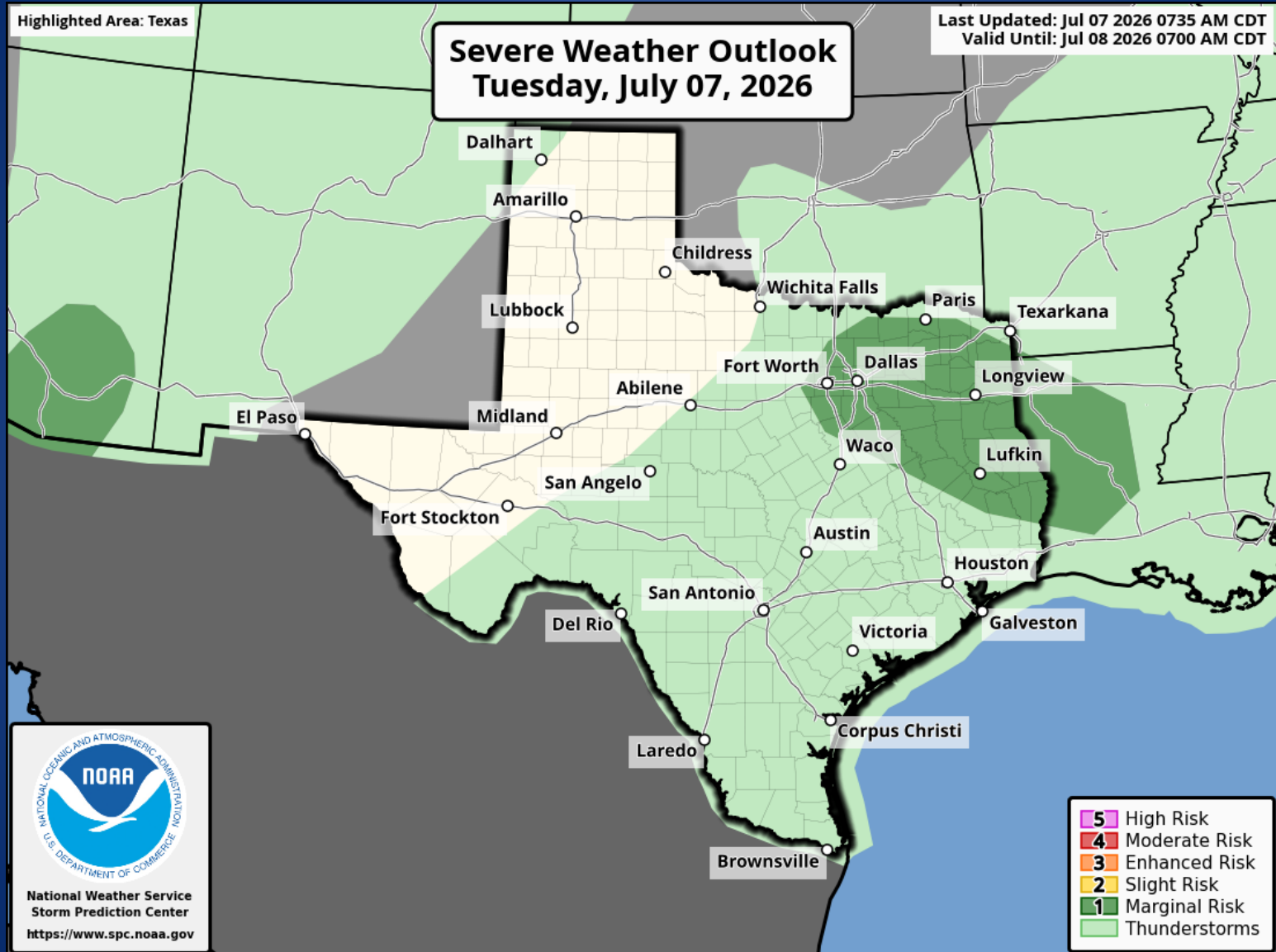

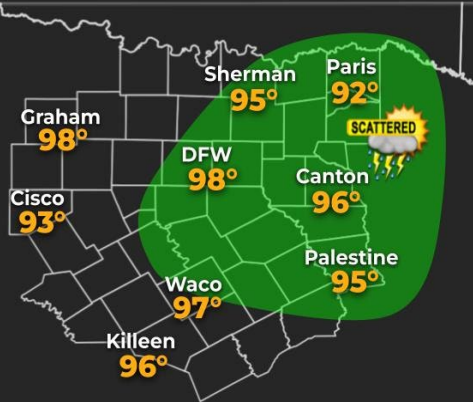

Additional isolated to scattered storms are expected today. A few storms may become strong to severe with a threat for damaging wind gusts, with the main storm timing around 3 to 9 PM. Storms may also contain locally heavy rain and frequent lightning. Be ready to seek safe shelter, especially if outdoors or if boating on the lakes!

There will be a continued threat of strong to severe thunderstorms once again Today through This Evening...mainly across much of Northeast Texas into Northern Louisiana. Damaging wind gusts will be the main threat.

