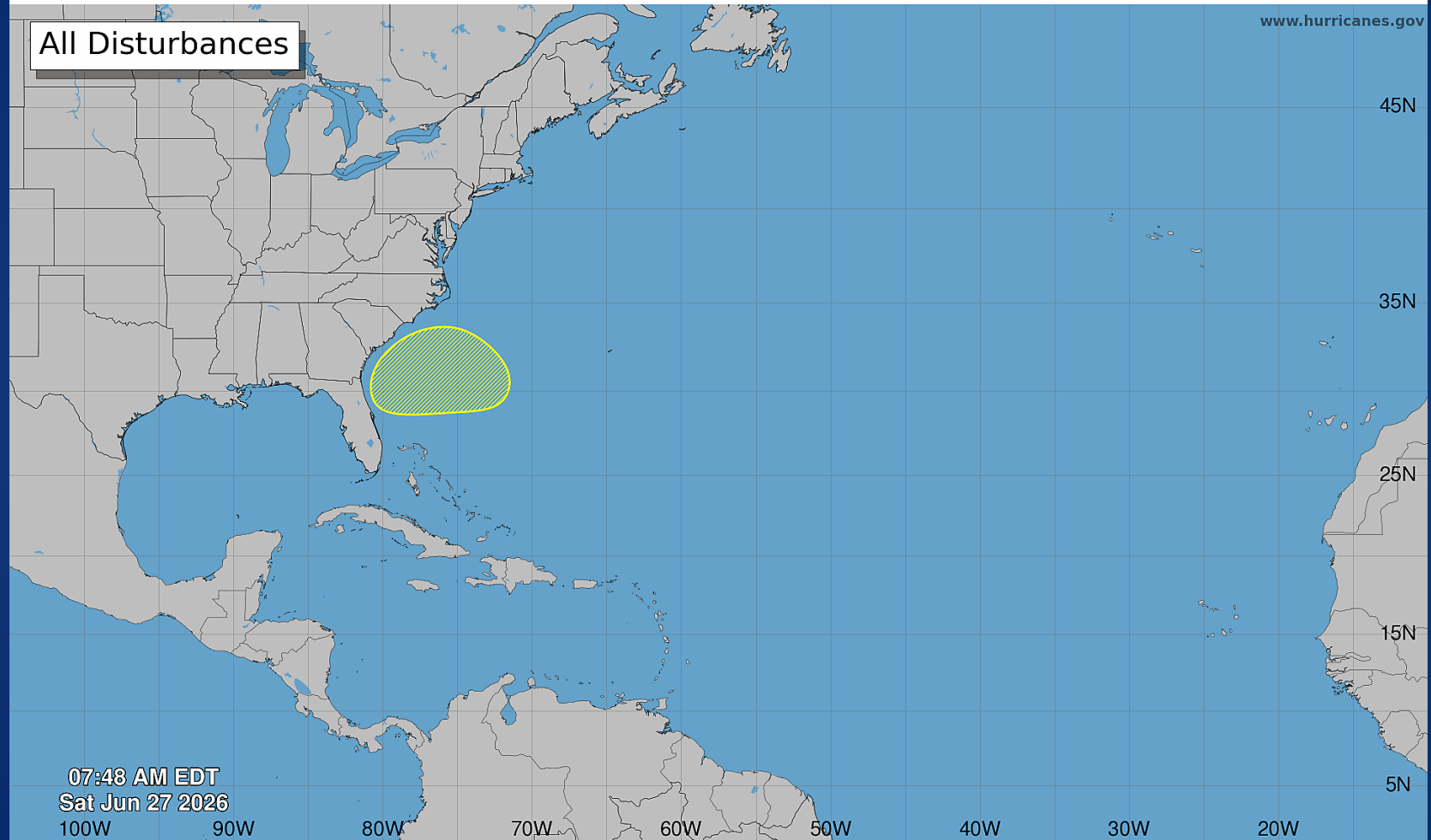
Seven-Day Graphical Tropical Weather Outlook

