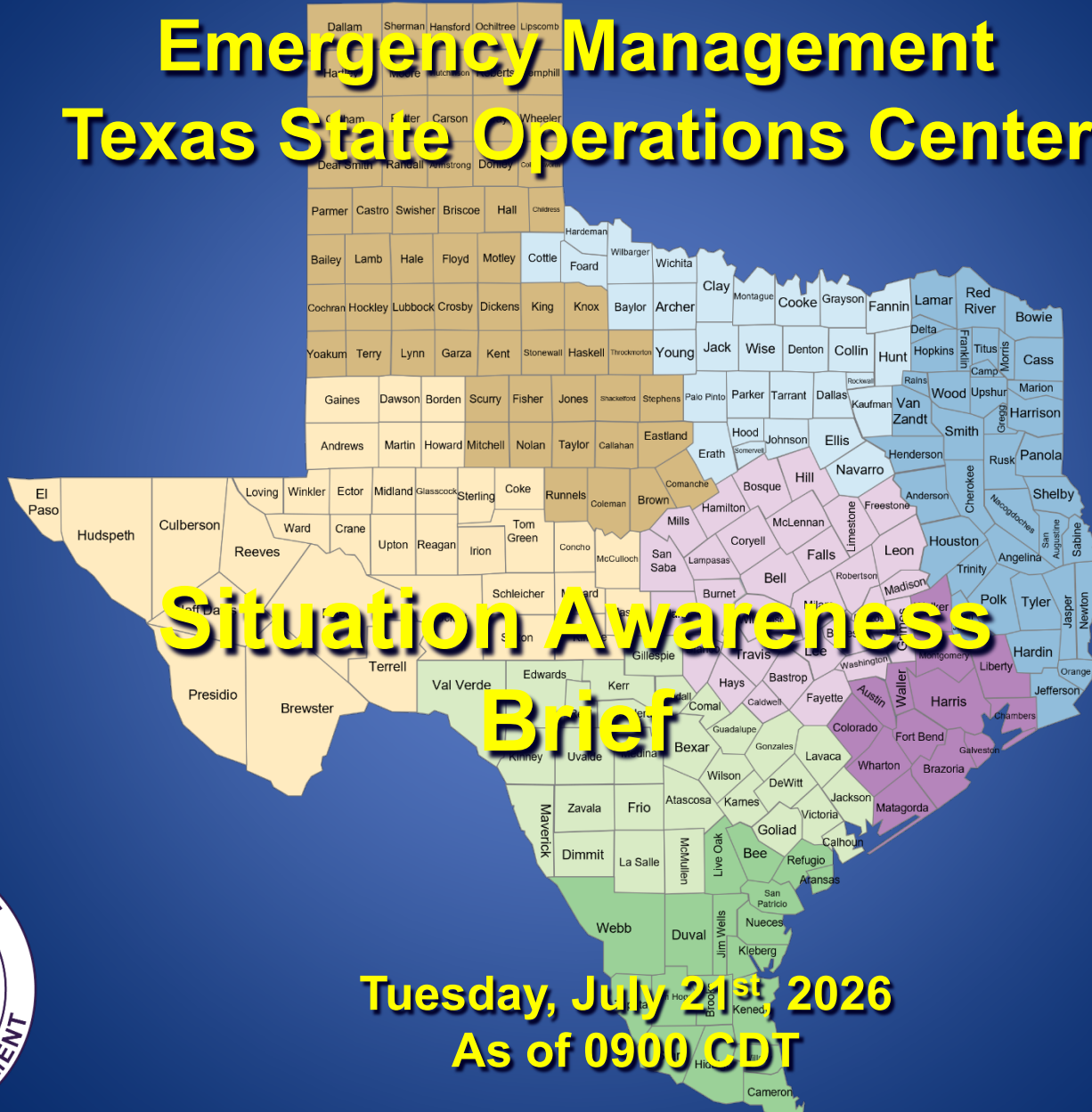

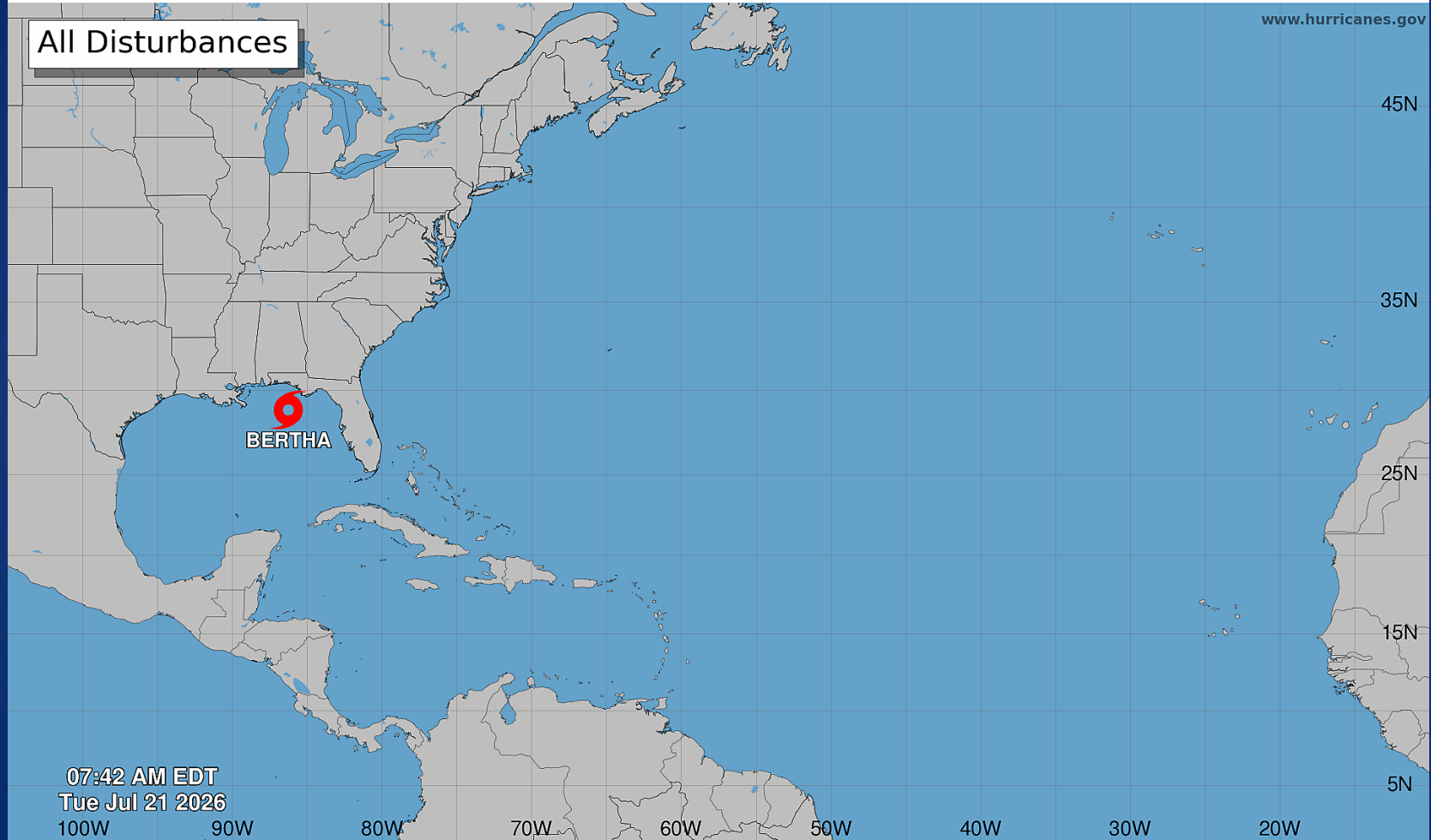
Seven-Day Graphical Tropical Weather Outlook

