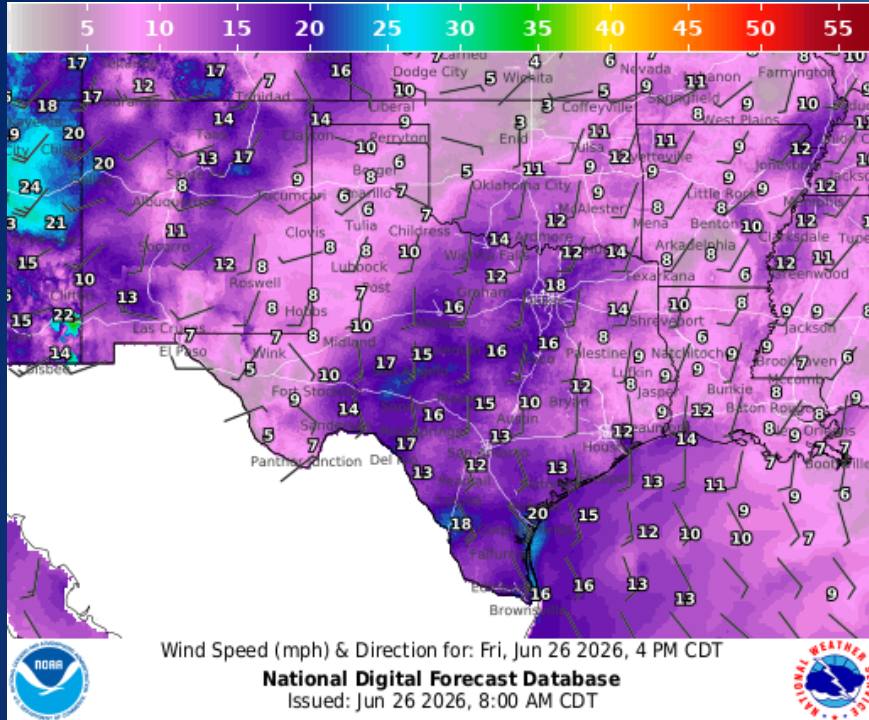

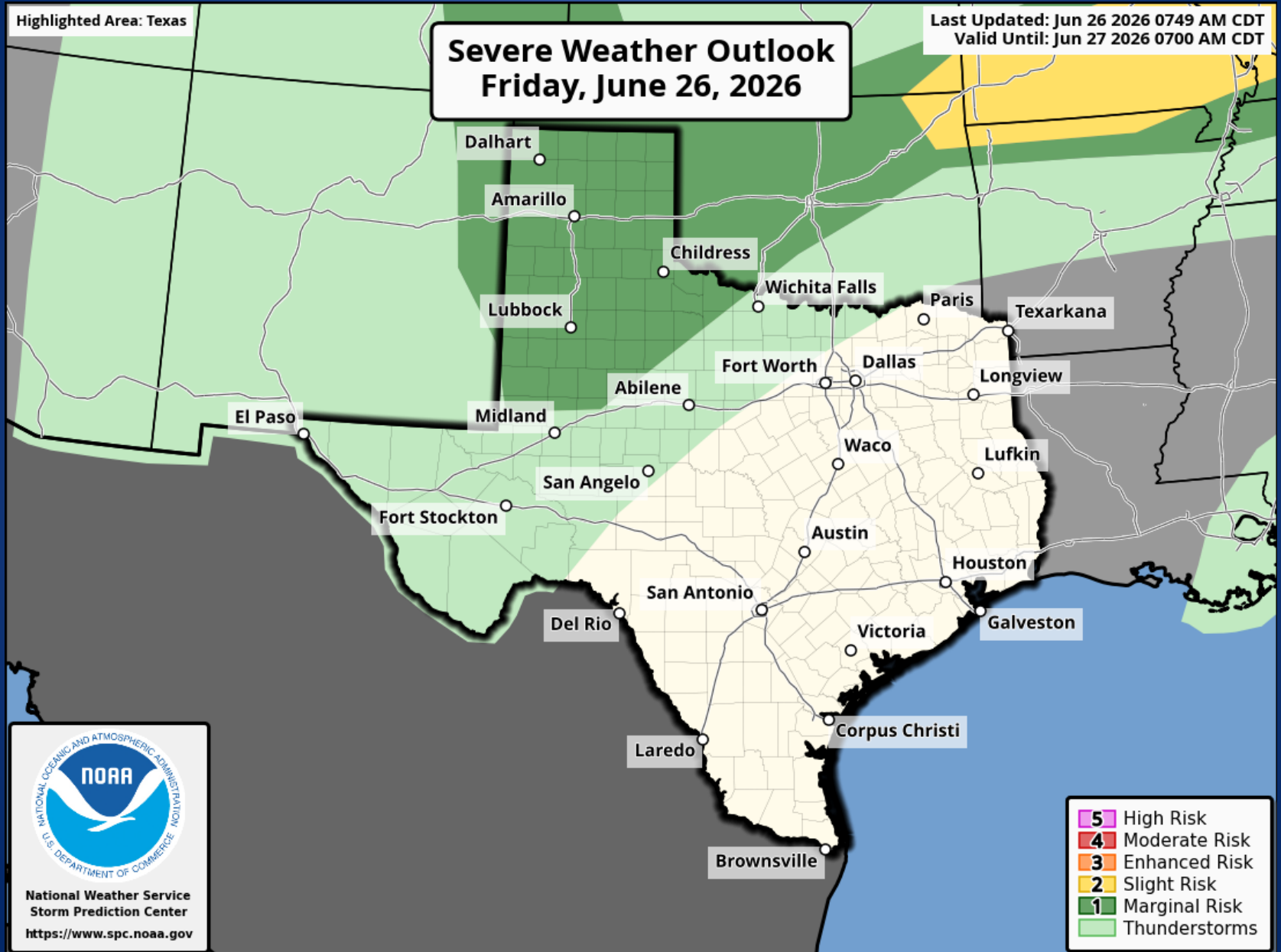


