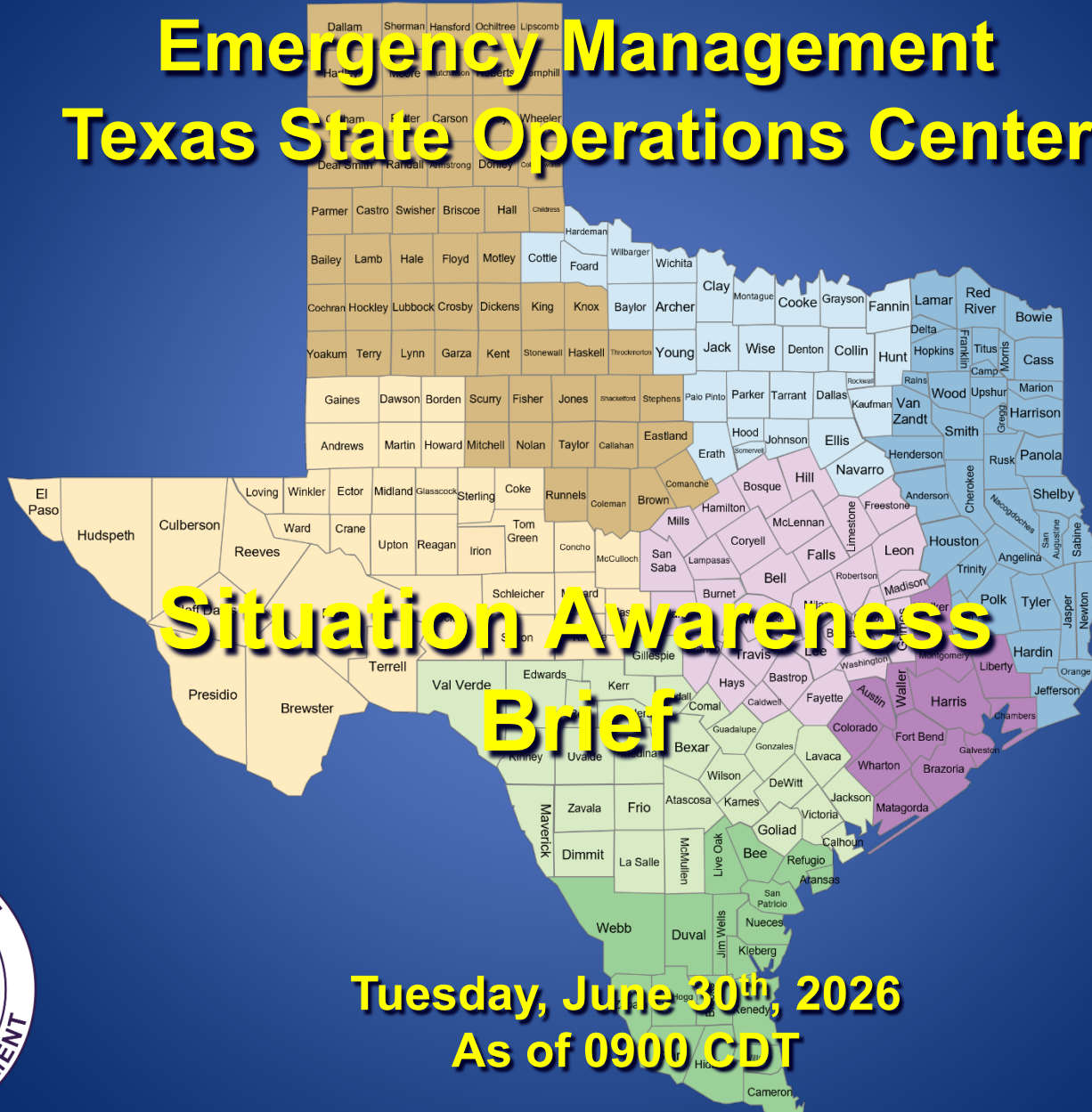

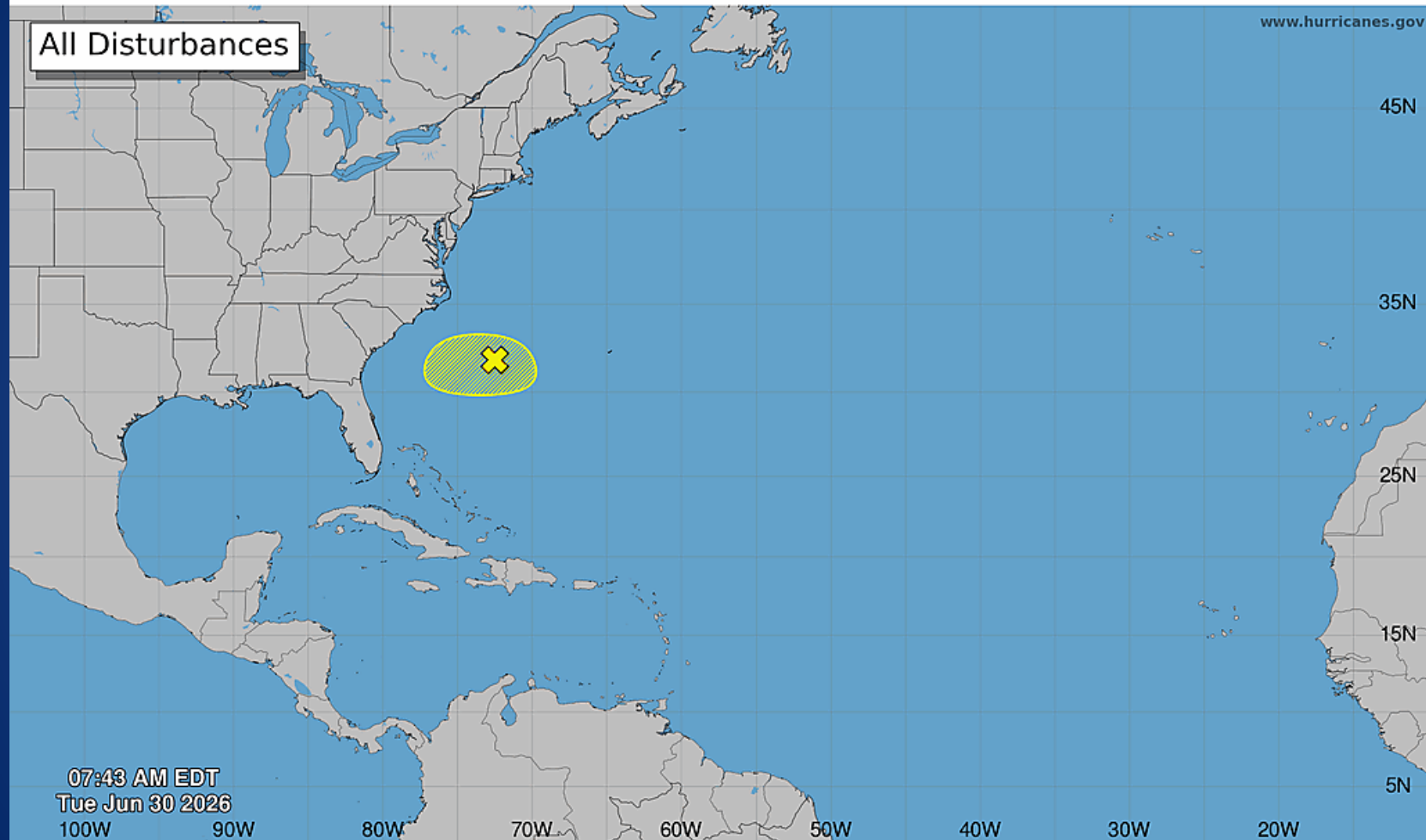
Seven-Day Graphical Tropical Weather Outlook

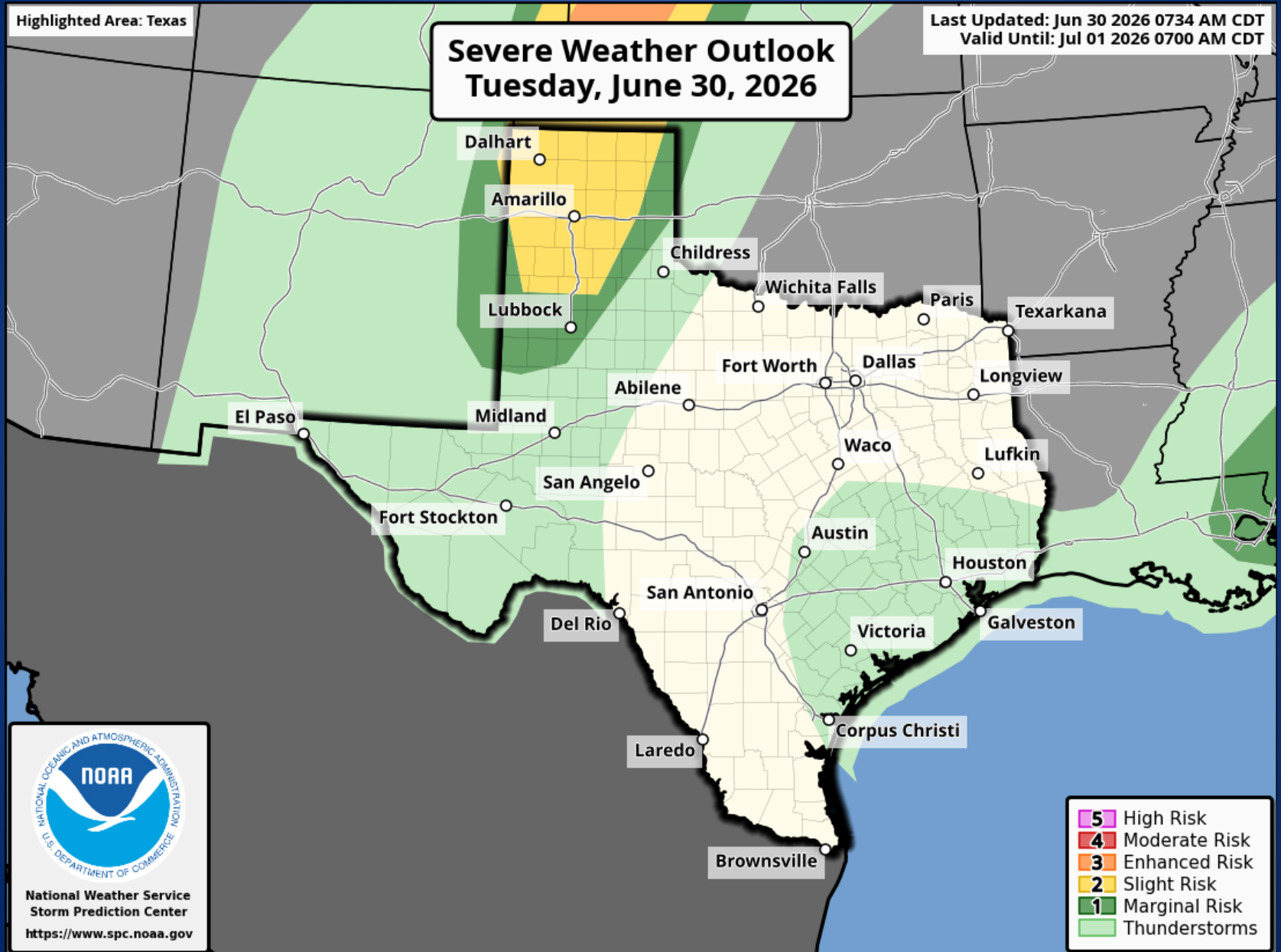