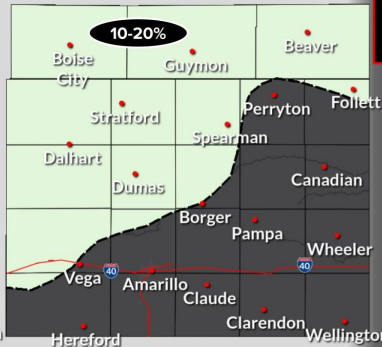

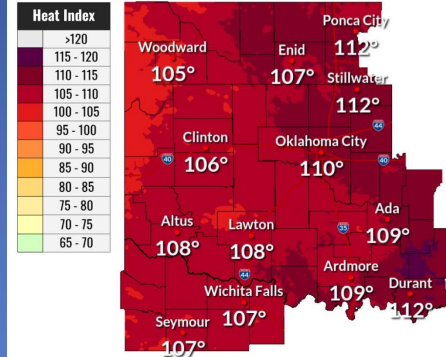

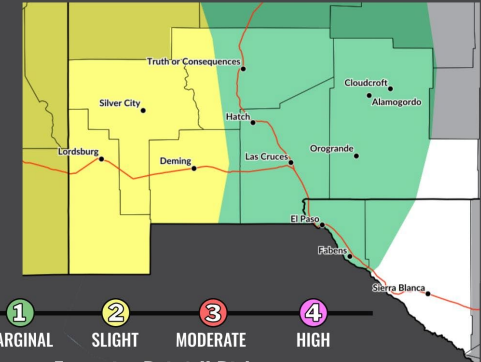

Nueces and Frio River Flooding

Tilden & Cotulla

The latest river observations shows the Nueces River at Cotulla currently in Major flood stage (17 ft) and is forecast to crest Tuesday evening (around 23 ft). For the Frio River at Tilden, the river is expected to rise into Minor Flood Stage (22 ft) early Tuesday morning, with a crest in Major Flood Stage (near 28 ft) Tuesday evening.

