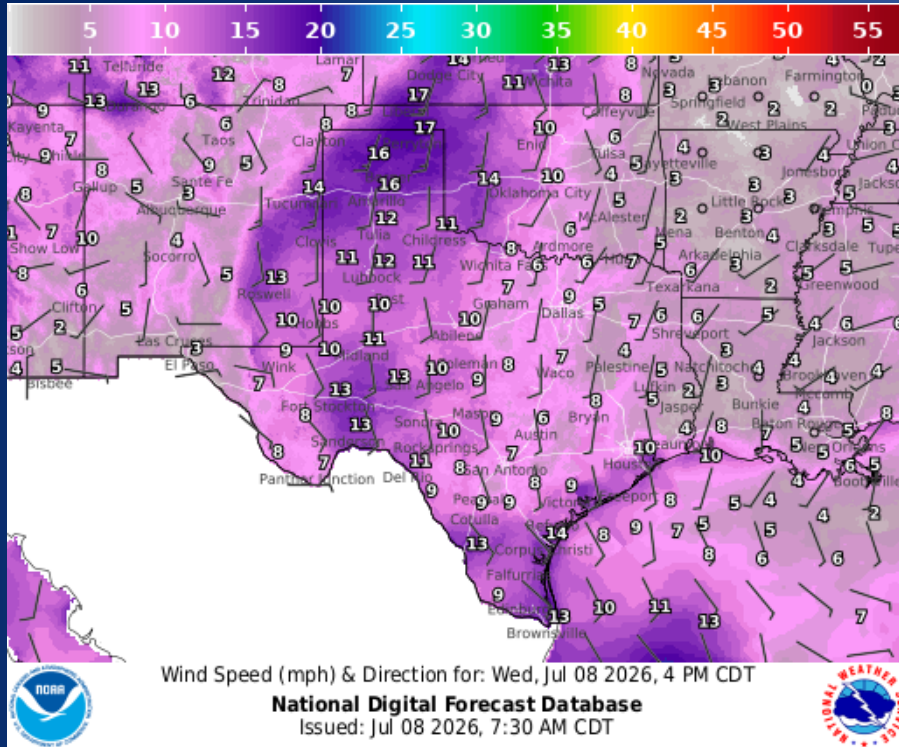

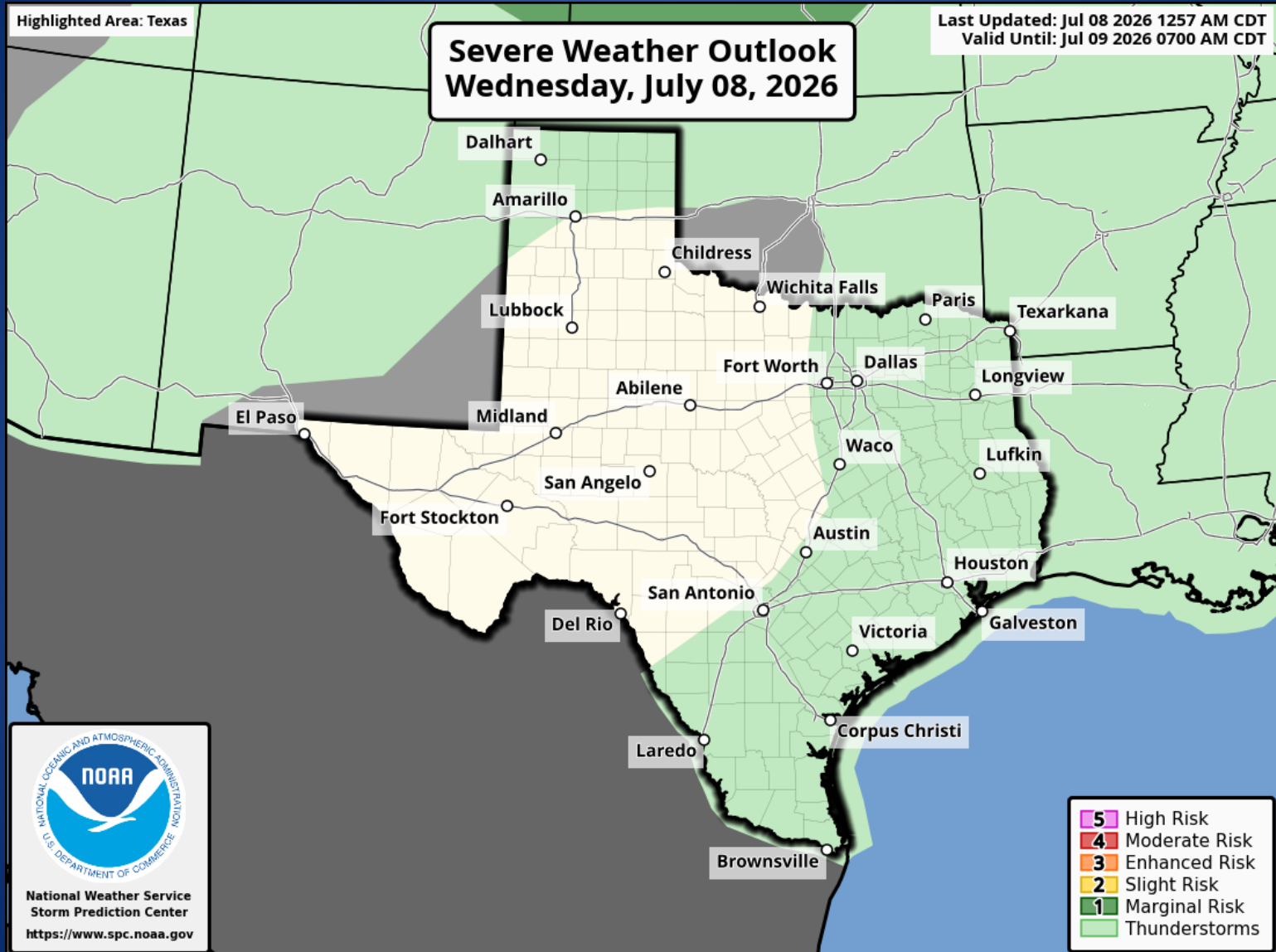

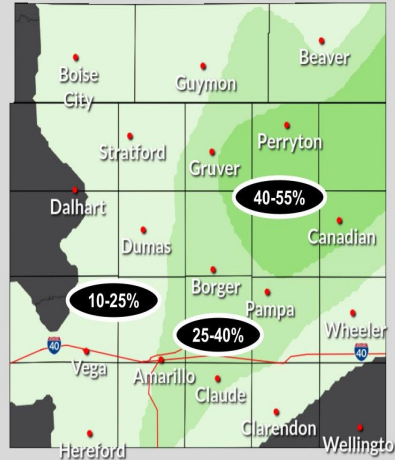

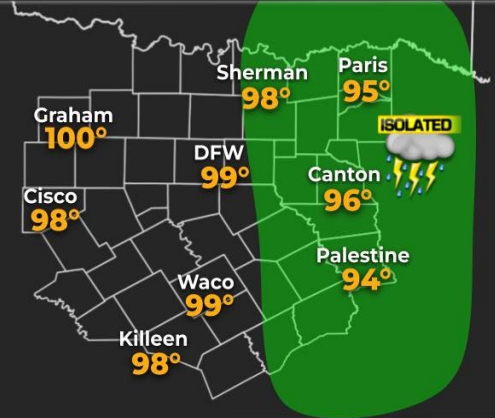