Wind Speeds



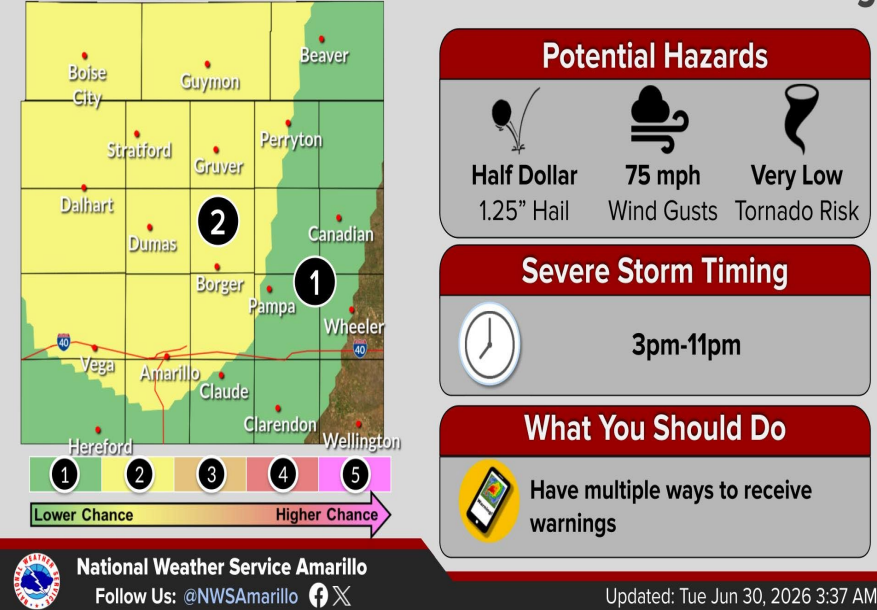

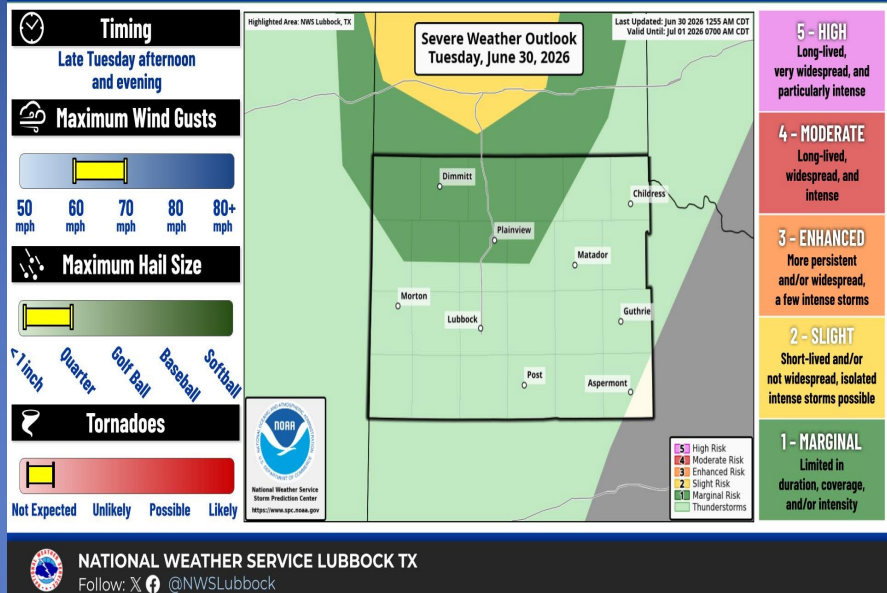
Severe Weather Potential This Afternoon and Evening



Thunderstorms will develop this afternoon with potential for some to become severe. The greatest risk for this will be in the northwest Panhandles down into the central Texas Panhandle. Much of the area has the risk for at least isolated severe thunderstorms to occur this afternoon and evening. The main hazard will be from damaging winds up to 75mph, but some hail may occur as well.

