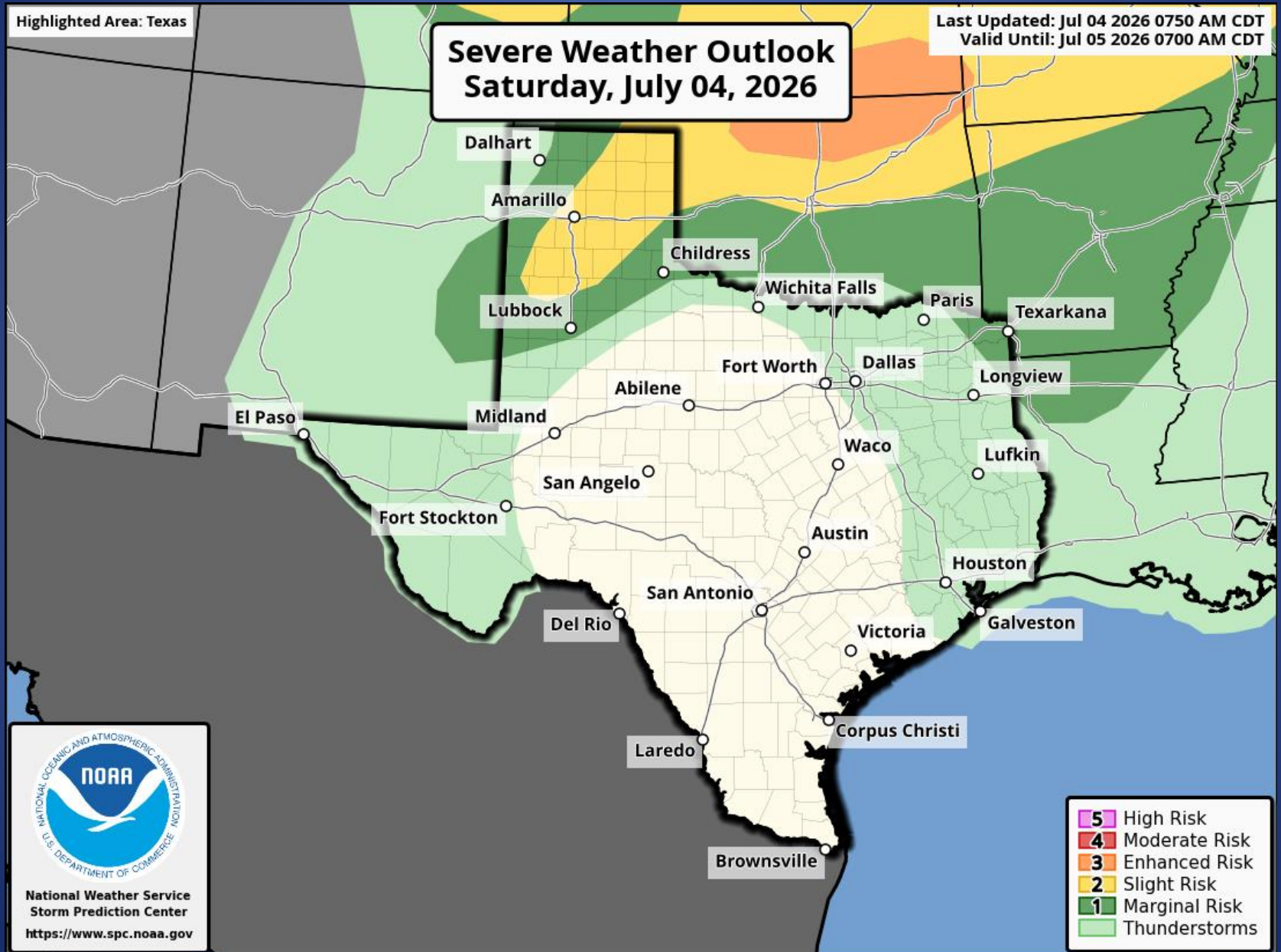

Severe Thunderstorm Potential Today

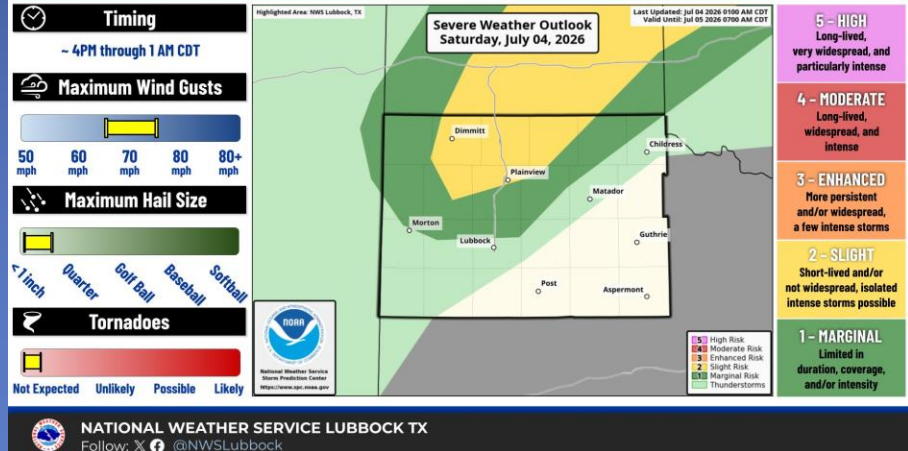