Wind Speeds

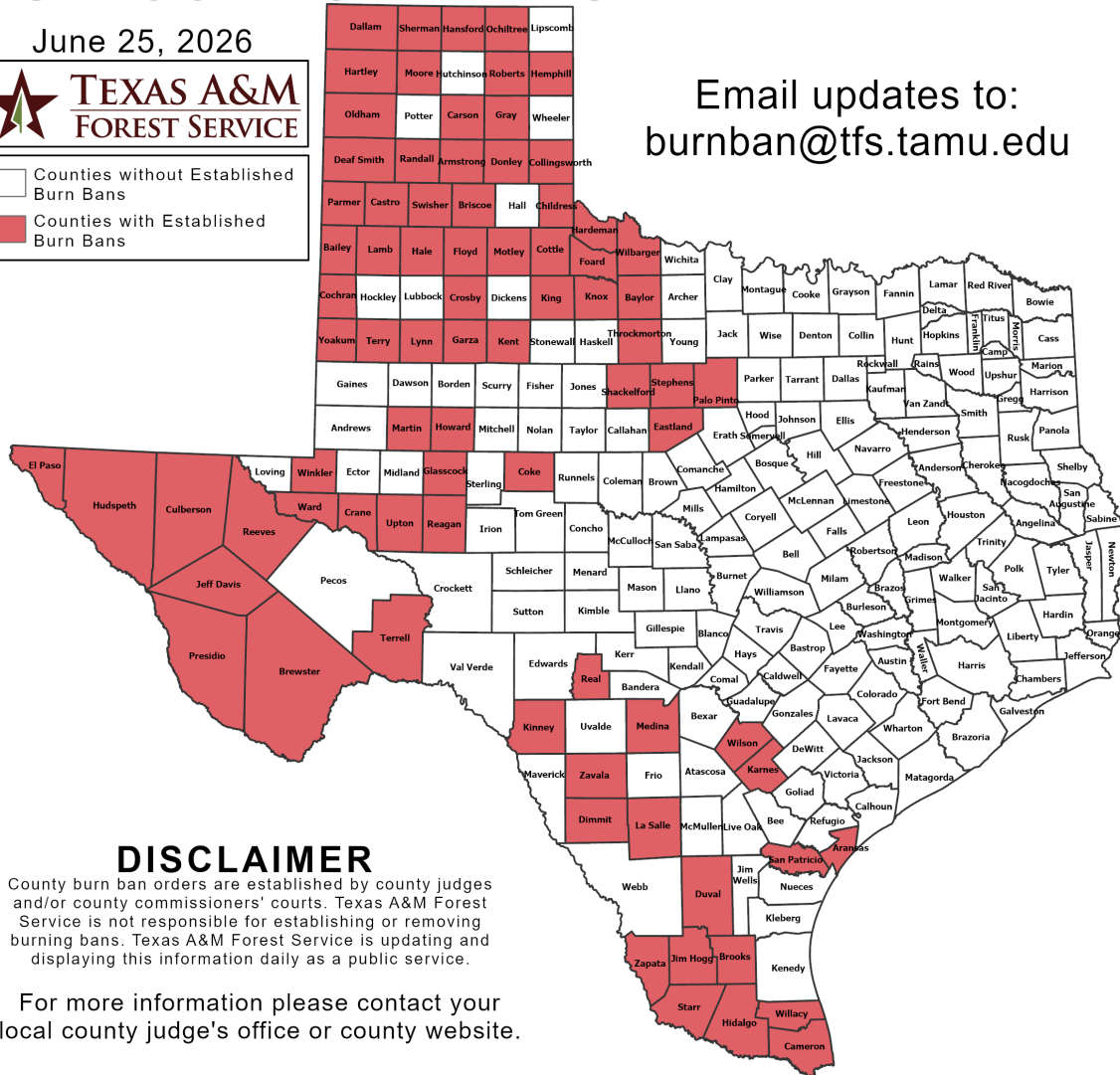

