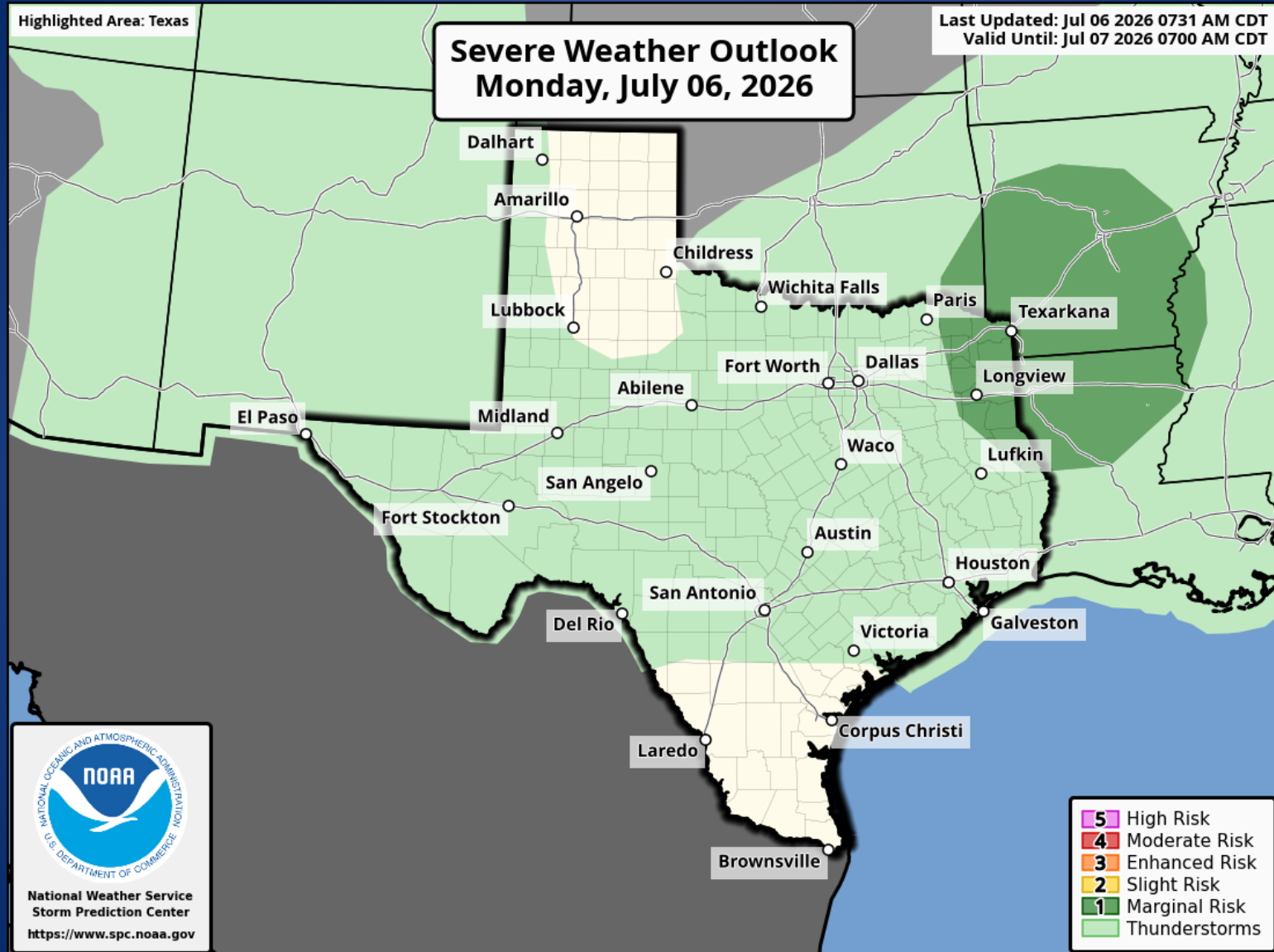

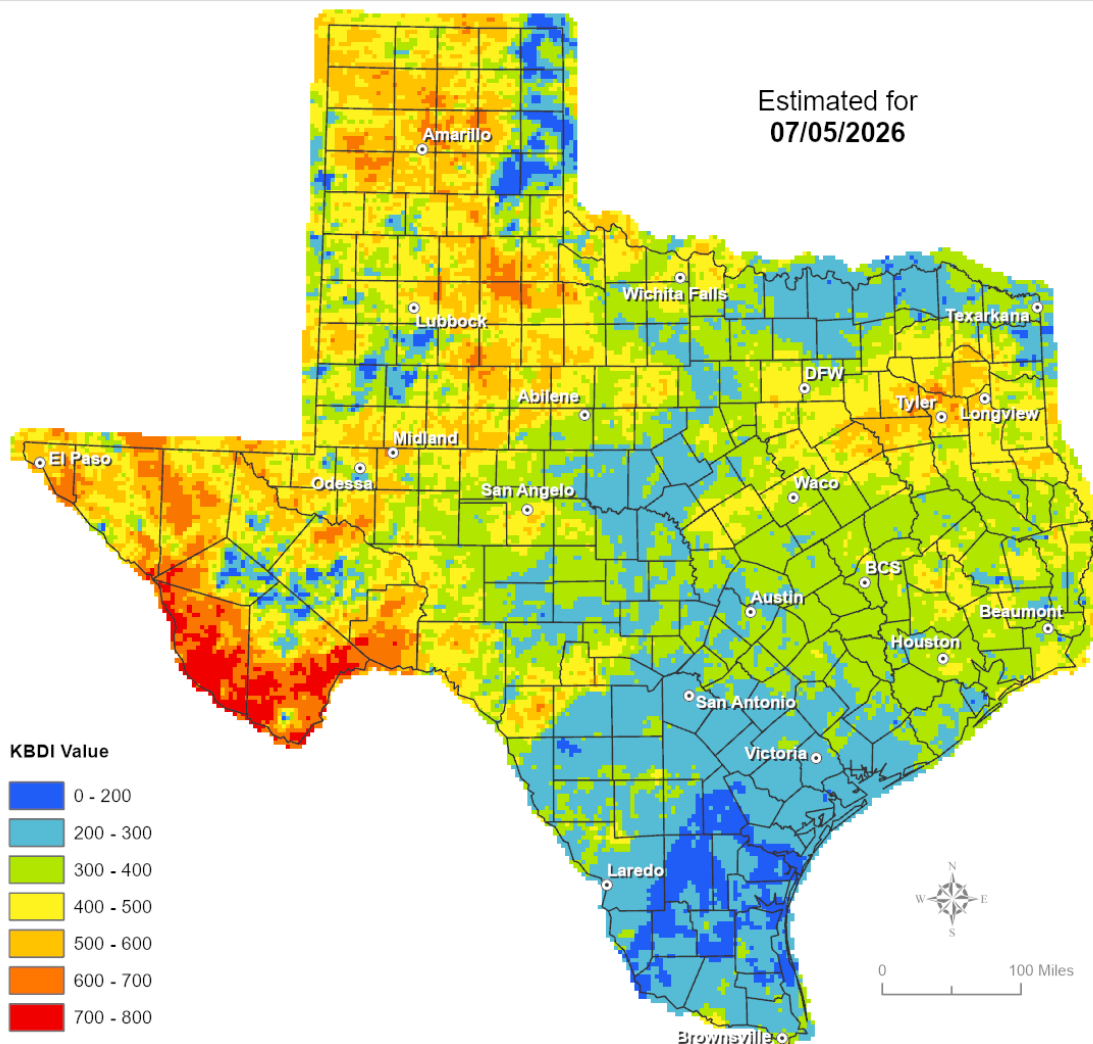

## Keetch-Byram Drought Index

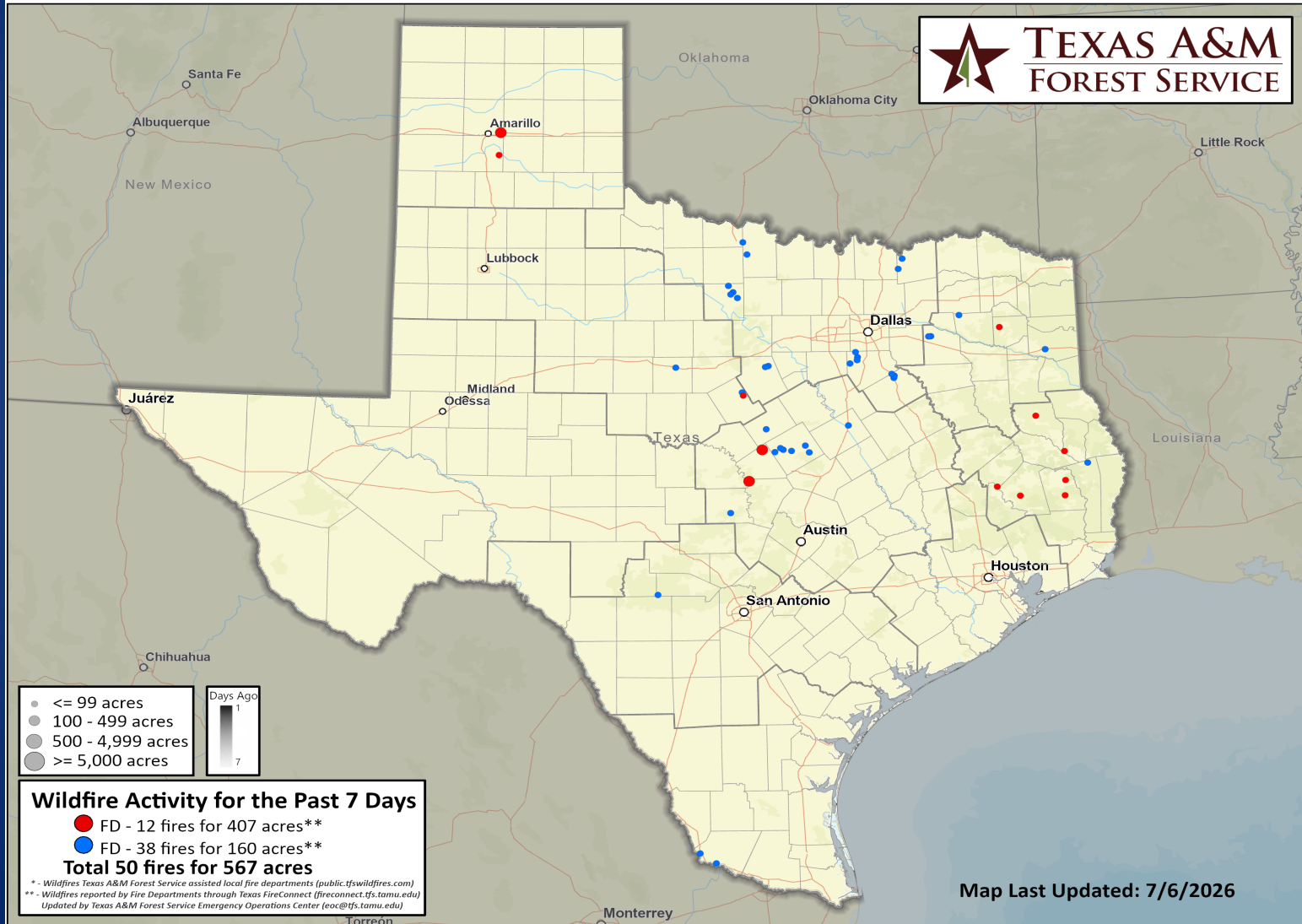

# Fire Activity (\*Last 24 Hours)

Report of 717 fires (No Change) and 104,509 (No Changes) acres have been burned this year. There are 82 (+2) counties with burn bans. The Keetch-Byram Drought Index list contains 98 (+6) counties with an average over 400.
