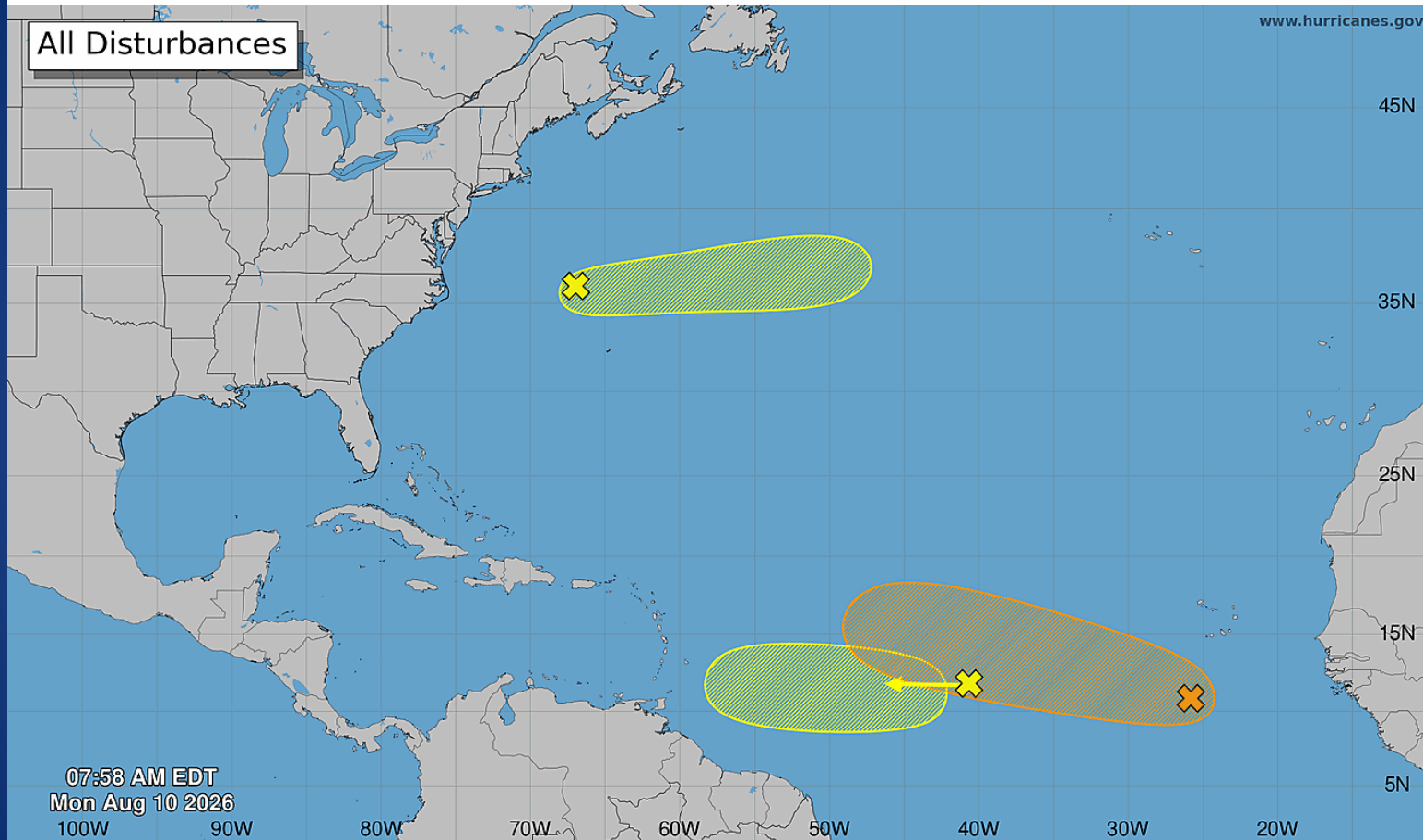
Seven-Day Graphical Tropical Weather Outlook

