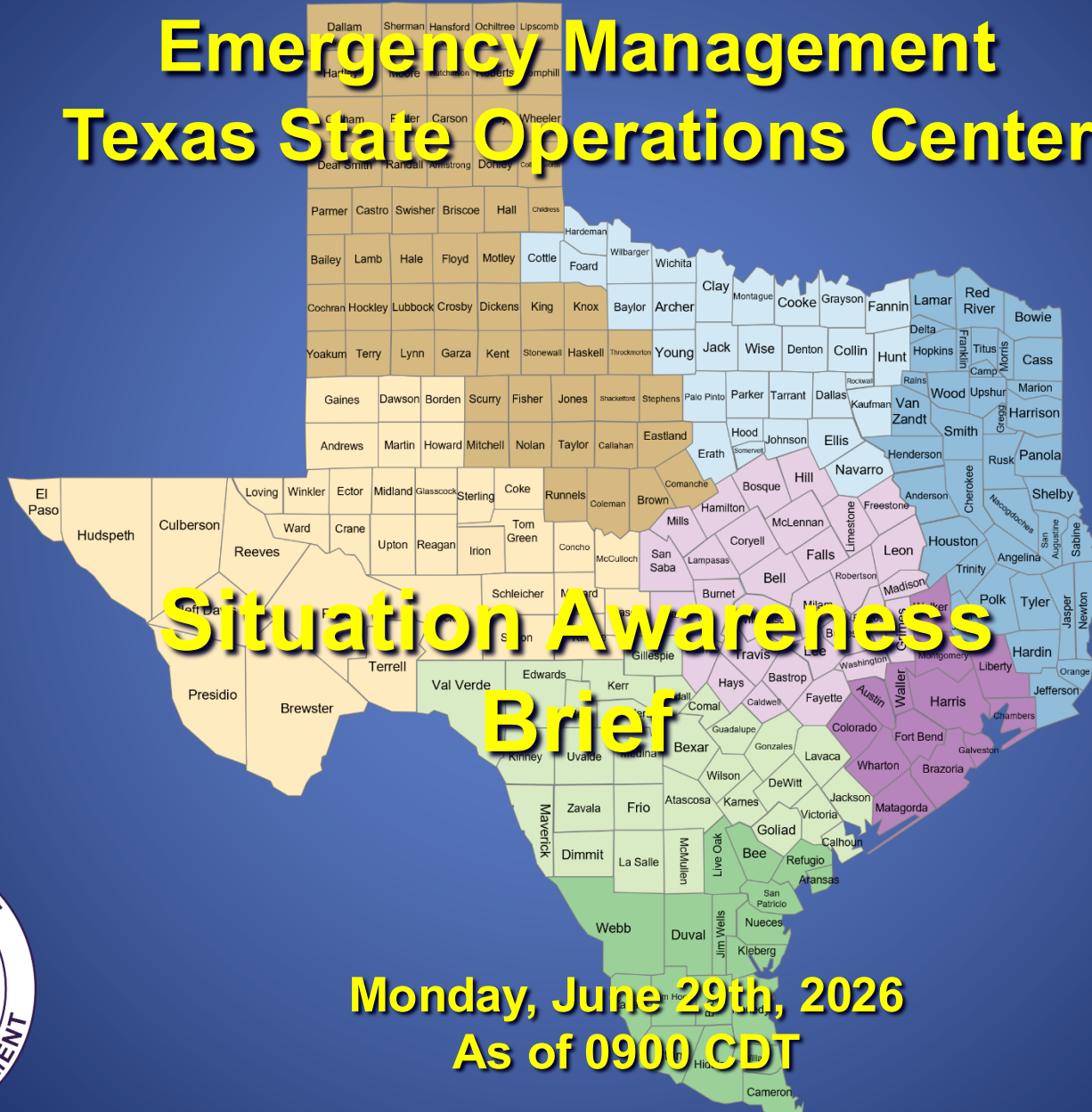

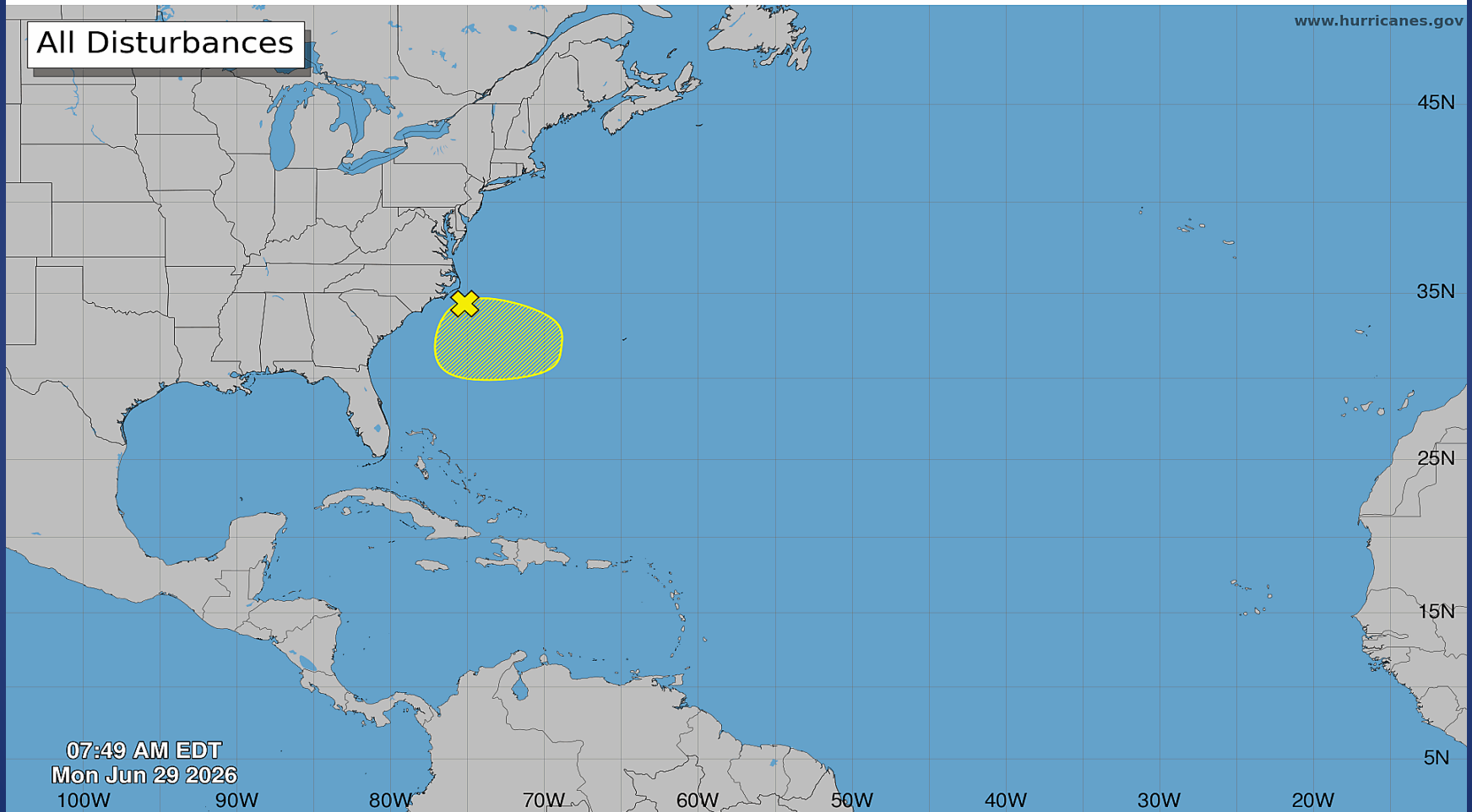
Seven-Day Graphical Tropical Weather Outlook