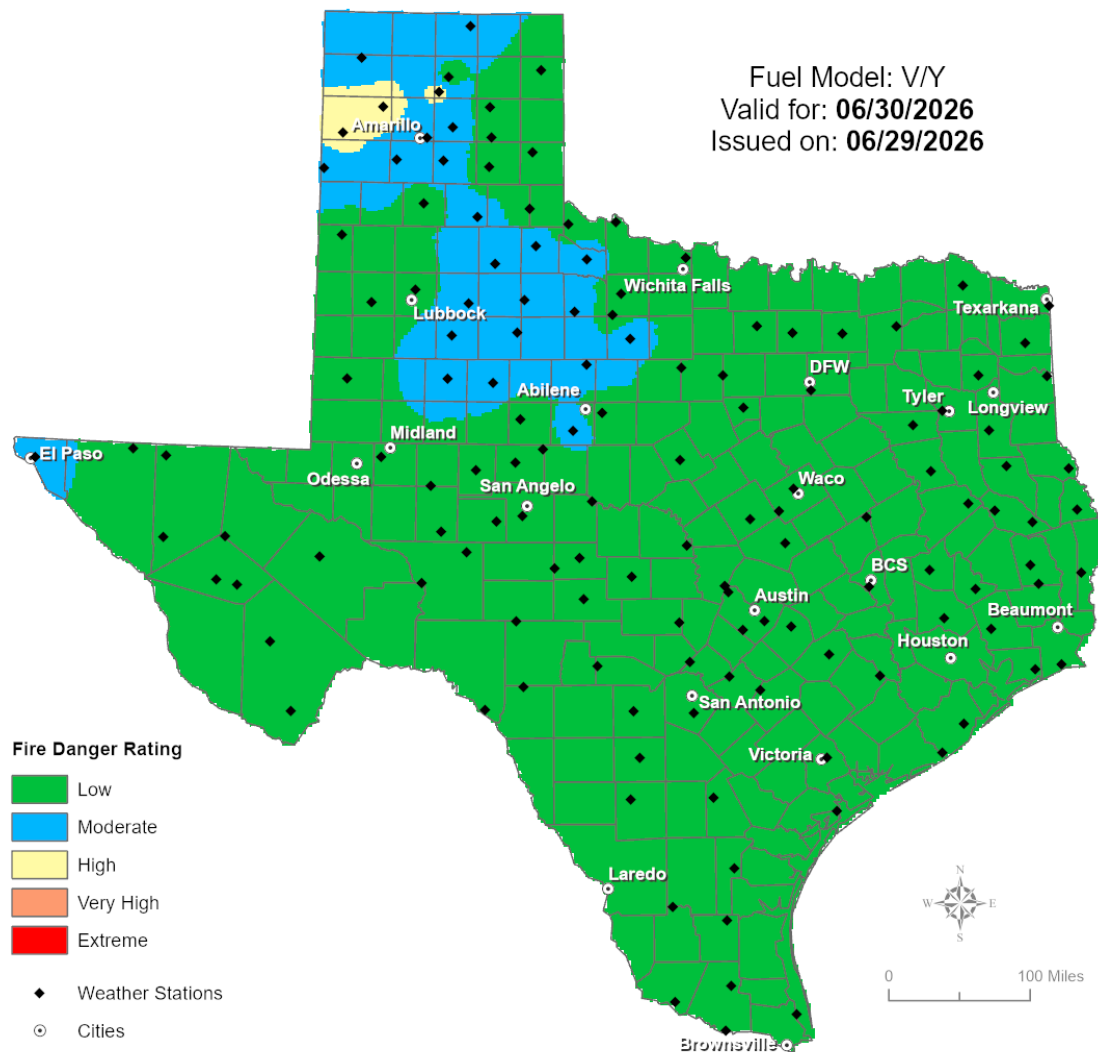
Afternoon and evening storms are expected again on Tuesday mainly across areas on the caprock. These storms will be capable of producing wind gusts to 70 mph and quarter size hail.