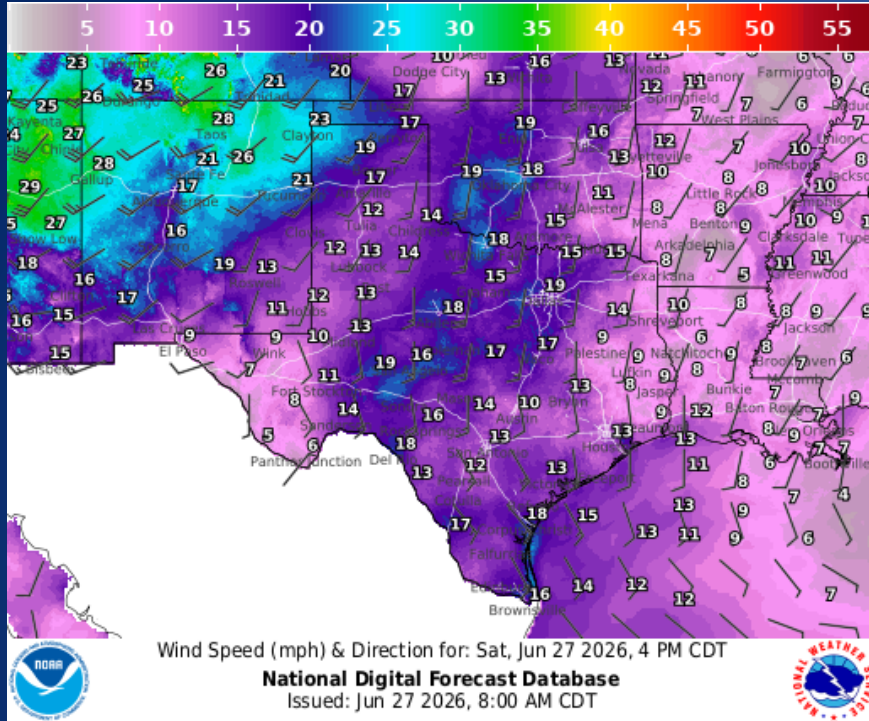

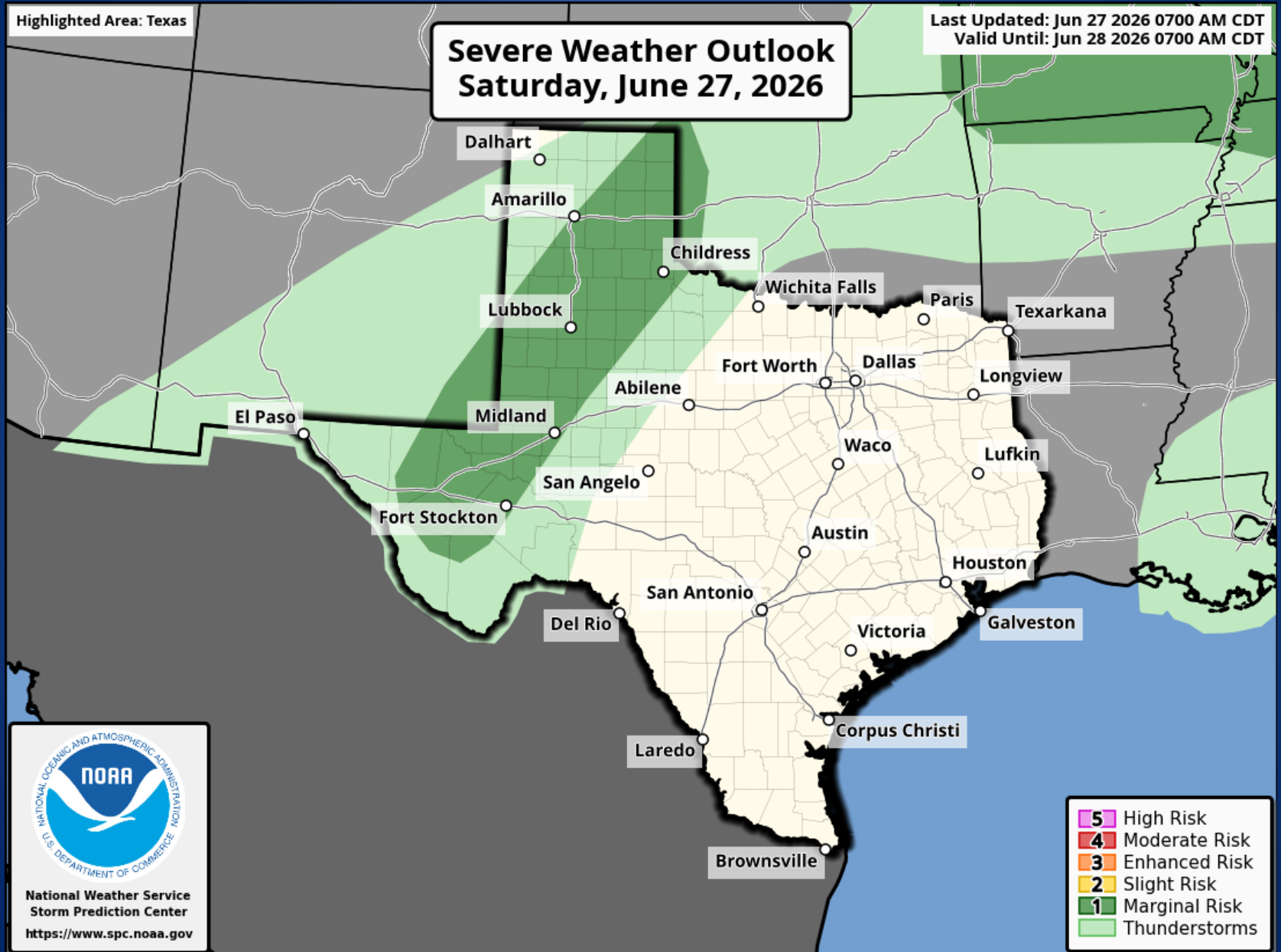

Scattered thunderstorms are possible again this afternoon and evening. Storms will be capable of producing wind gusts to 70 mph and hail up to quarter size.