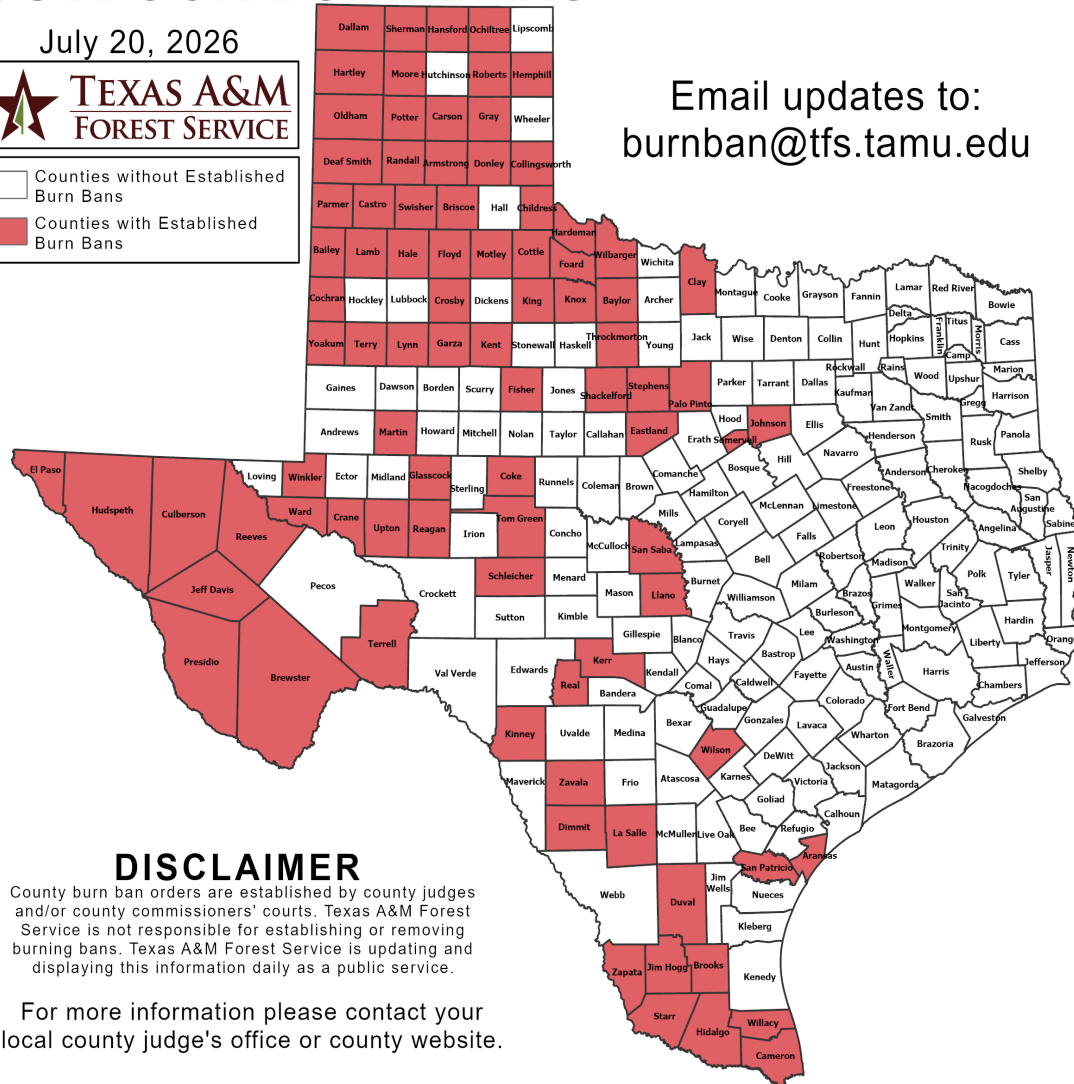

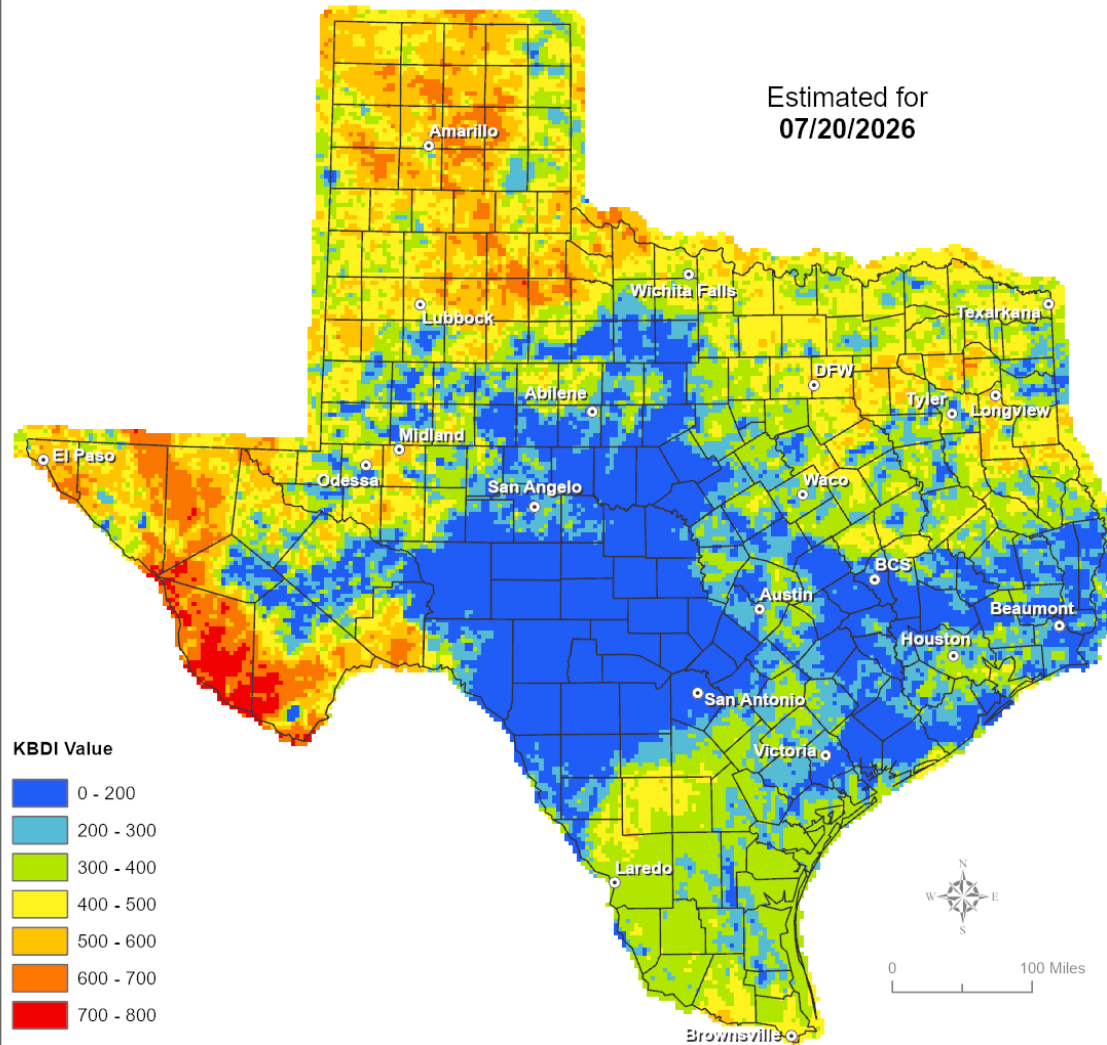

