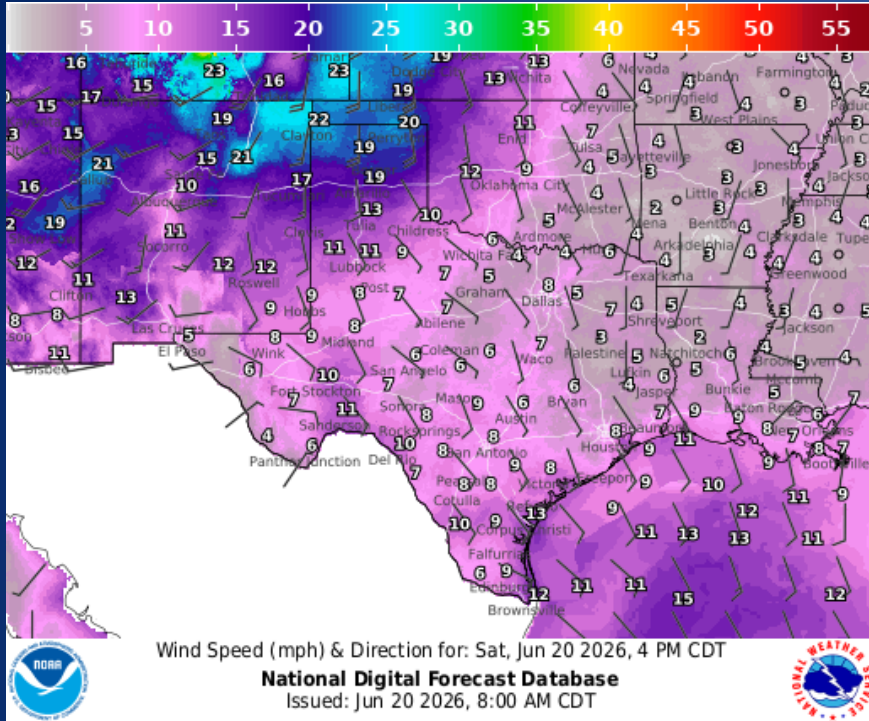

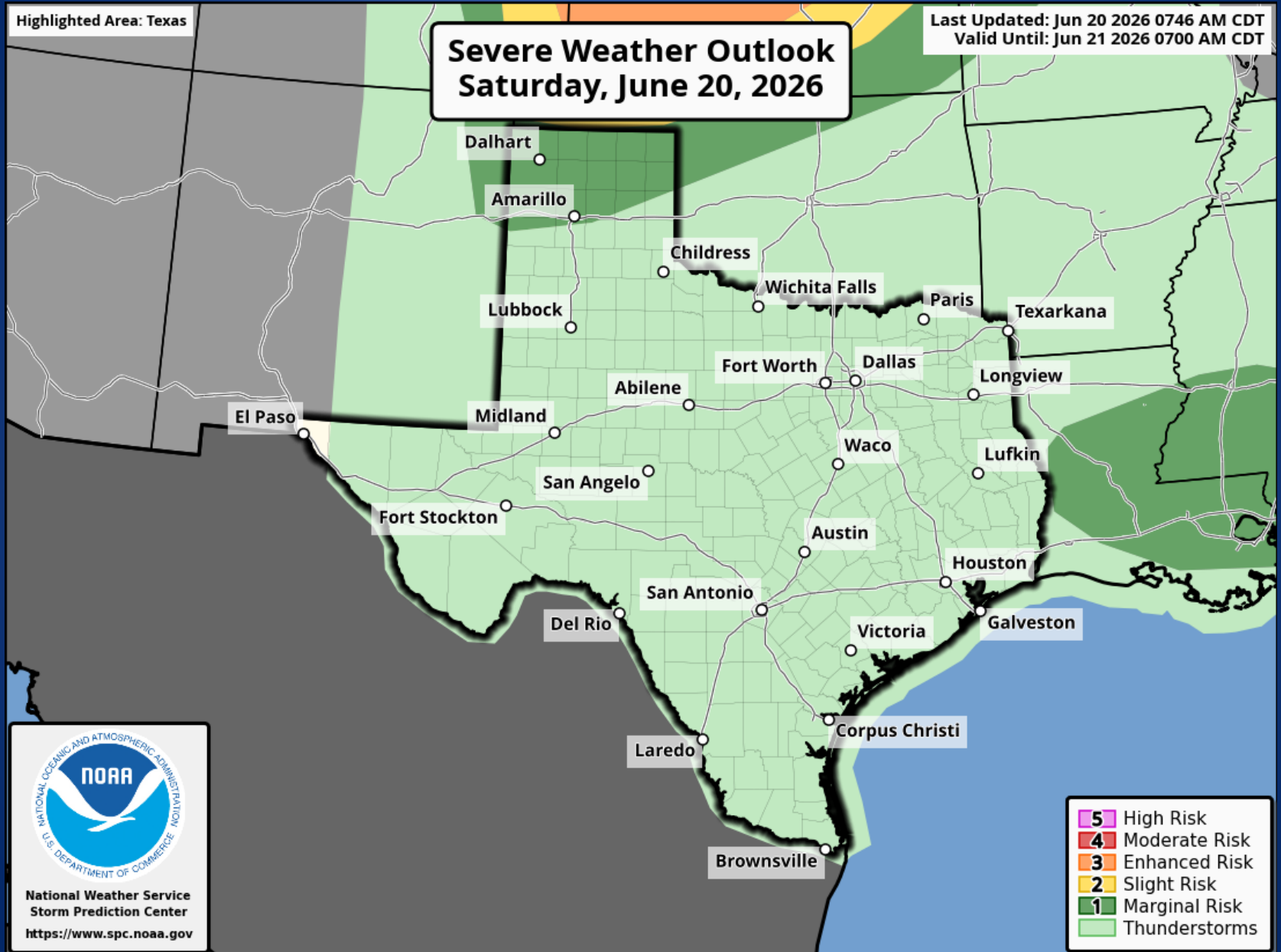

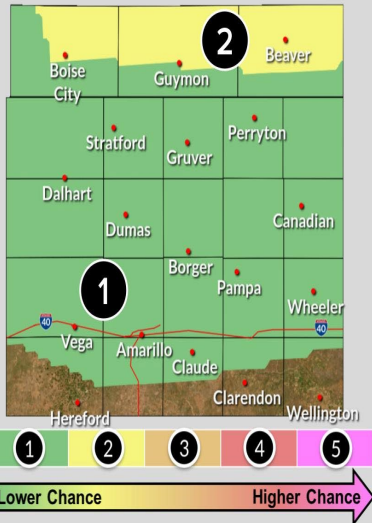

We will be watching for a supercell or two moving across the northern Panhandles this afternoon and evening, which could pose a threat for large hail, damaging wind gusts, and a non-zero tornado threat. Confidence in storms developing is lower further south across the TX Panhandle, but could easily be severe if they form.

- Heavy rainfall may lead to flooding of low-lying areas, rivers/creeks, and roads