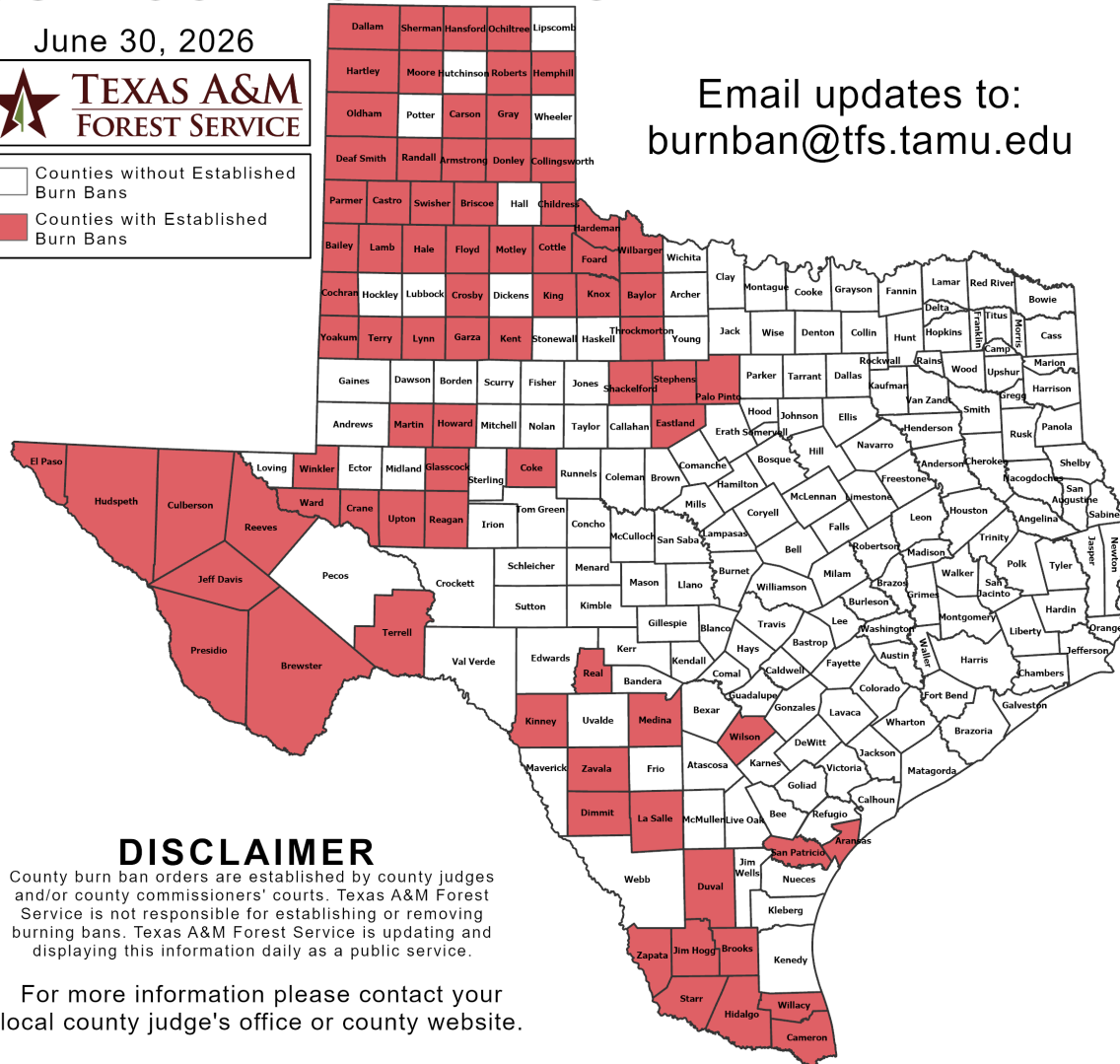