Keetch-Byram Drought Index

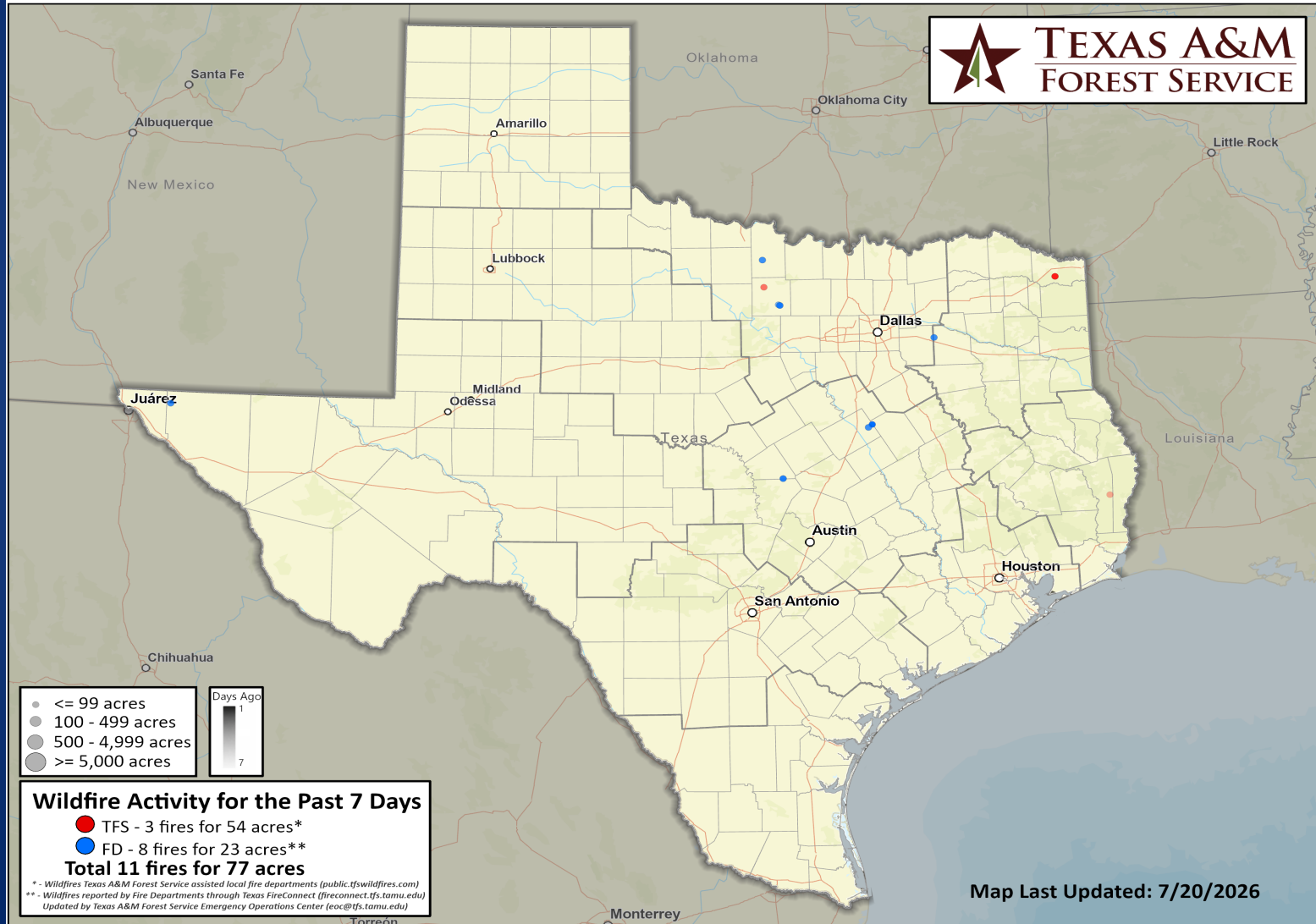