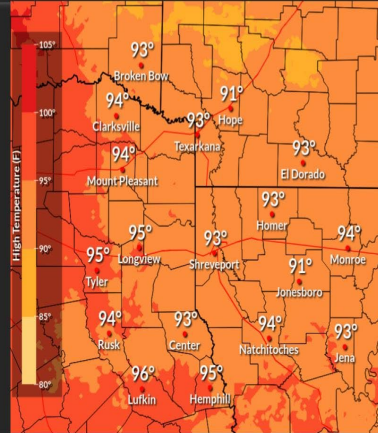

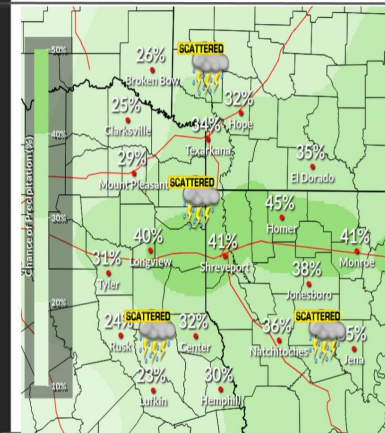
Typical Hot July Day with Scattered Storm Chances

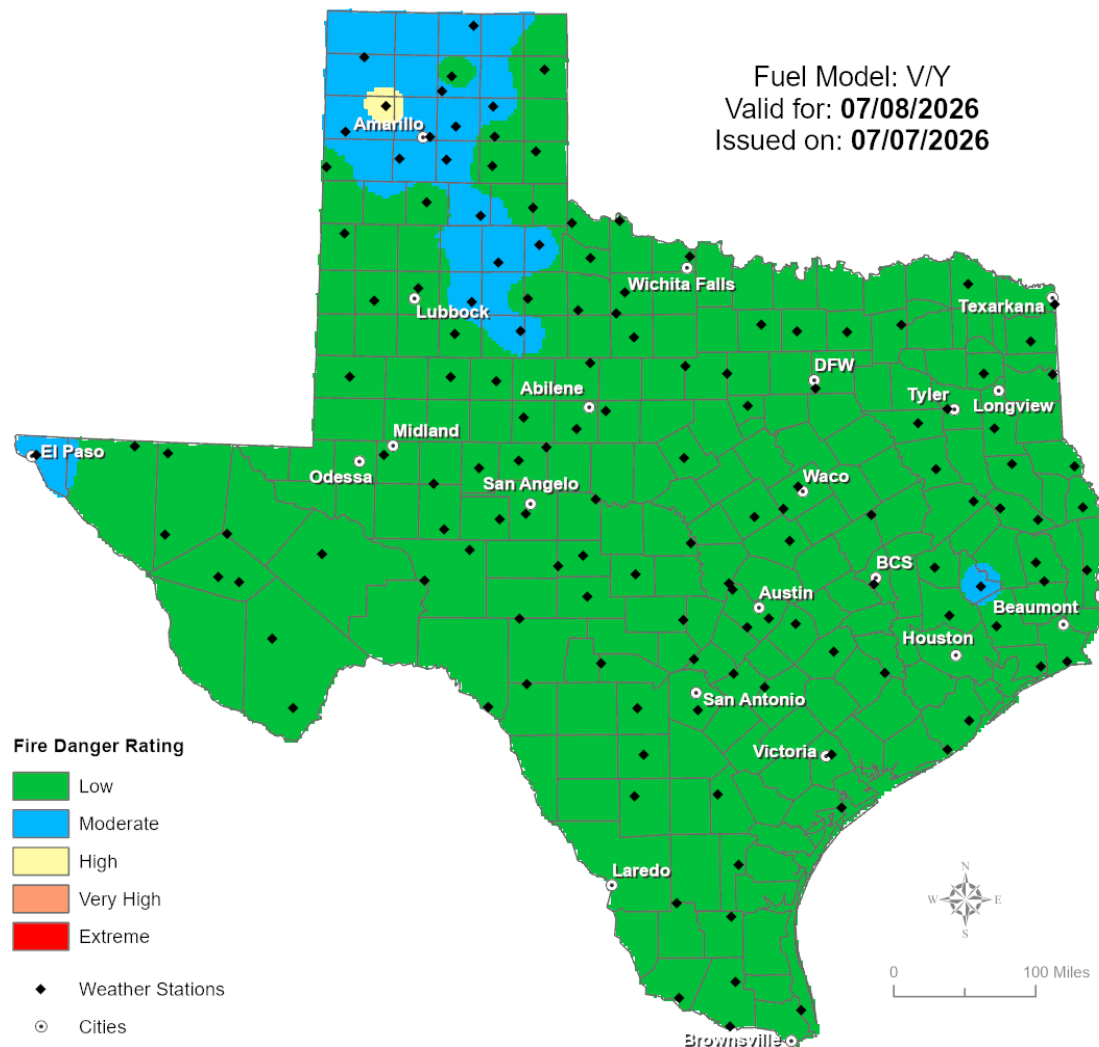
Another Hot day across the Four State Region with high temperatures well into the 90s. Scattered showers and thunderstorms will continue to be possible as well.