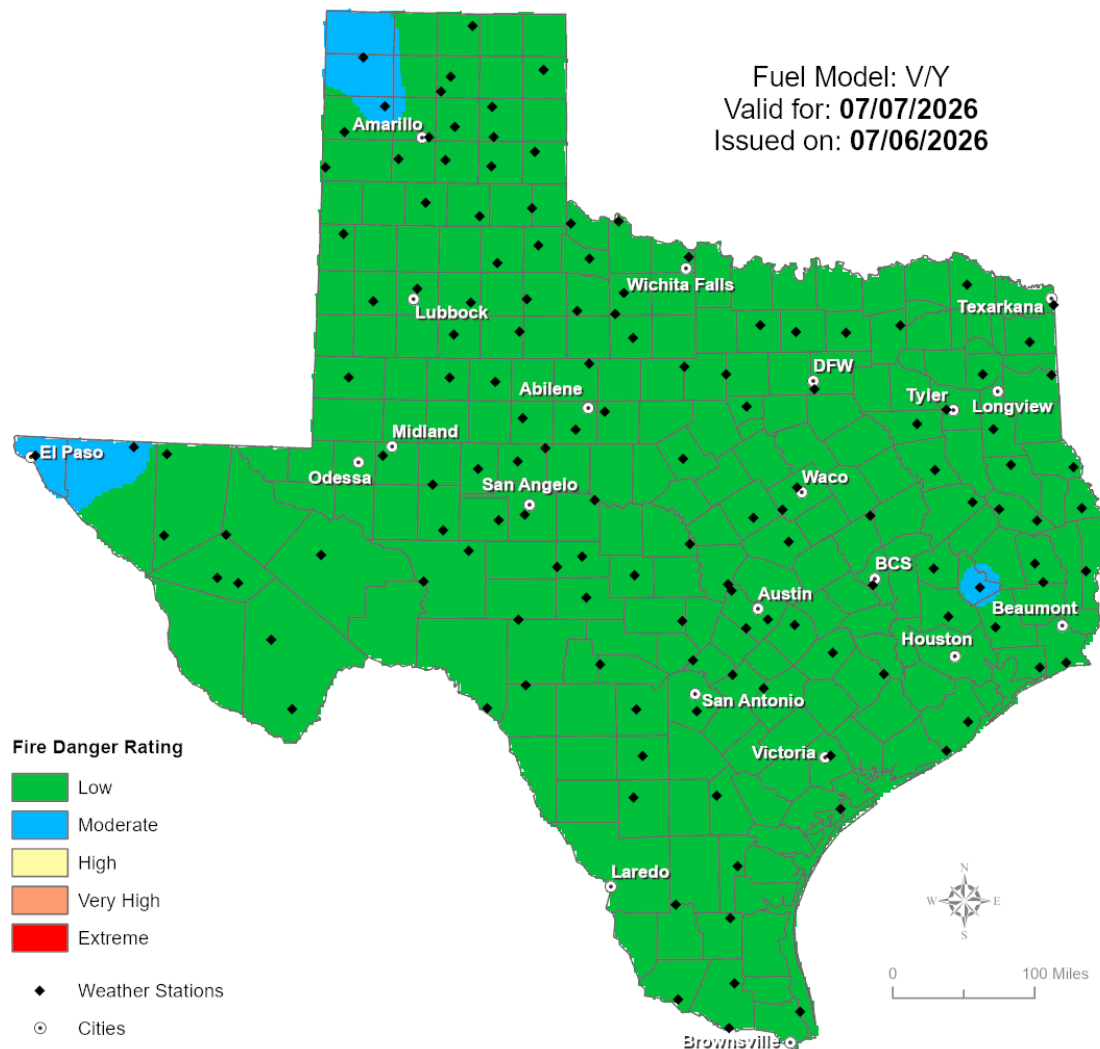

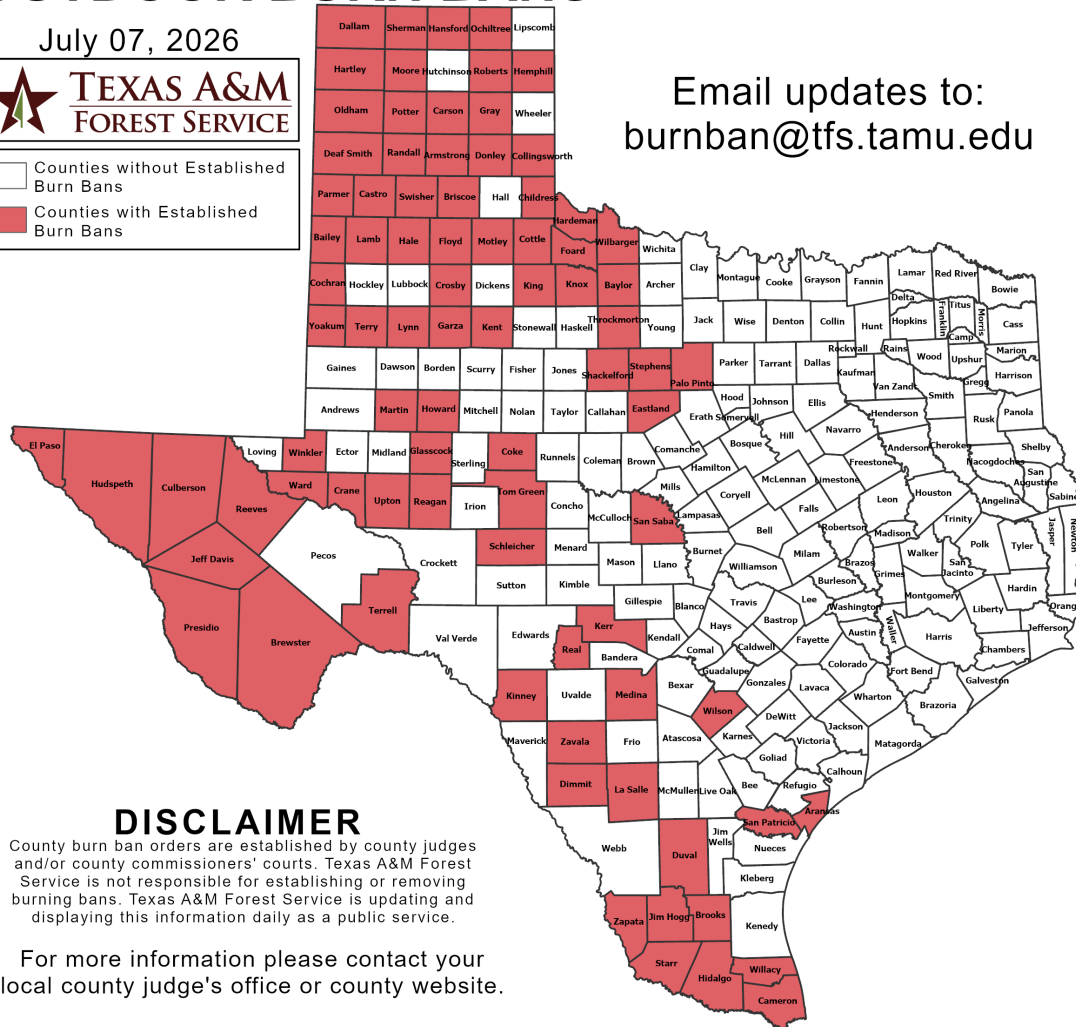

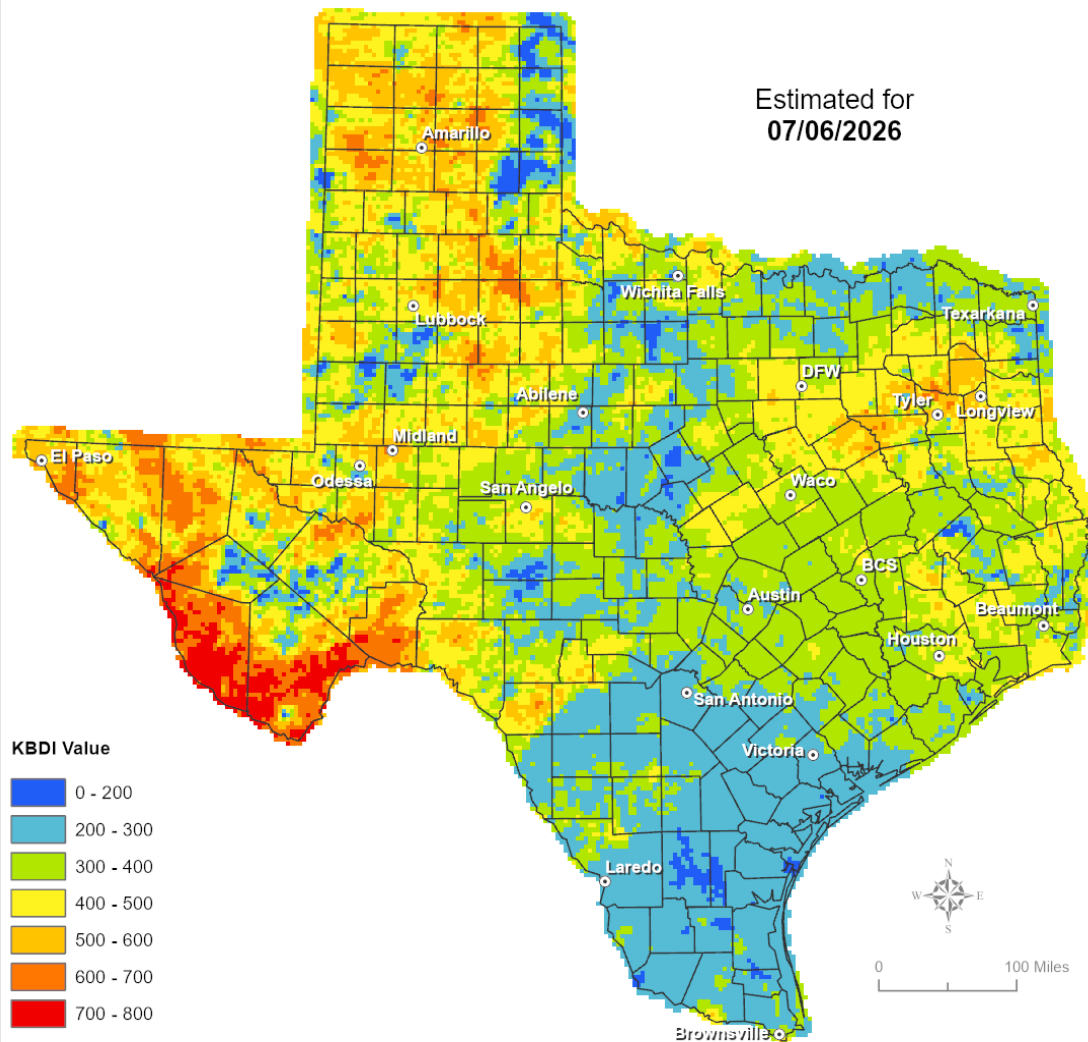