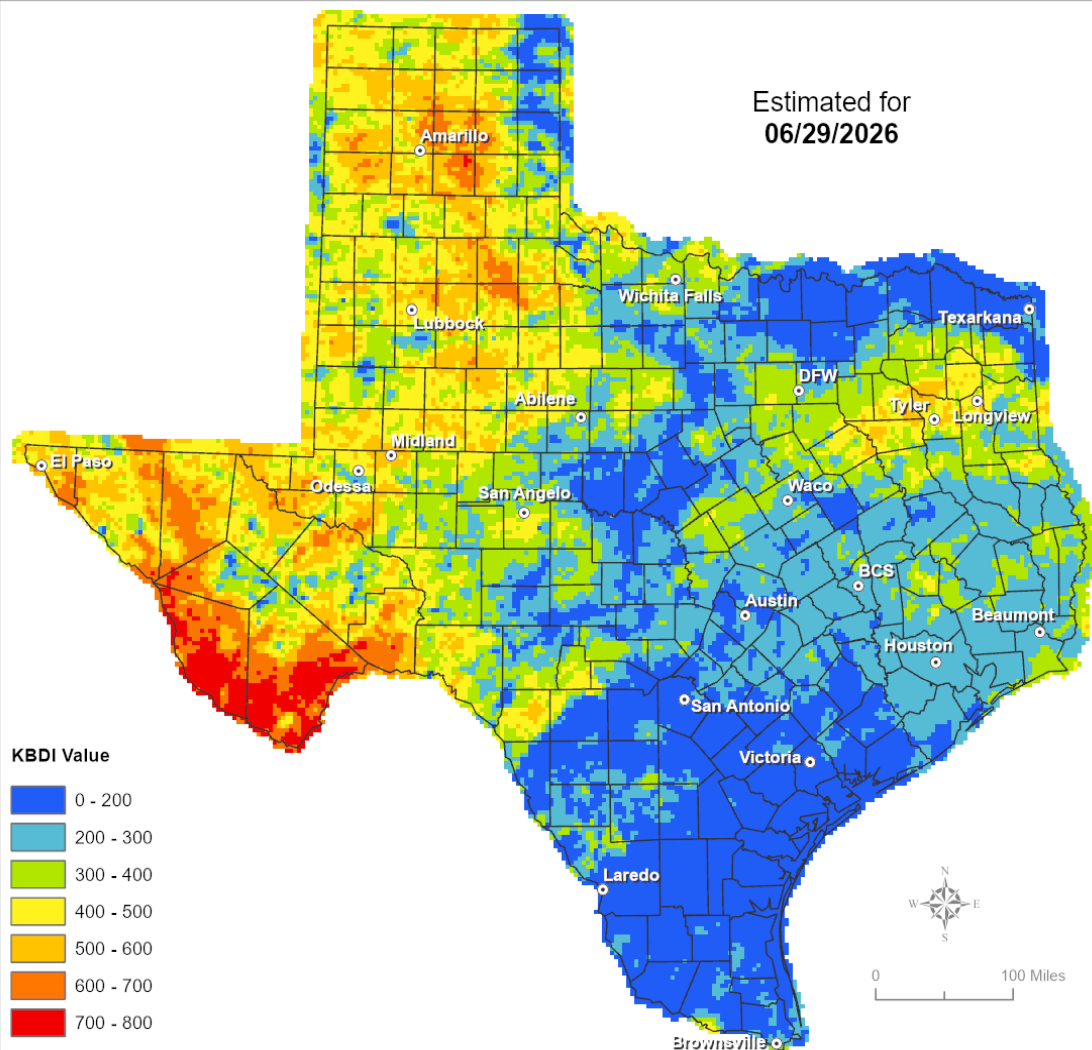

Keetch-Byram Drought