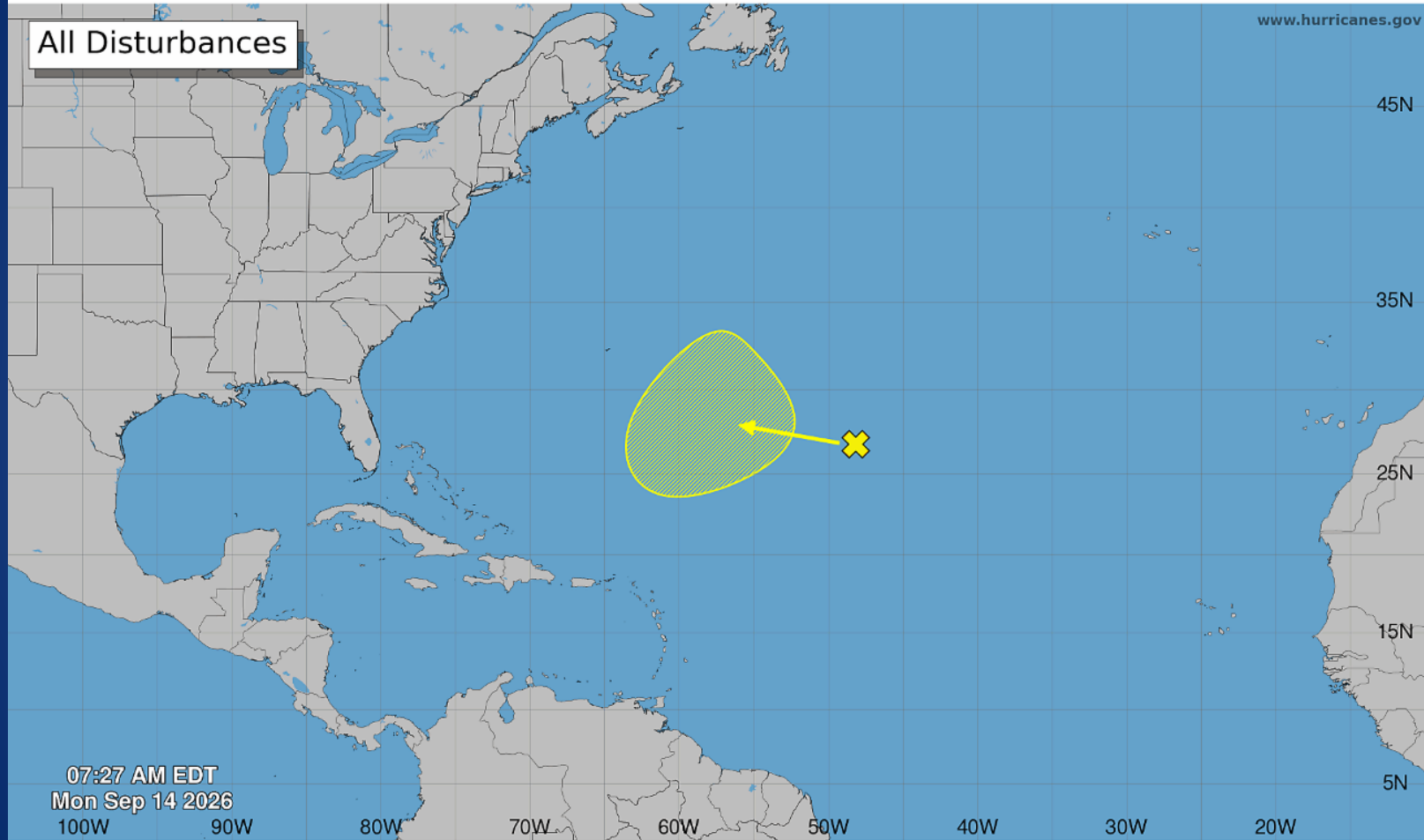
Seven-Day Graphical Tropical Weather Outlook