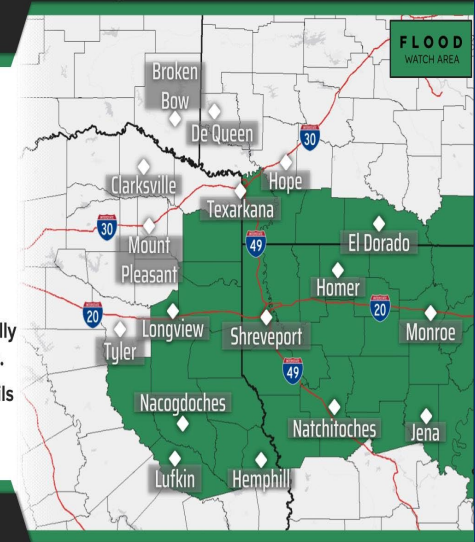

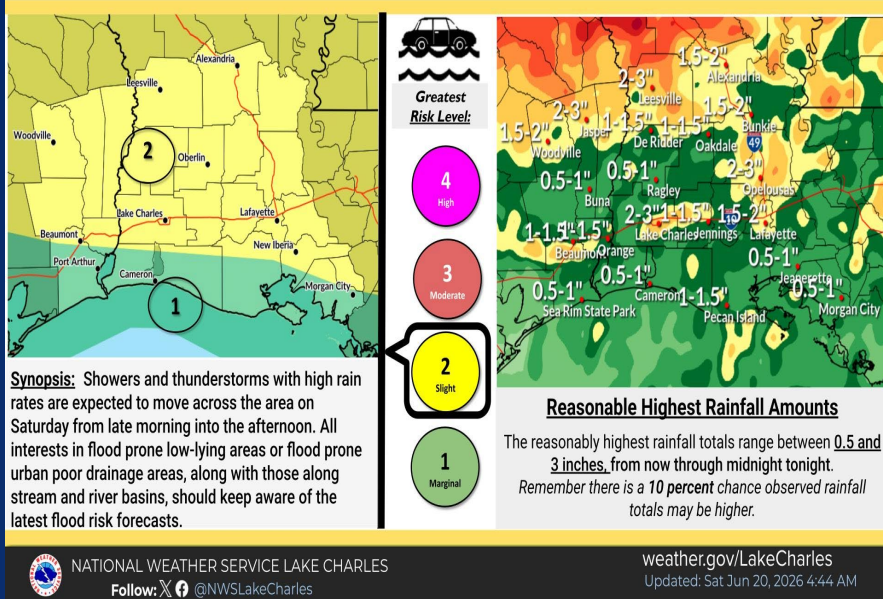

A Flood Watch has been issued for much of deep east and northeast Texas, for our Louisiana parishes and for extreme southern Arkansas until 3 PM this afternoon. Training and slow moving storms may result in 1-3+ inch amounts, with some higher totals near 4-5 inches possible.

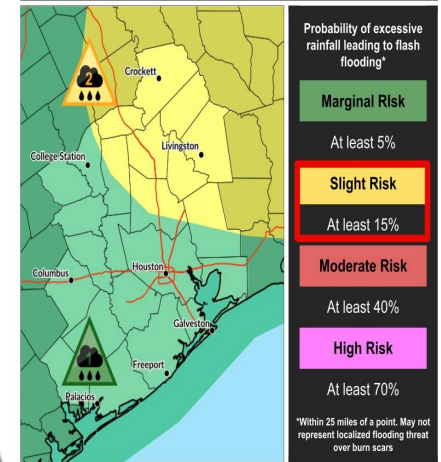

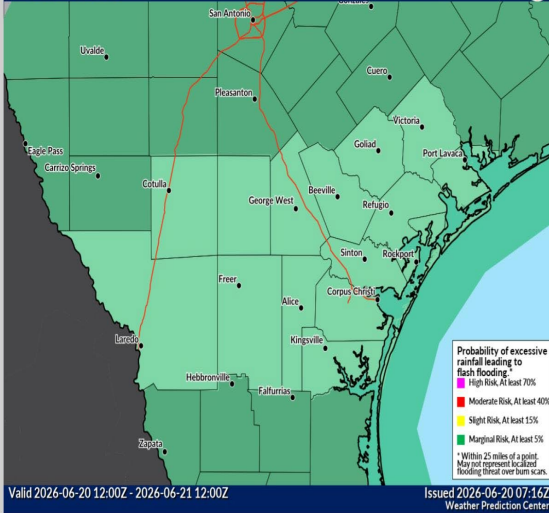

Isolated Flash Flooding Possible Saturday

Deep South Texas Under a Level 1 of 4 Risk of Excessive Rainfall Today

Key Messages

- Locally heavy rainfall in Deep South Texas is possible Saturday through Saturday night.
- Scattered showers and thunderstorms (30-40% chance) are possible across the region.

