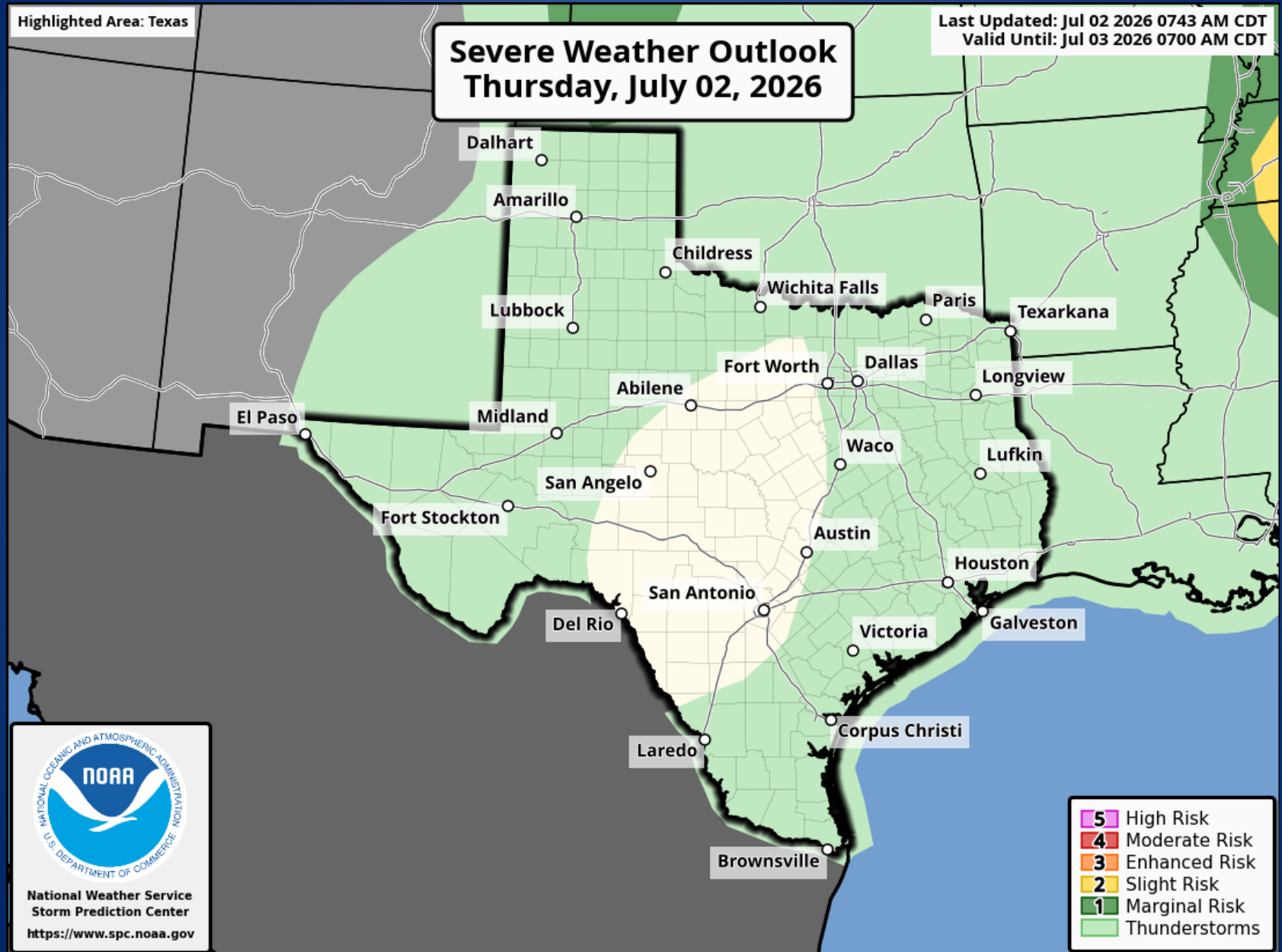

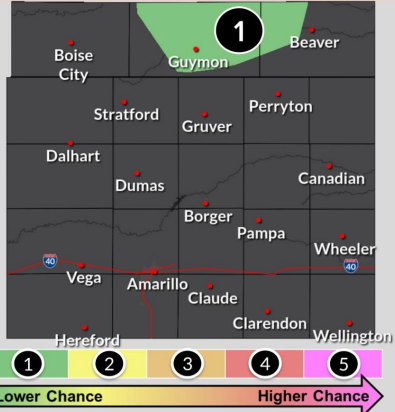