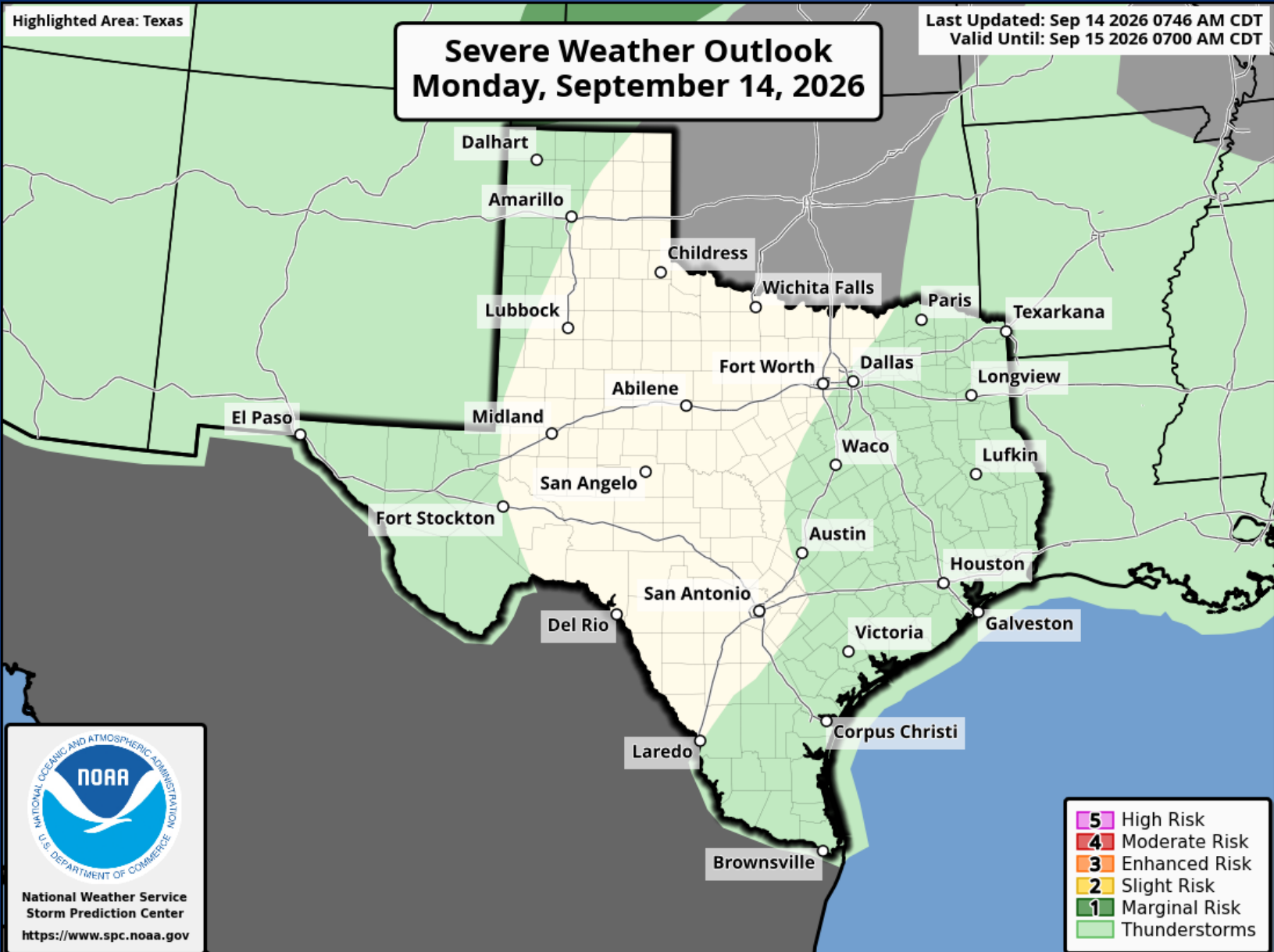

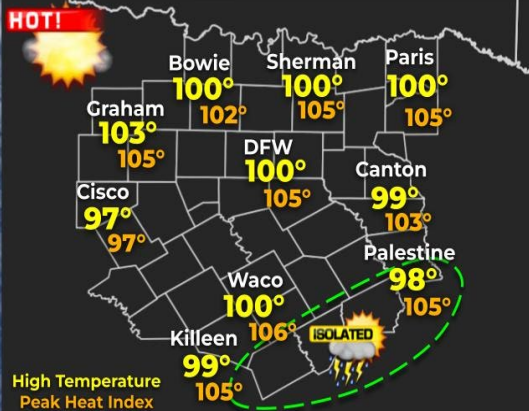

