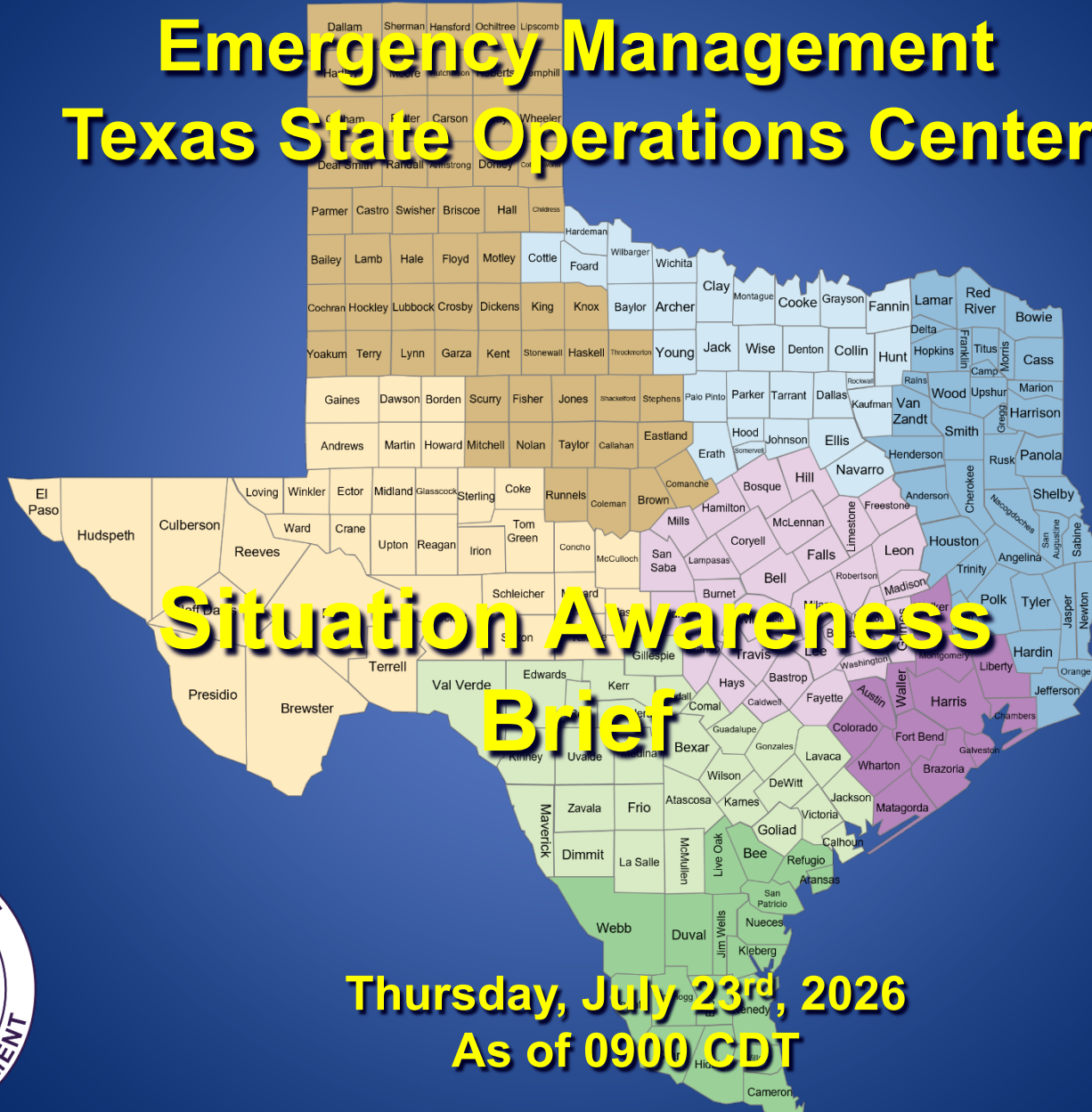

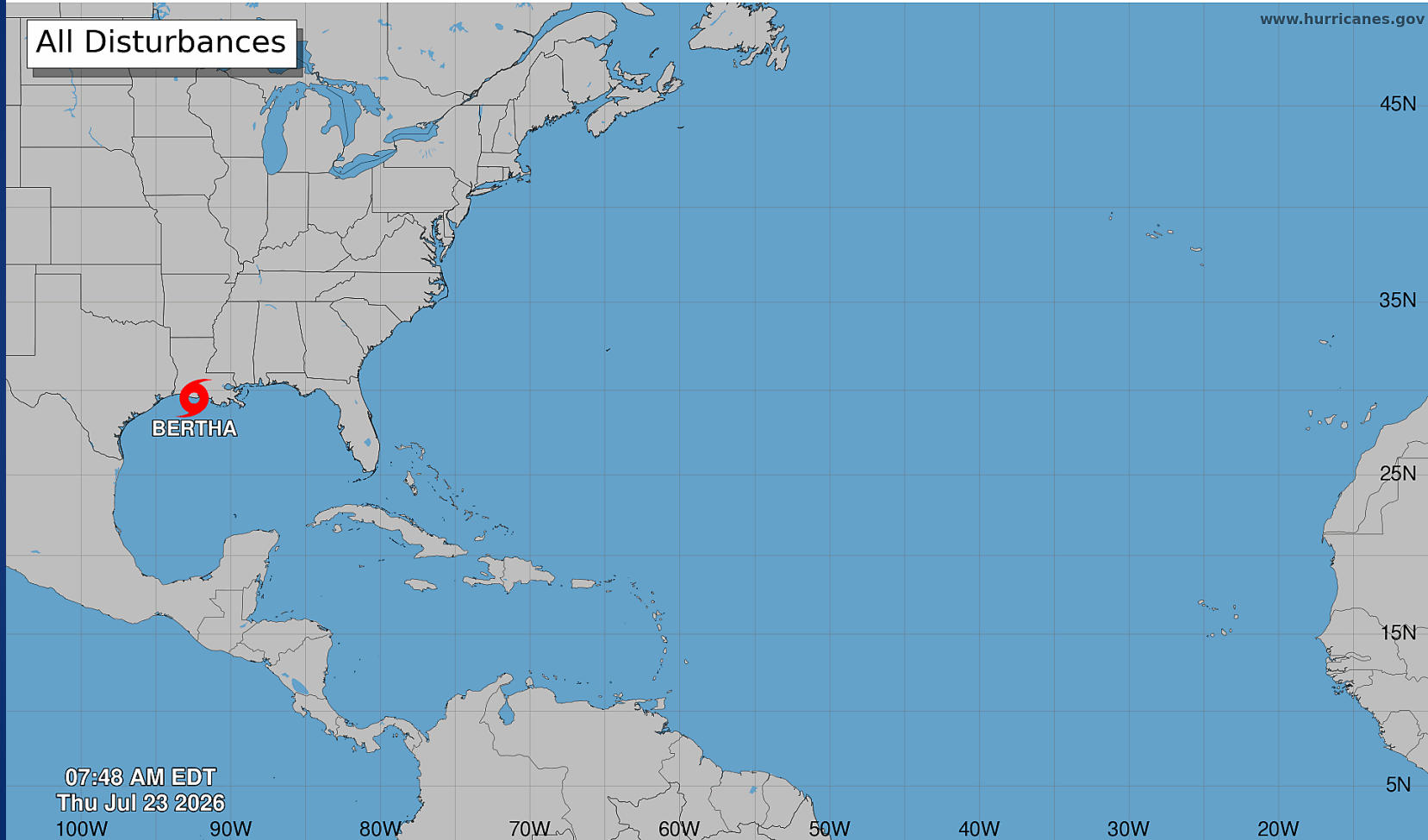
## Seven-Day Graphical Tropical Weather Outlook

Heat indices will climb triple digit across most areas west of I-35 on Thursday afternoon. Heat indices will exceed 105 degrees across much of southwest Oklahoma and adjacent western north Texas where a Heat Advisory will be in effect during the afternoon until sundown.

Areas off the Caprock will experience hot temperatures up to 106°F. The Heat Advisory was extended to include Thursday afternoon/evening. Temperatures will remain hot through at least early next week, and additional heat advisories may be needed.

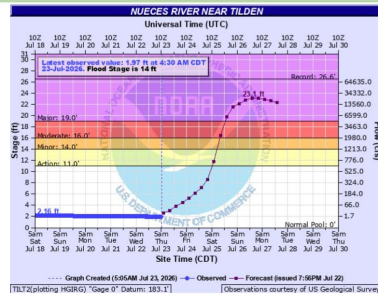
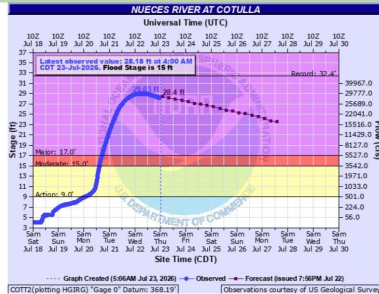


## Nueces River Flooding

Cotulla & Near Tilden

The Nueces River at Cotulla has crested and is gradually subsiding. The river is forecast to continue falling through the weekend while remaining in major flood stage. Further downstream at Tilden, the river is forecasted to rise into flood stage early Saturday and will rapidly rise into major flood stage Saturday afternoon.