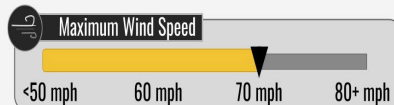

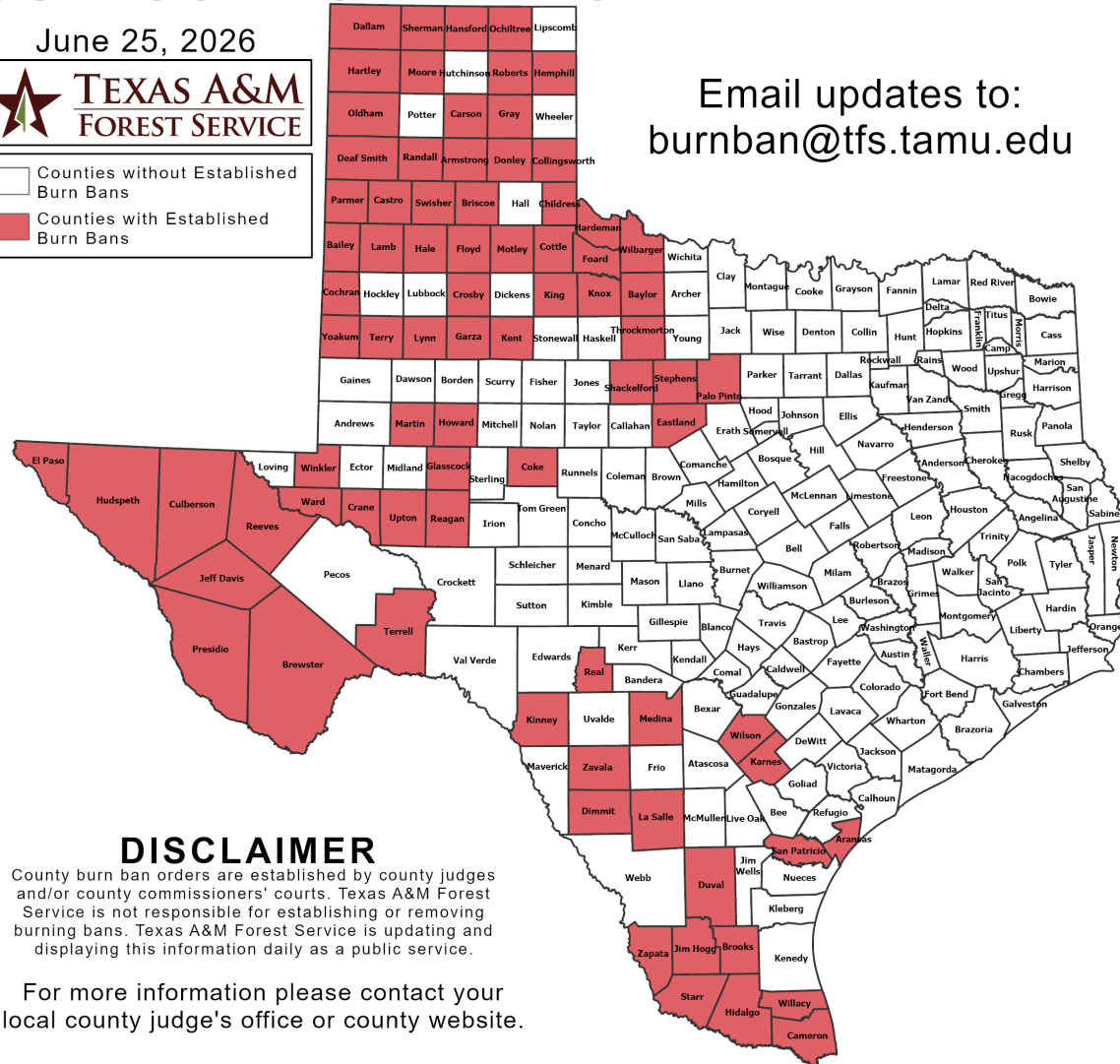

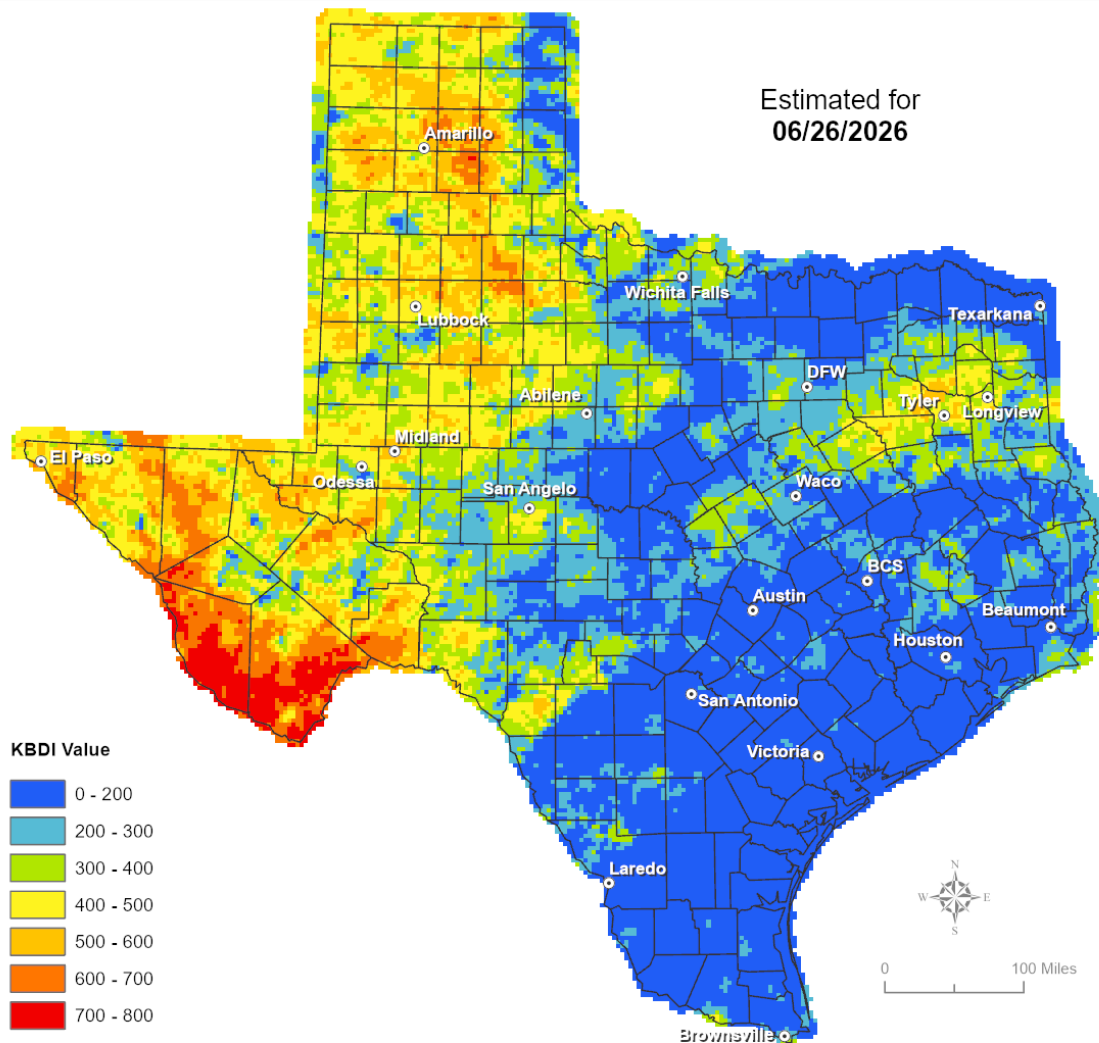

Keetch-Byram Drought Index