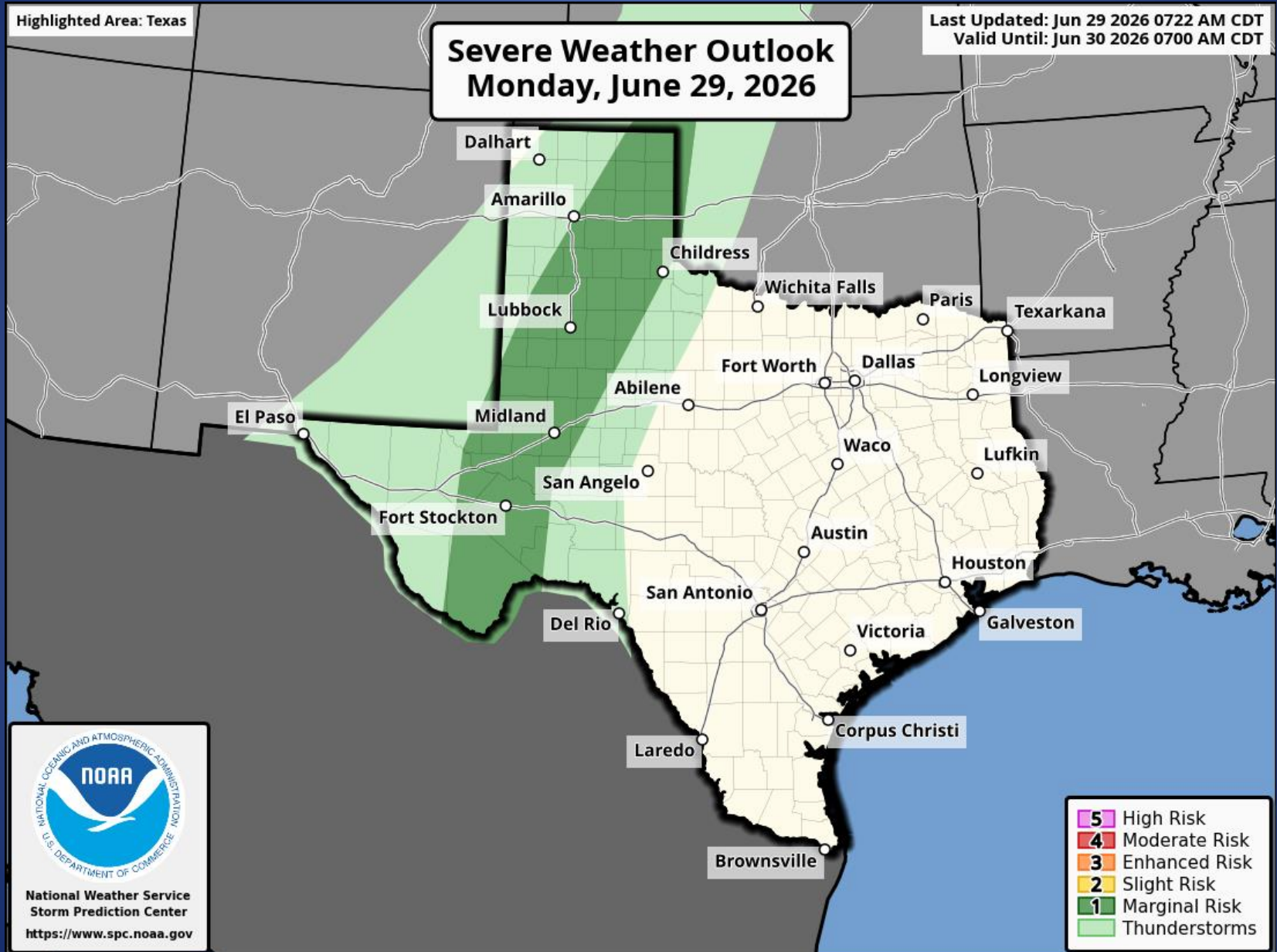

Through Monday



Gulf-facing Beaches



Numerous, Strong, Life-Threatening Rip Currents

Rip Currents can sweep even the best swimmers away from shore!

- Don't swim against the current.
- You may be able to escape by swimming in a direction following the shoreline, then at an angle toward the beach.
- If you feel you will be unable to reach shore, draw attention to yourself.

HIGH RISK
RIP
CURRENTS

A HIGH risk of rip currents is expected for all Gulf-facing beaches through Monday evening. Rip currents can sweep even strong swimmers away from shore. If caught in one, do not swim against it; swim parallel to the shoreline until you escape, then angle toward the beach. If you cannot reach shore, call for help.