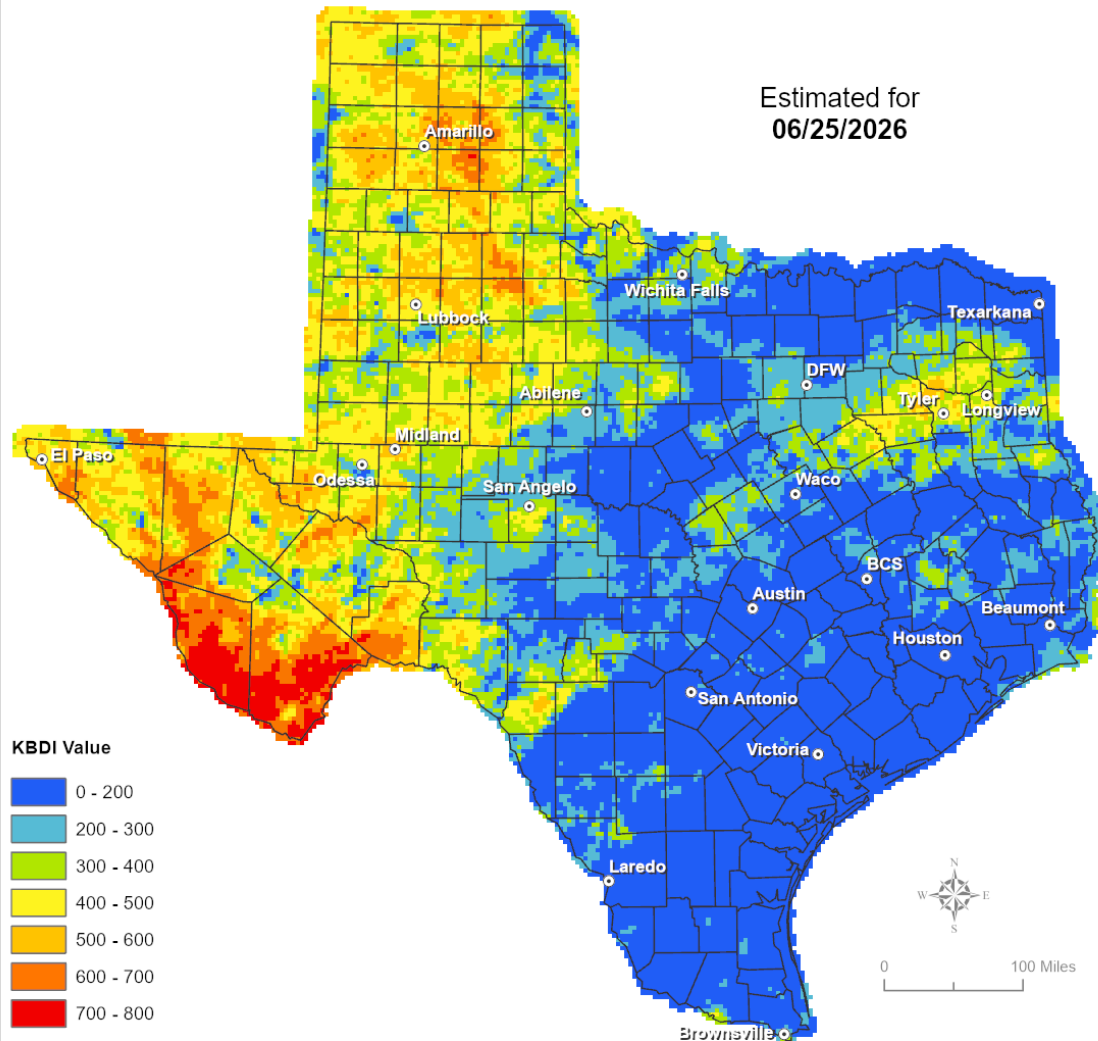