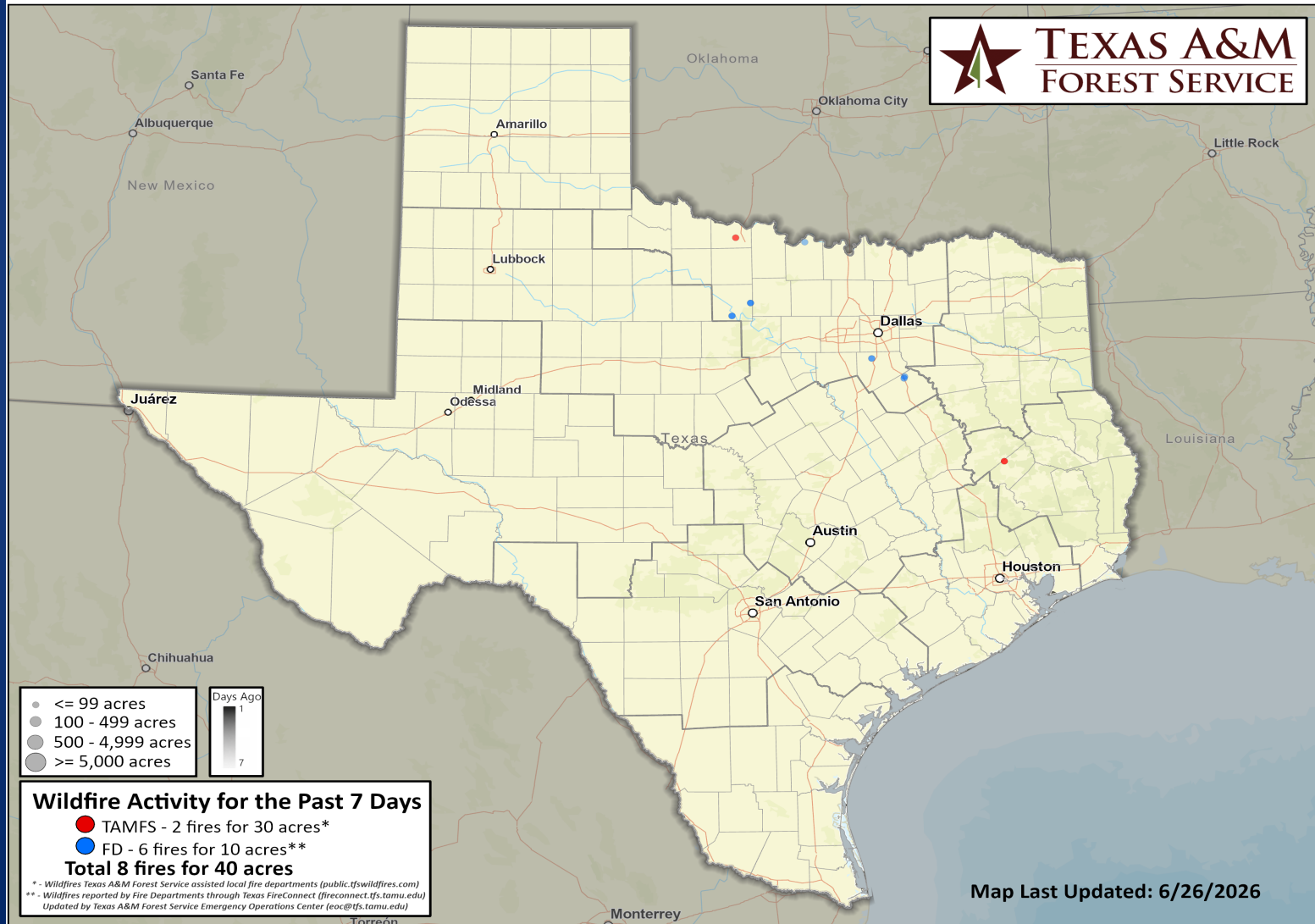

Report of 708 fires (No Change) and 104,427 (No Change) acres have been burned this year. There are 80 (No Change) counties with burn bans. The Keetch–Byram Drought Index list contains 58 (+3) counties with an average over 400.