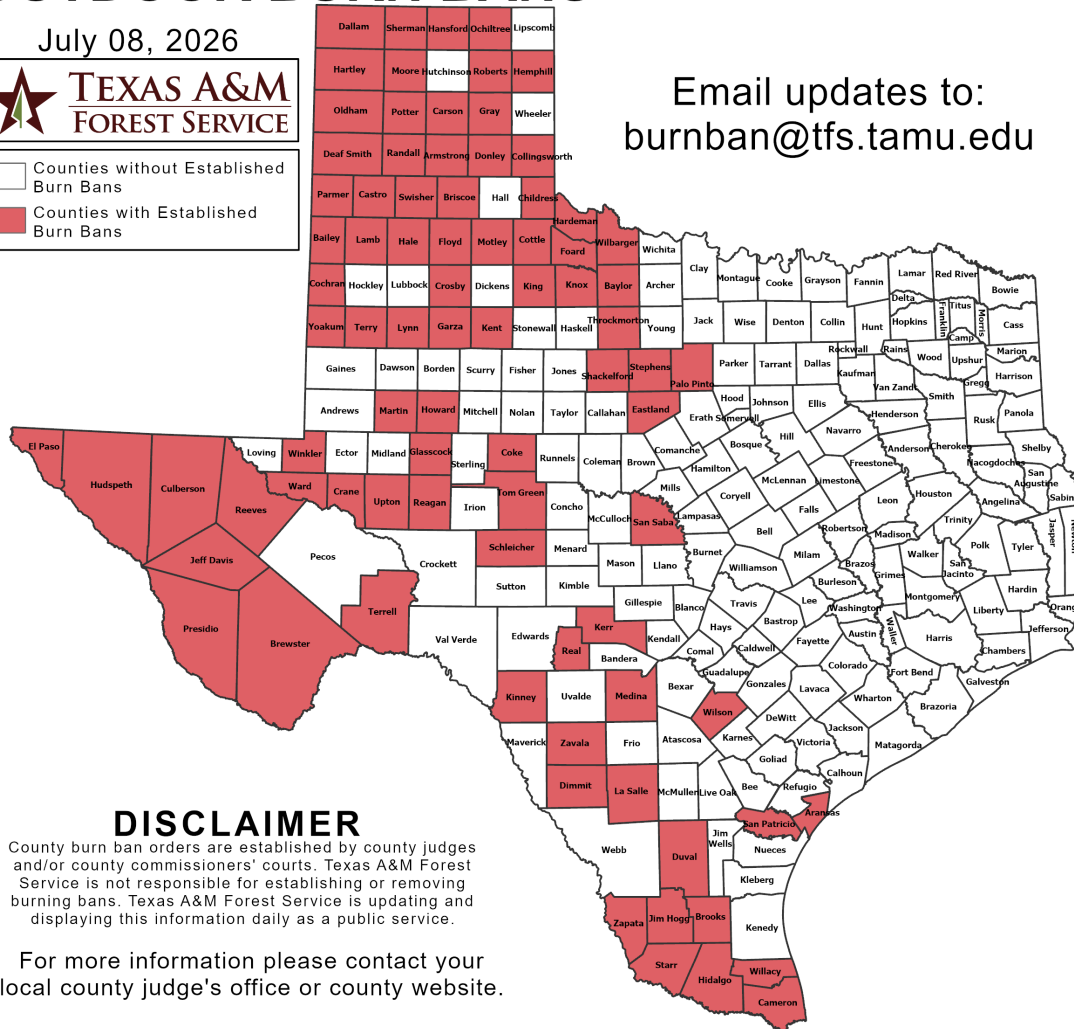