Hot Temperatures Continue Through Thursday

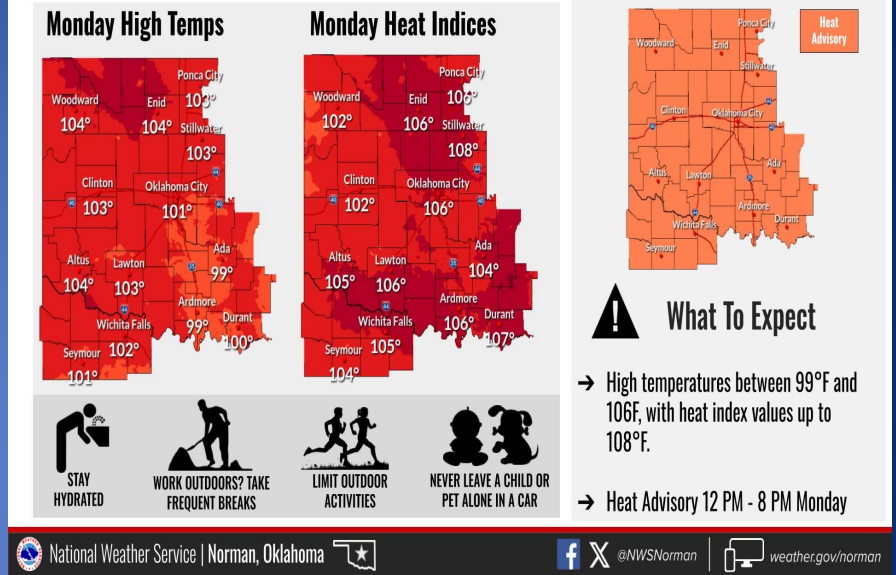

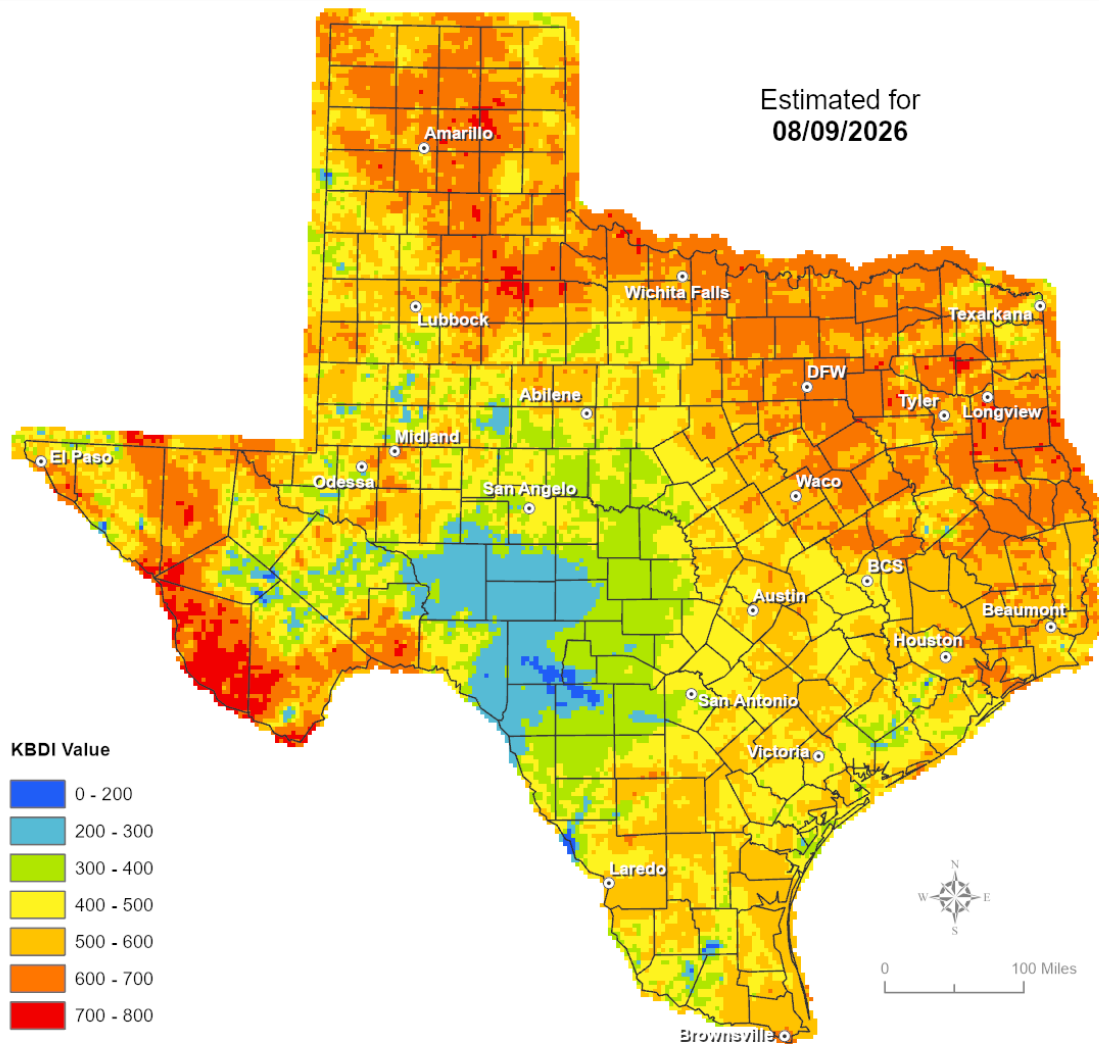

Report of 818 fires and 110,201 acres have been burned this year. There are **113 (+1)** counties with burn bans. The Keetch–Byram Drought Index list contains **229 (+4)** counties with an average over 400.