Keetch-Byram Drought Index

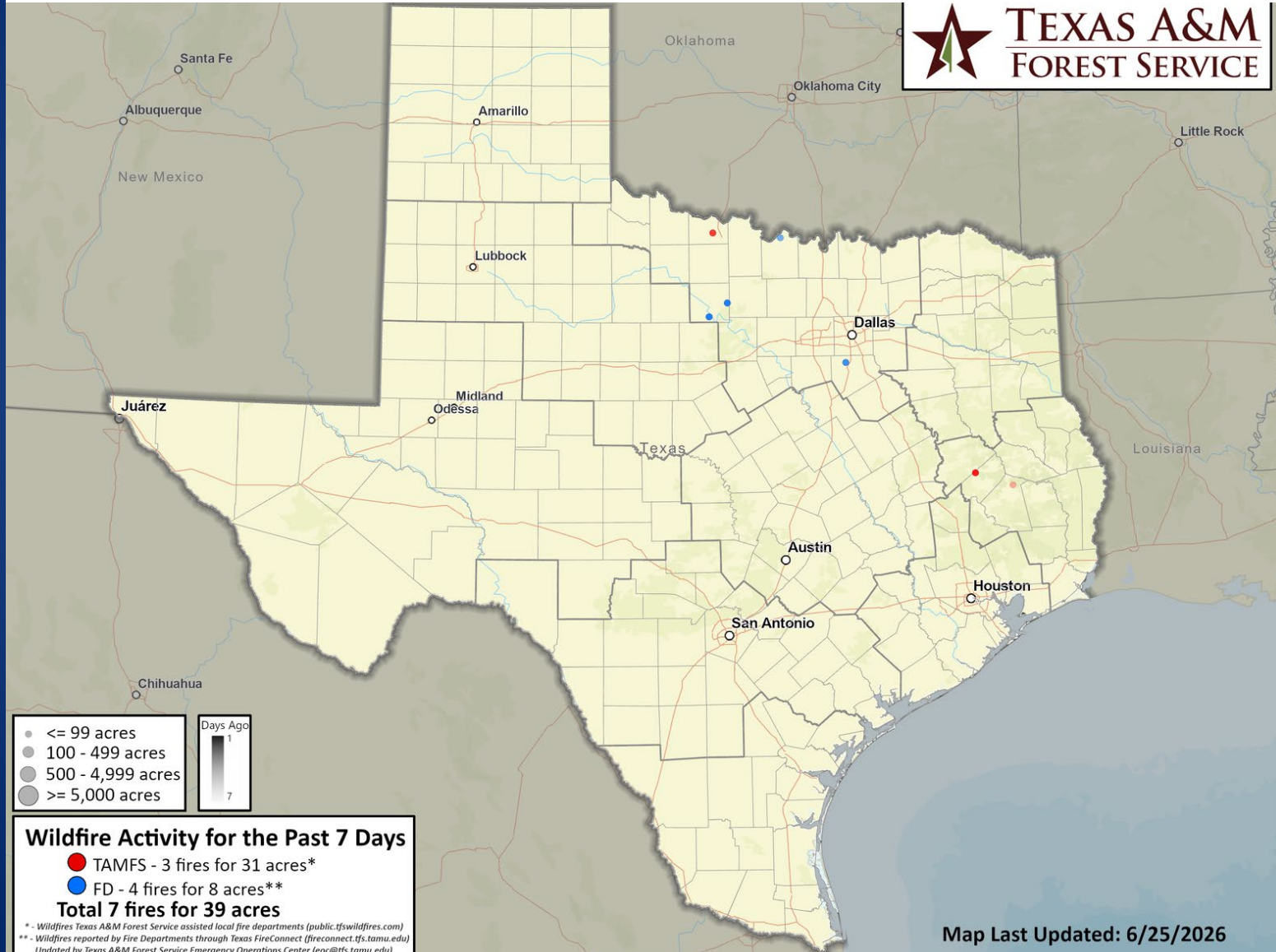