Index

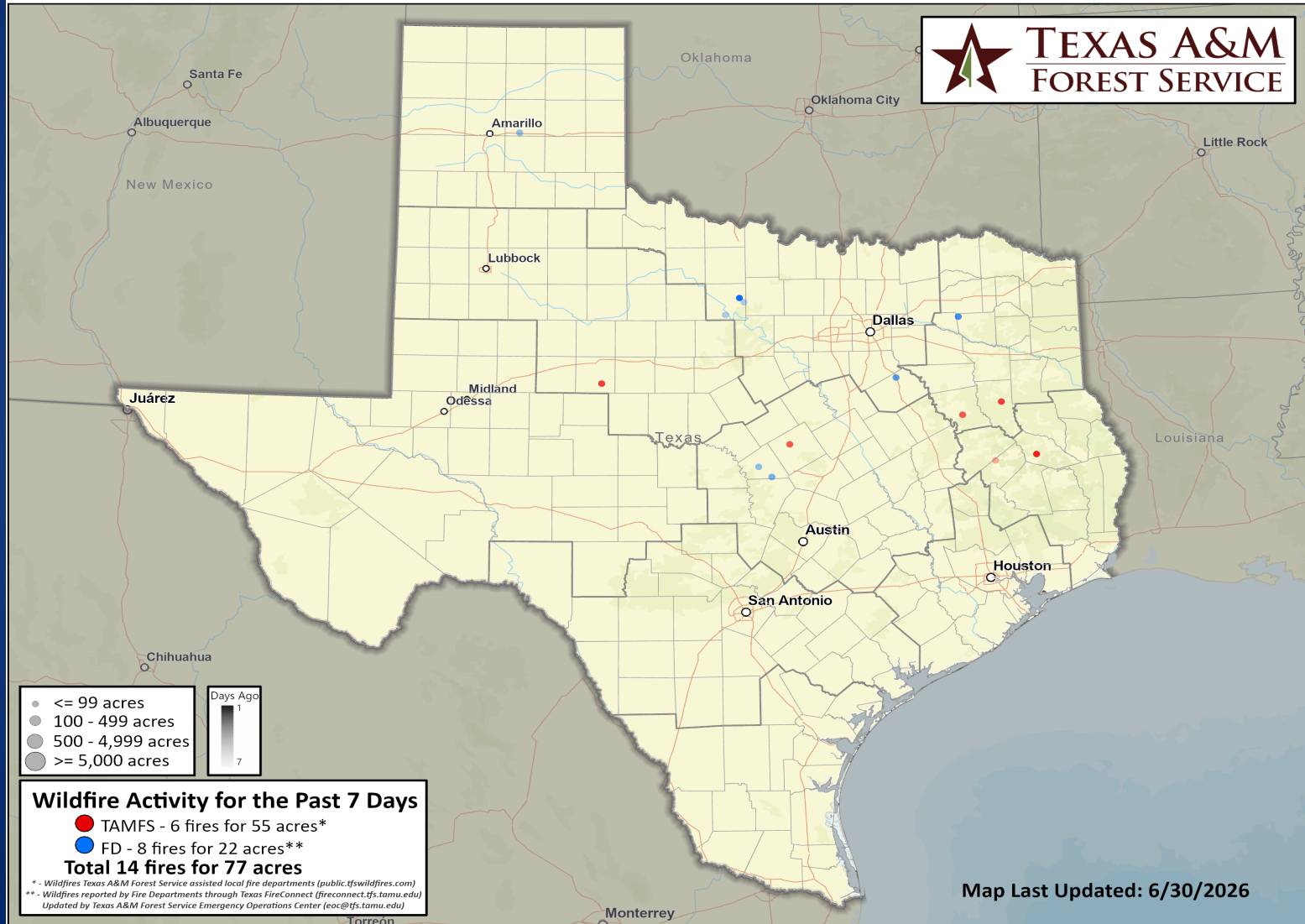