Scattered Showers and Storms Tuesday

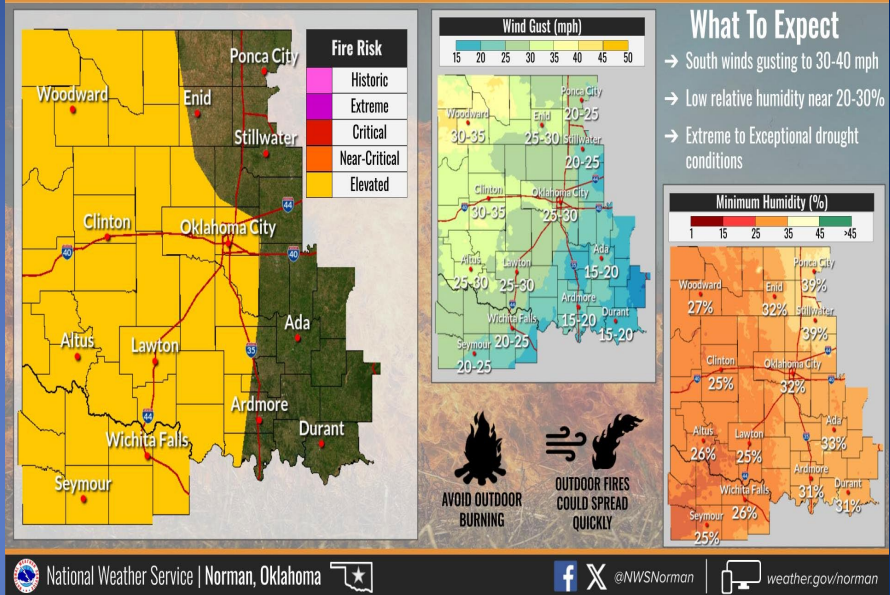

