STATEWIDE CURRENT SITUATION: On July 12, Governor Greg Abbott directed the Texas Division of Emergency Management (TDEM) to activate state emergency response resources ahead of severe weather and flash flooding threats expected to impact multiple regions of Texas over the next several days.

OPERATIONAL PRIORITIES:

- Protect life and property.
- Support rapid & effective response.
- Collect and disseminate accurate incident information to improve decision-making.
- Accurately track incident costs associated with assigned resources for cost recovery.

Region 1 (Includes Disaster District (DD) 1, 2, and 7)

DD 7 – Abilene (Includes Brown, Callahan, Coleman, Comanche, Eastland, Fisher, Haskell, Jones, Kent, Knox, Mitchell, Nolan, Runnels, Scurry, Shackelford, Stephens, Stonewall, Throckmorton, and Taylor Counties): DDEOC 7 activated to Level III (Increased Readiness Conditions) under 26-0013 18MAY Severe Weather and remains activated under 26-0019 12JUL Severe Weather.

RESPONDING STATE AGENCIES/ORGANIZATIONS REPORTS

Texas Division of Emergency Management, Texas A&M University System (TDEM):

The State Operations Center (SOC) has activated to Level II (Escalated Response) in support of this severe weather incident. The SOC is directing interagency coordination to maintain unified communication, deploy necessary resources, and support response operations in affected regions across Texas.

Texas A&M Engineering Extension Service Texas Task Force 1 (TEEX/TX-TF1):

On July 13, TX-TF1 activated three additional Swift Water Rescue (SWR) boat squads and a Water Rescue boat squad from TX-TF3. TX-TF1 has rostered a Type 3 Water Capable (WC) Urban Search and Rescue (US&R). Helicopter Search and Rescue Team (HSART) have joined TMD aircraft.

Texas A&M Engineering Extension Service Texas Task Force 2 (TEEX/TX-TF2):

On July 13, TX-TF2 activated a Type 3 WC US&R.

Texas Military Department (TMD):

TMD has two Ground Transportation Platoons (GTP), and one Rotary Wing Medium and one Rotary Wing Heavy Mission Ready Packages (MRP) supporting State Agency partners. TMD has activated 39 personnel, 10 vehicles, and two rotary wing aircraft.