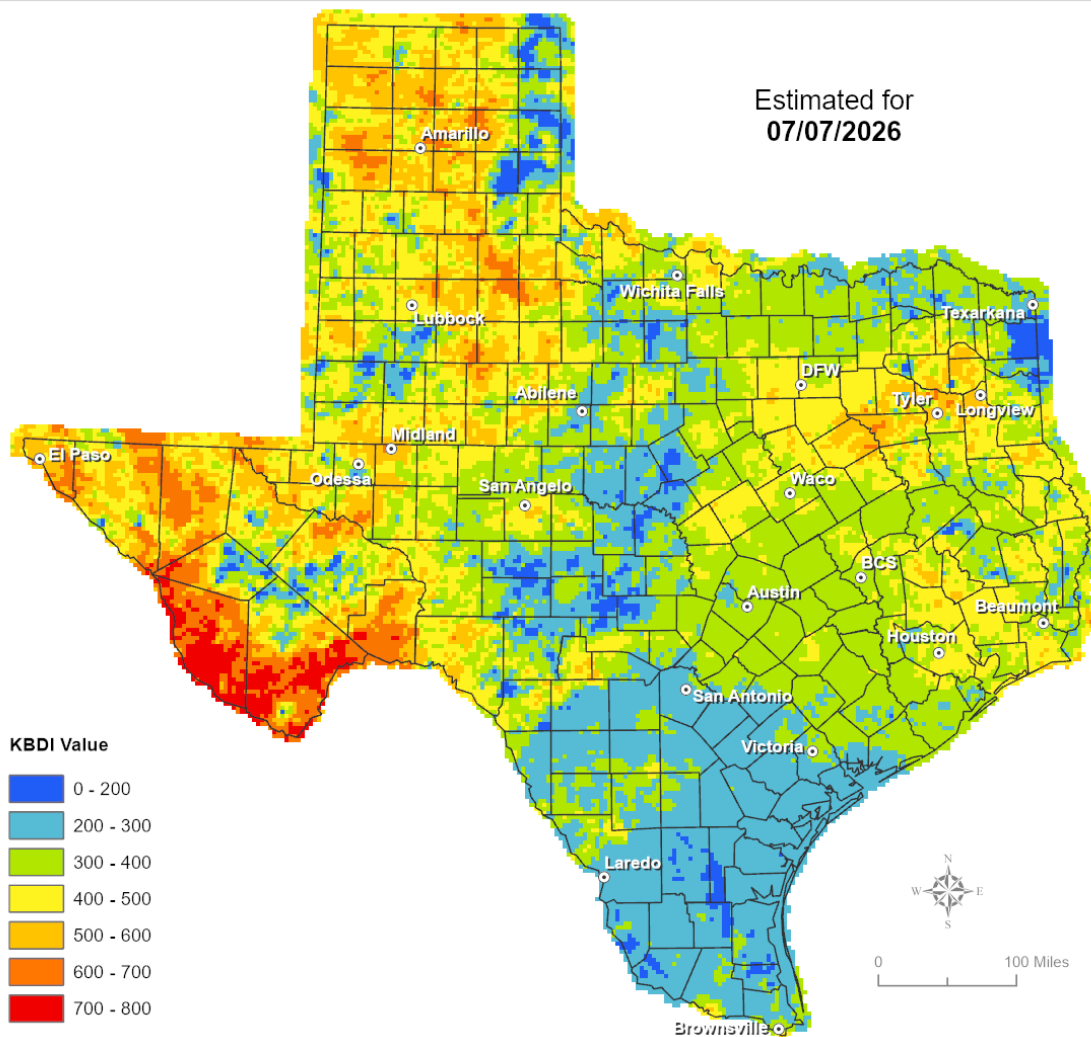

Keetch-Byram Drought