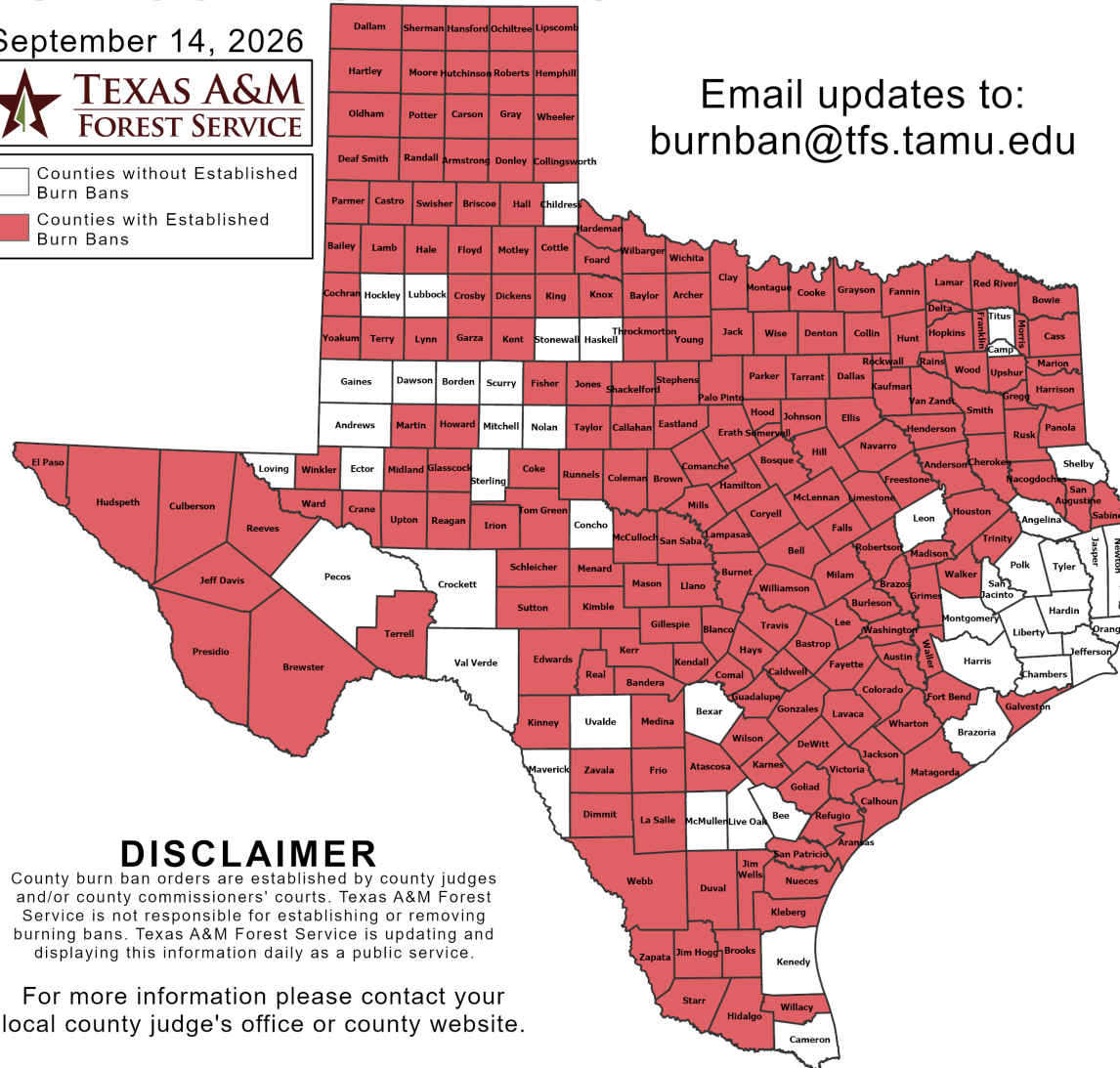

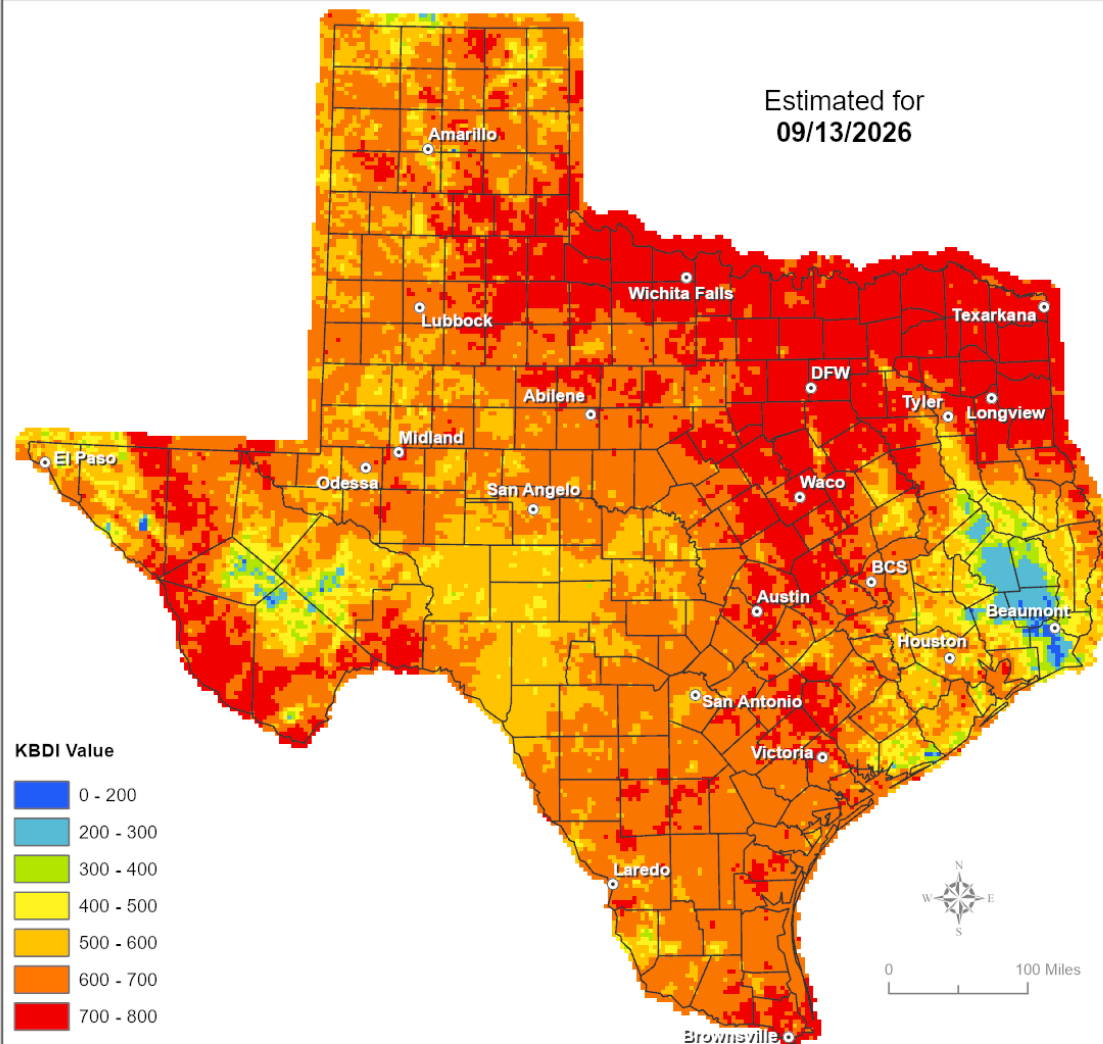