# Keetch-Byram Drought Index

## Keetch-Byram Drought Index

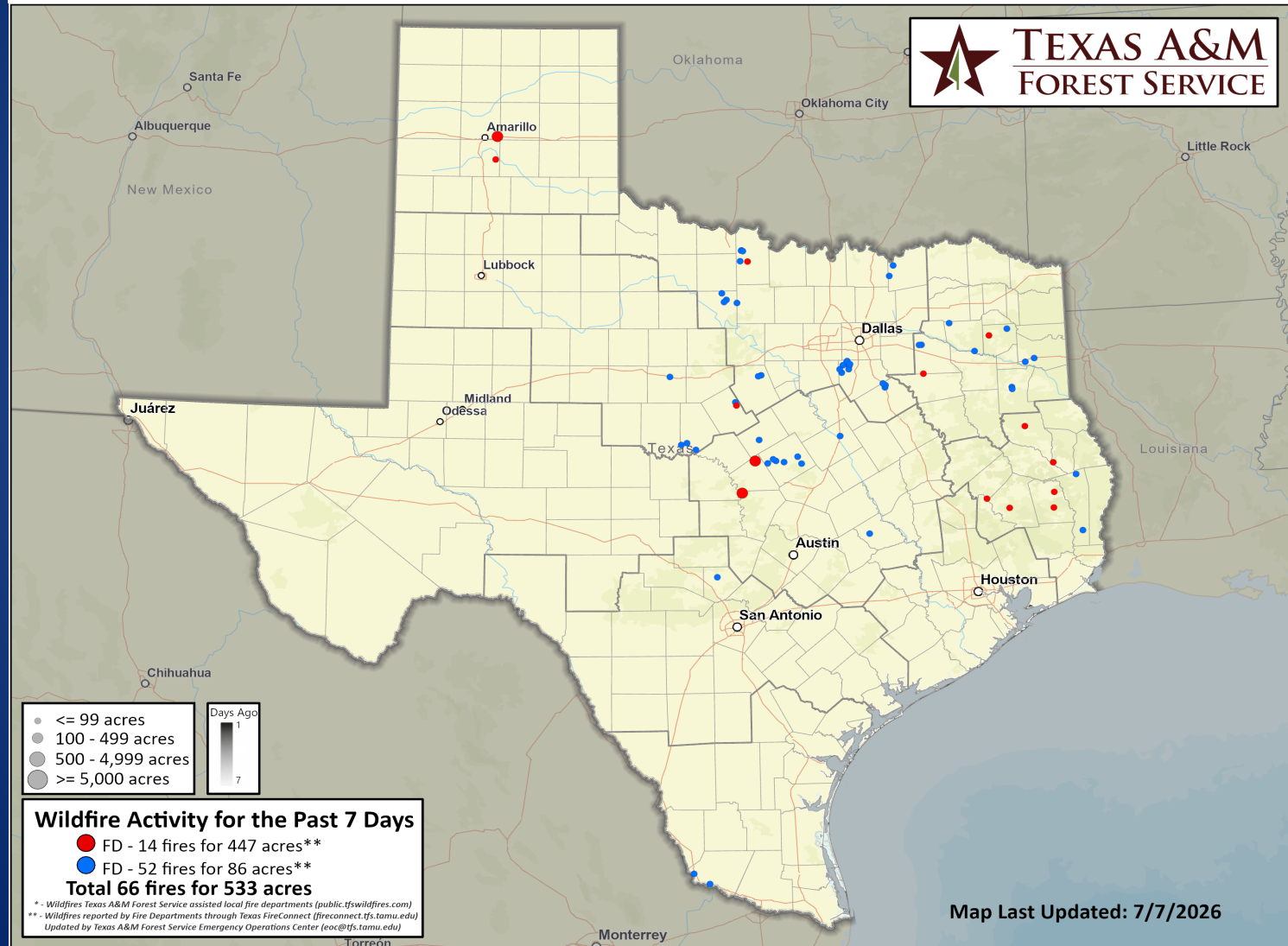
(4 km x 4 km resolution)

# Fire Activity (\*Last 24 Hours)

Report of 725 fires (+8) and 104,873 (+363) acres have been burned this year. There are 84 (+2) counties with burn bans. The Keetch–Byram Drought Index list contains 98 (No Change) counties with an average over 400.