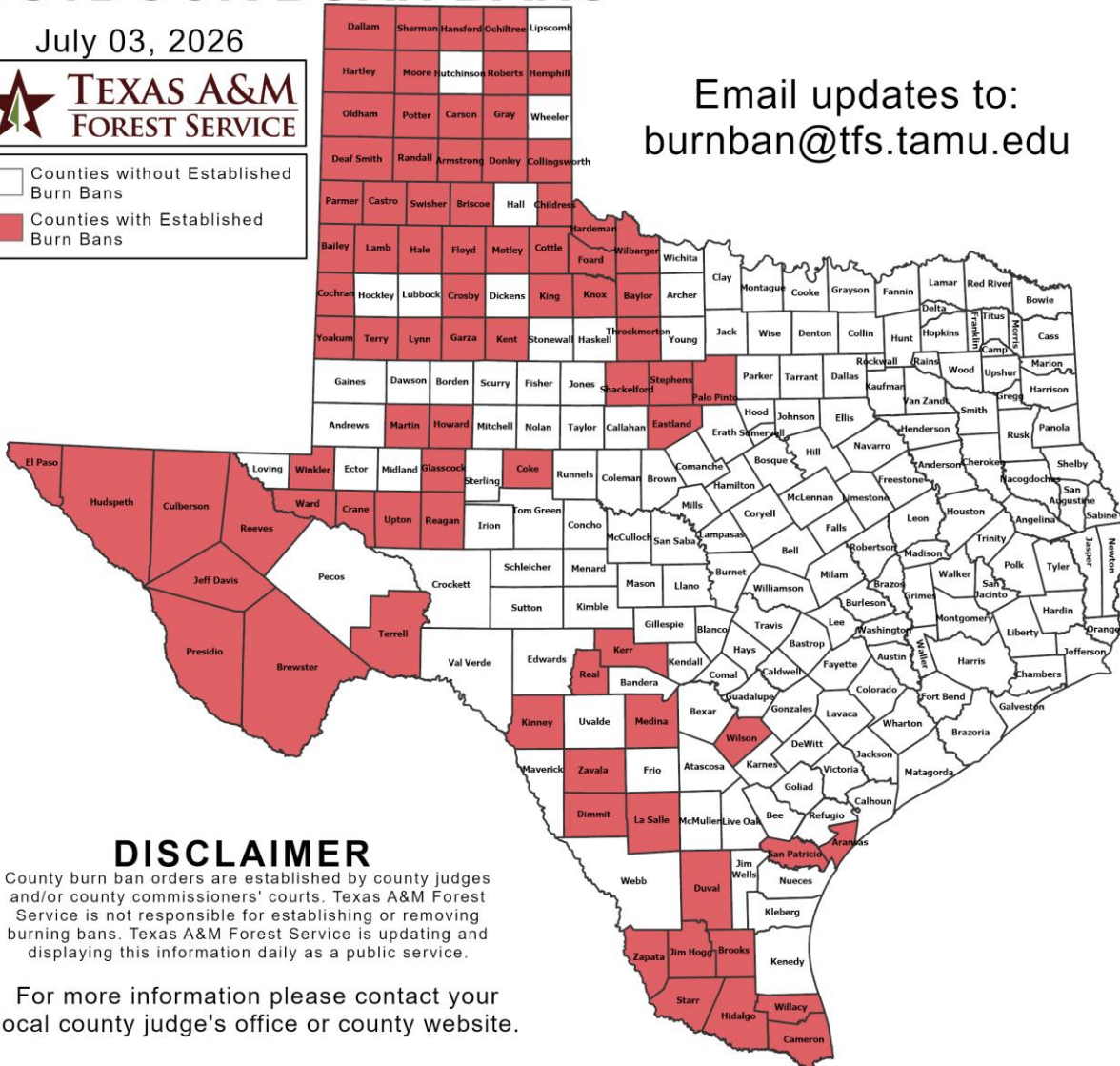

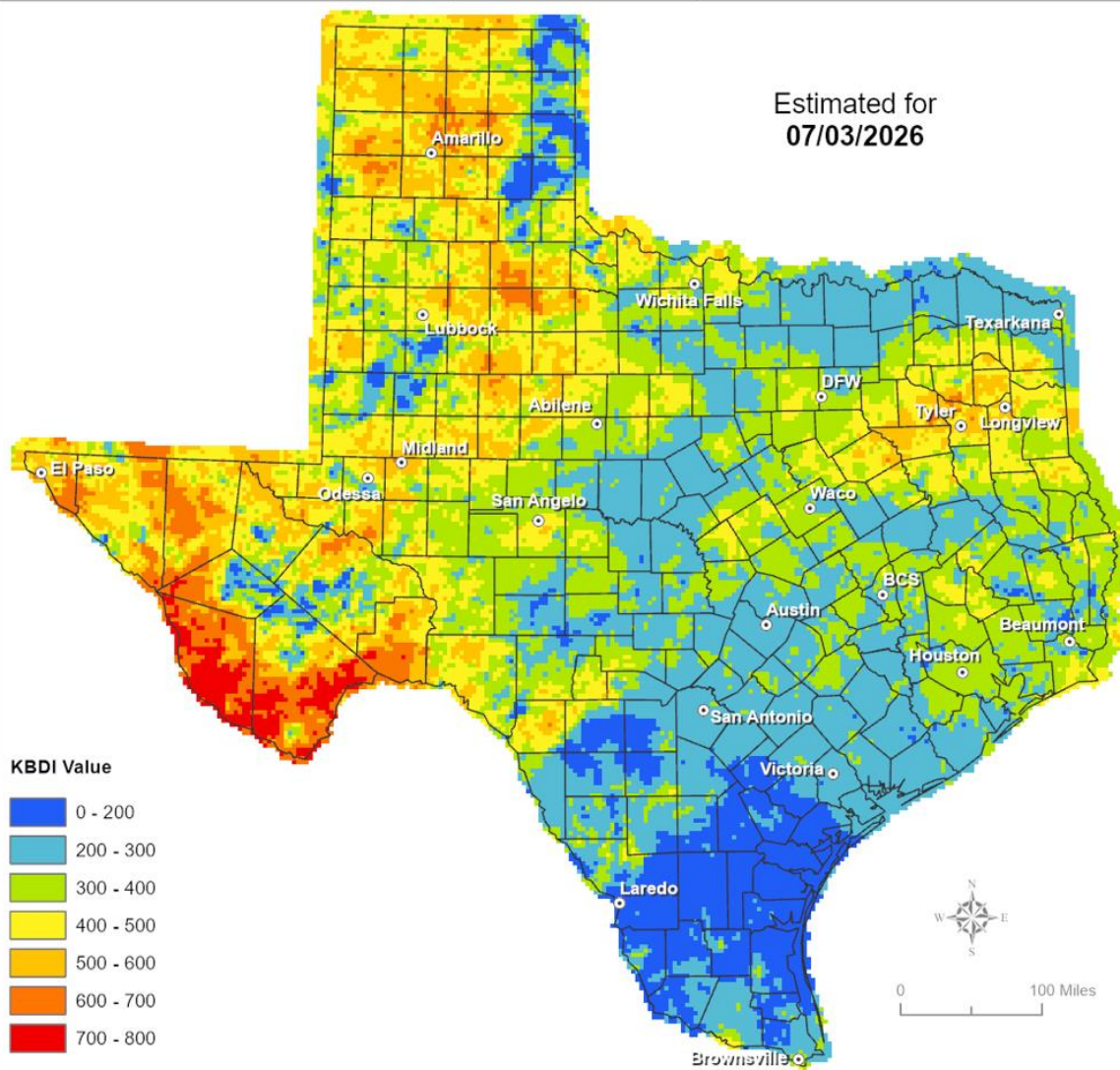

Keetch-Byram Drought Index

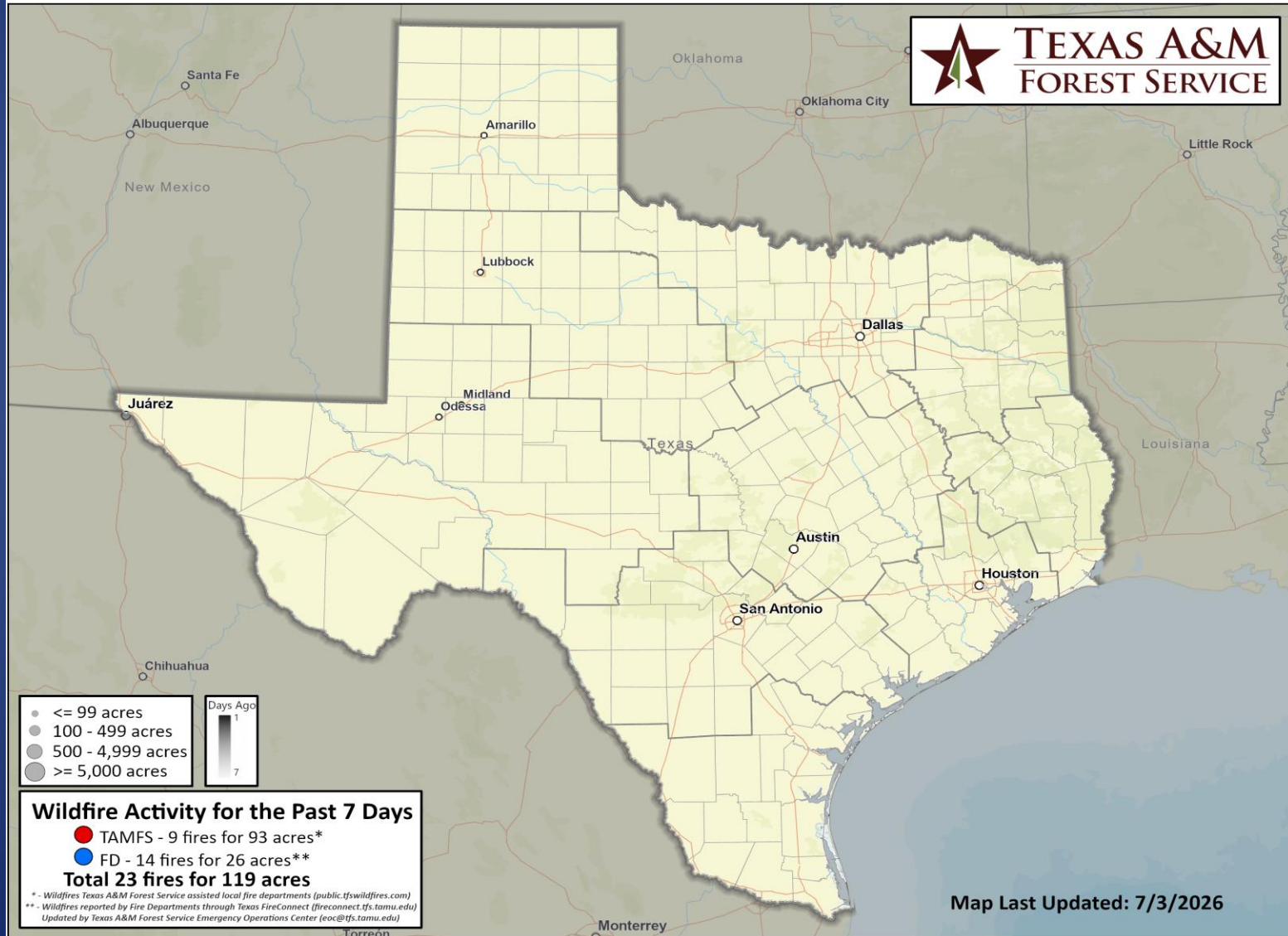
Keetch-Byram Drought Index

Report of 717 fires (No Change) and 104,509 (No Changes) acres have been burned this year. There are 81 (No Change) counties with burn bans. The Keetch–Byram Drought Index list contains **80 (+6)** counties with an average over 400.