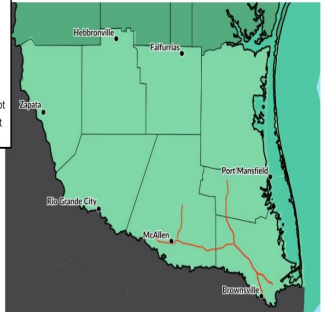
What We're Watching

- Areas of locally heavy rainfall may see isolated flash flooding.
 - ◆ Flood-prone areas: Low lying land, urban areas, and poor drainage areas.

Probability of excessive rainfall
leading to flash flooding.*

- High Risk, At least 70%
- Moderate Risk, At least 40%
- Slight Risk, At least 15%
- Marginal Risk, At least 5%

* Within 25 miles of a point. May not represent localized flooding threat over burn scars.

There is a marginal risk for excessive rainfall today. The ground remains nearly saturated from recent rains, so it won't take much rain for flash flooding to occur.

The combination of low pressure in the middle layers of the atmosphere and deep tropical moisture will produce a threat for isolated flash flooding across the region today.

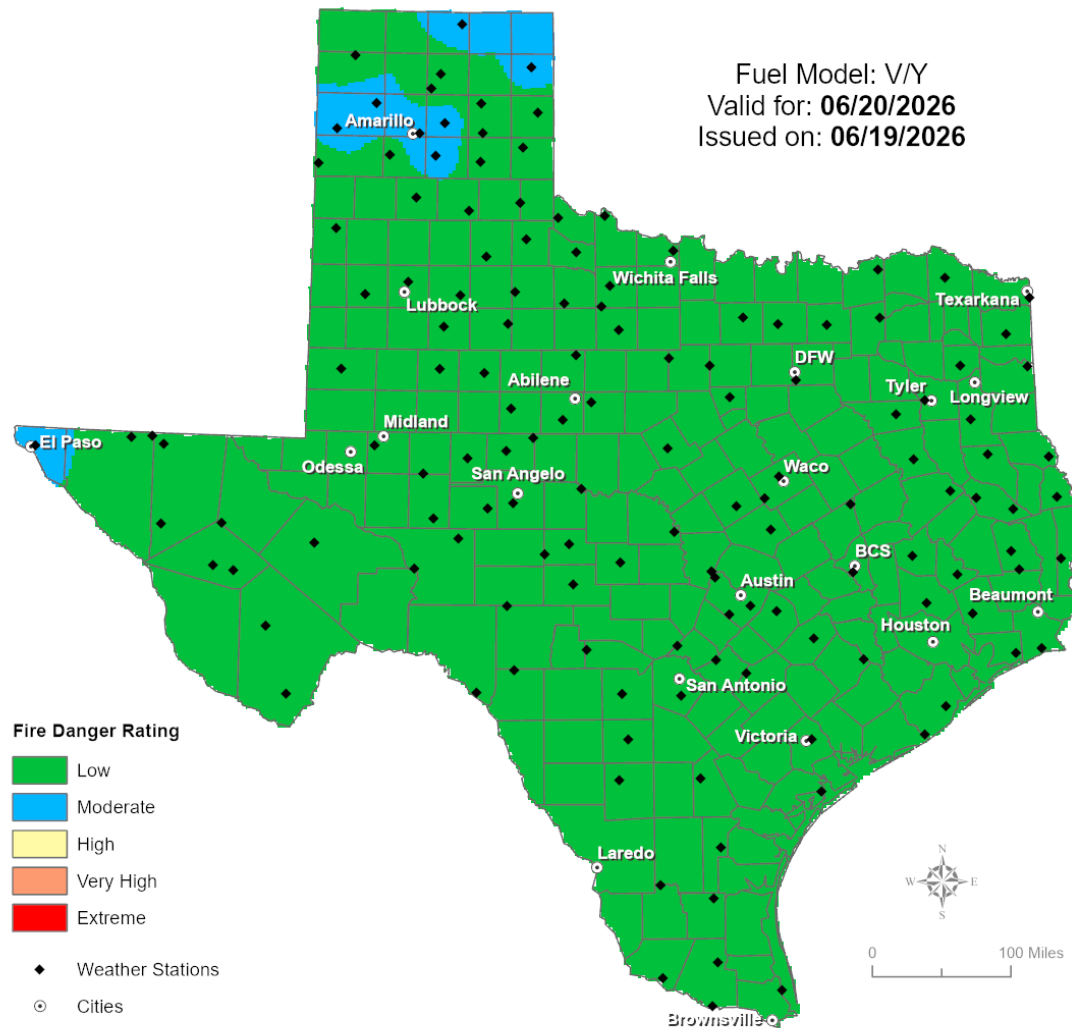

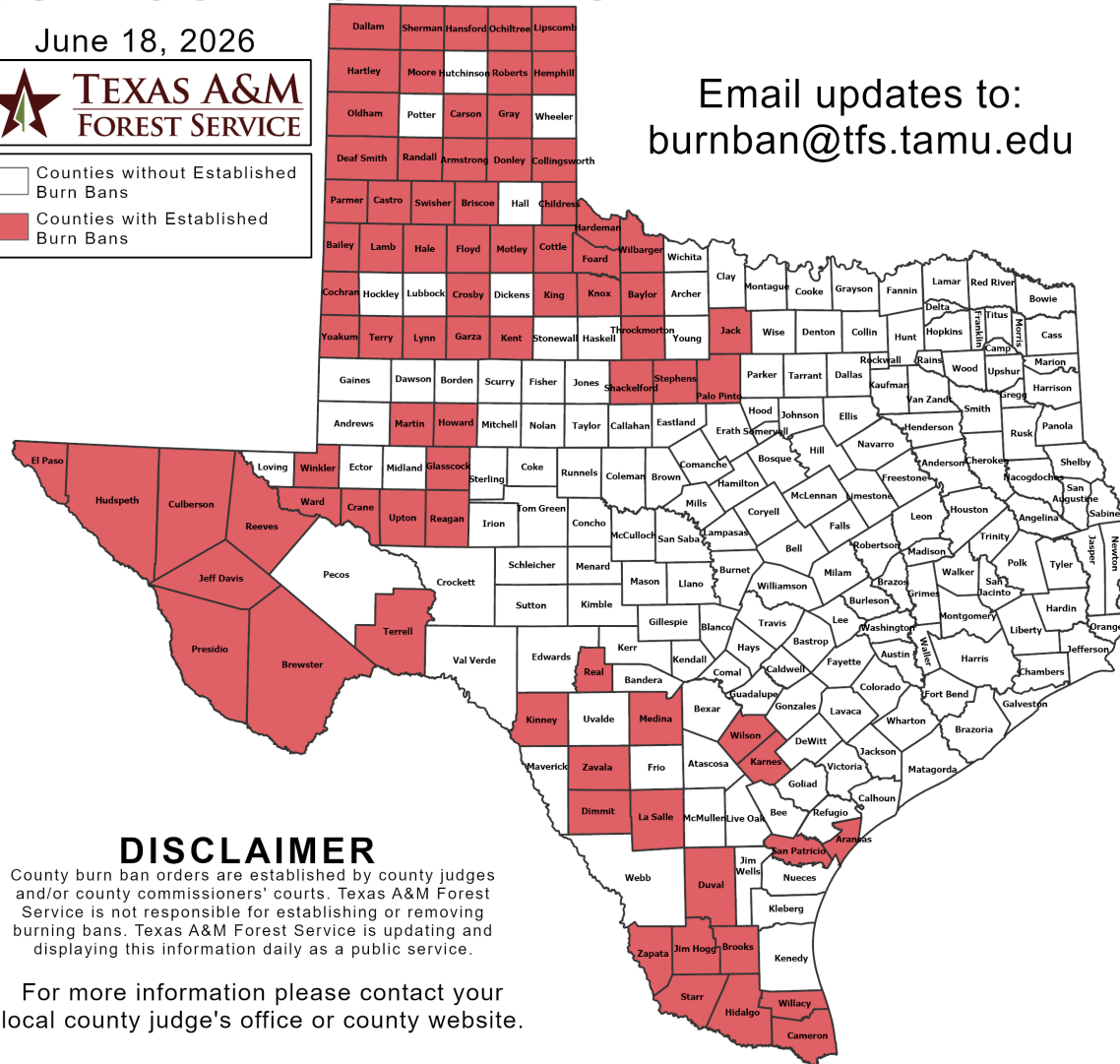

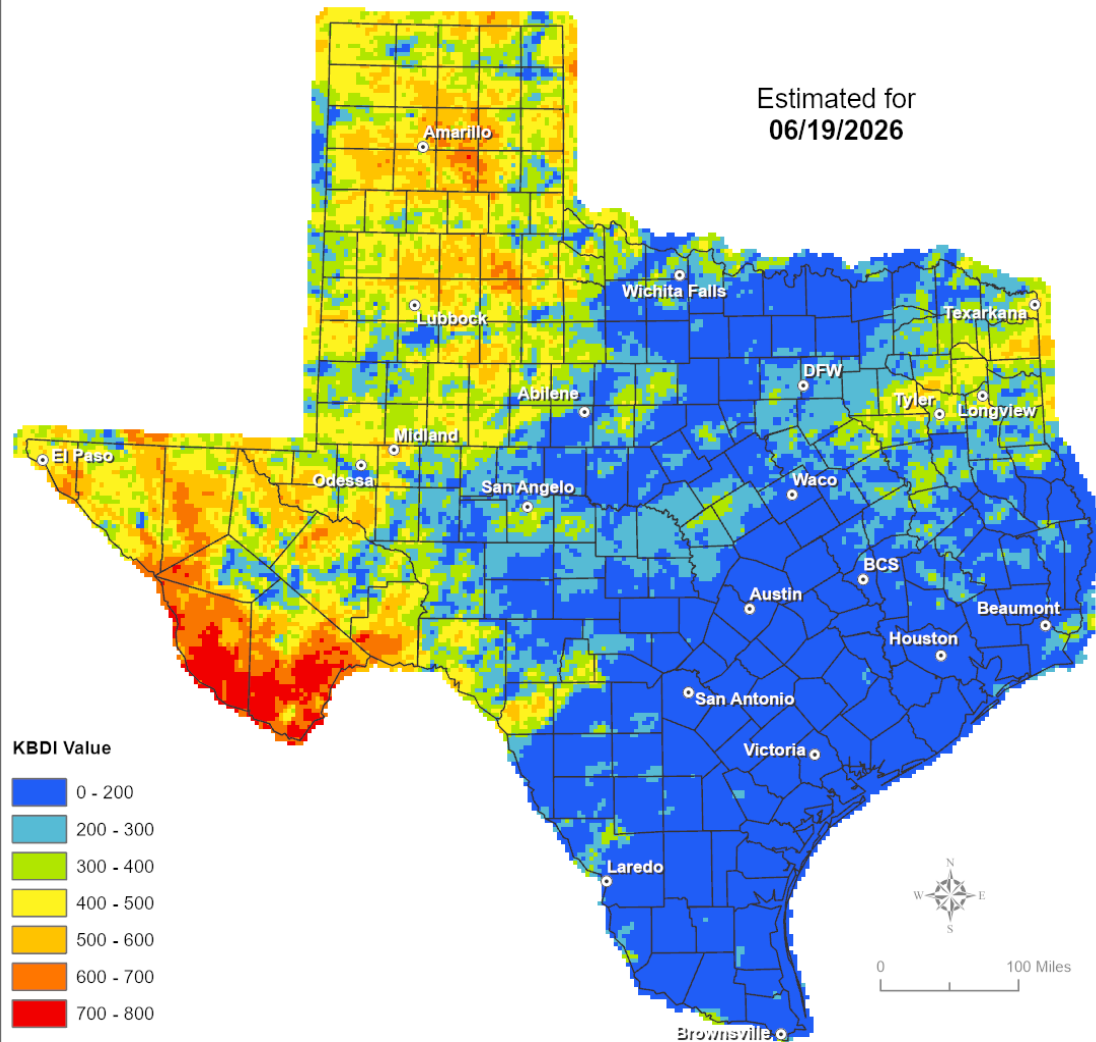

Keetch-Byram Drought Index

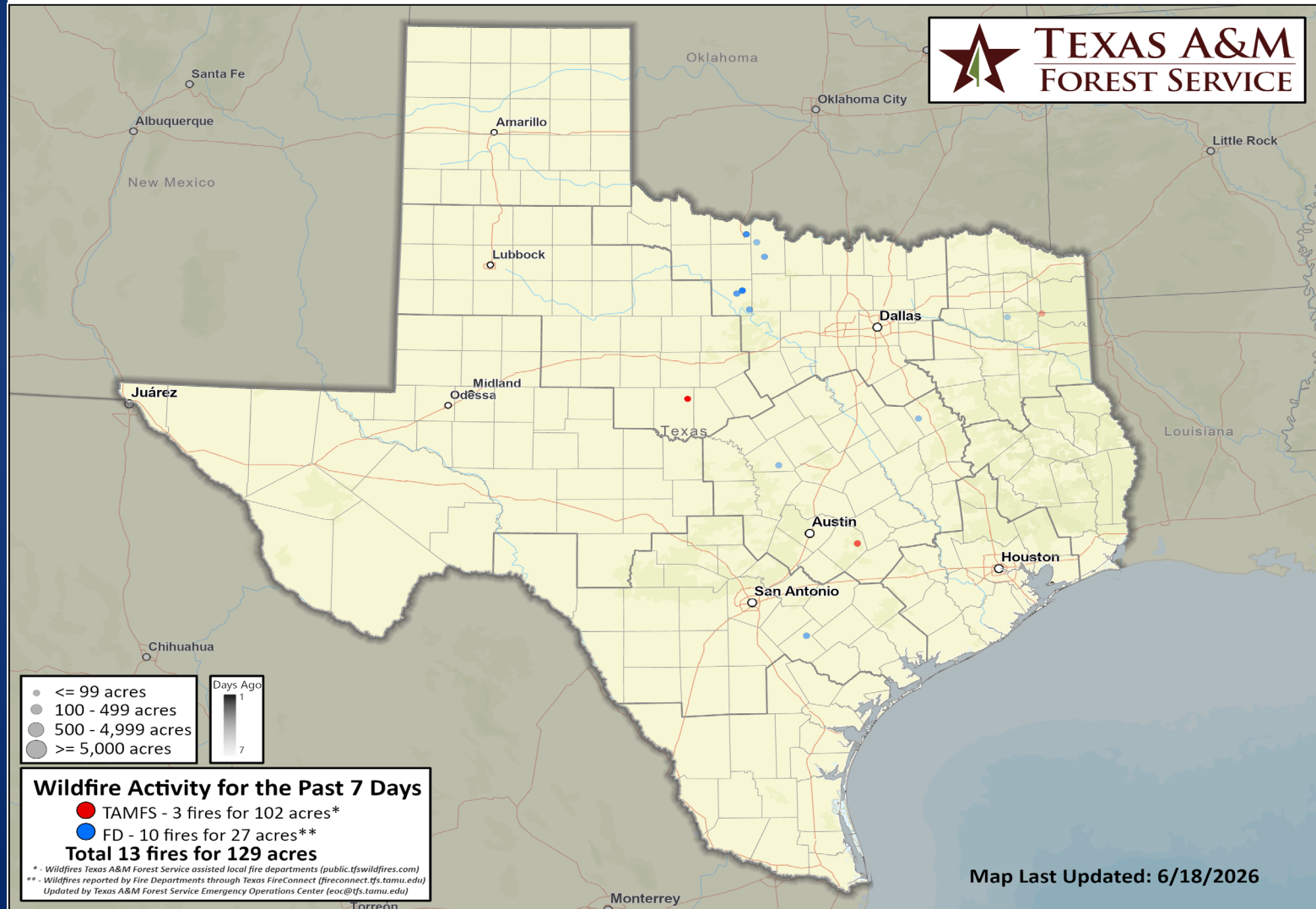
