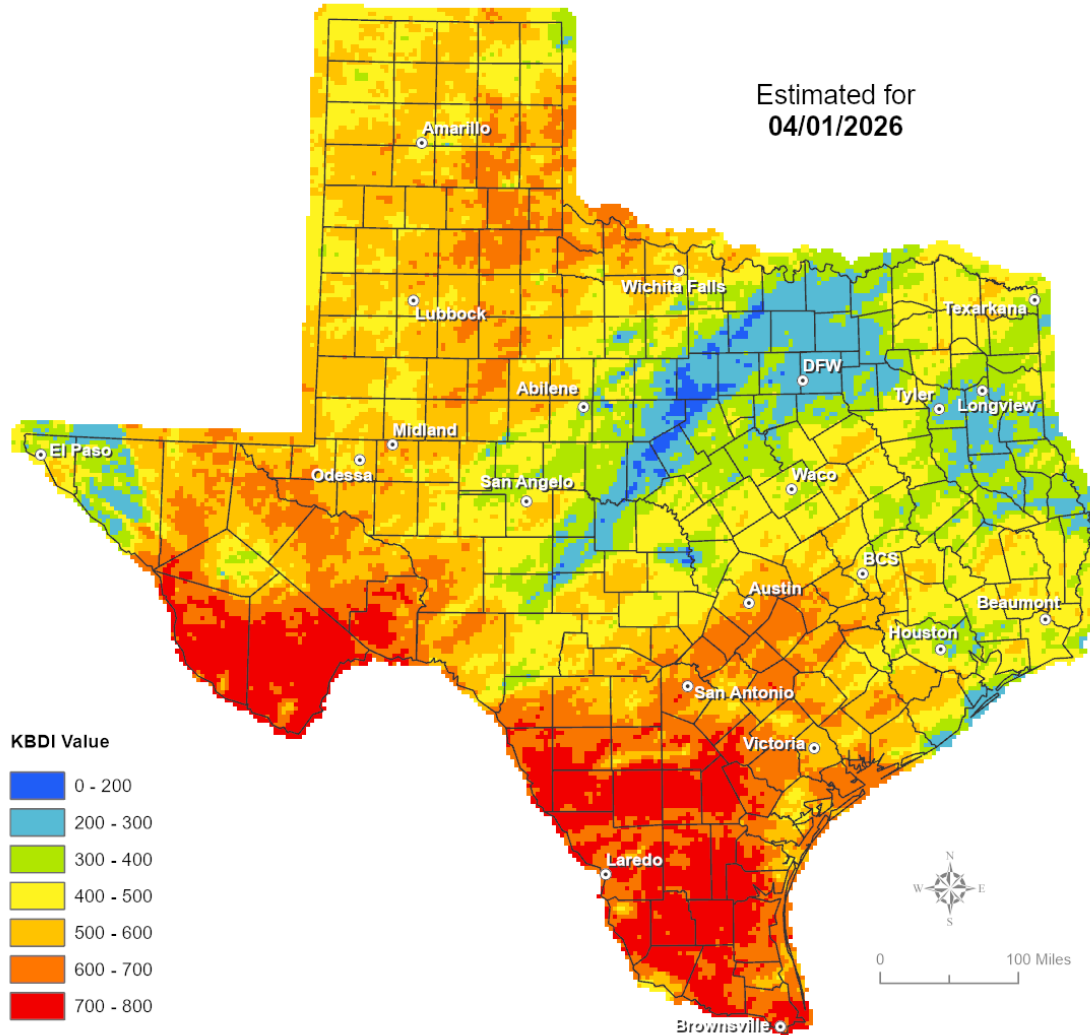


# Keetch-Byram Drought

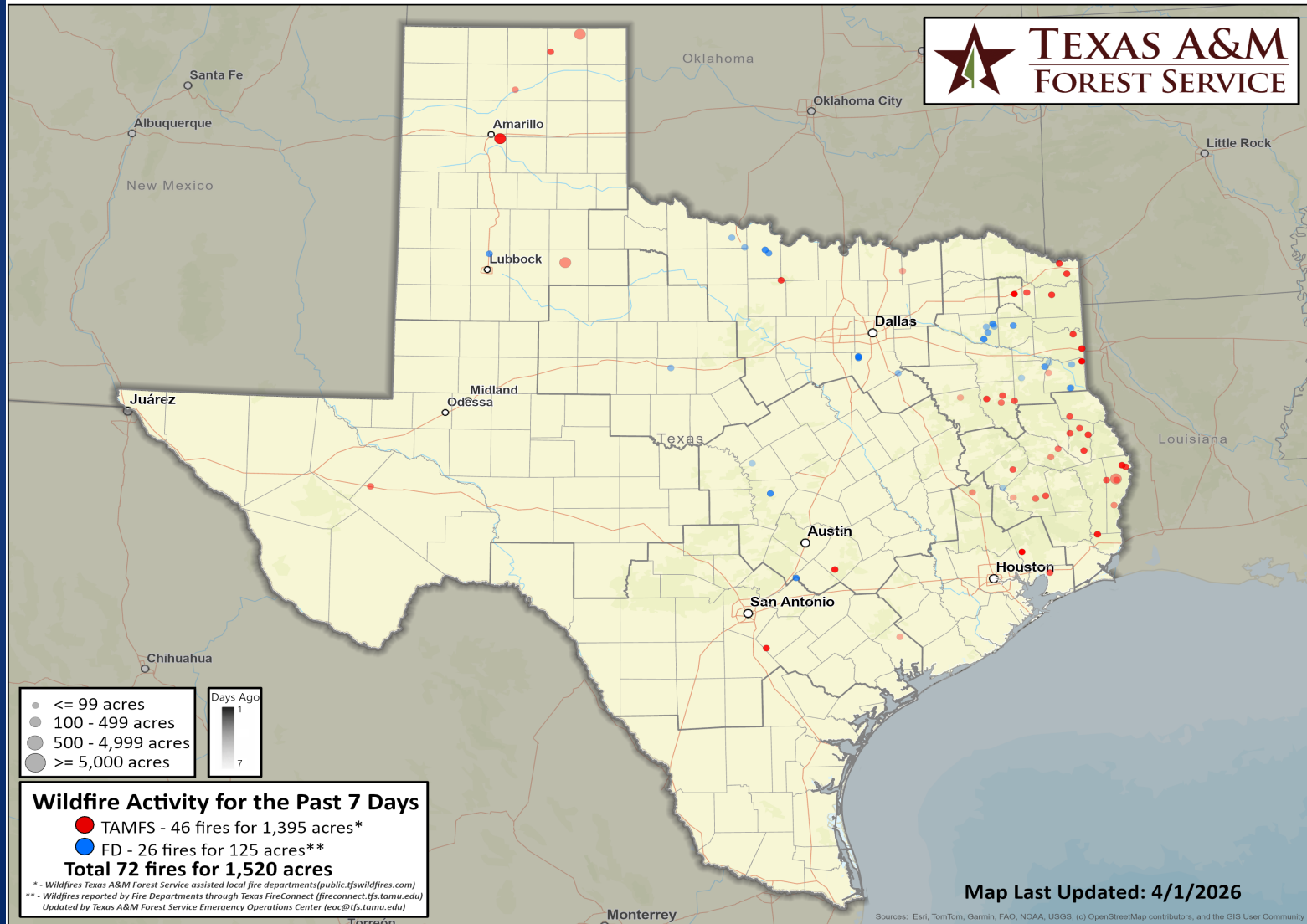