**Note:** The forecast at Tilden is based on the current flow at Cotulla and the latest satellite image of the flood wave.

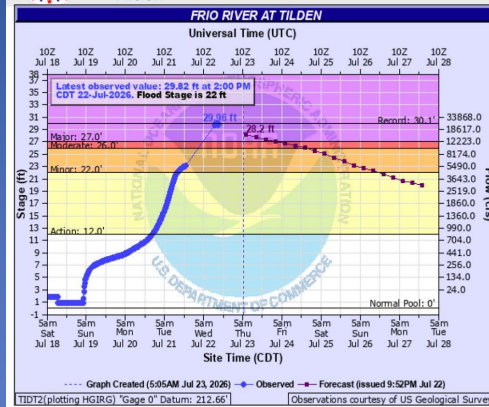
The Nueces River at Cotulla is gradually falling, but will remain in major flood levels through the weekend. Downstream at Tilden, the river is forecast to begin rising today with a rapid increase on Saturday into major flood stage.

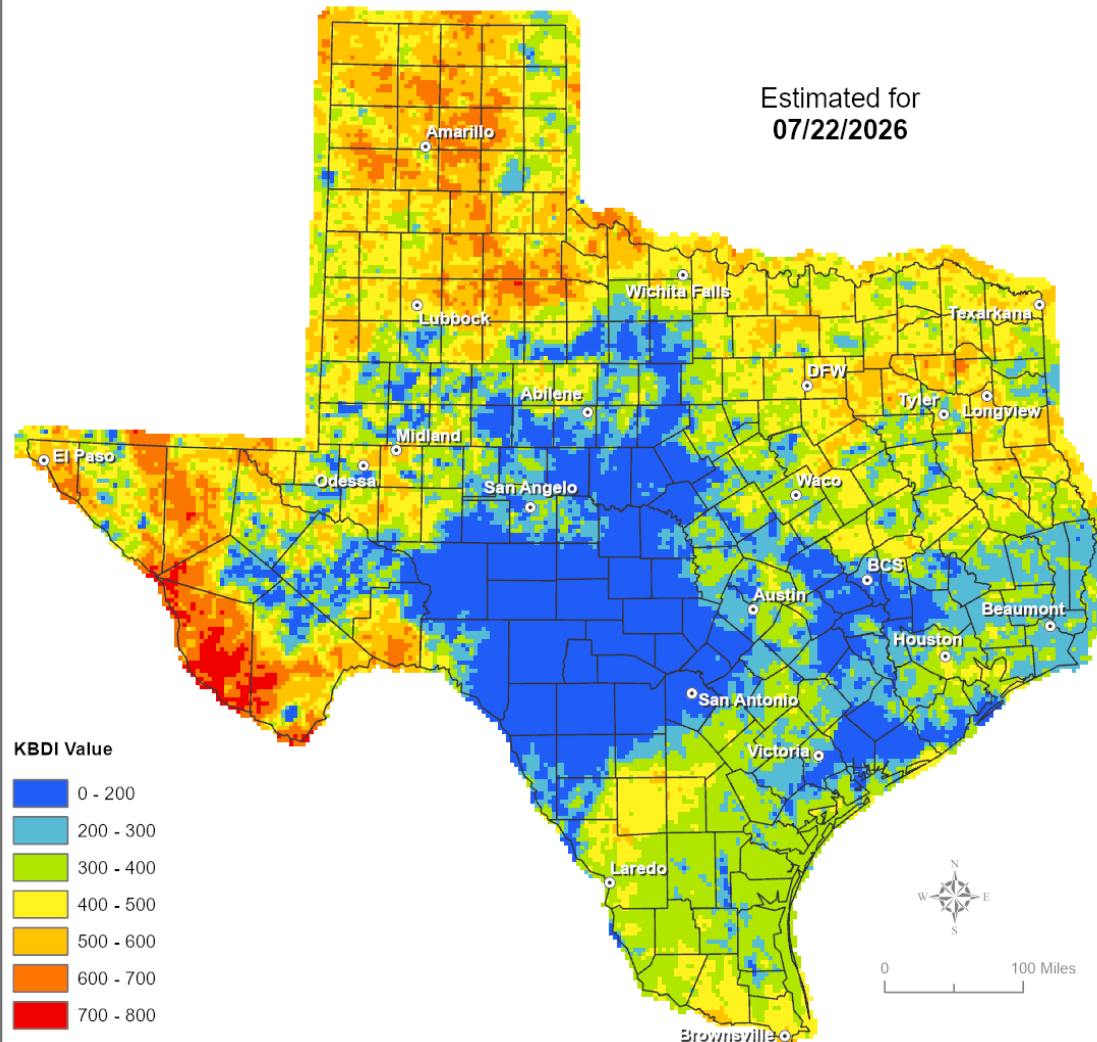


# Keetch-Byram Drought Index

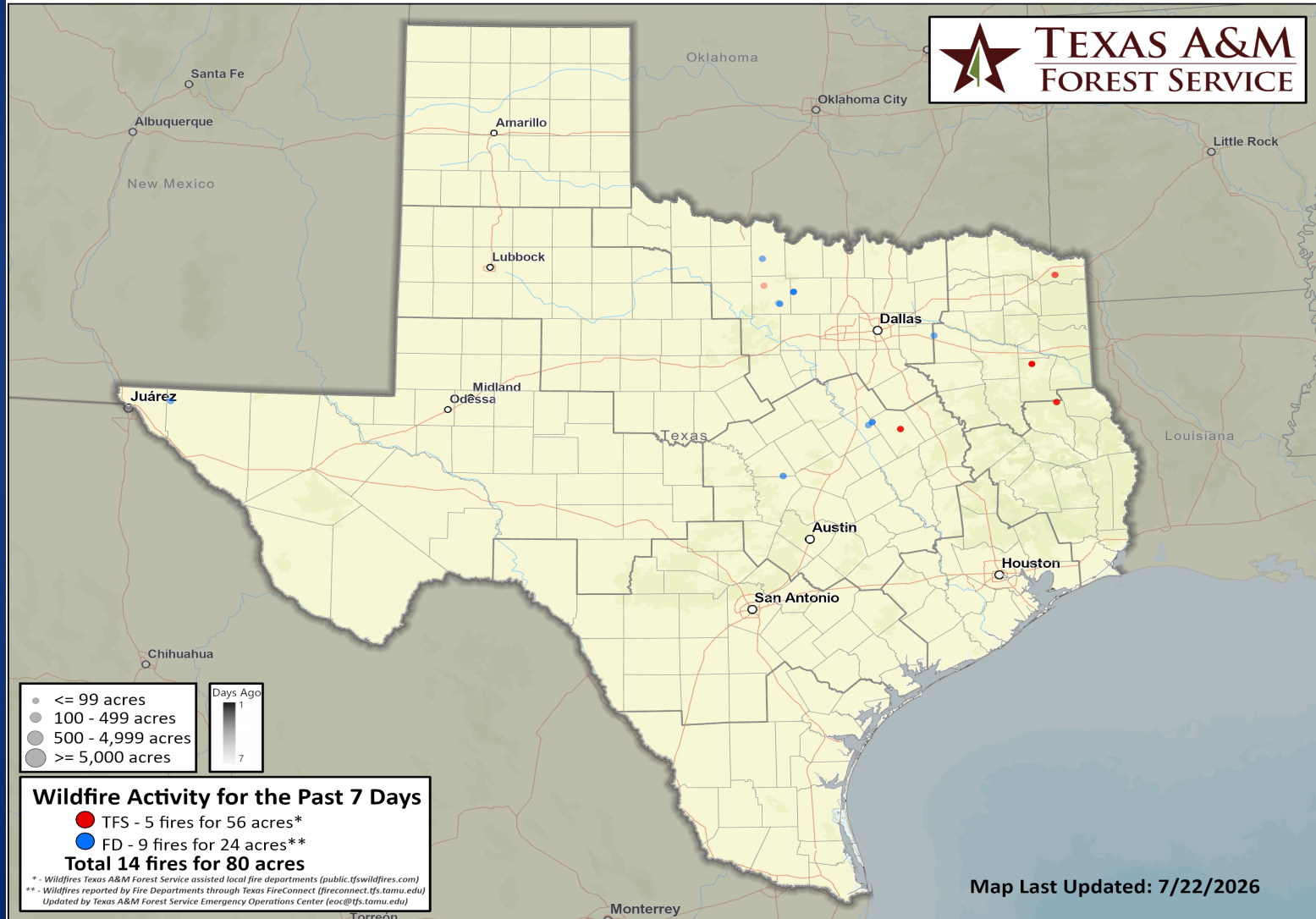