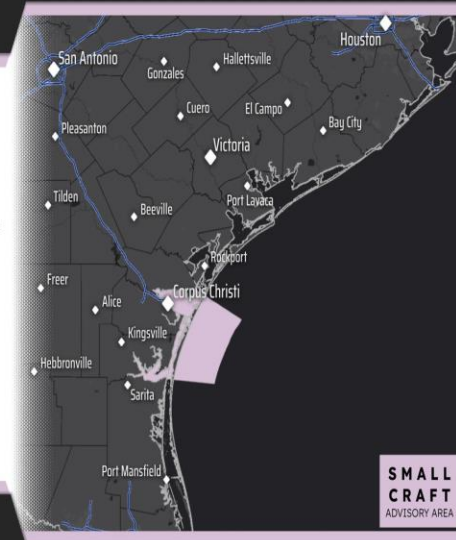


- Wind and wave conditions will be hazardous for small craft.

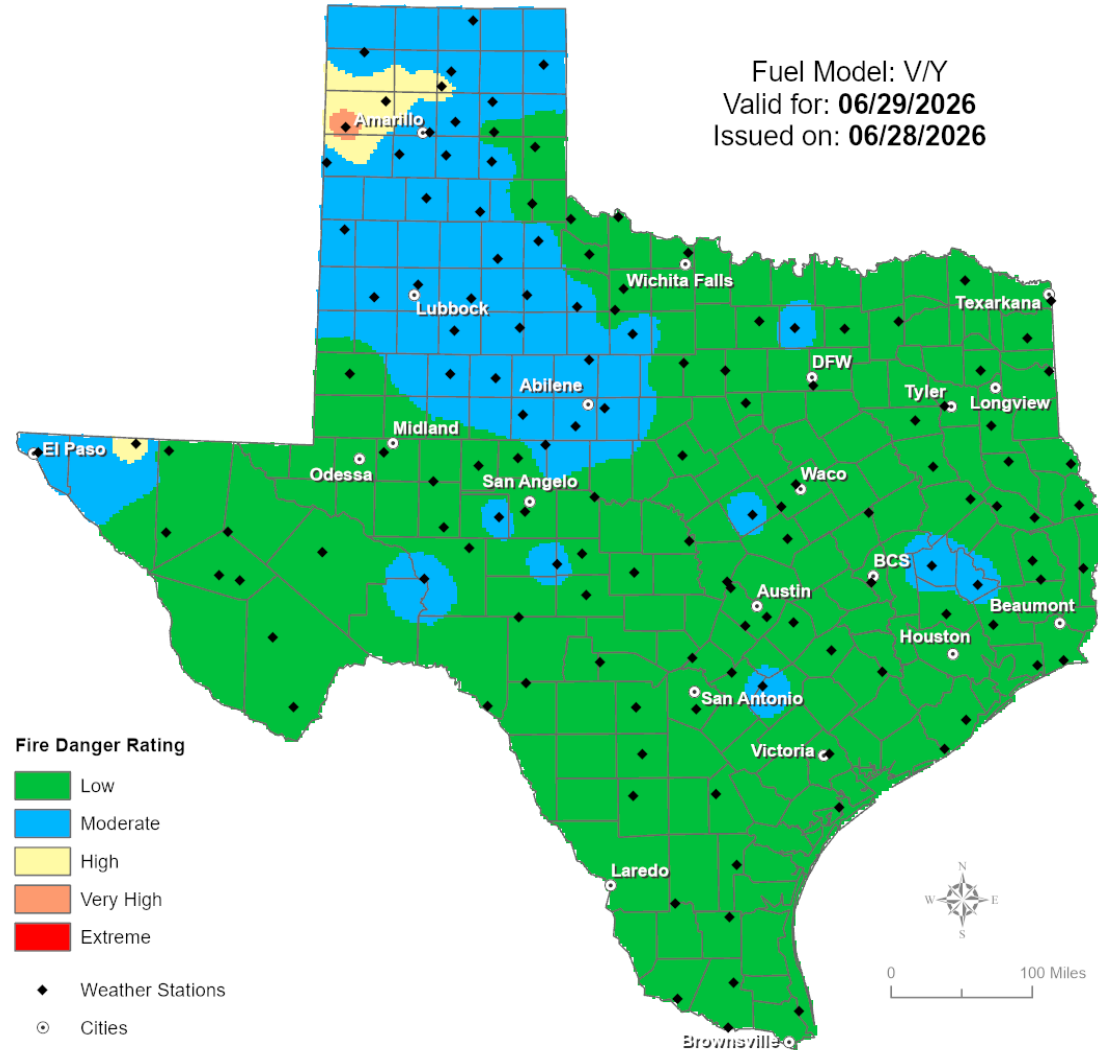