Index

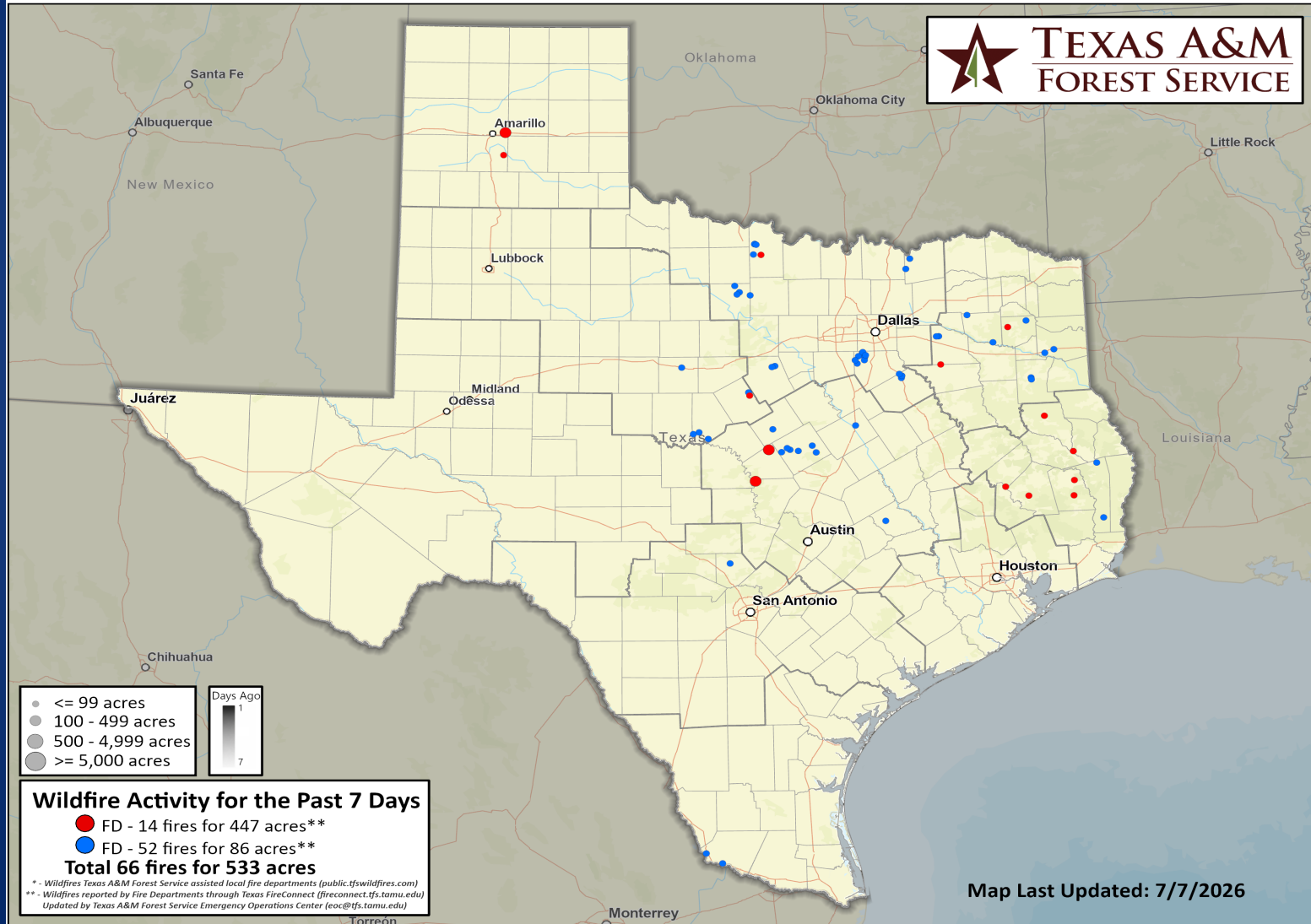