- Temperatures near normal for this time of year

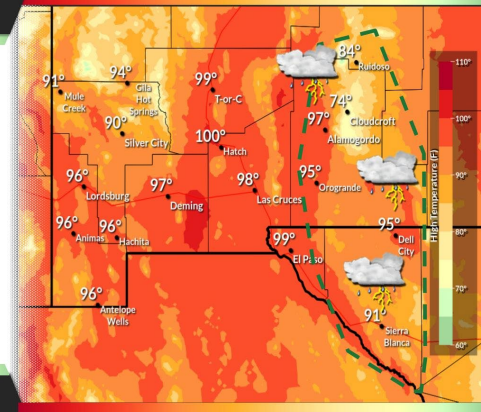

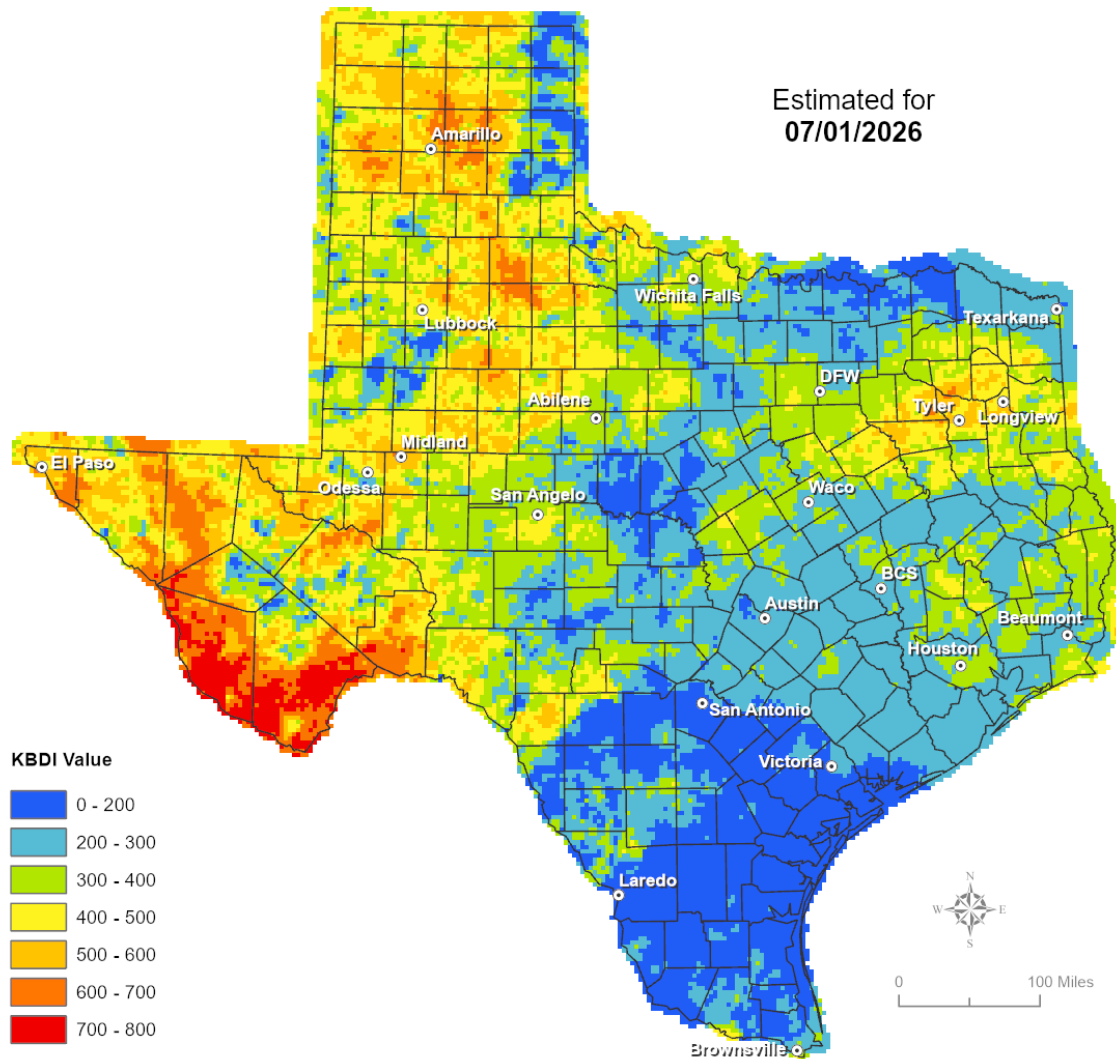

Keetch-Byram Drought Index

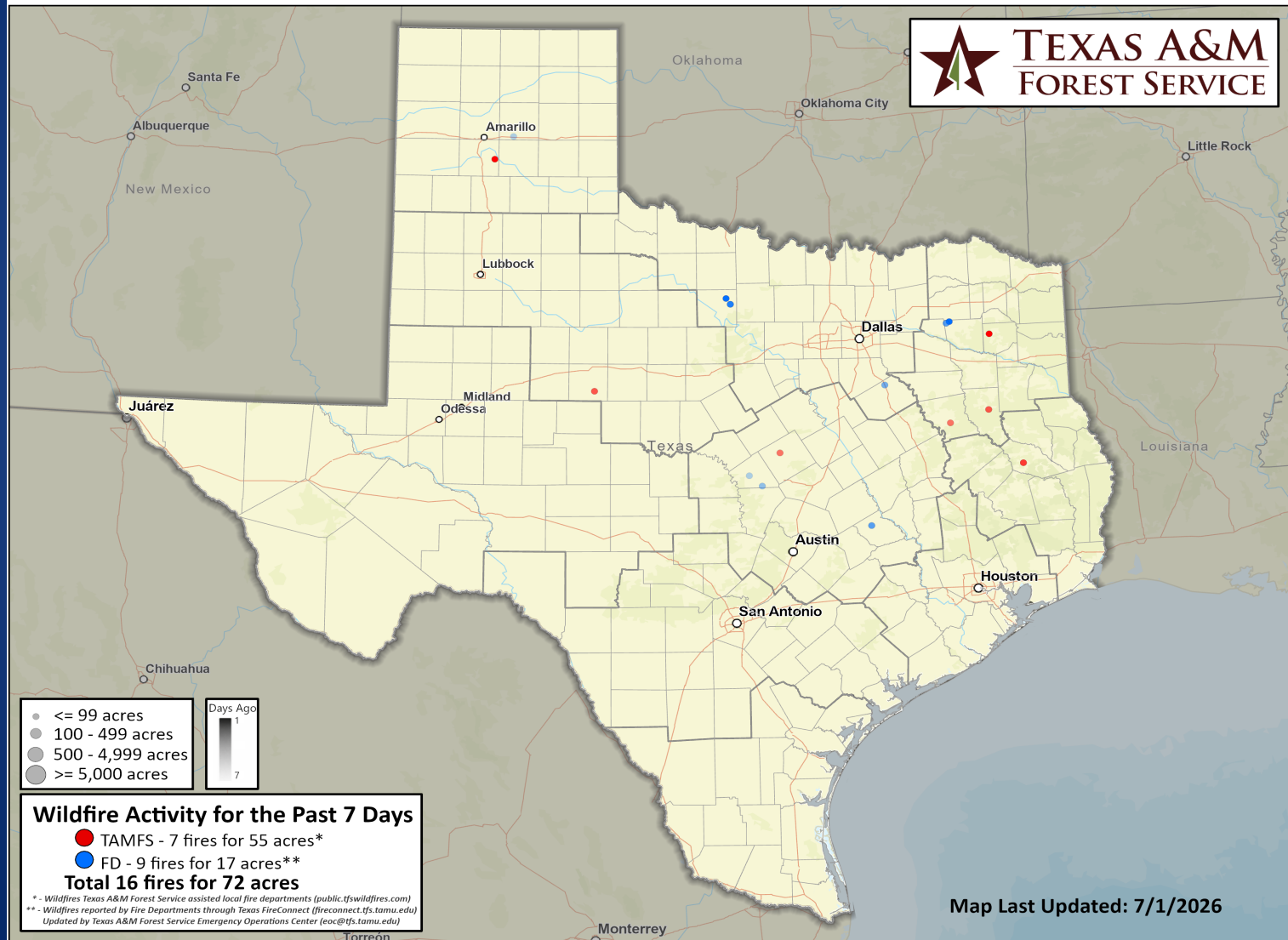