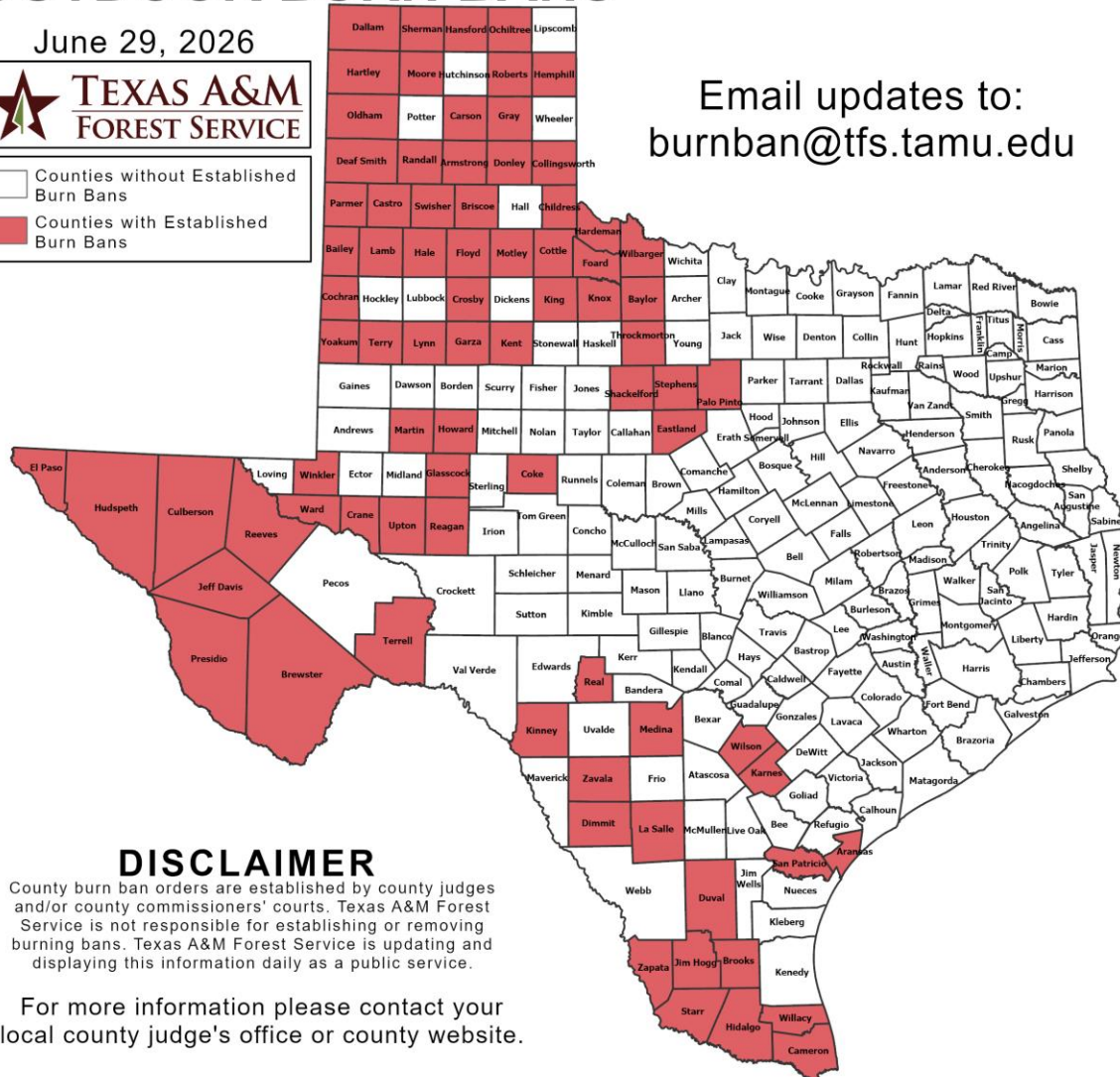

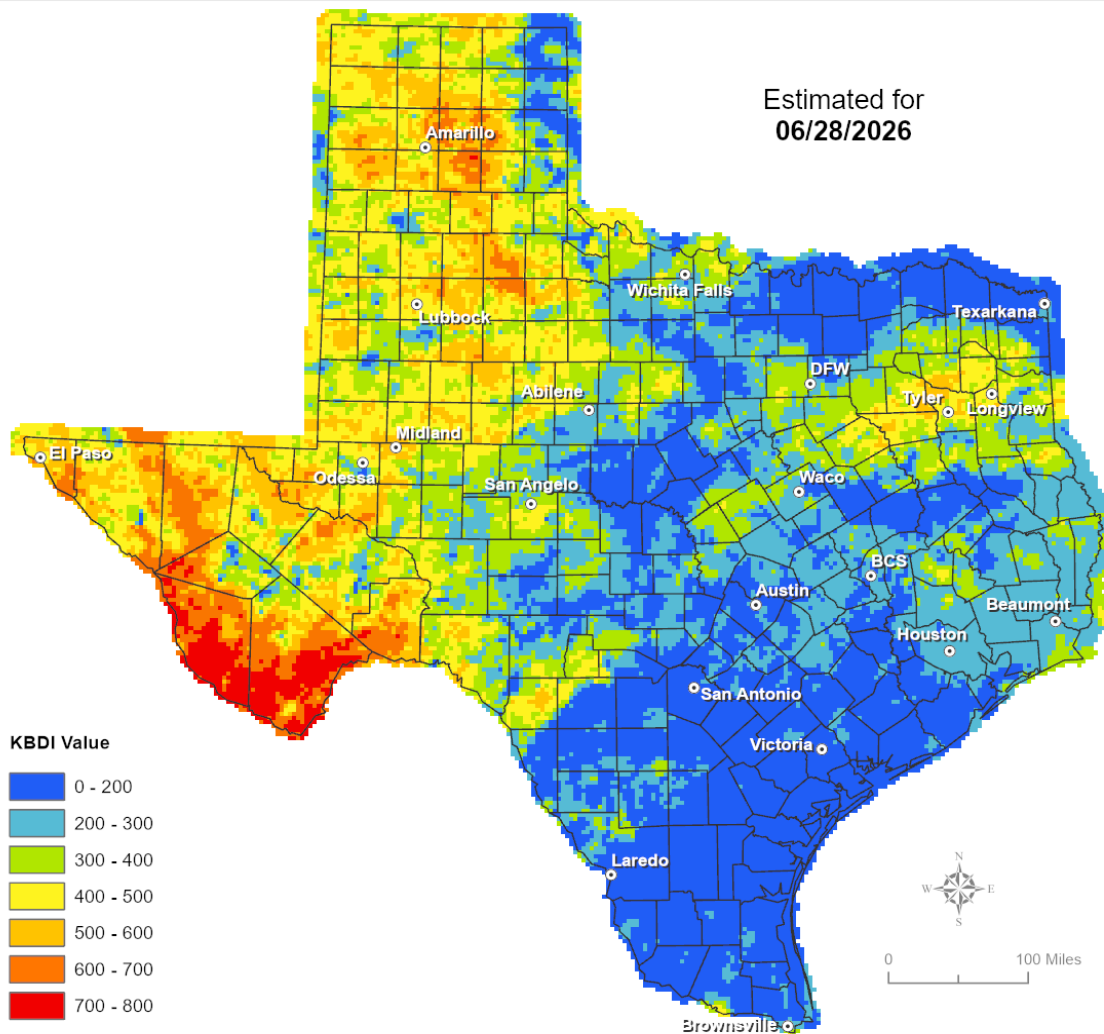

Keetch-Byram Drought Index

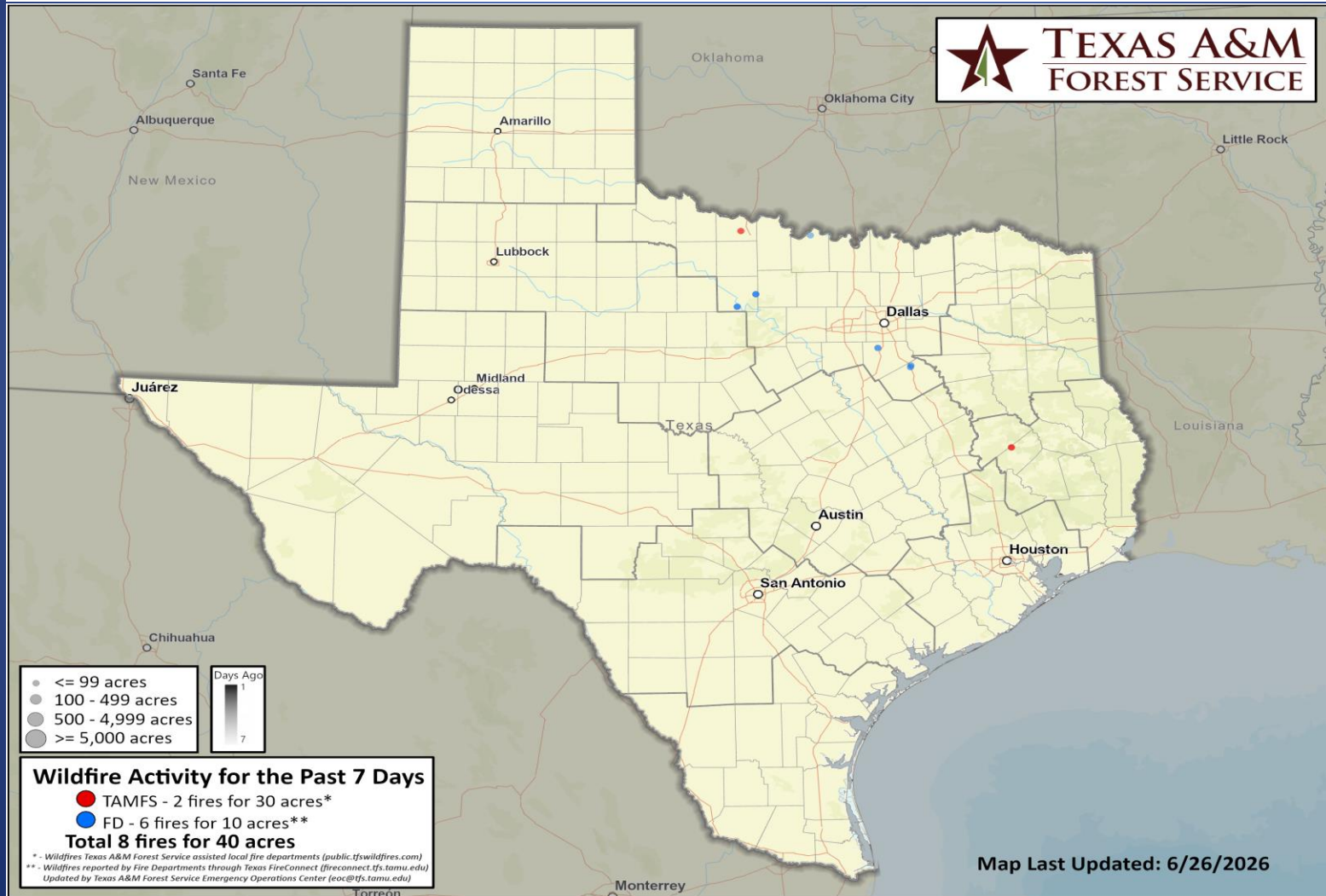

Report of 708 fires (No Change) and 104,427 (No Change) acres have been burned this year. There are 80 (No Change) counties with burn bans. The Keetch–Byram Drought Index list contains 62 (+5) counties with an average over 400.
